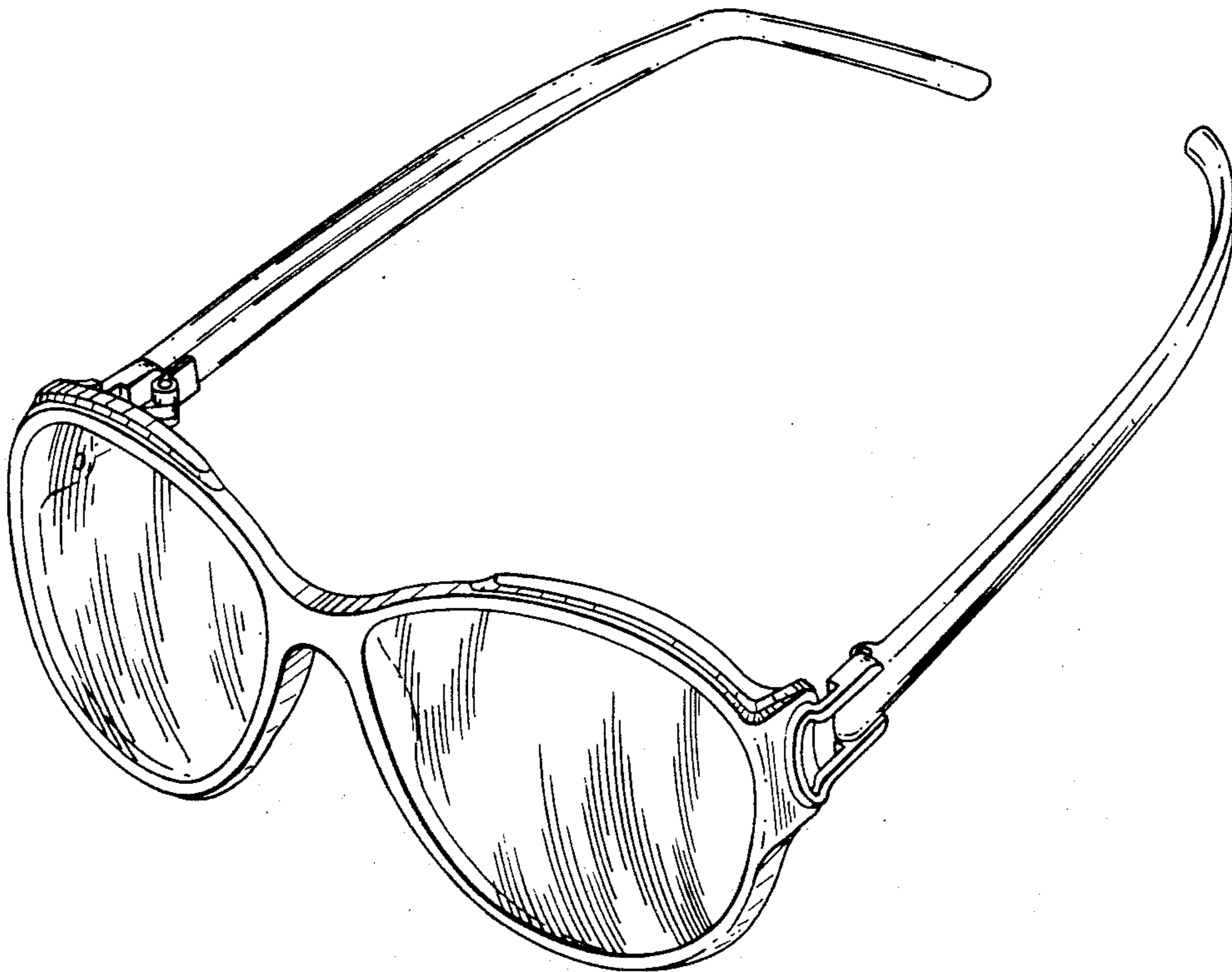
The ornamental design for a pair of spectacles, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image.



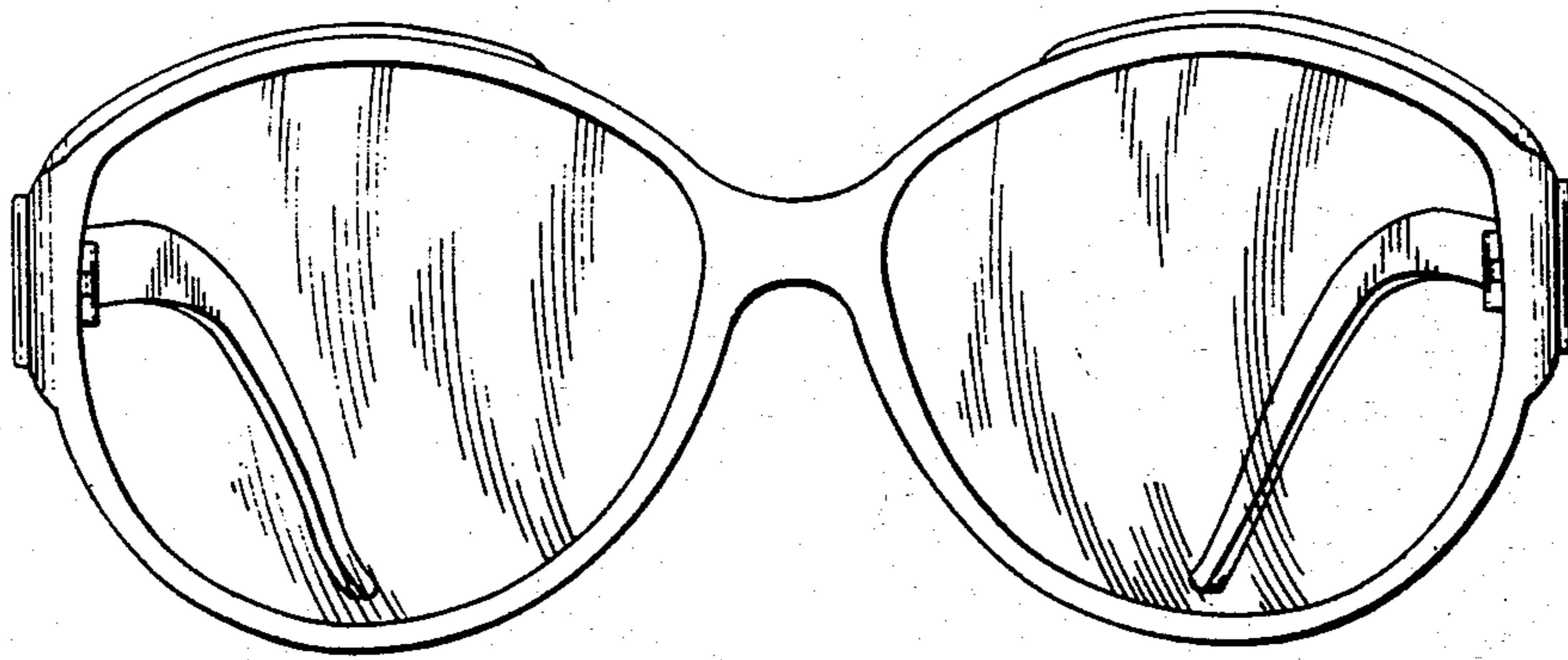

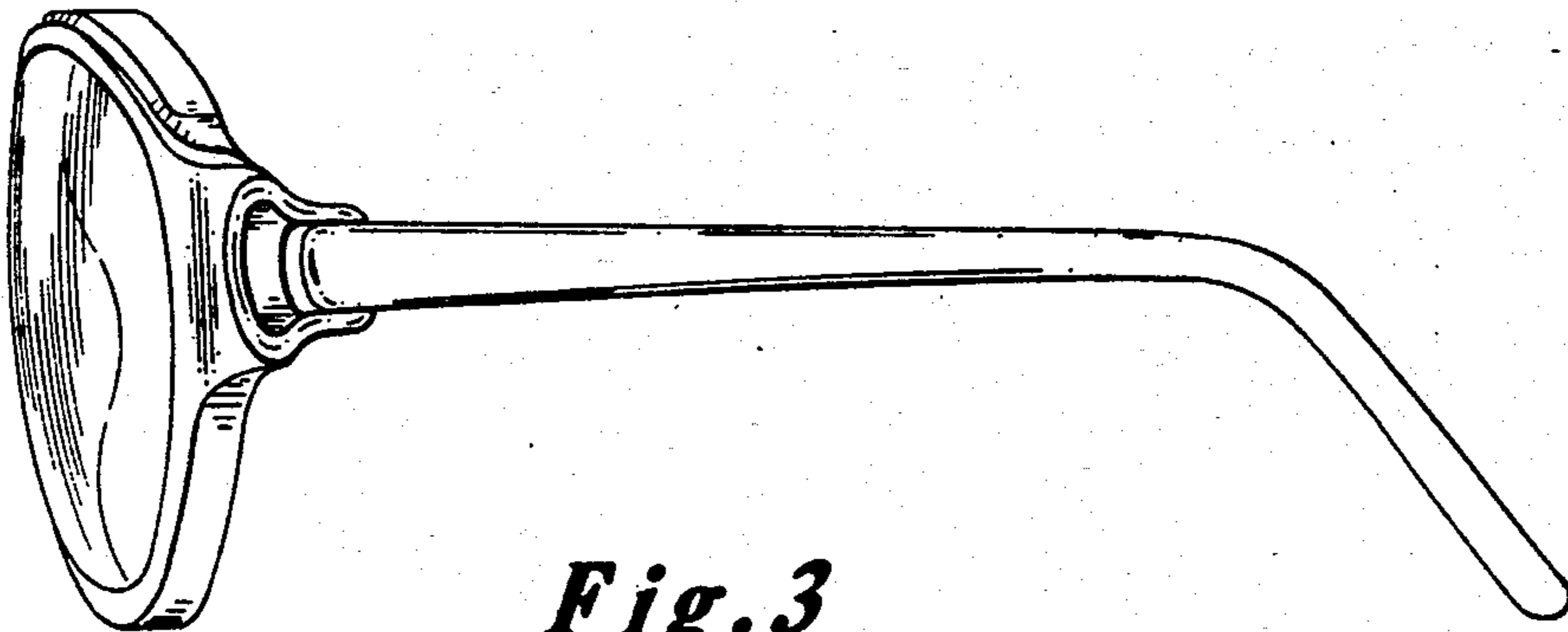

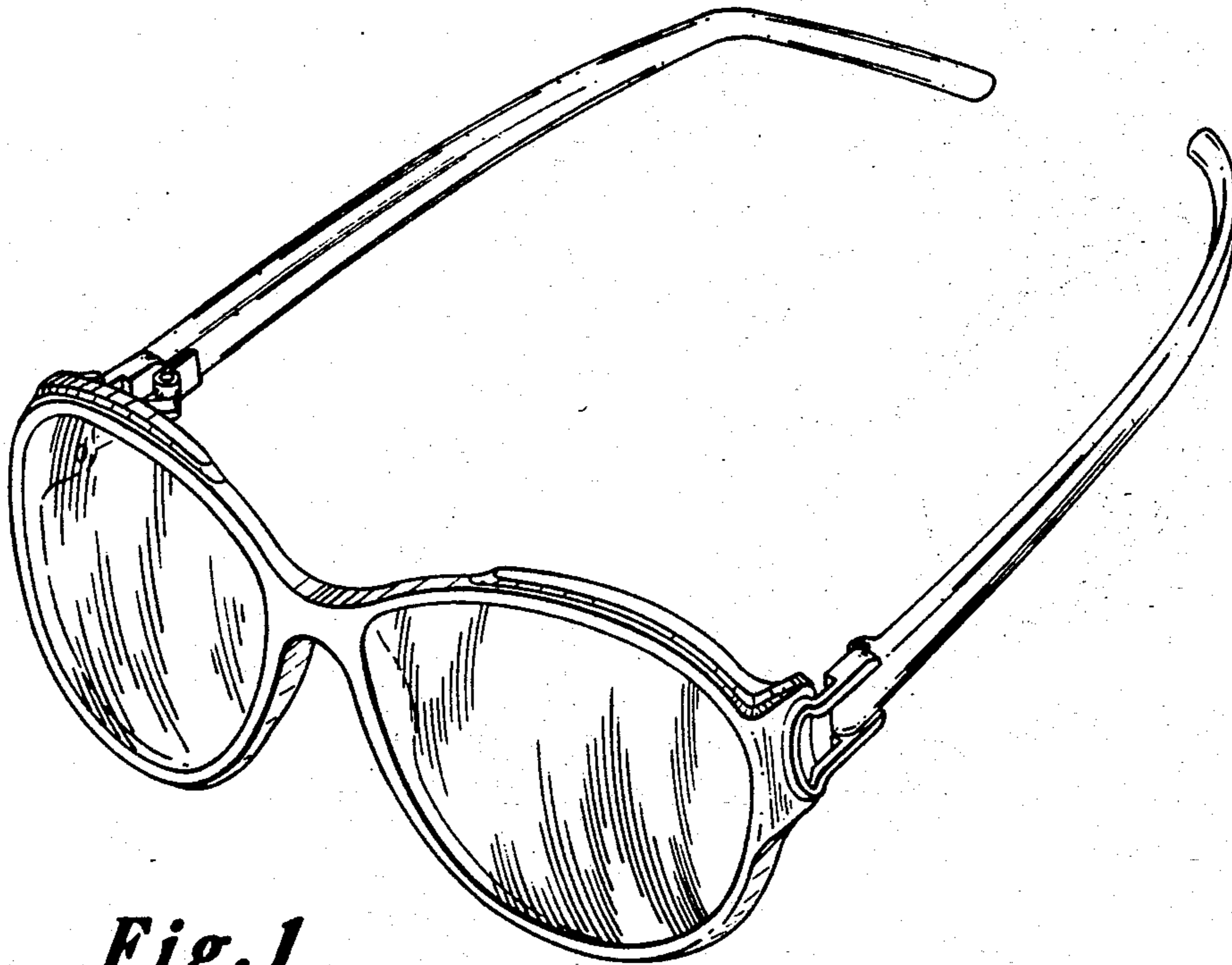
