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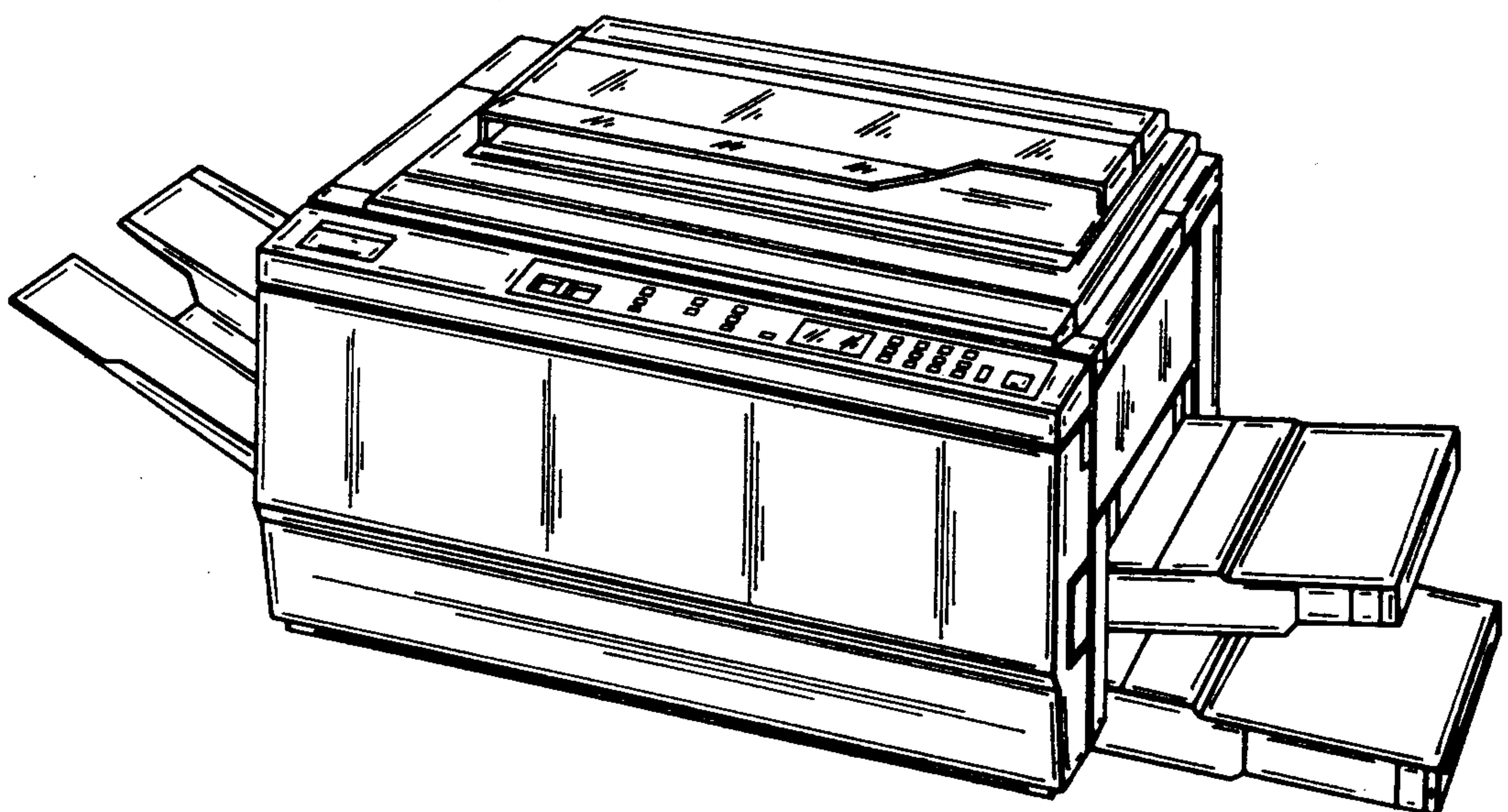

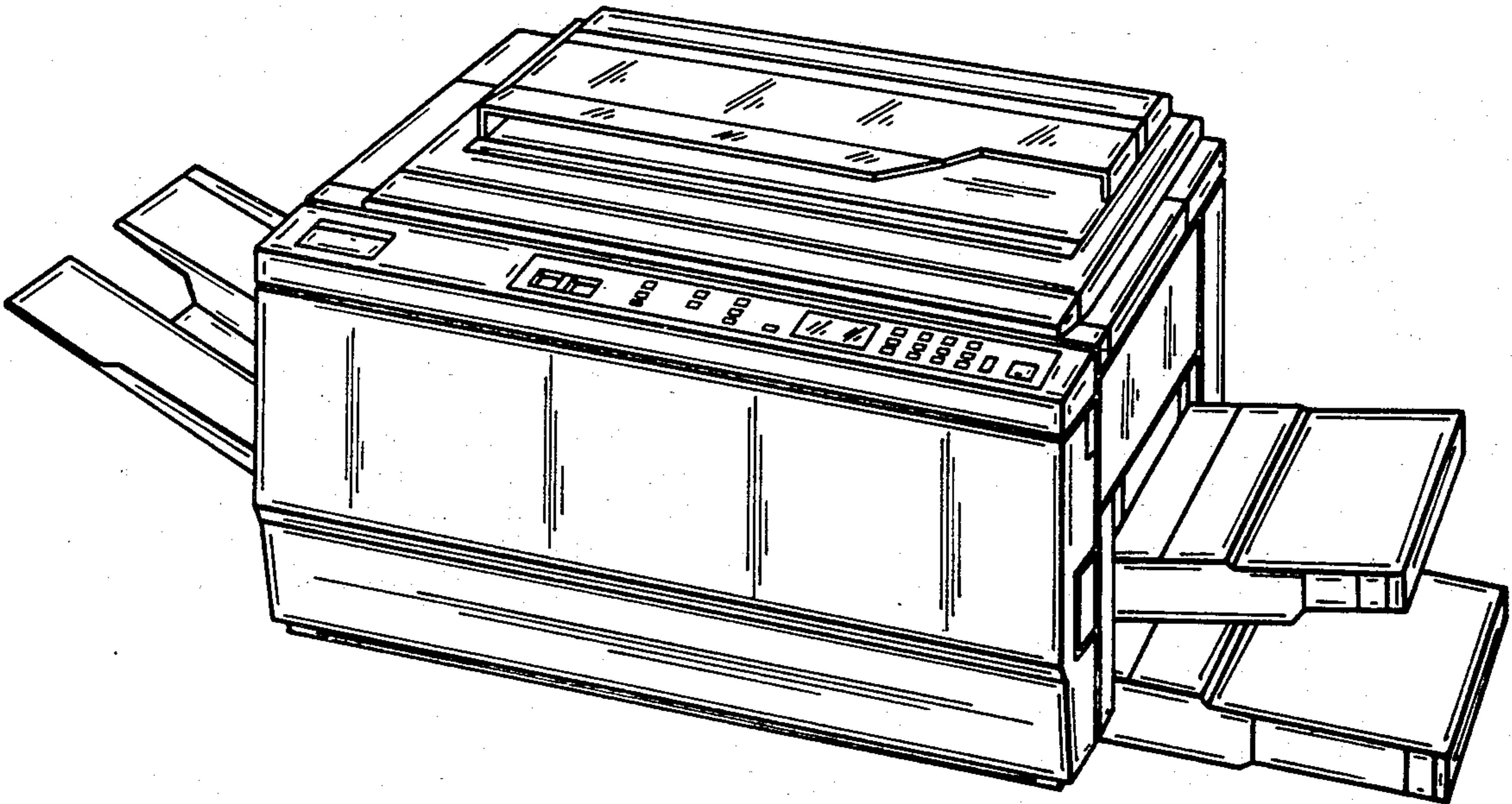
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an electronic copying machine, as shown and described.

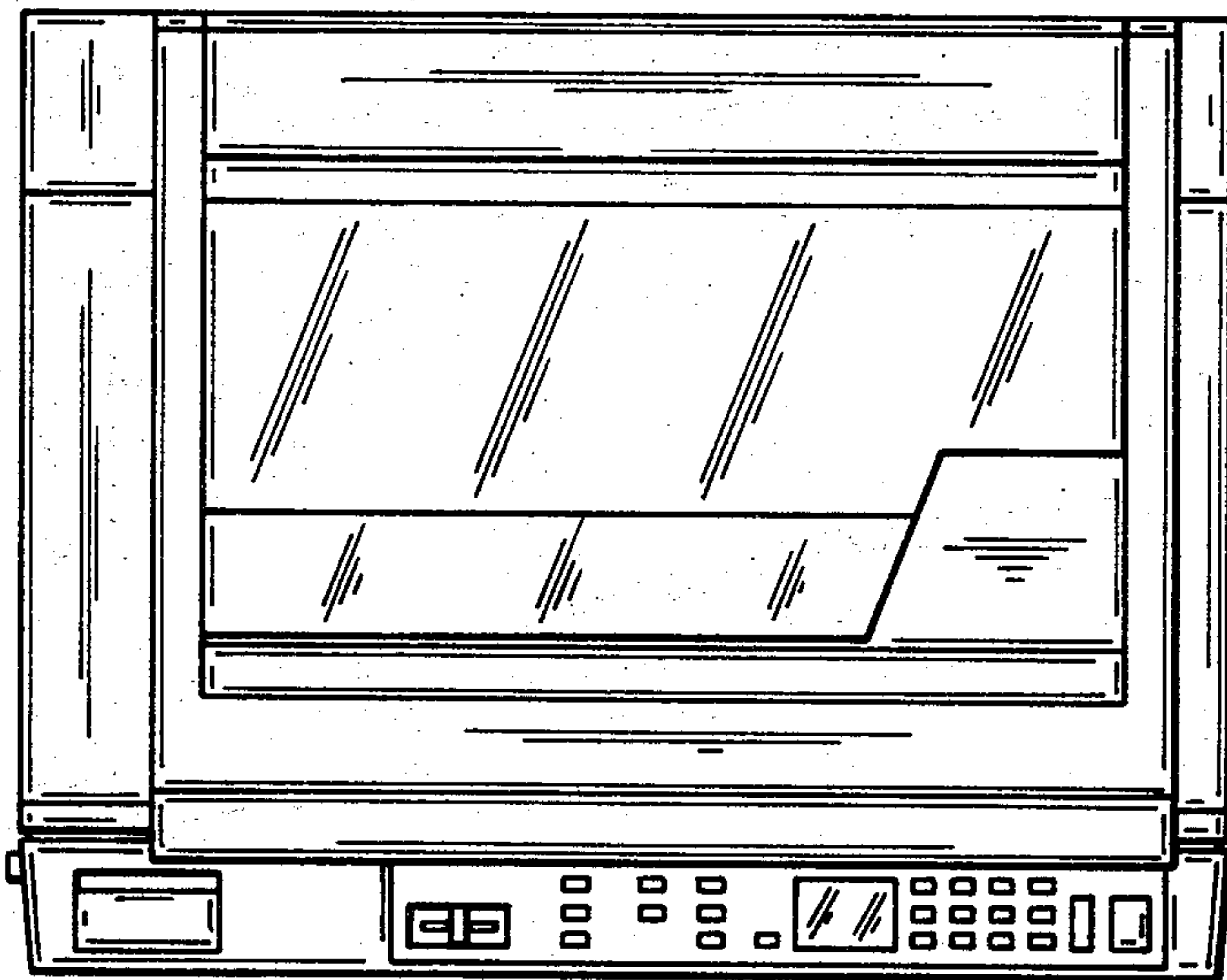
DESCRIPTION

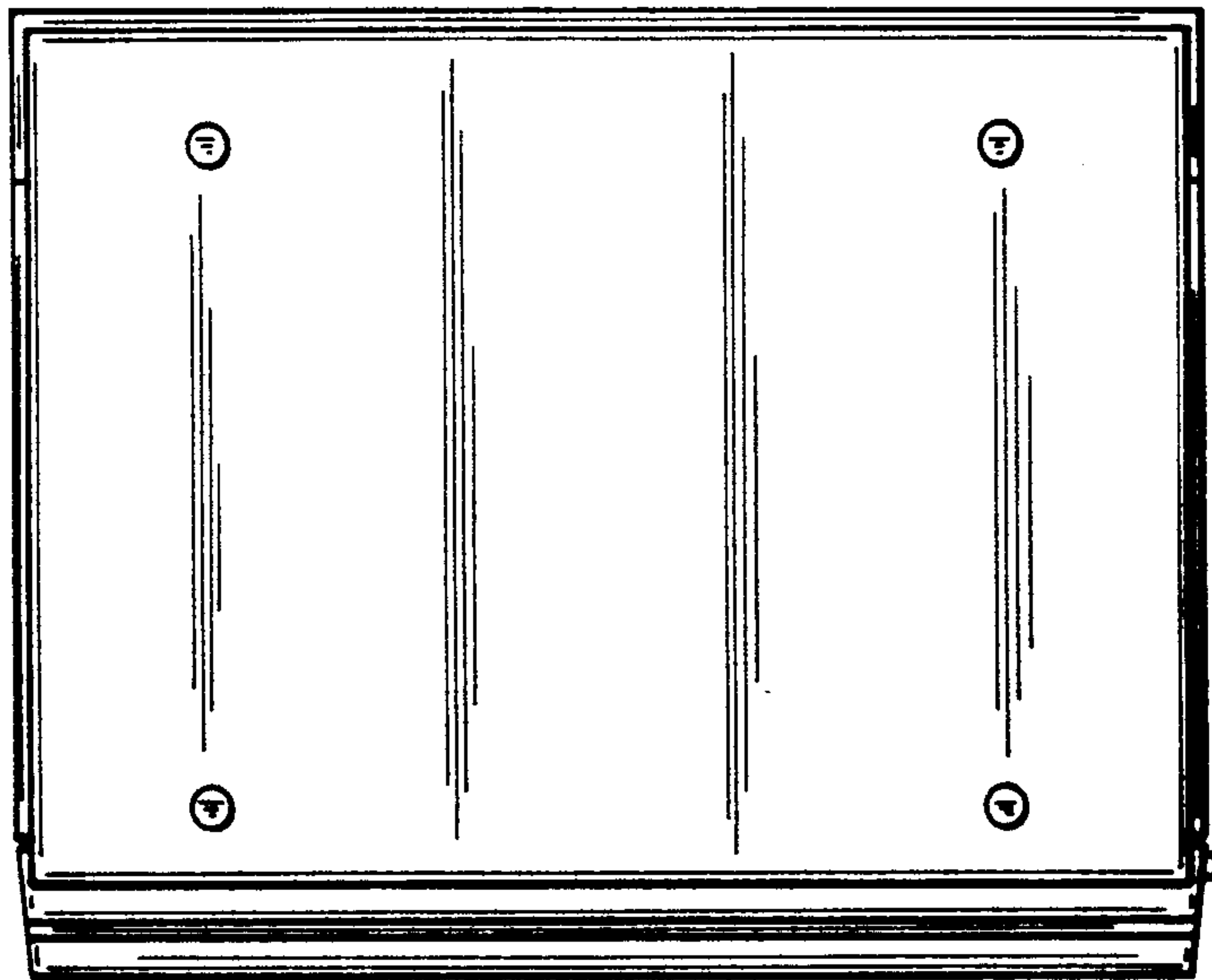




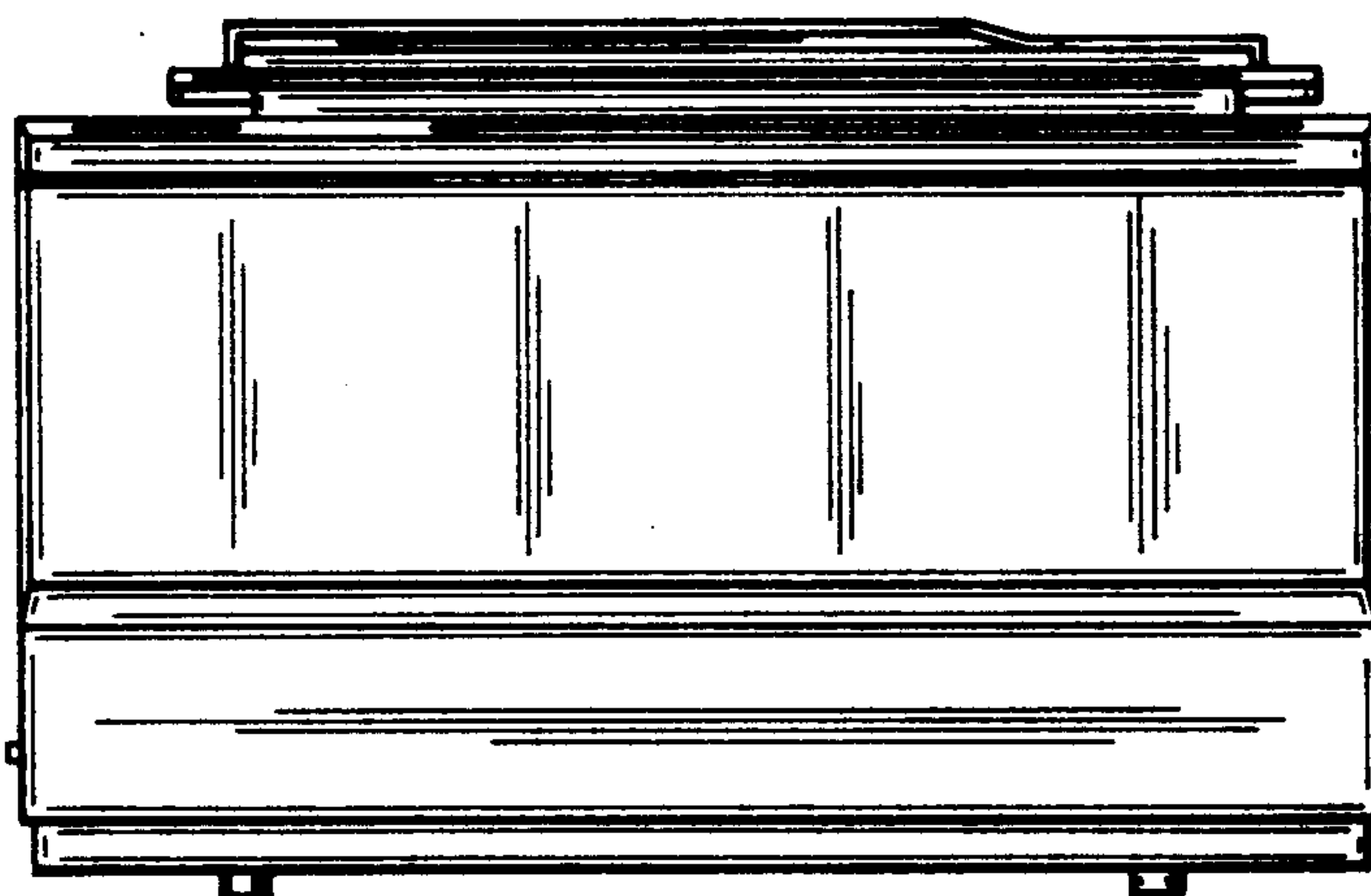

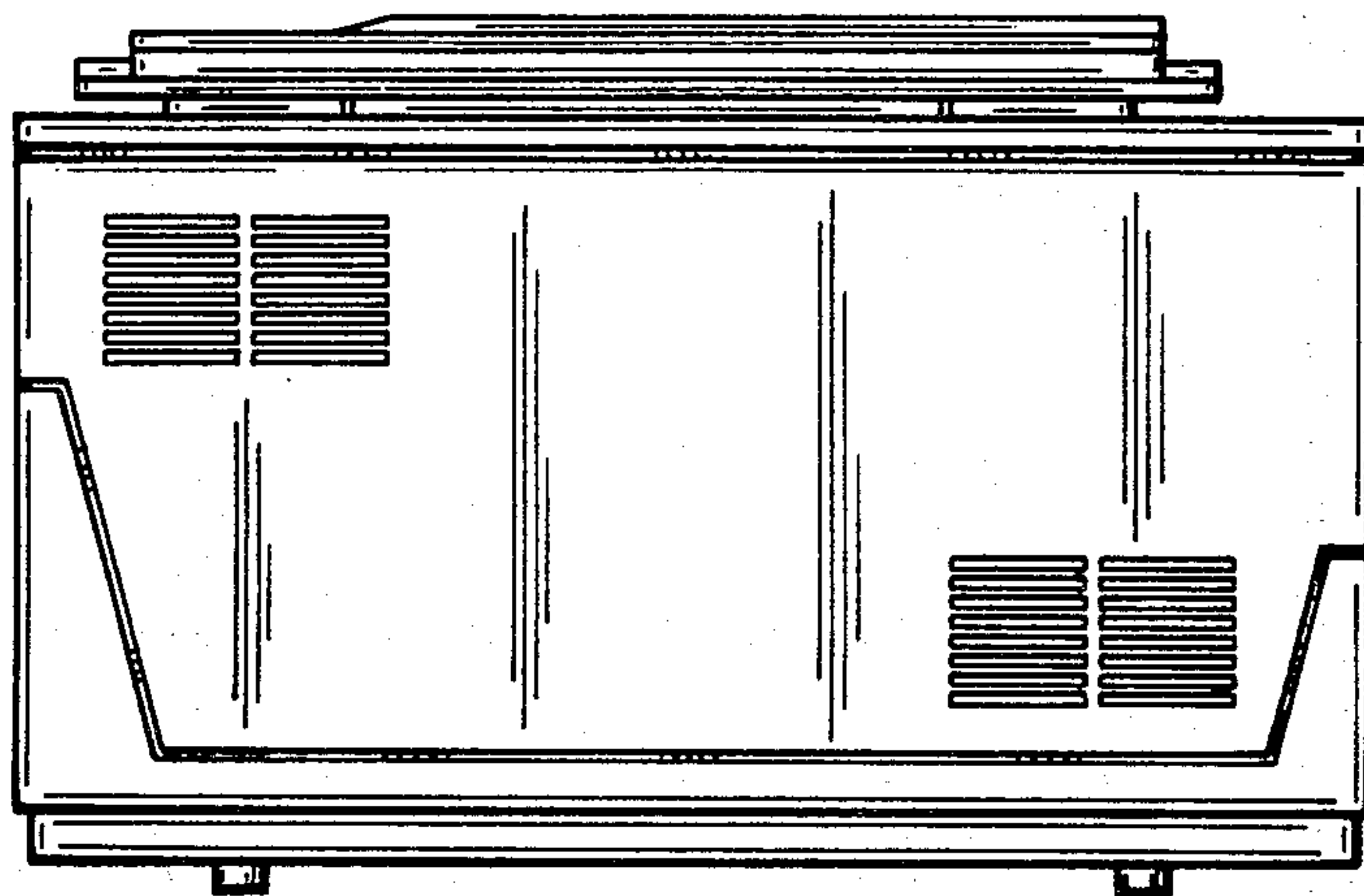

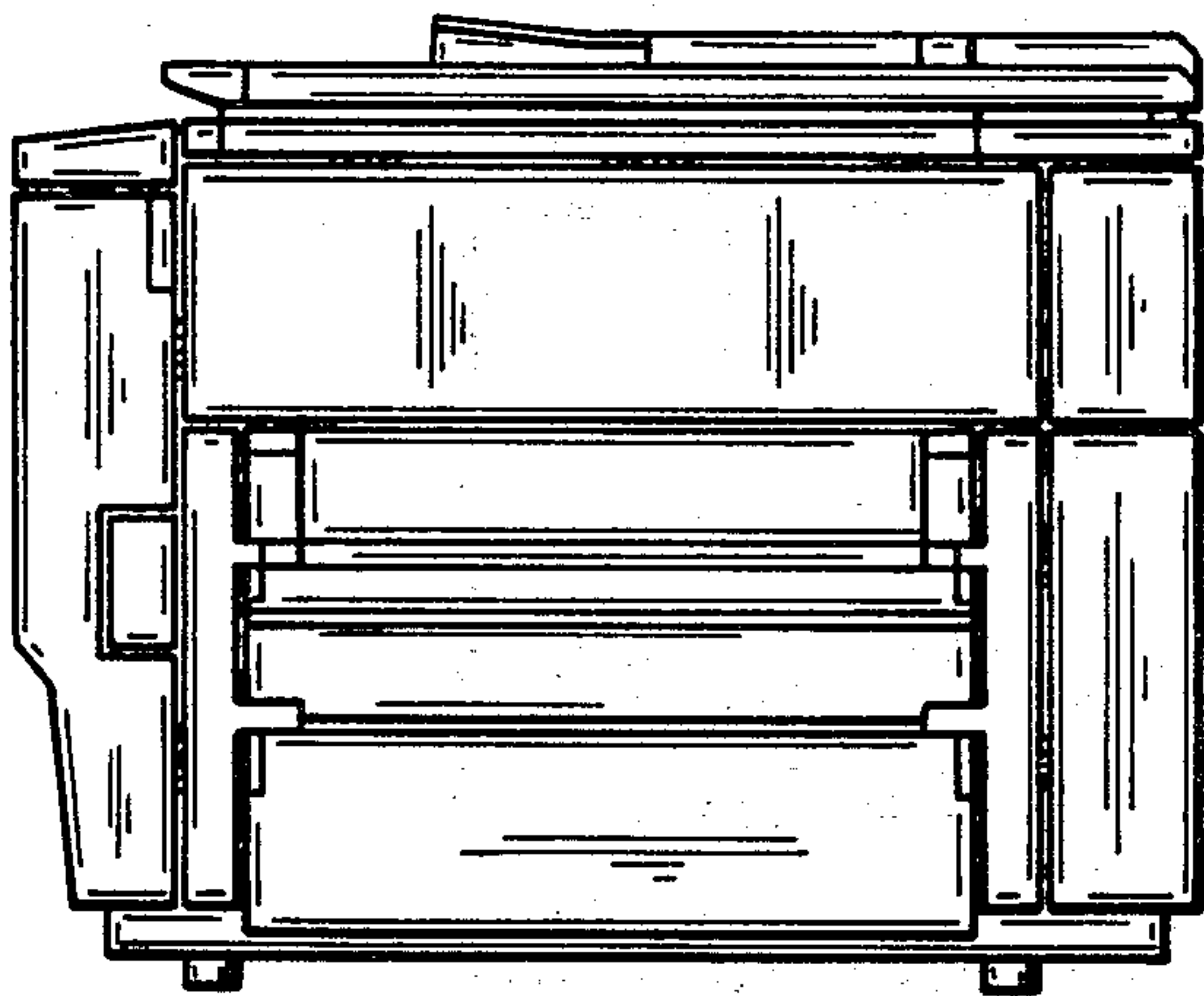

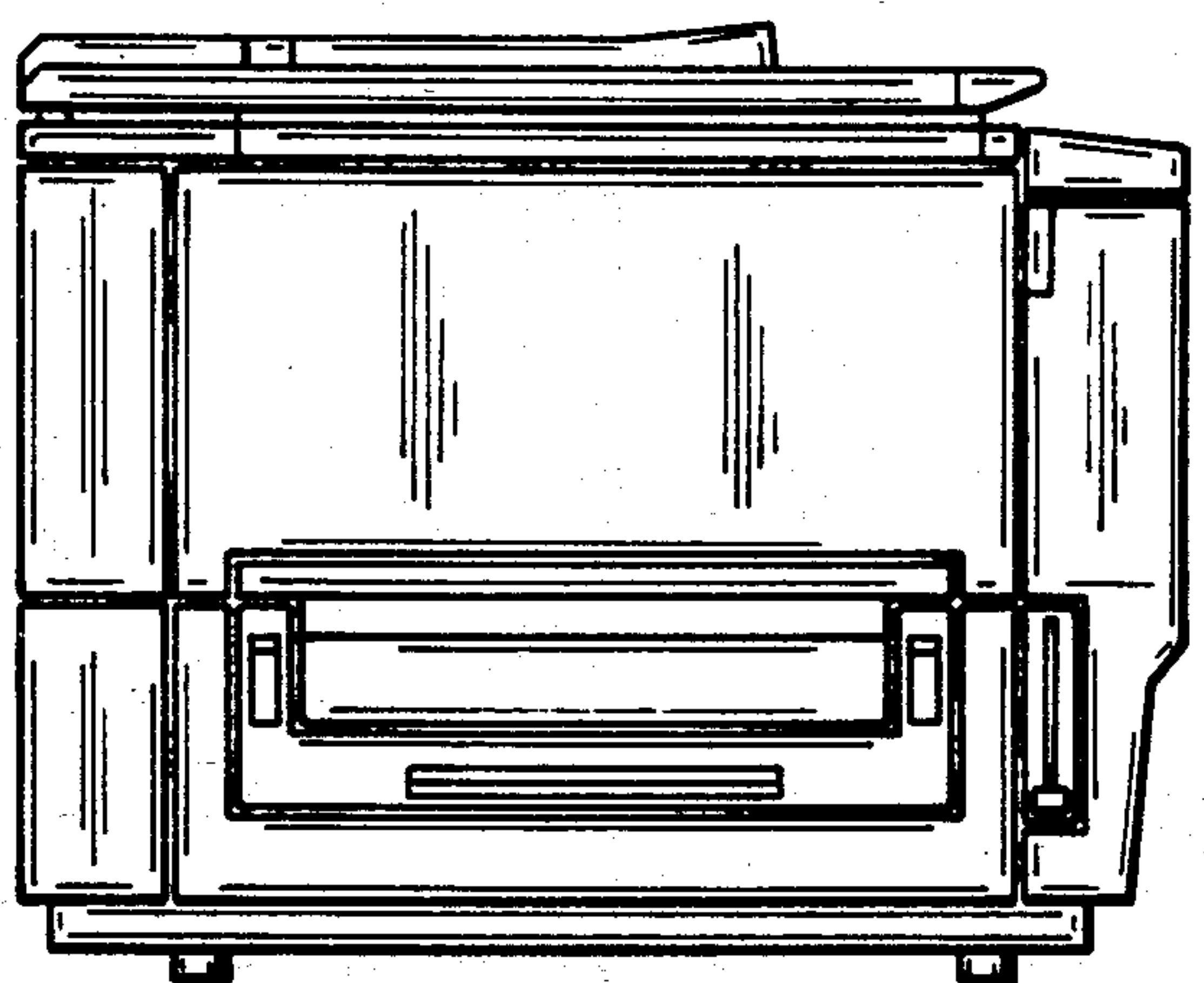
