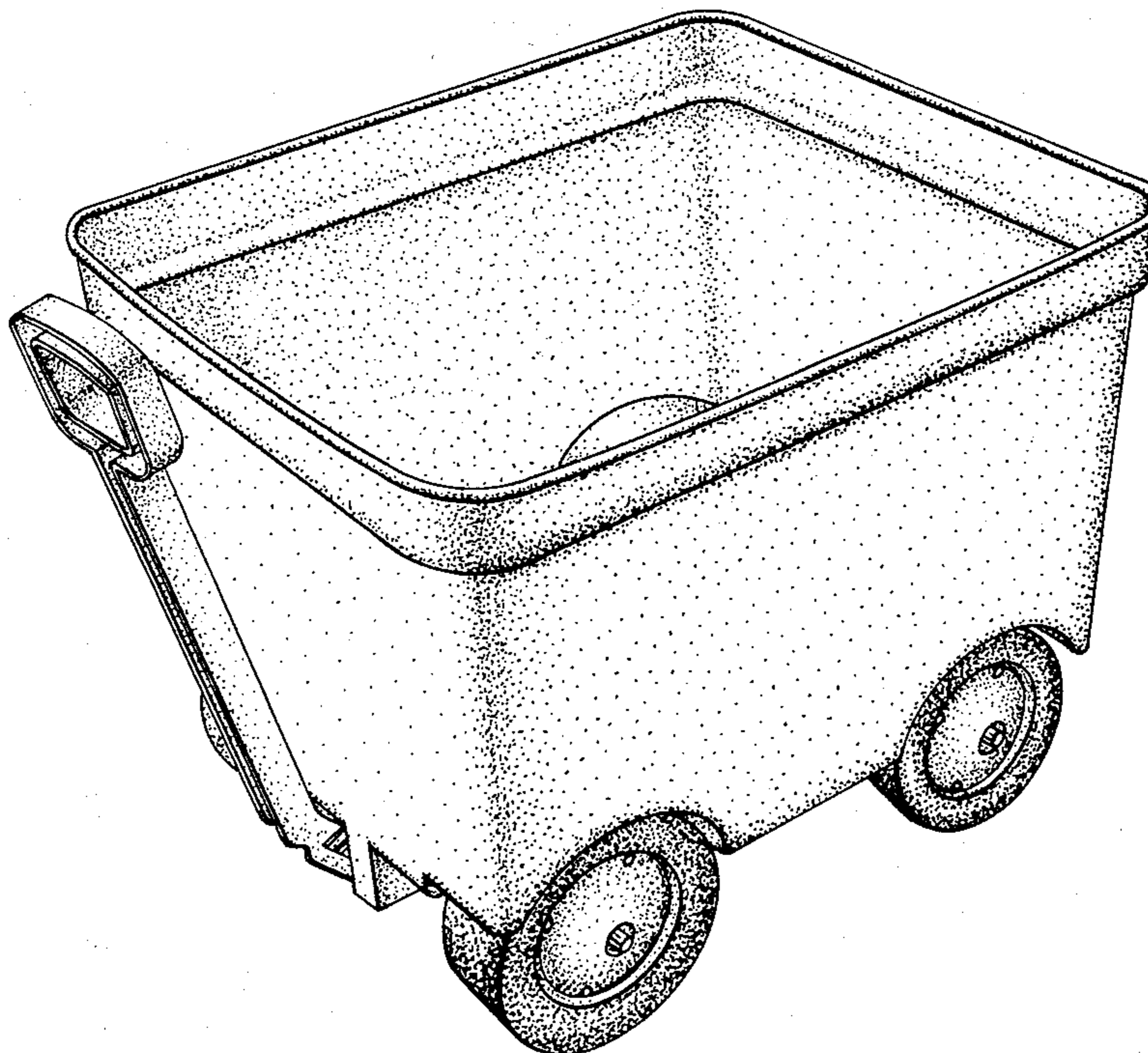
The ornamental design for a toy wagon, as shown and described.

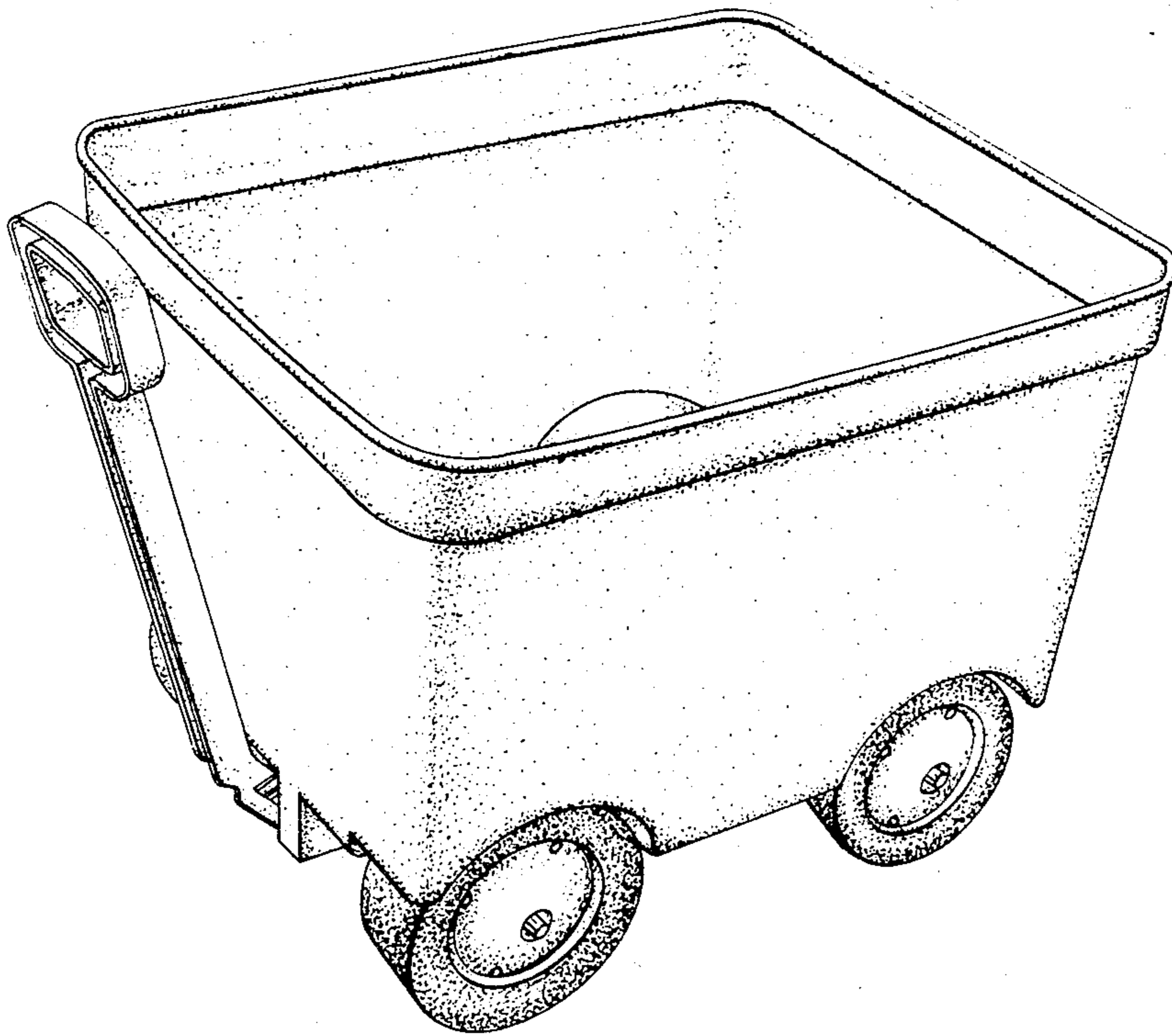
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy wagon showing my new design, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and,

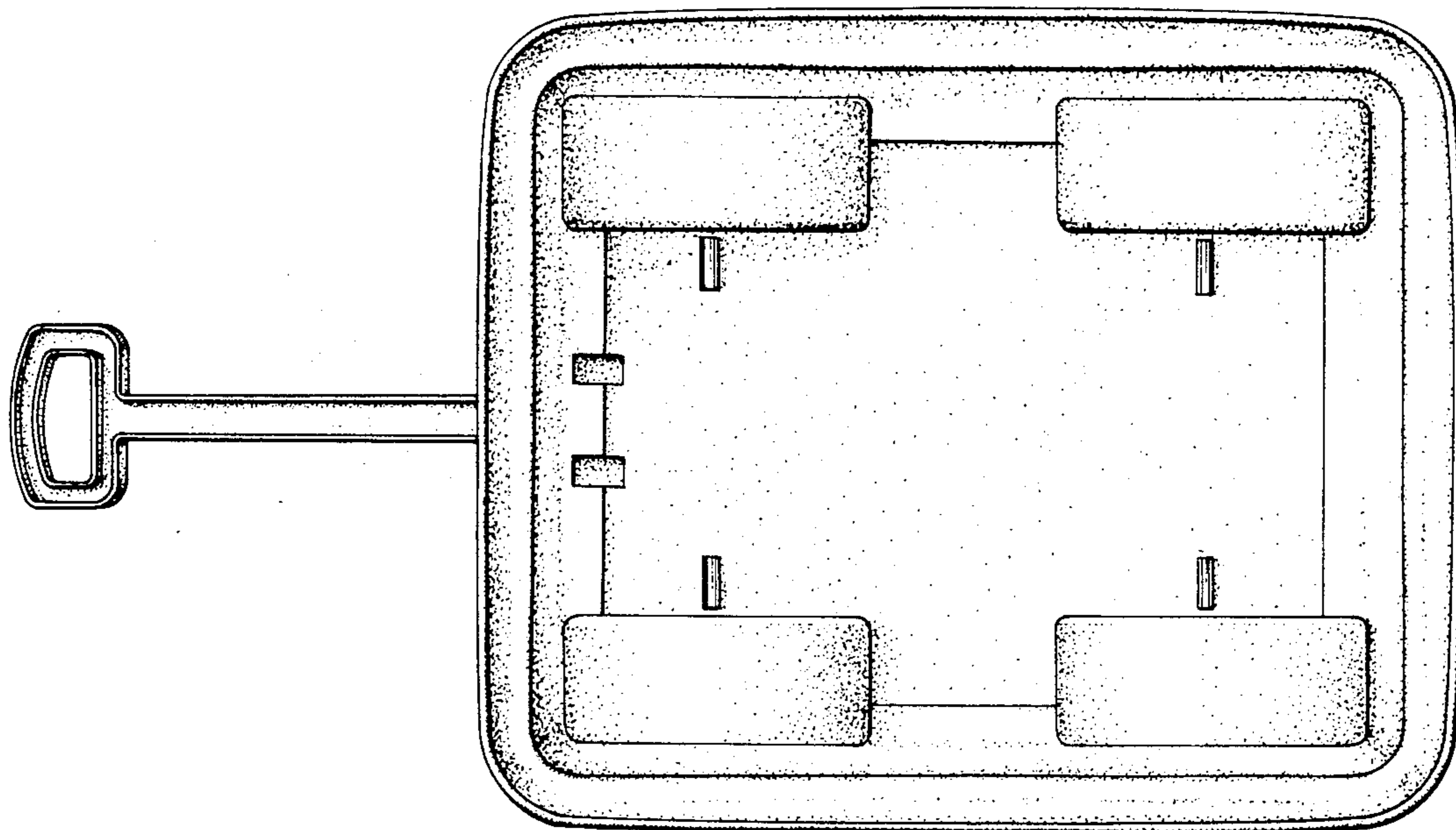
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.
