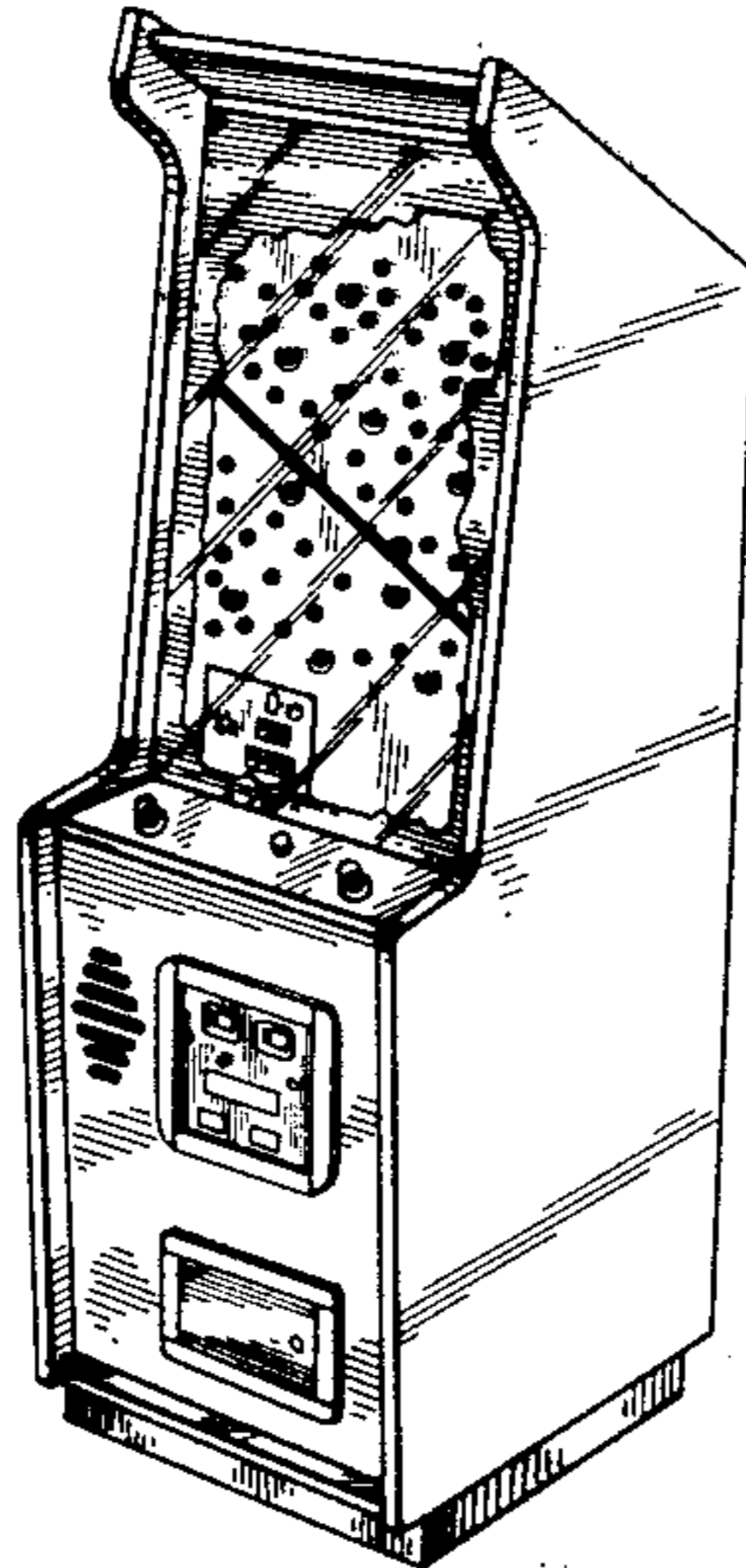

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electromechanical amusement housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an electromechanical amusement housing showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof. FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of the upper portion of the design showing the playing field area.



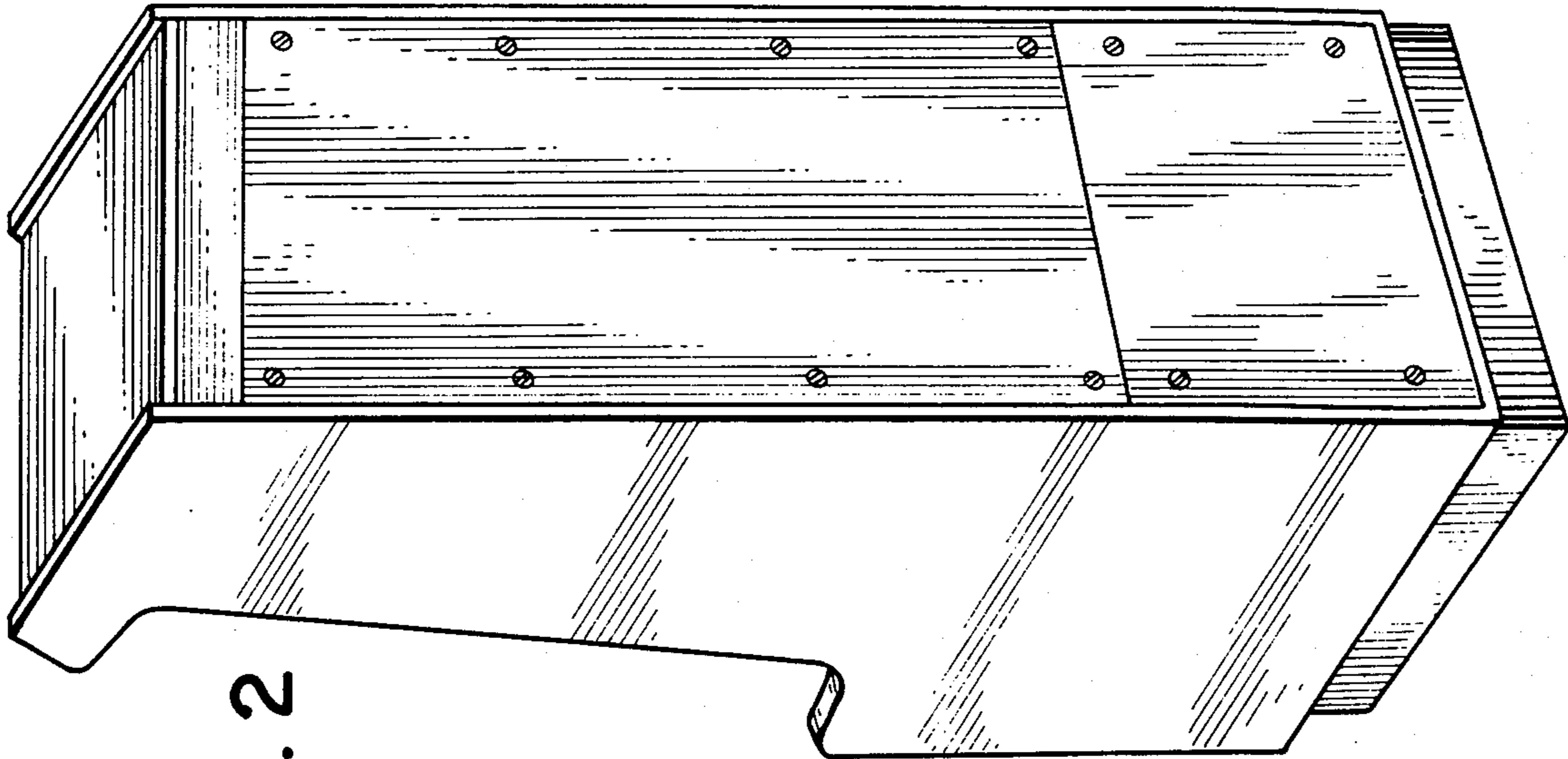

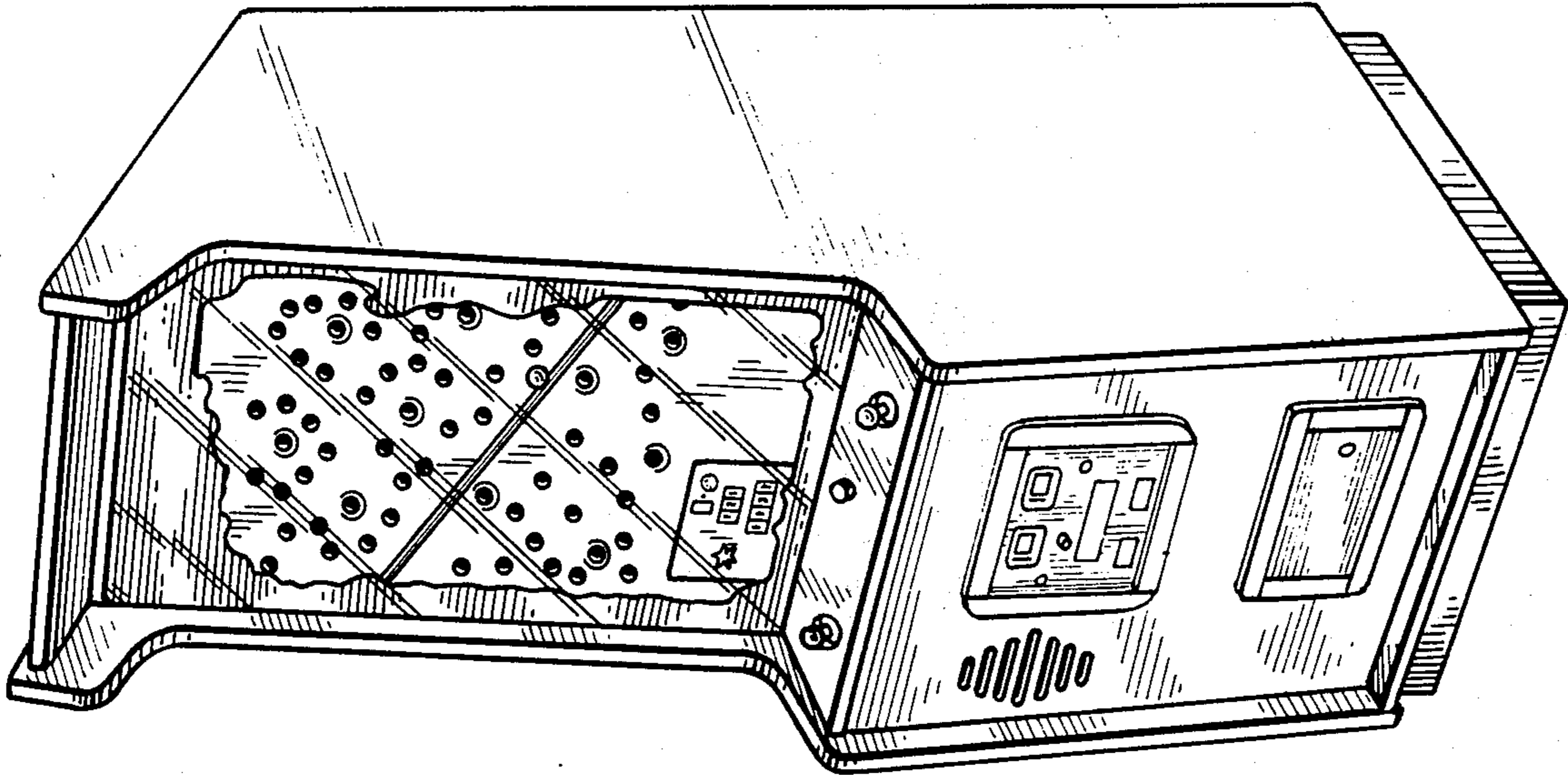
