

## **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a gravy boat stand, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a gravy boat stand showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIGS. 3-6 are side elevational views as taken in the direction of the respective arrows 3-6 in FIG. 1; and  
FIG. 7 is a sectional view as taken along the line 7—7 in FIG. 1.








