[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a payout component for a coin dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a payout component for a coin dispenser showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view thereof taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

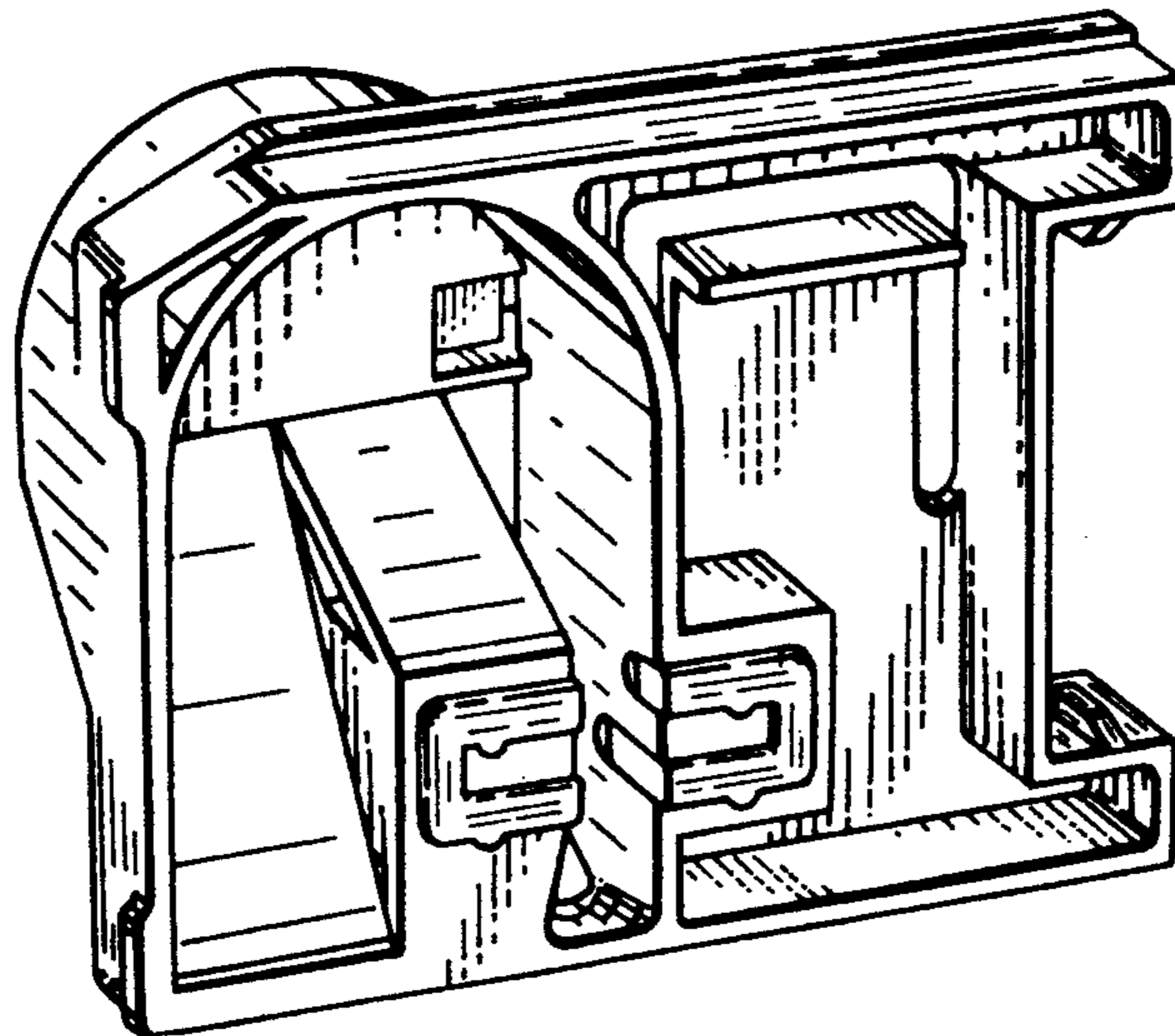

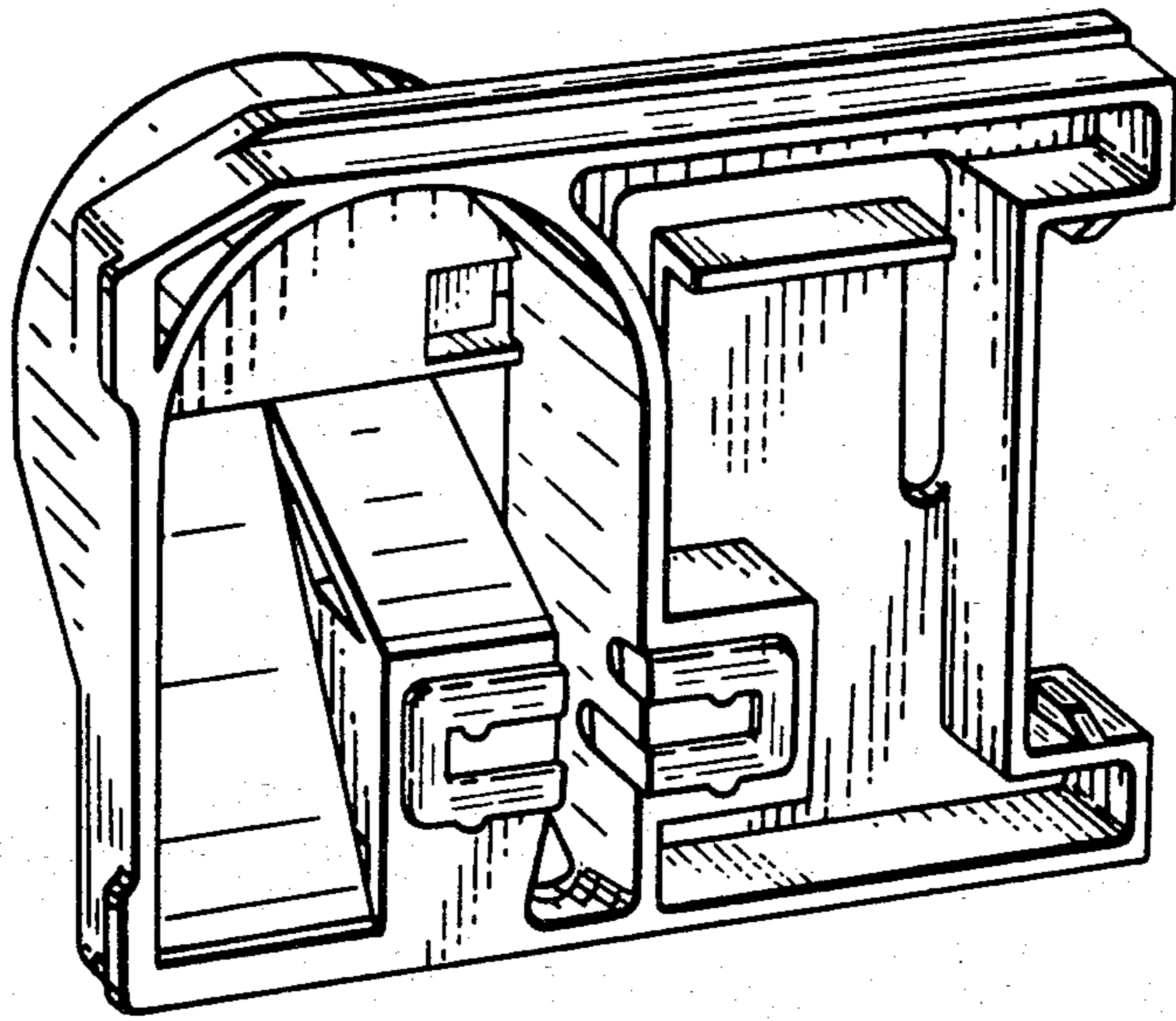
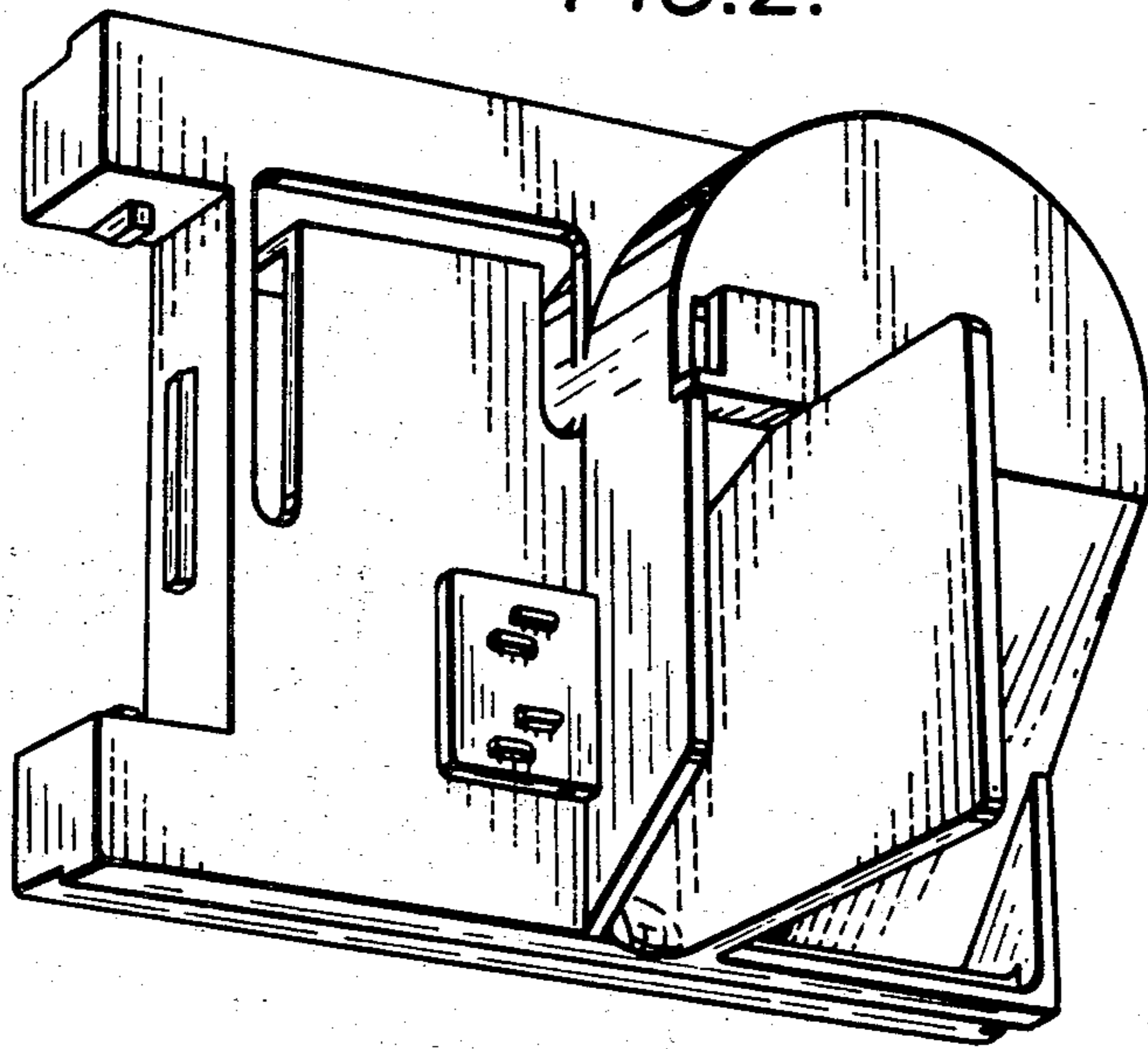

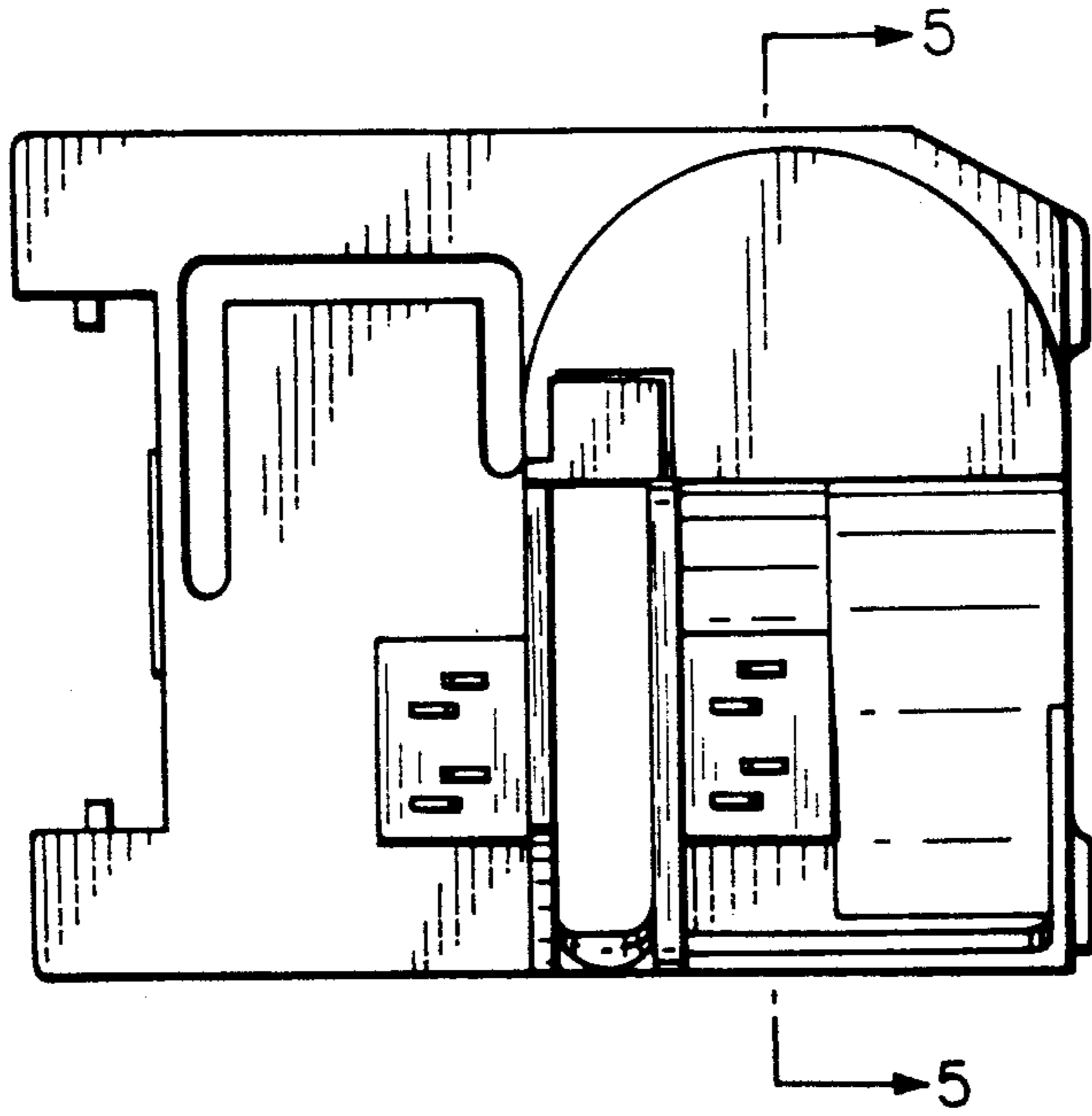

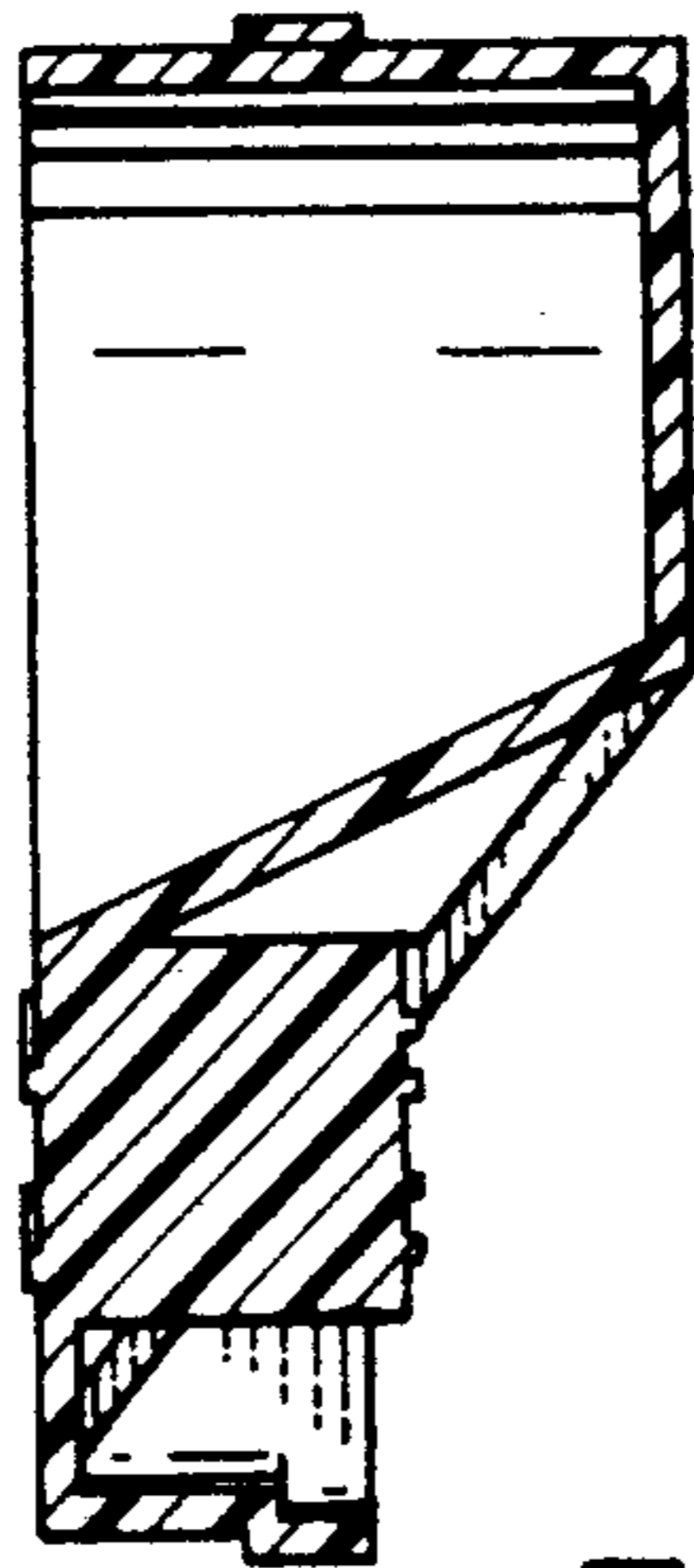
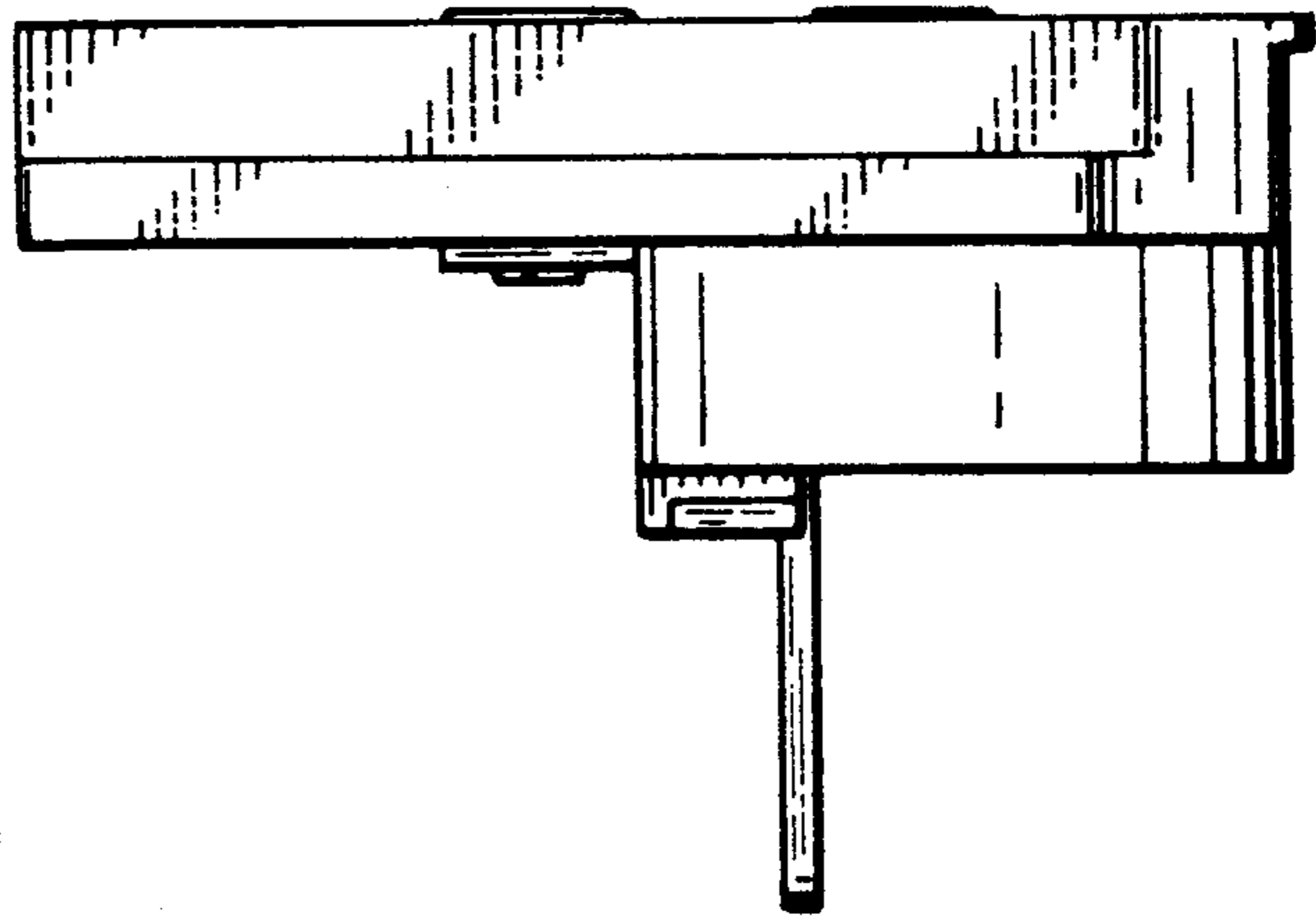
