[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bread bag clip, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a bread bag clip showing my new design, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

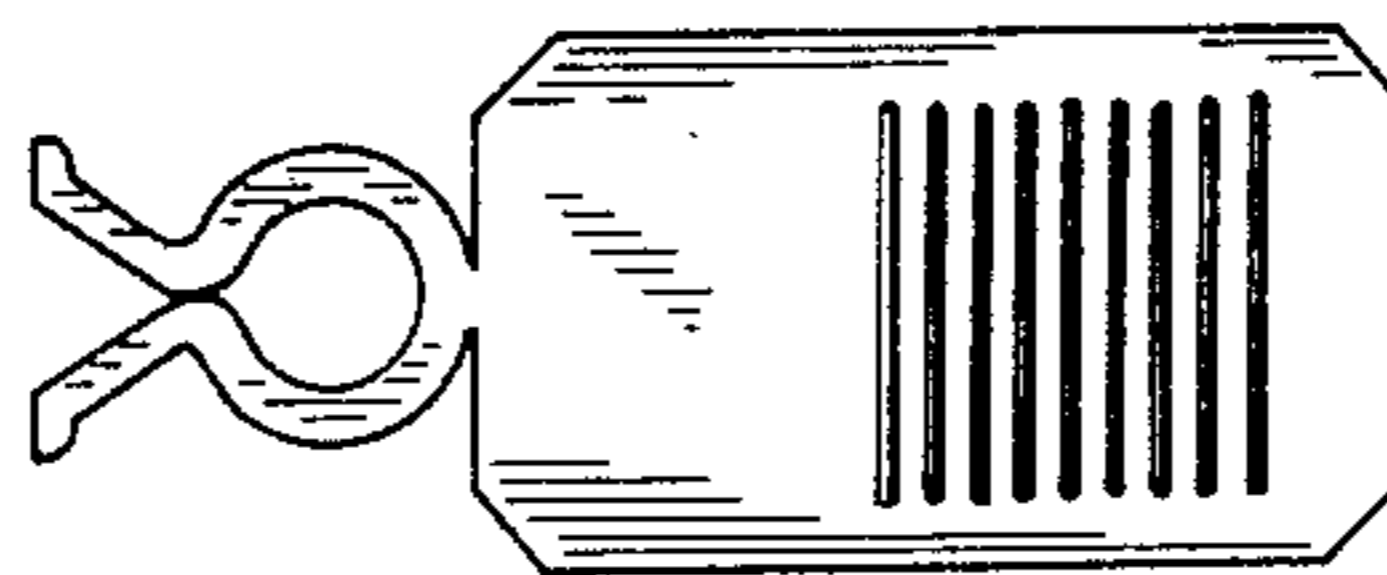

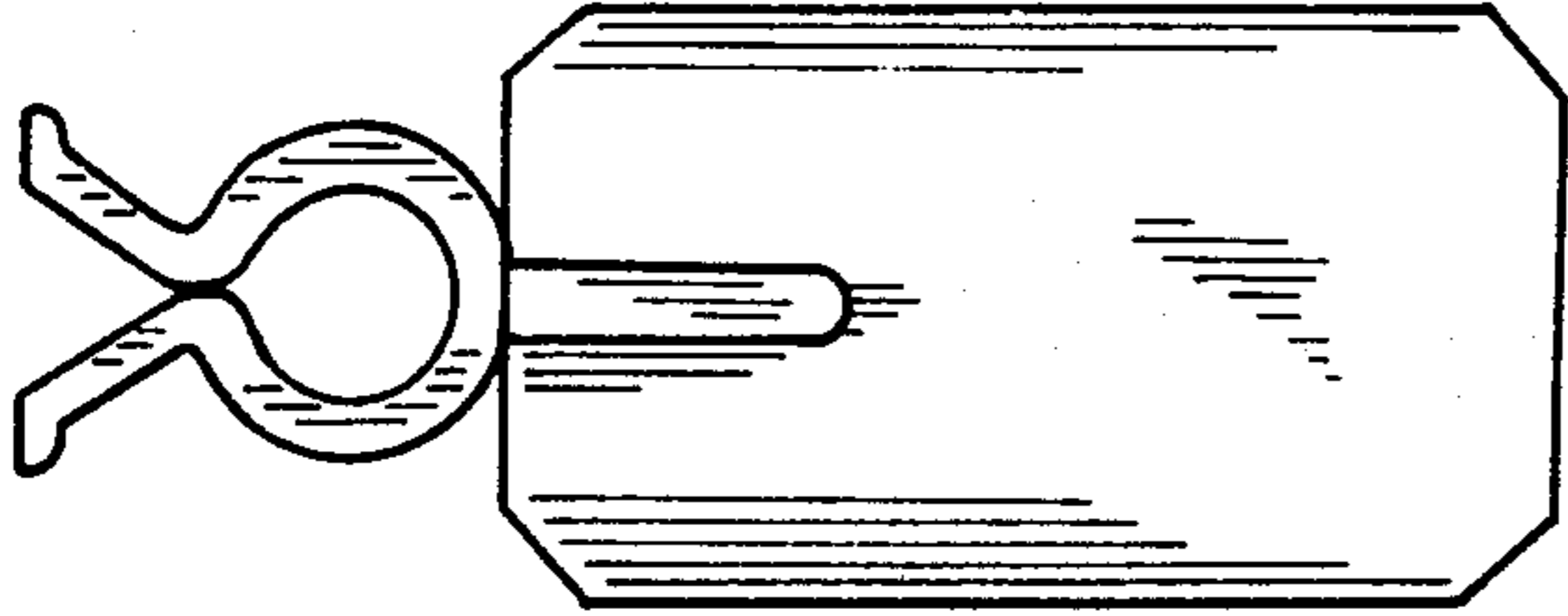

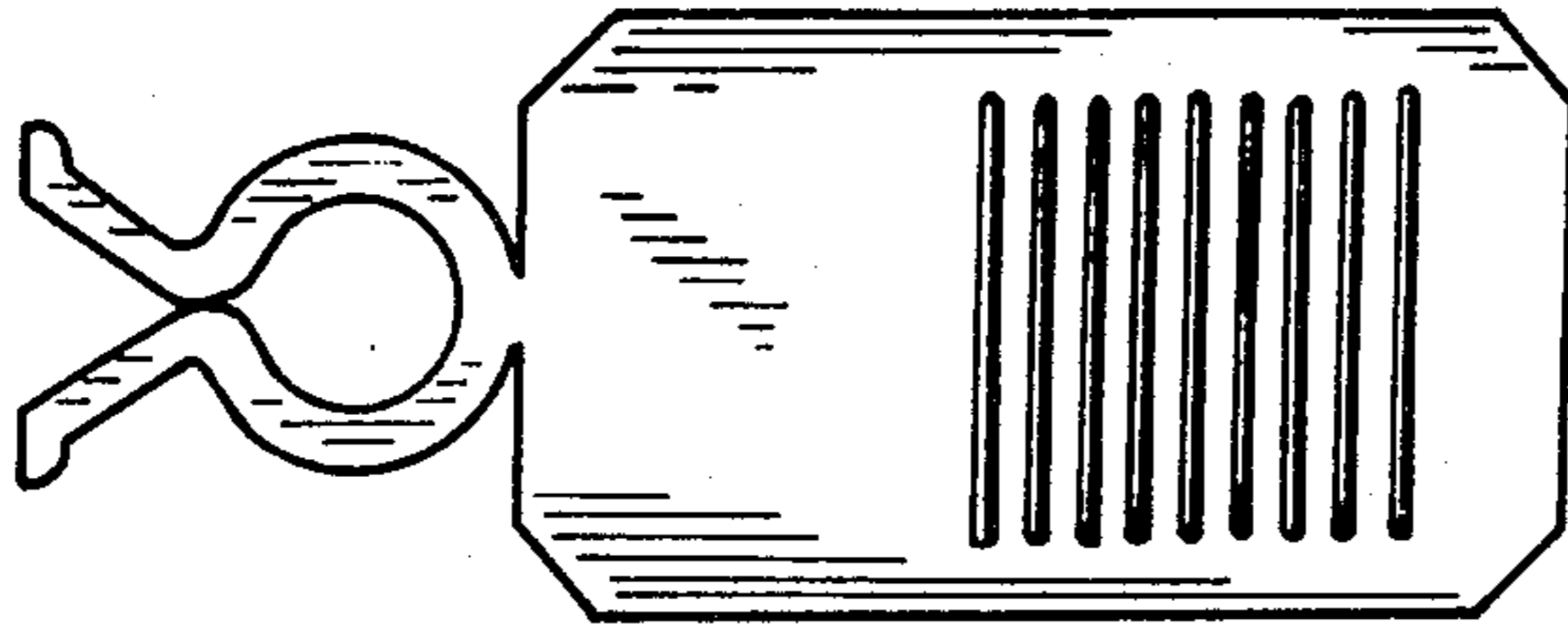
