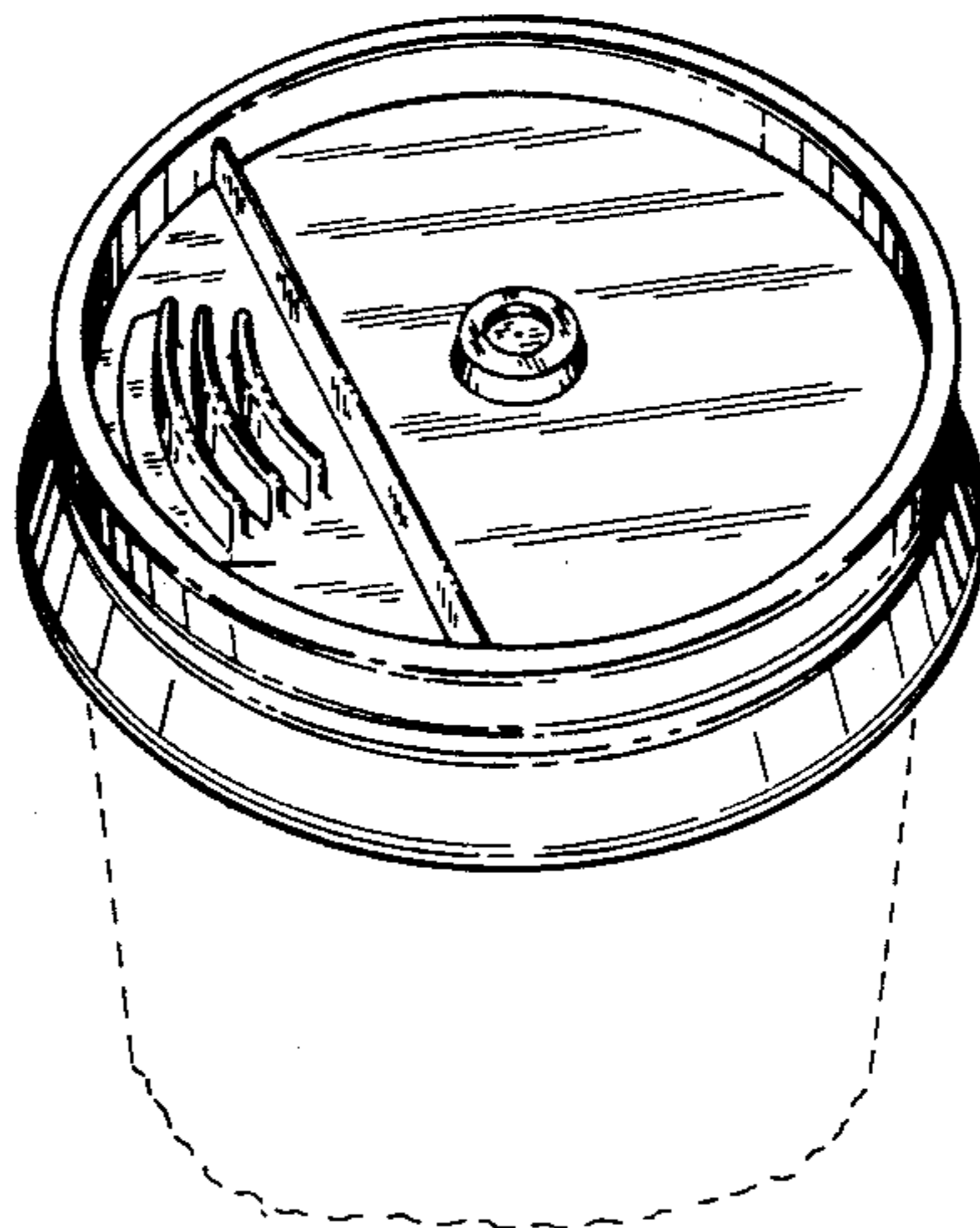

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lid for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lid for a container, showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof, taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1, the broken lines indicating liquid and a fragmentary cup wall are shown for illustrative purposes only;  
 FIG. 6 is a fragmentary top plan view of a second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 6;  
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 9 is a side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 11—11 of FIG. 8;  
 FIG. 12 is a fragmentary top plan view of a fourth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 13 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 13—13 of FIG. 12;  
 FIG. 14 is a top perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1, the broken lines indicating a cup are shown for illustrative purposes only;  
 FIG. 15 is a top perspective view of the second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 16 is a top perspective view of the third embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1; and  
 FIG. 17 is a top perspective view of the fourth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1.



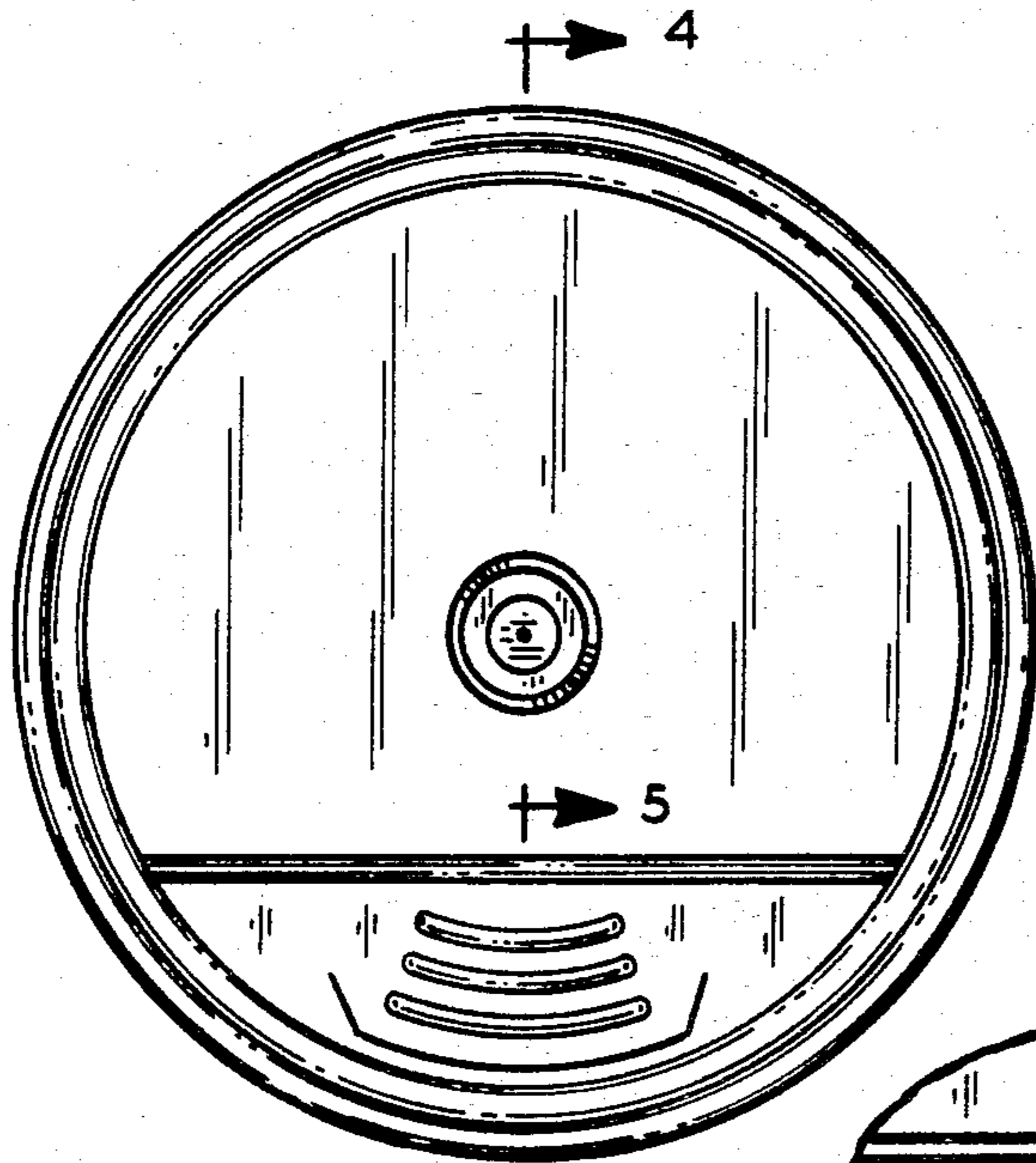

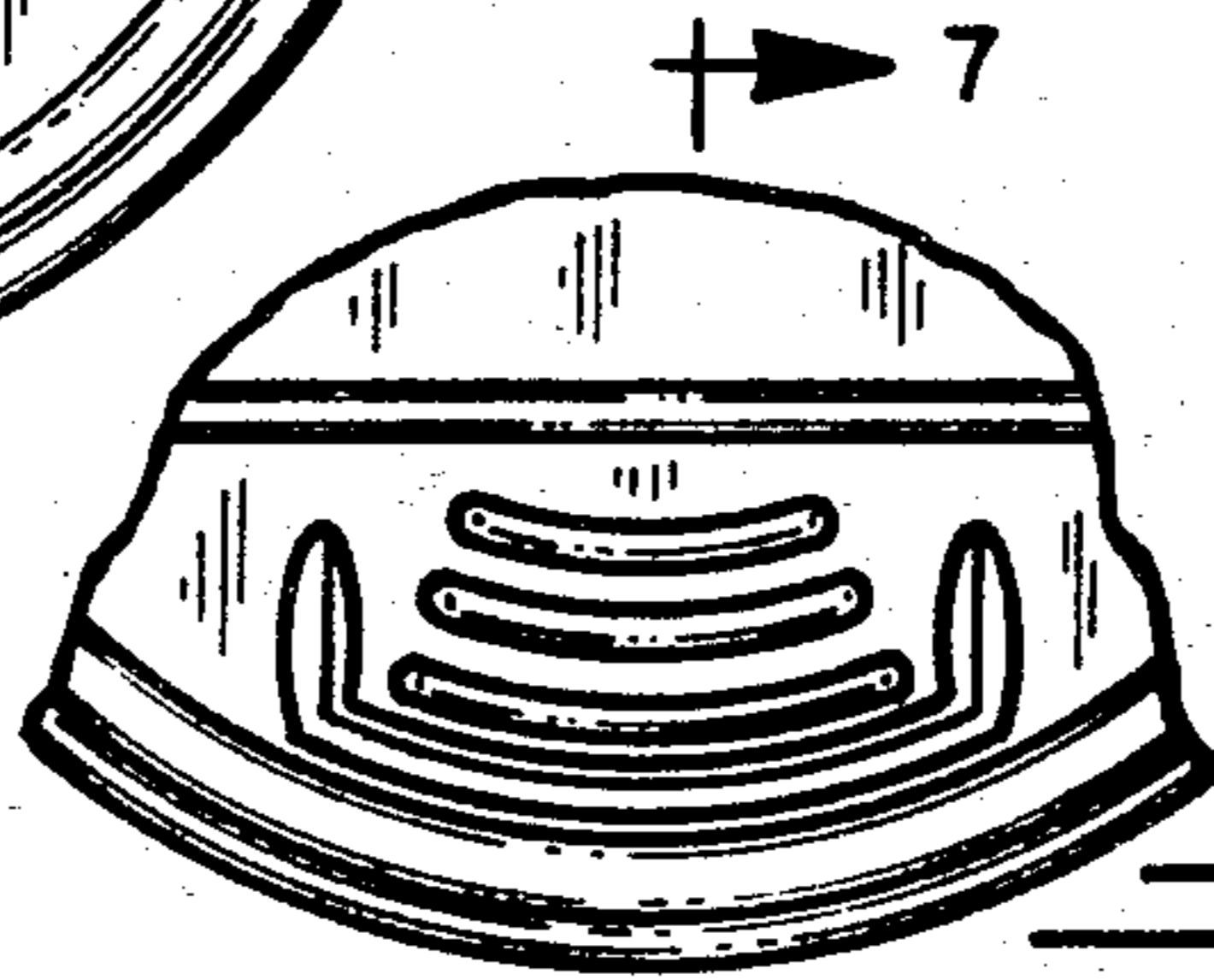

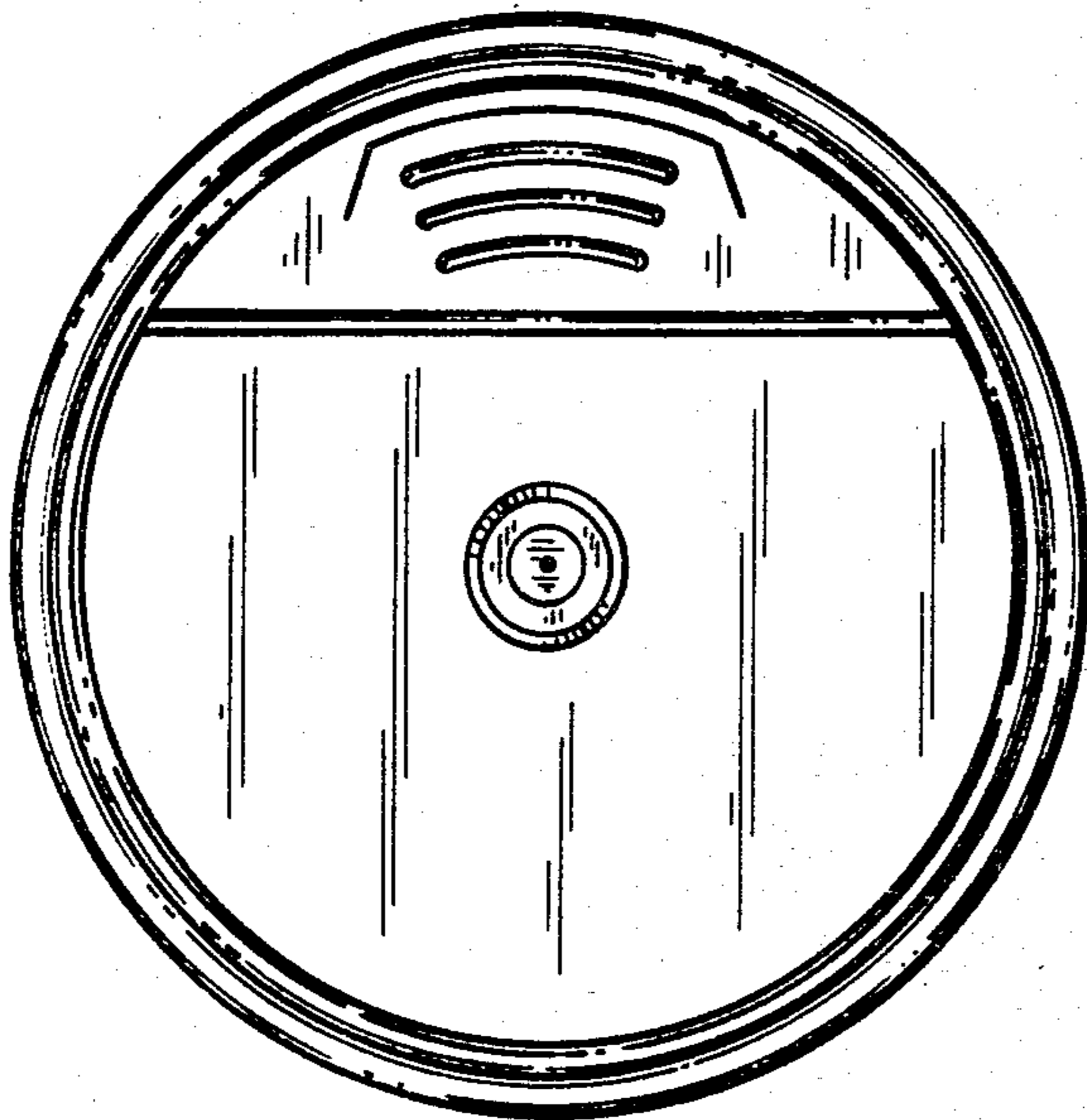

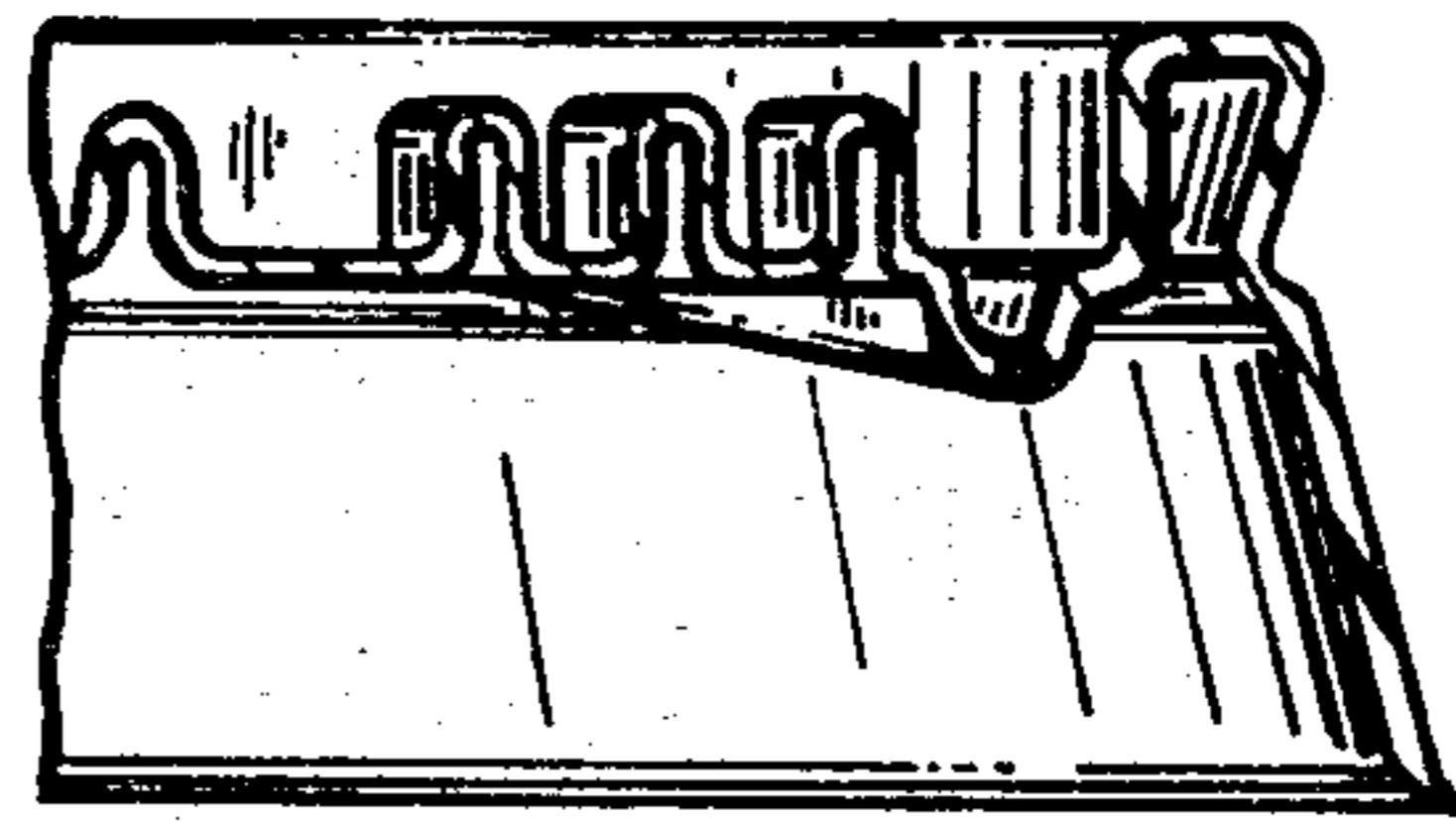
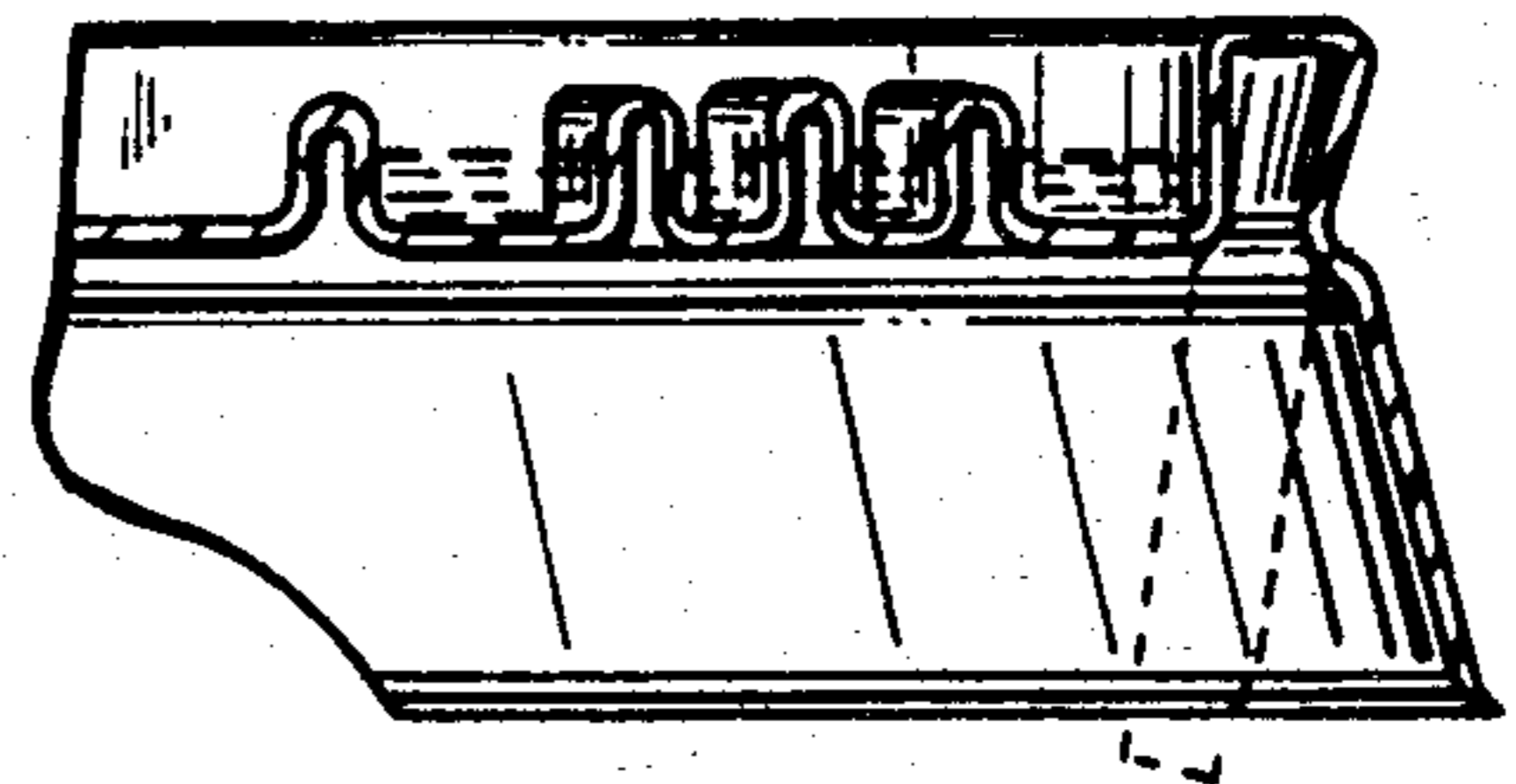

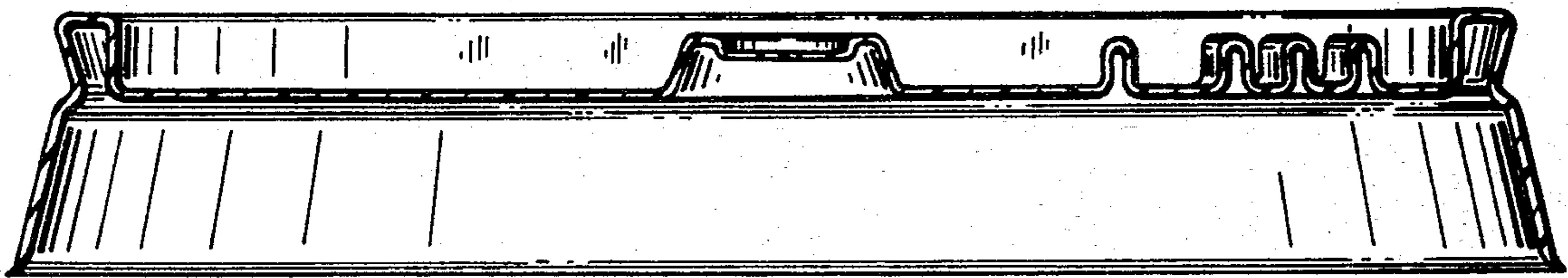

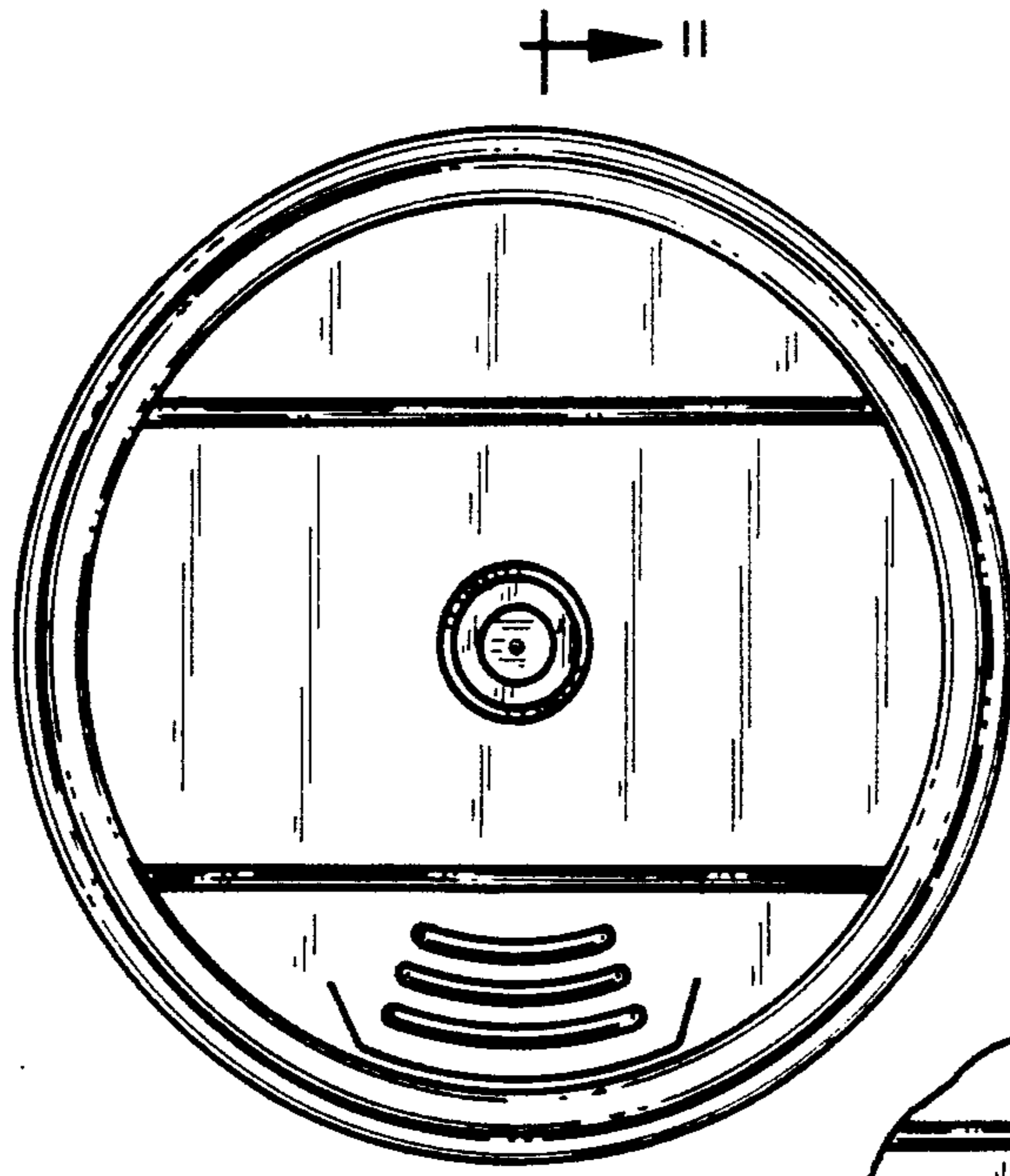

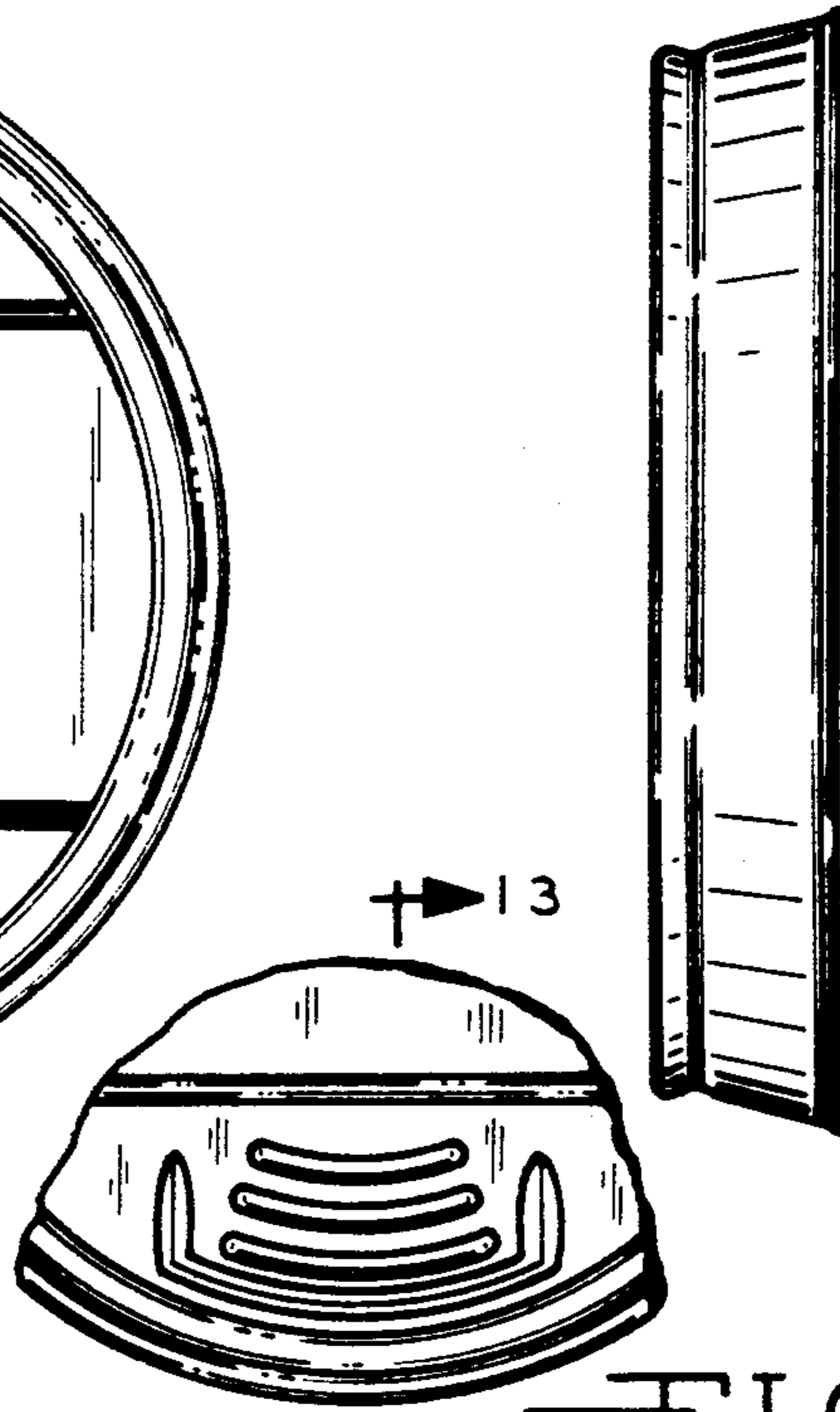

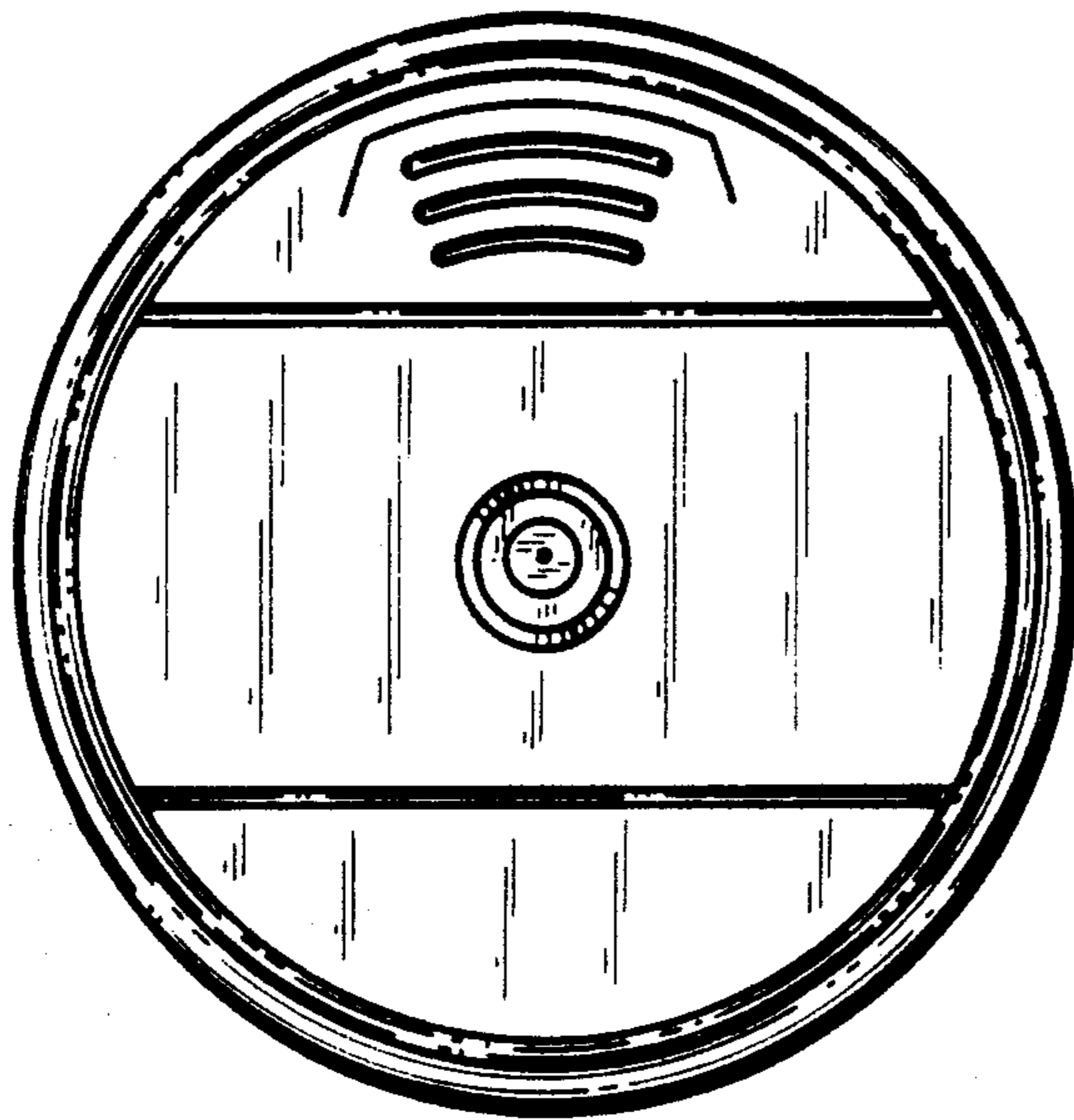

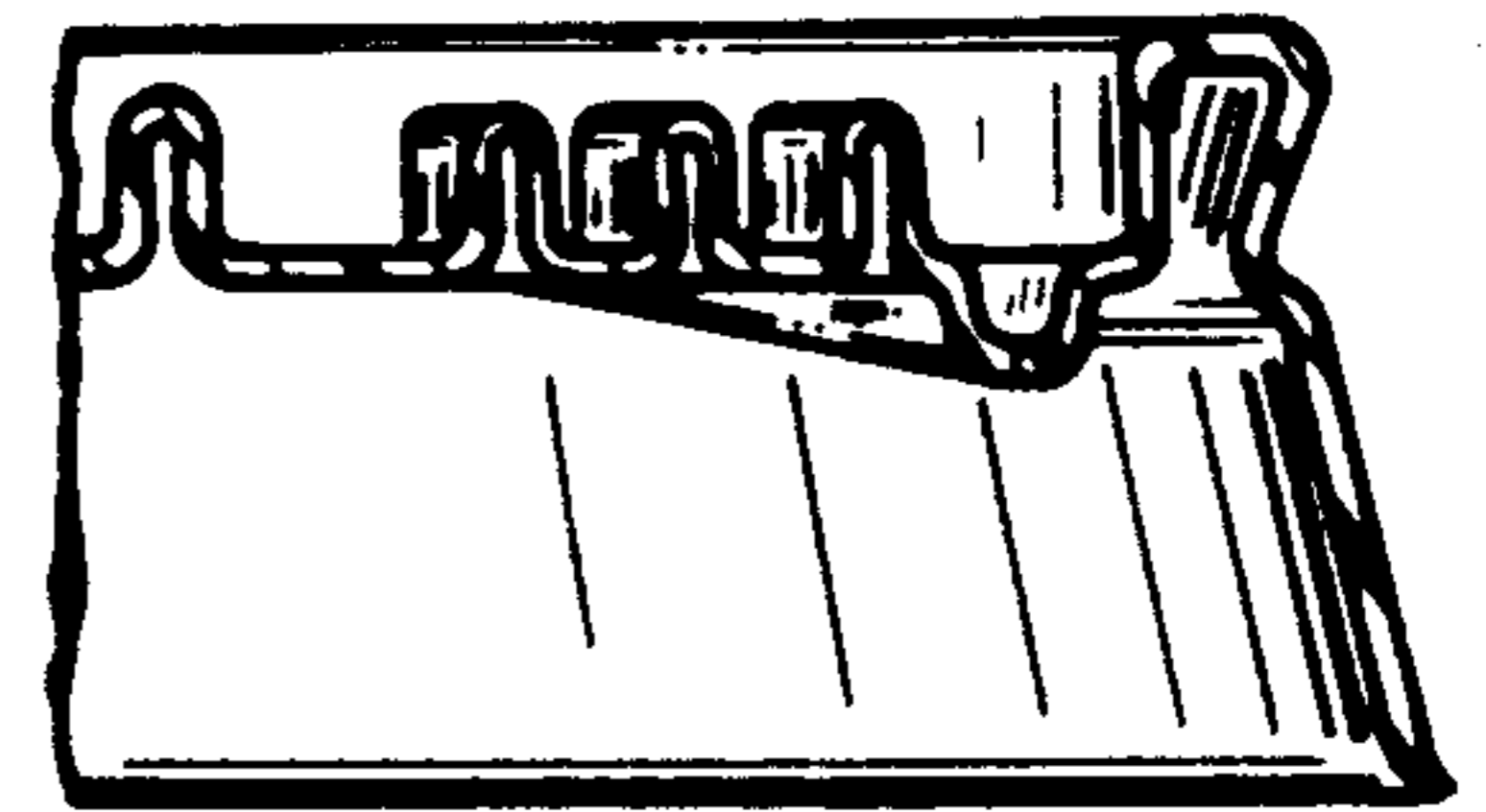

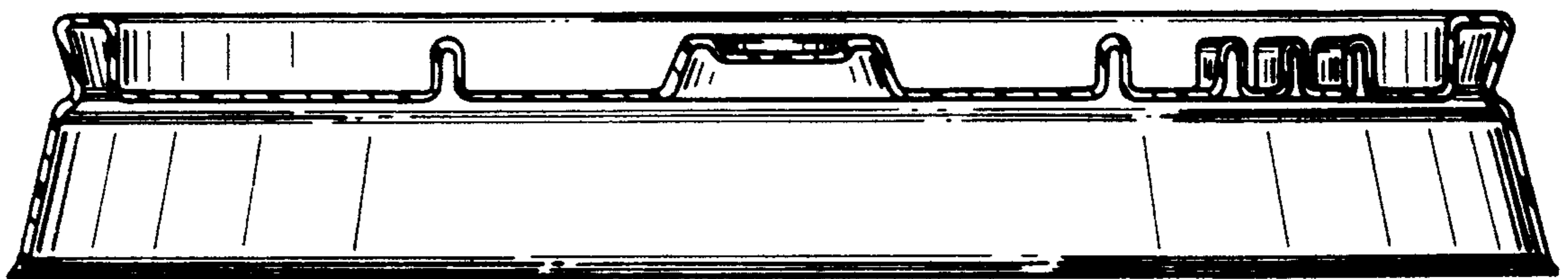
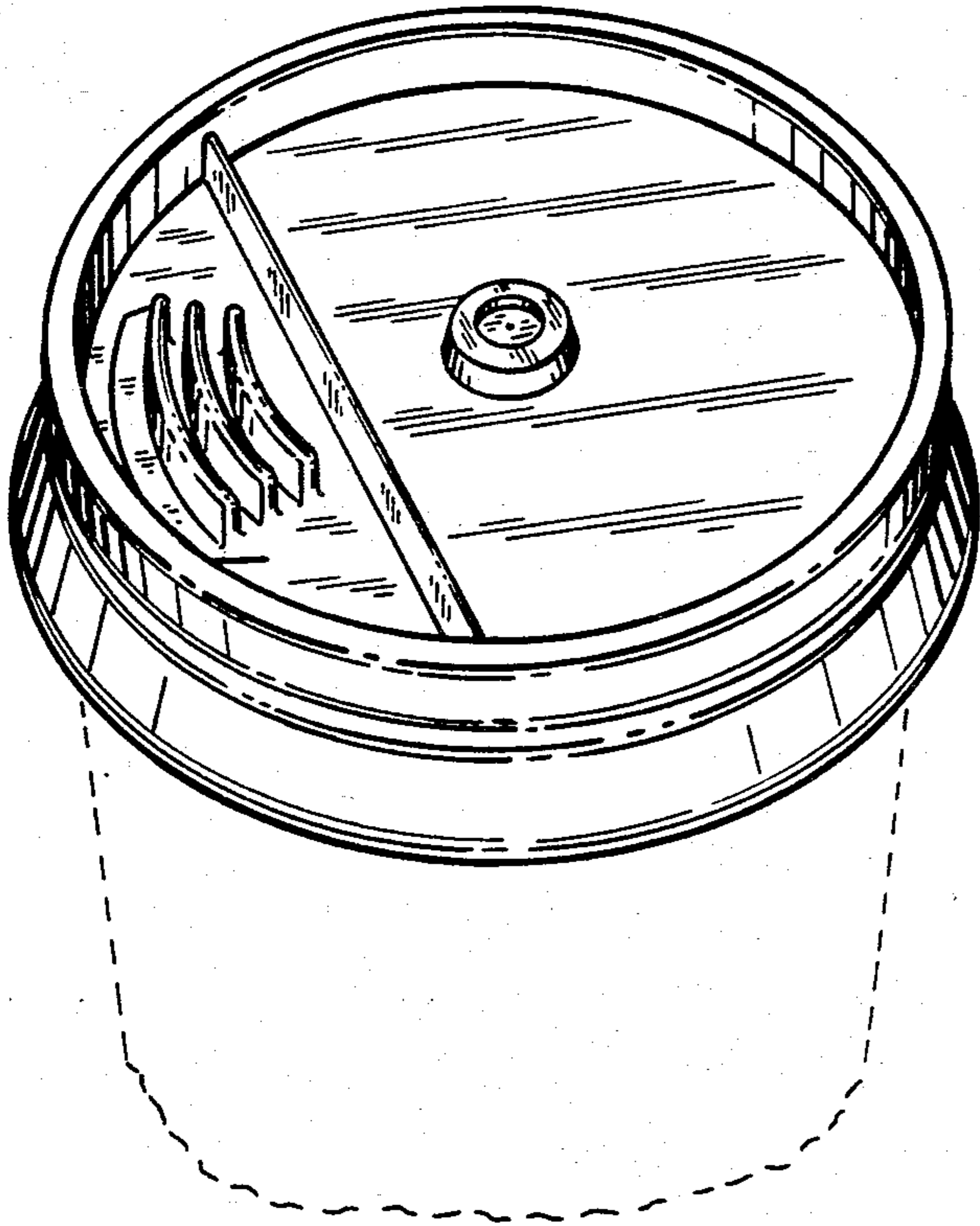
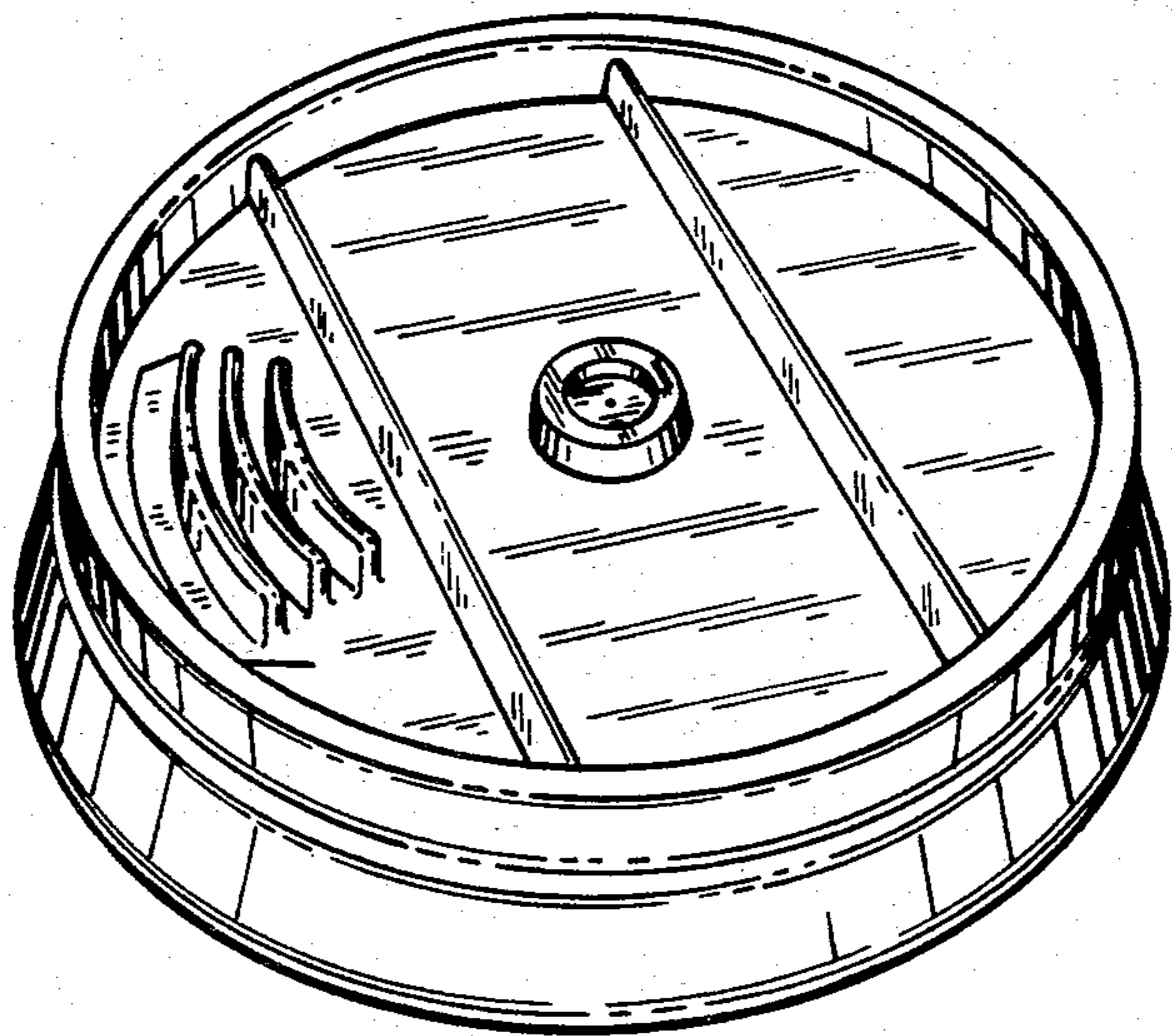


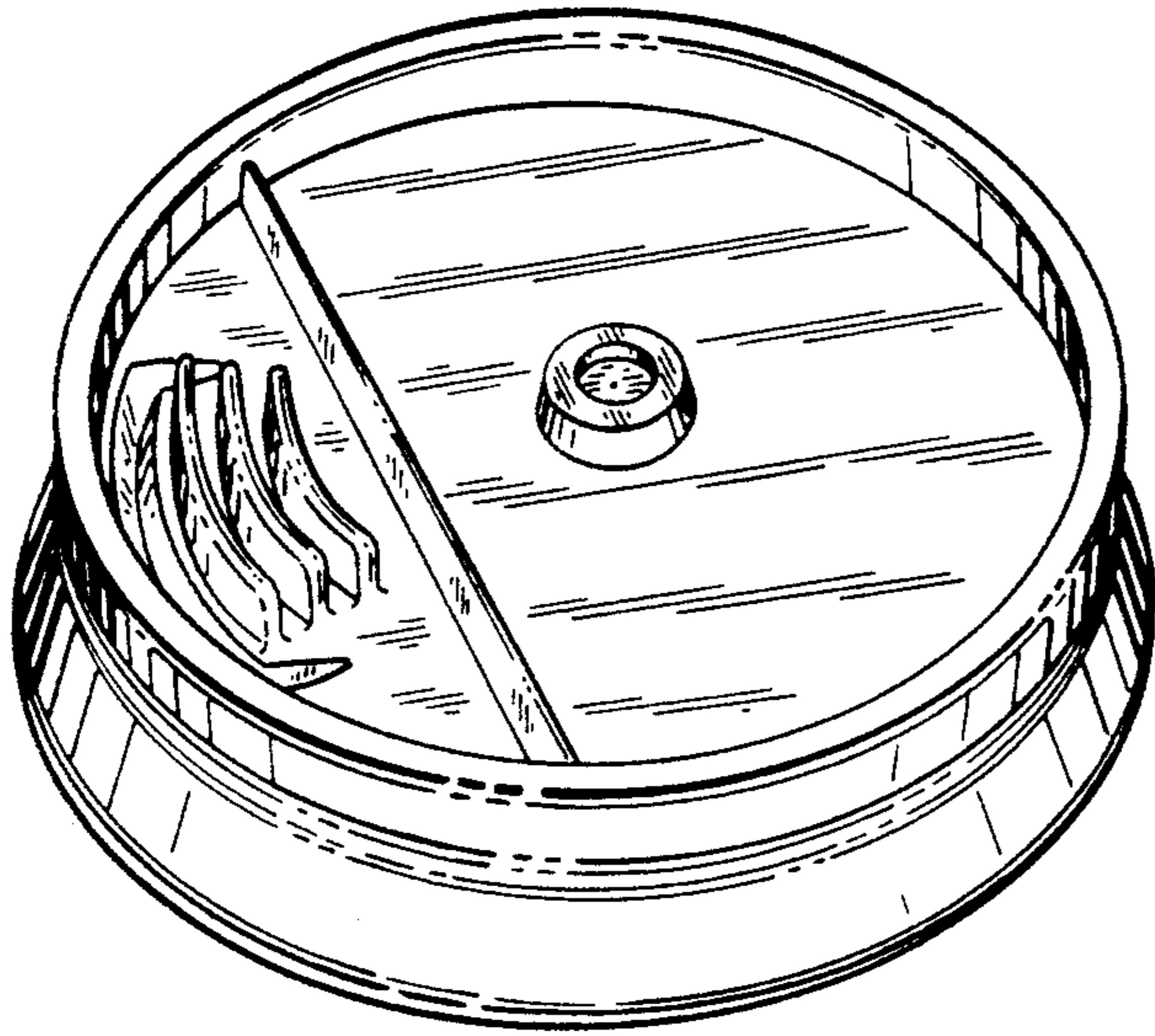

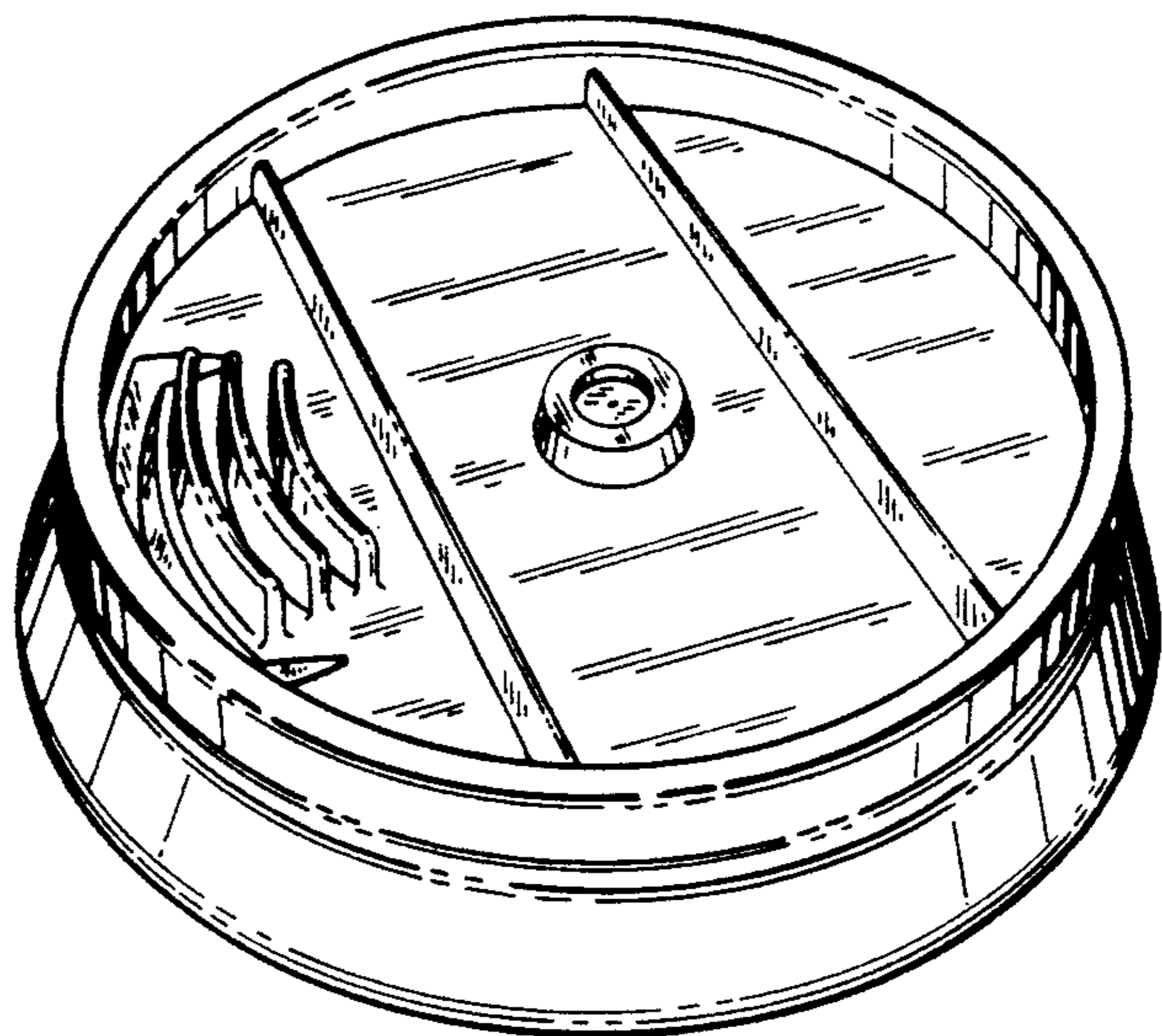
