The ornamental design for a soap dish, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a soap dish showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

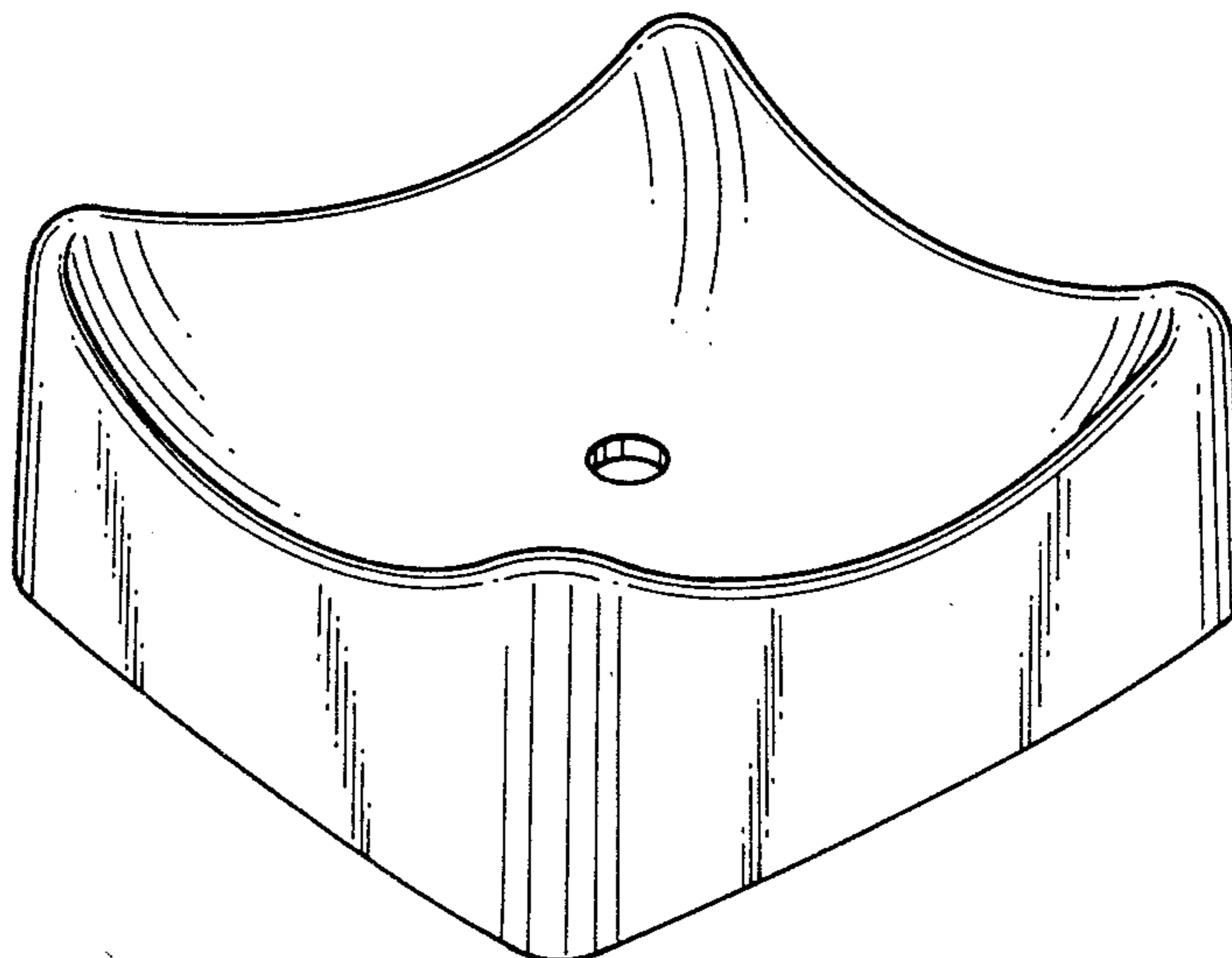

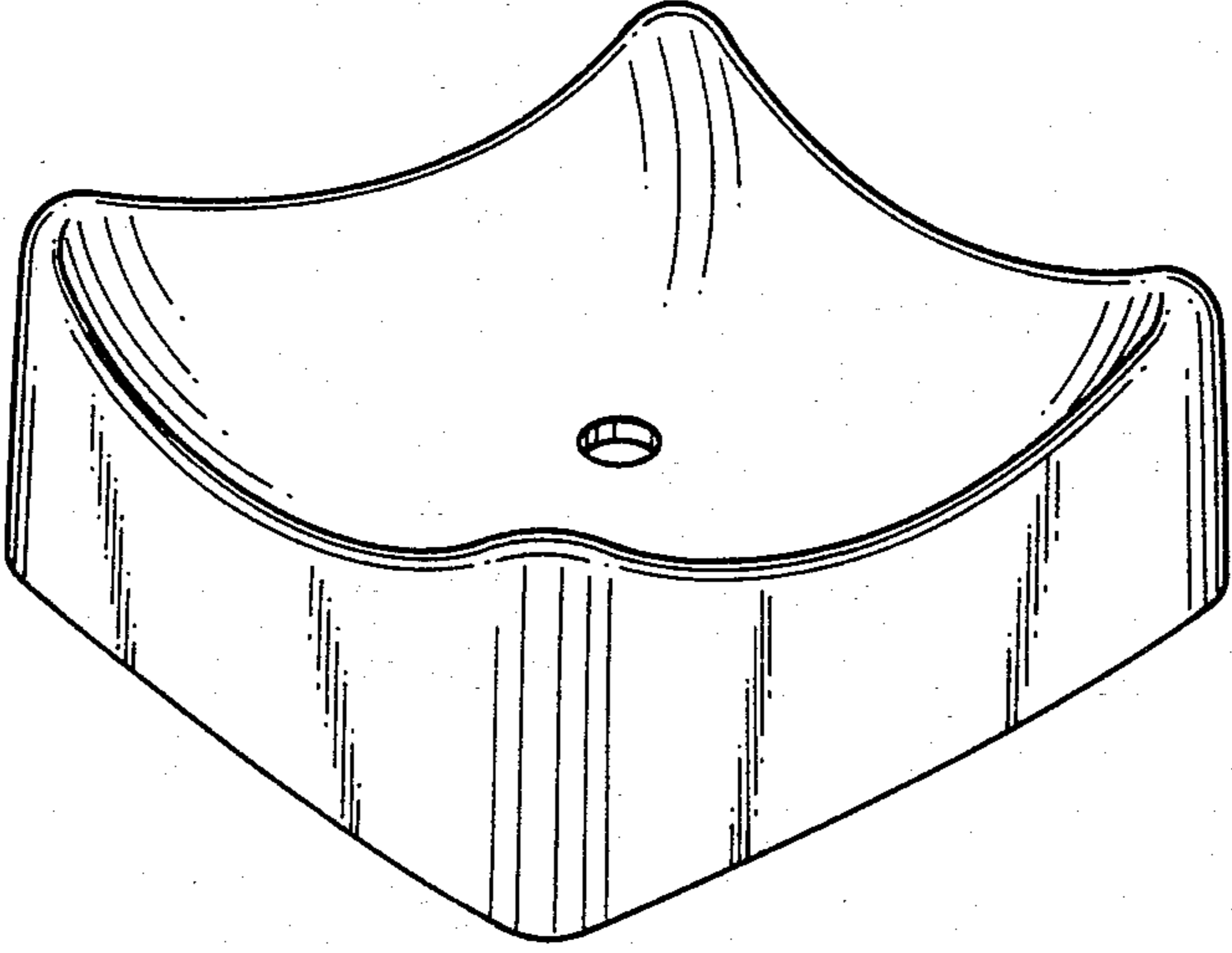

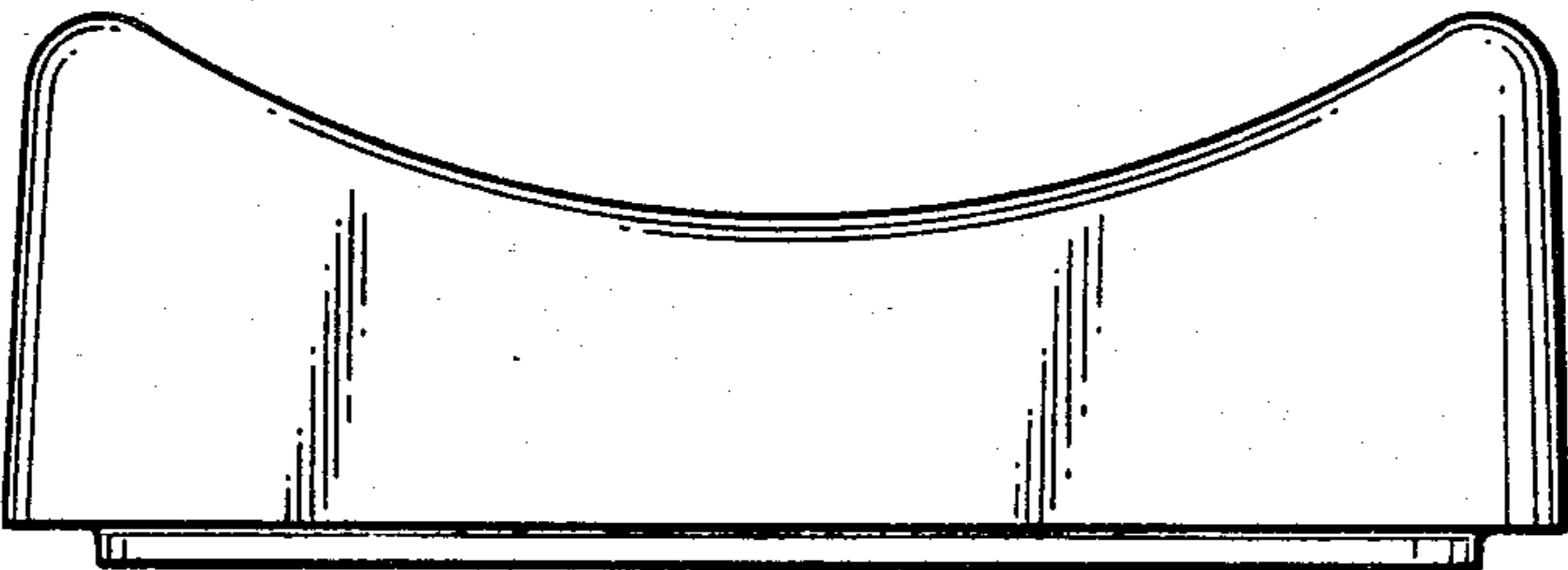

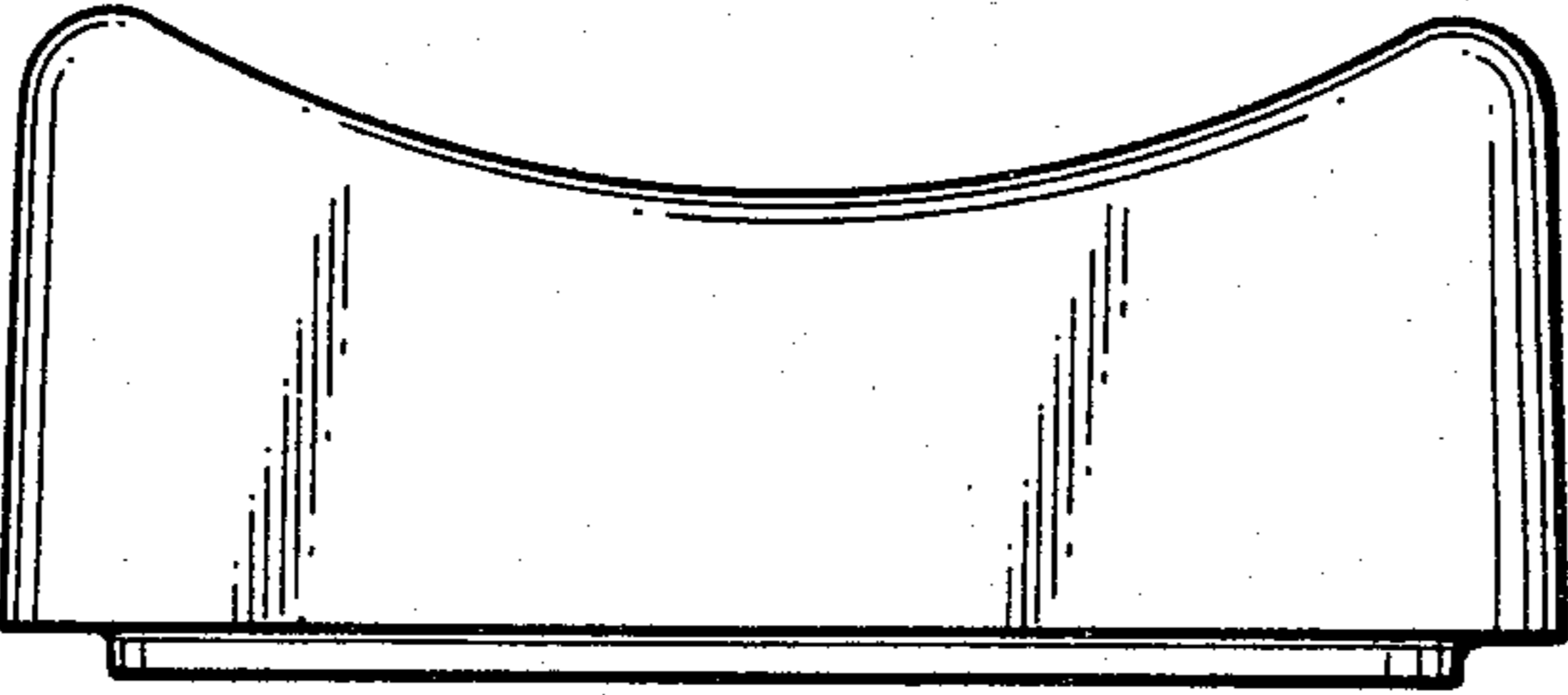

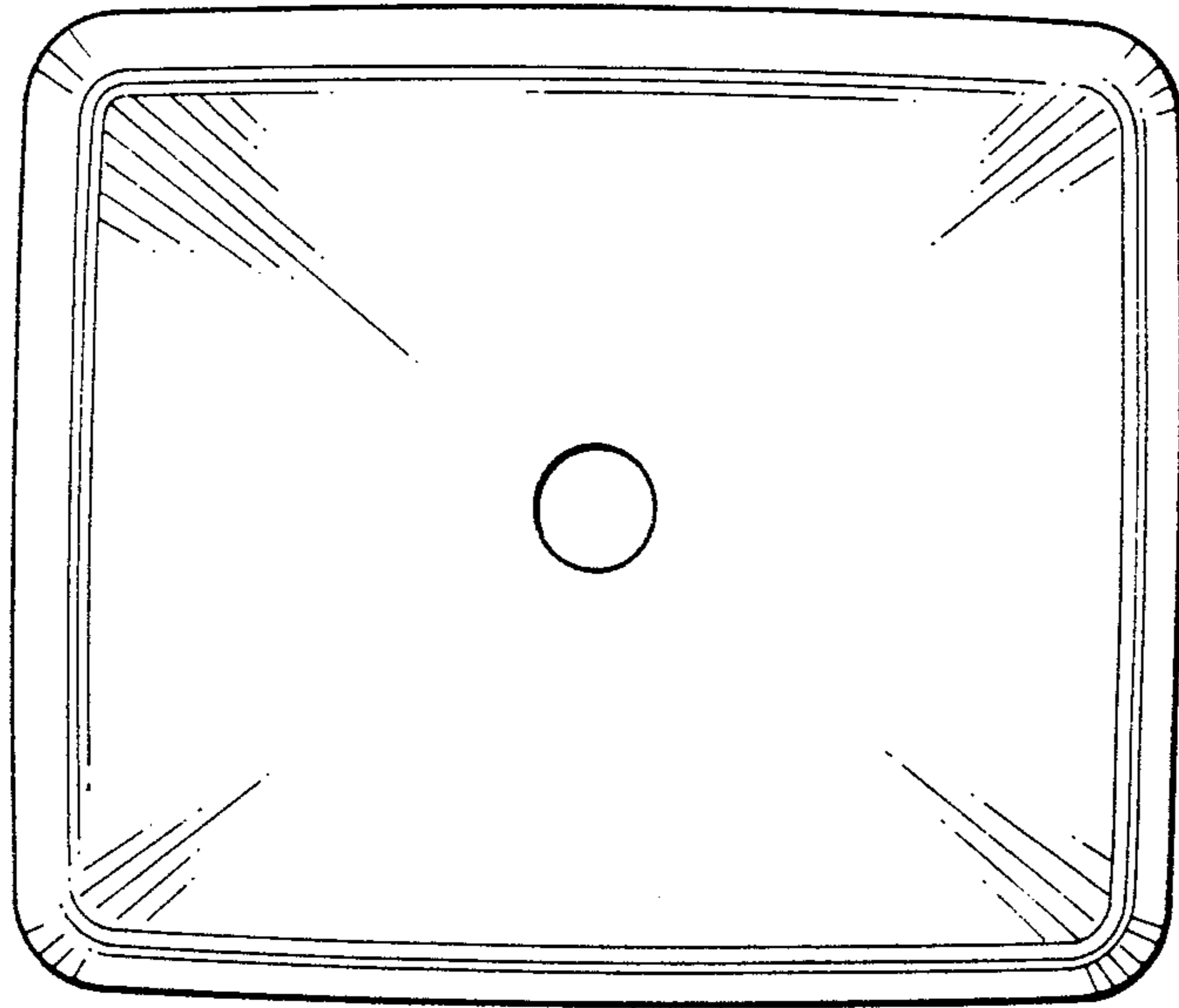
