## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy bear showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right elevational view thereof; the left side is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
