DESCRIPTION

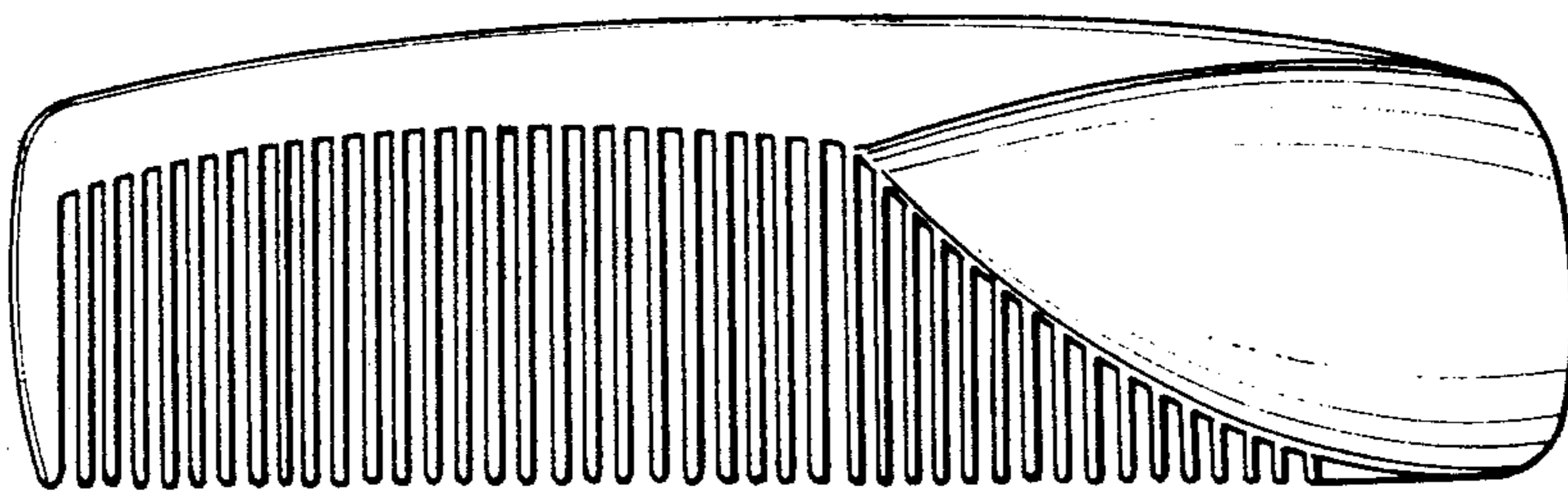
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined comb and shoehorn showing my new design;

The rear is unadorned.



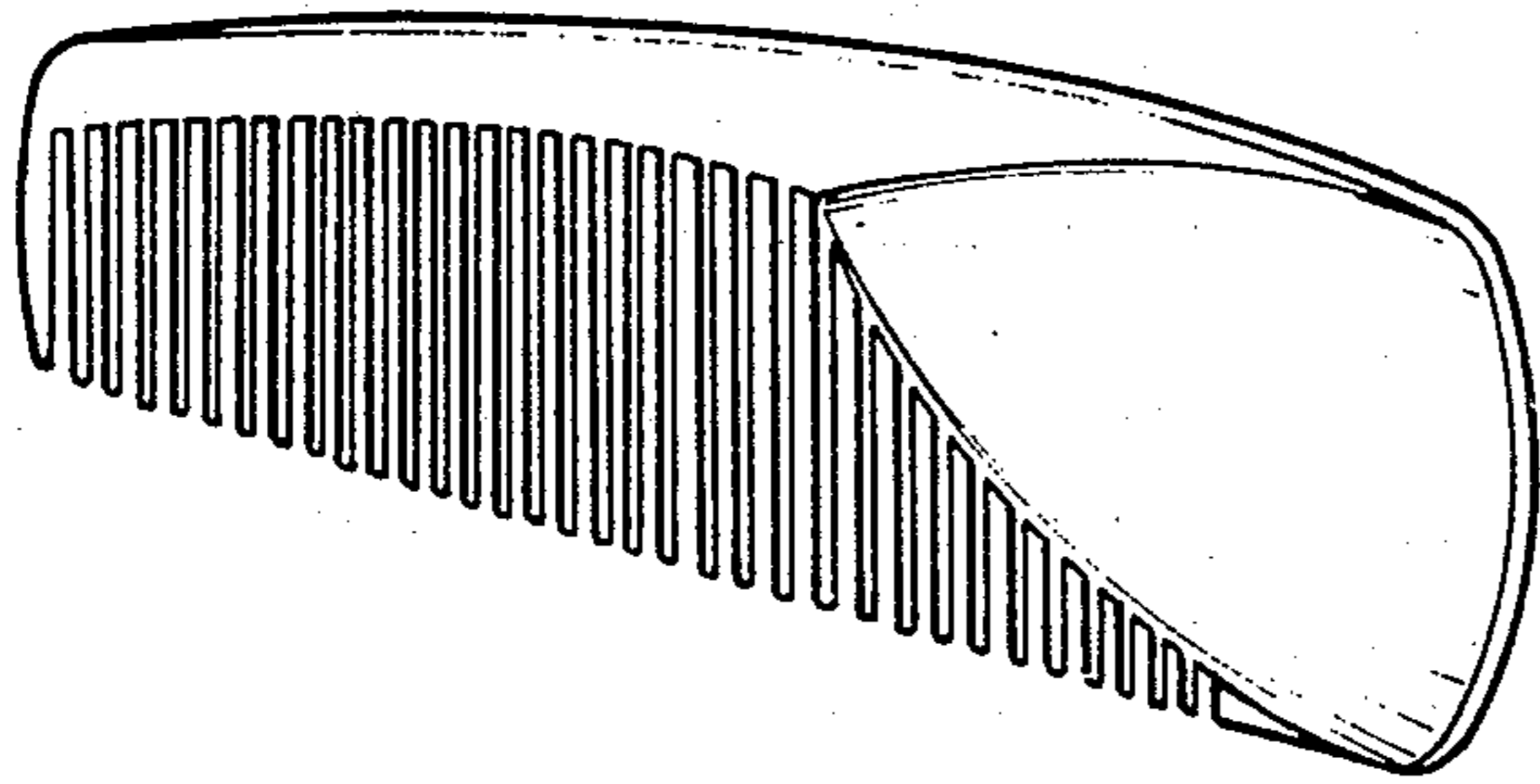

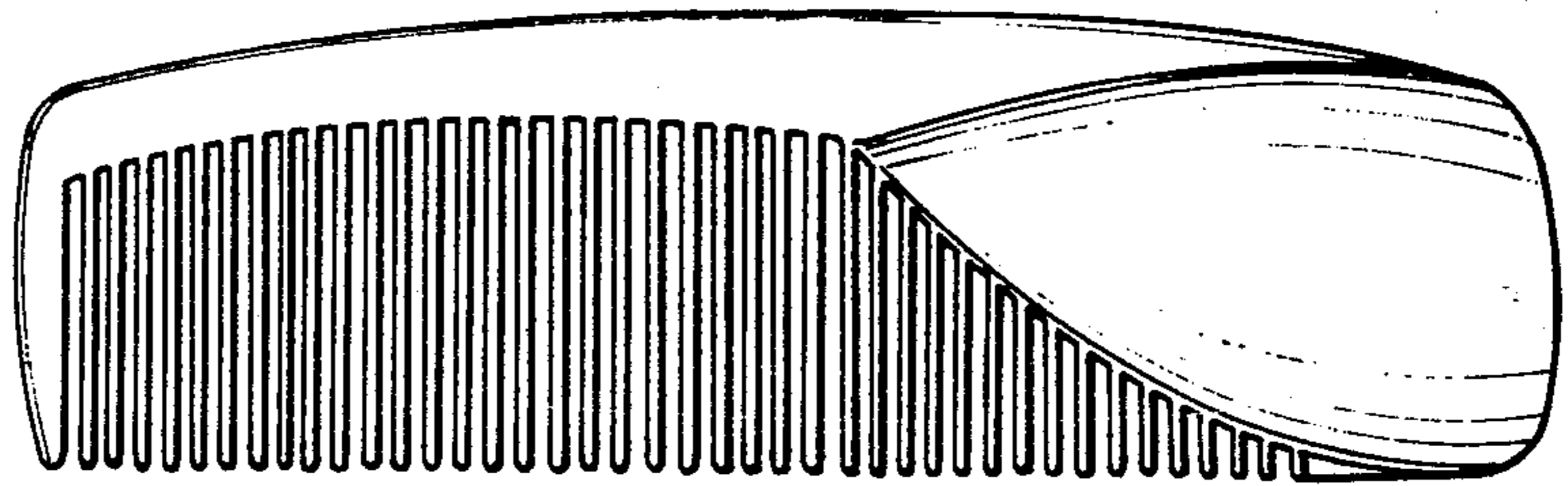
