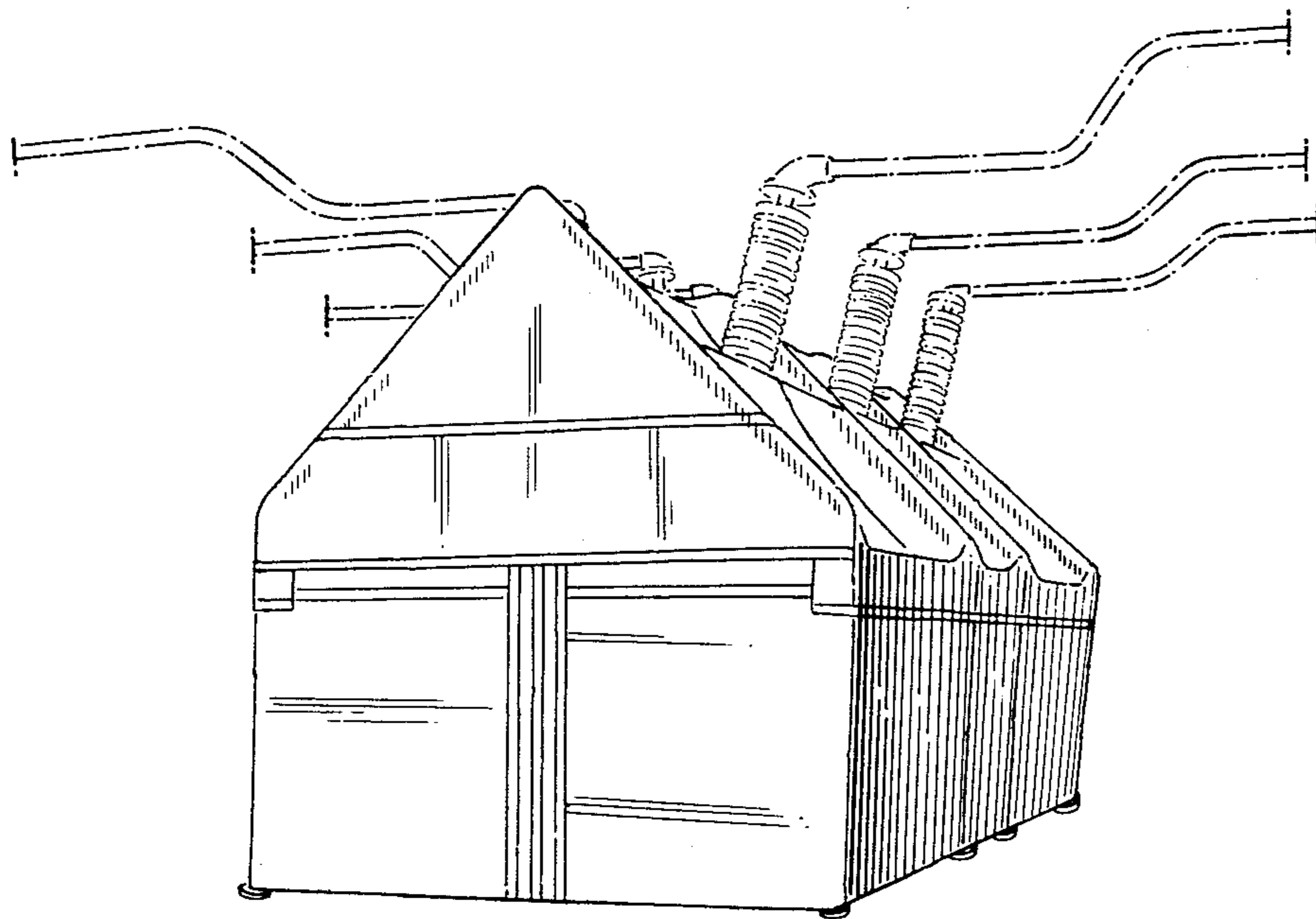
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a frame and cloth shelter, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the frame and cloth shelter assembled to protect a circuit breaker apparatus; FIG. 2 is an isometric view of the frame for such shelter; FIG. 3 is an isometric view of said shelter depicted in FIG. 1. The dotted lines in FIG. 1 are disclosed for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

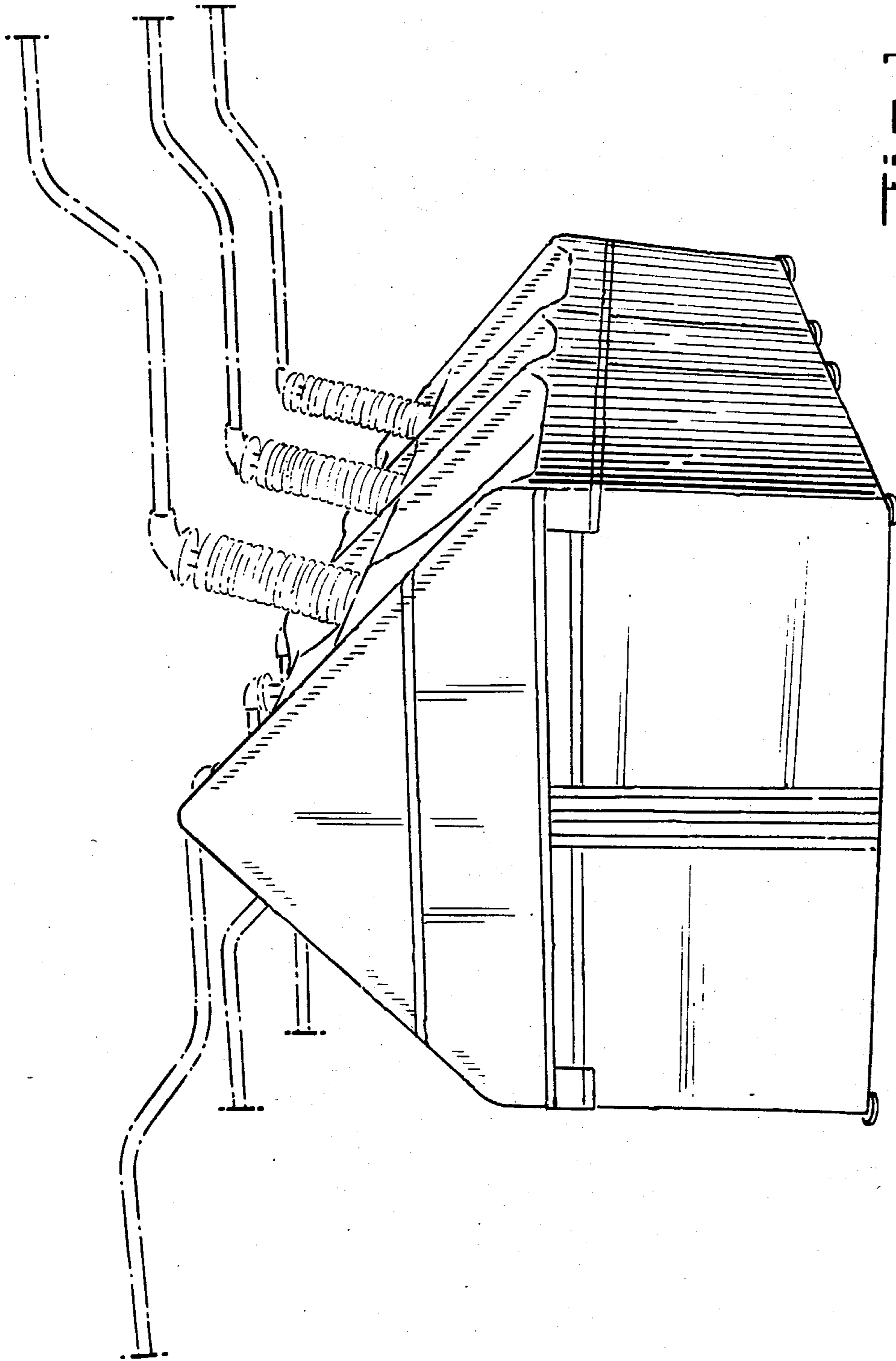

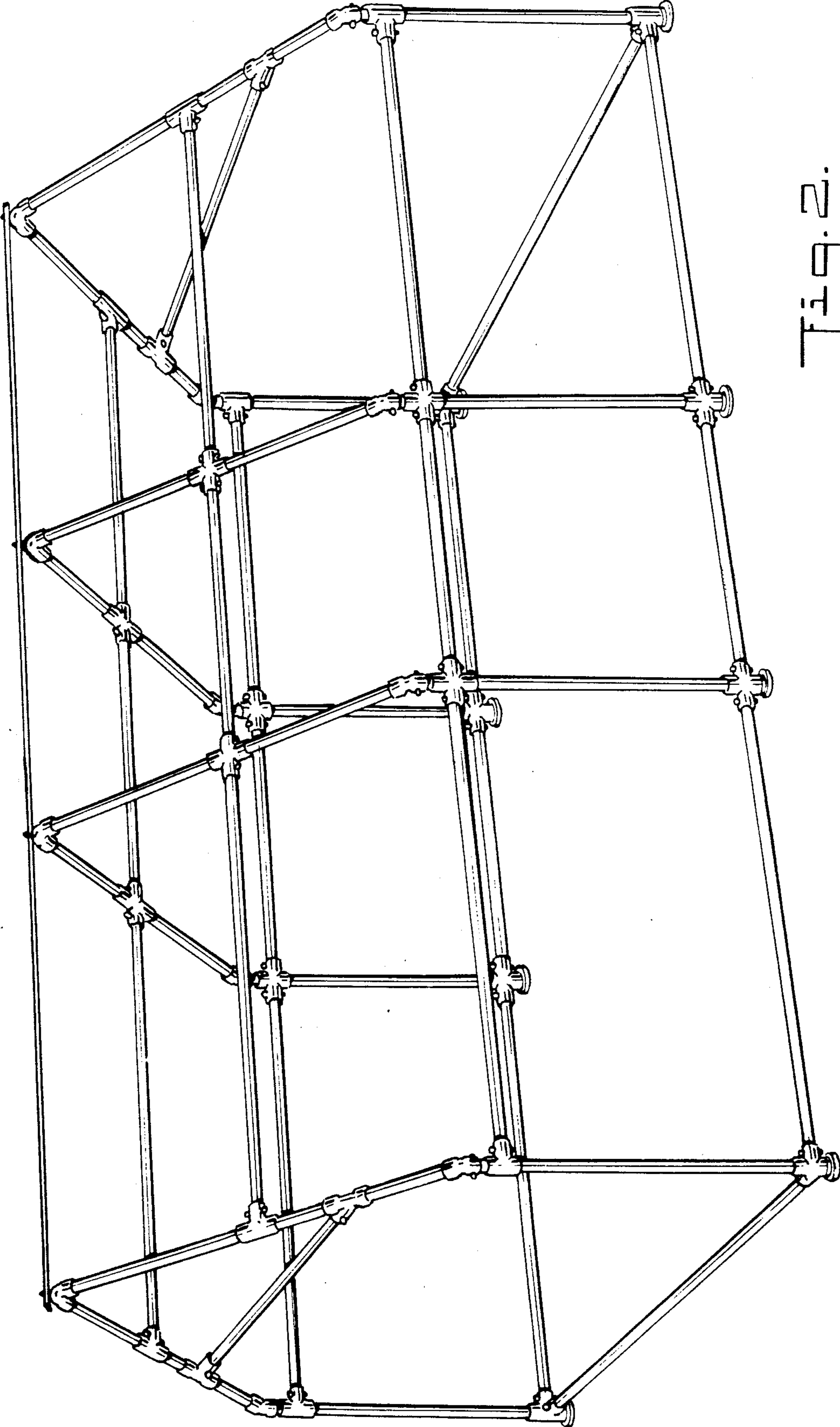

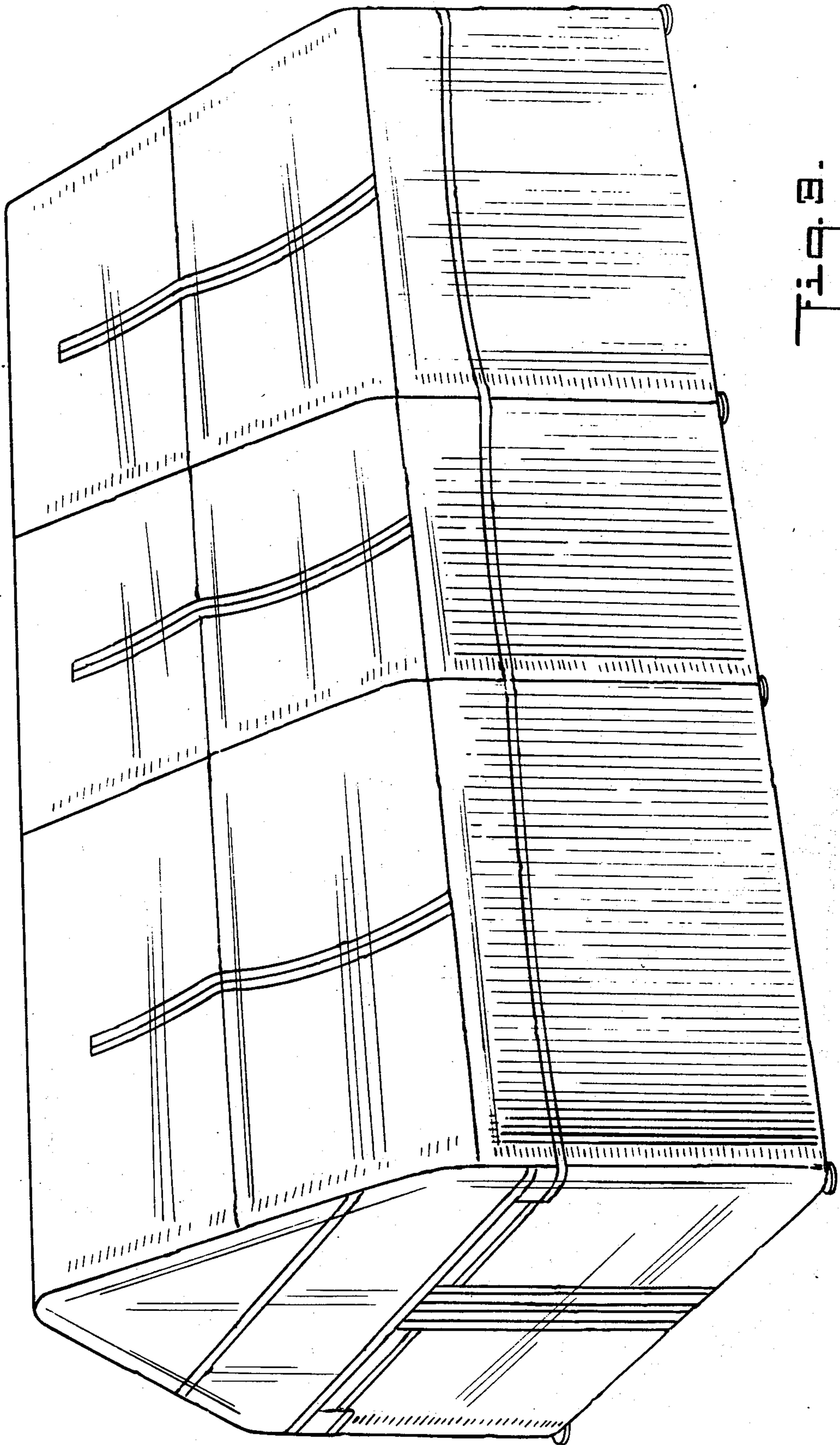
