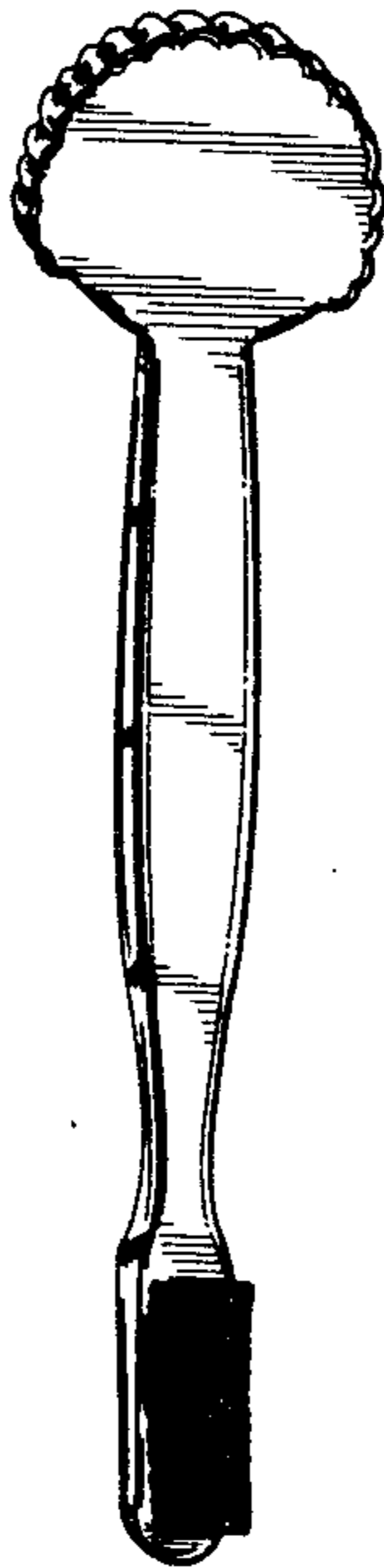

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the enlarged area at the end of the handle.



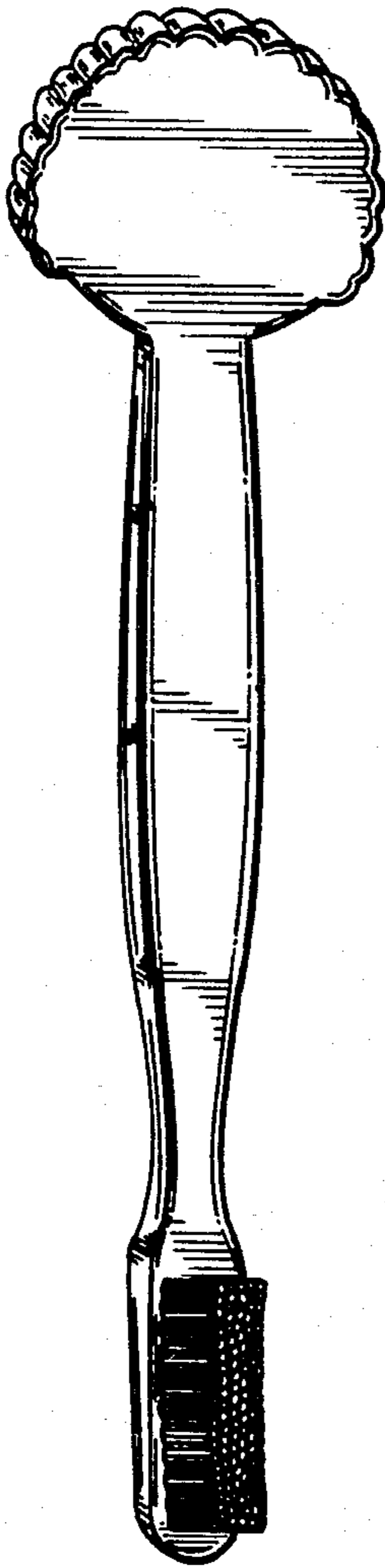

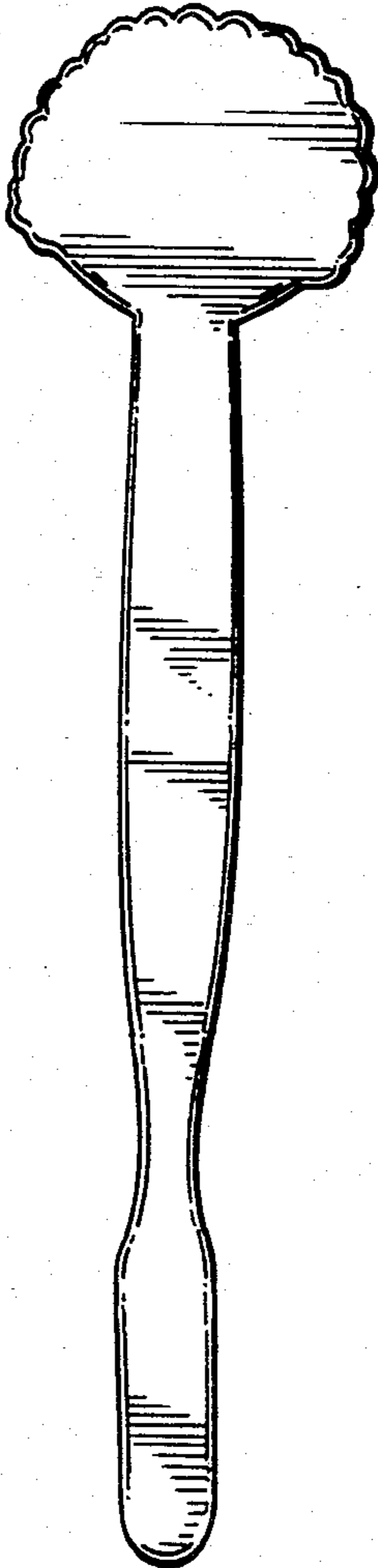
