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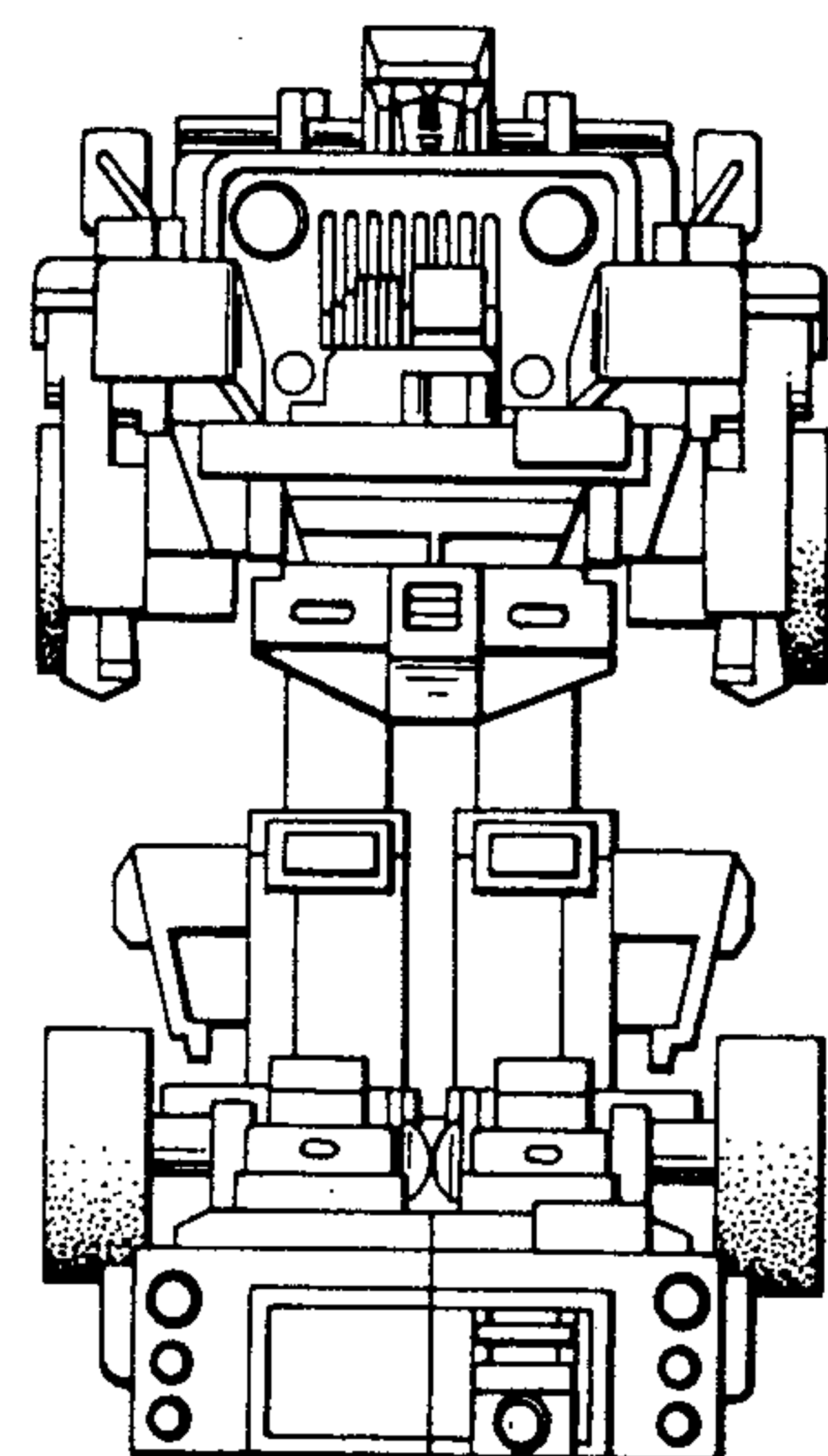
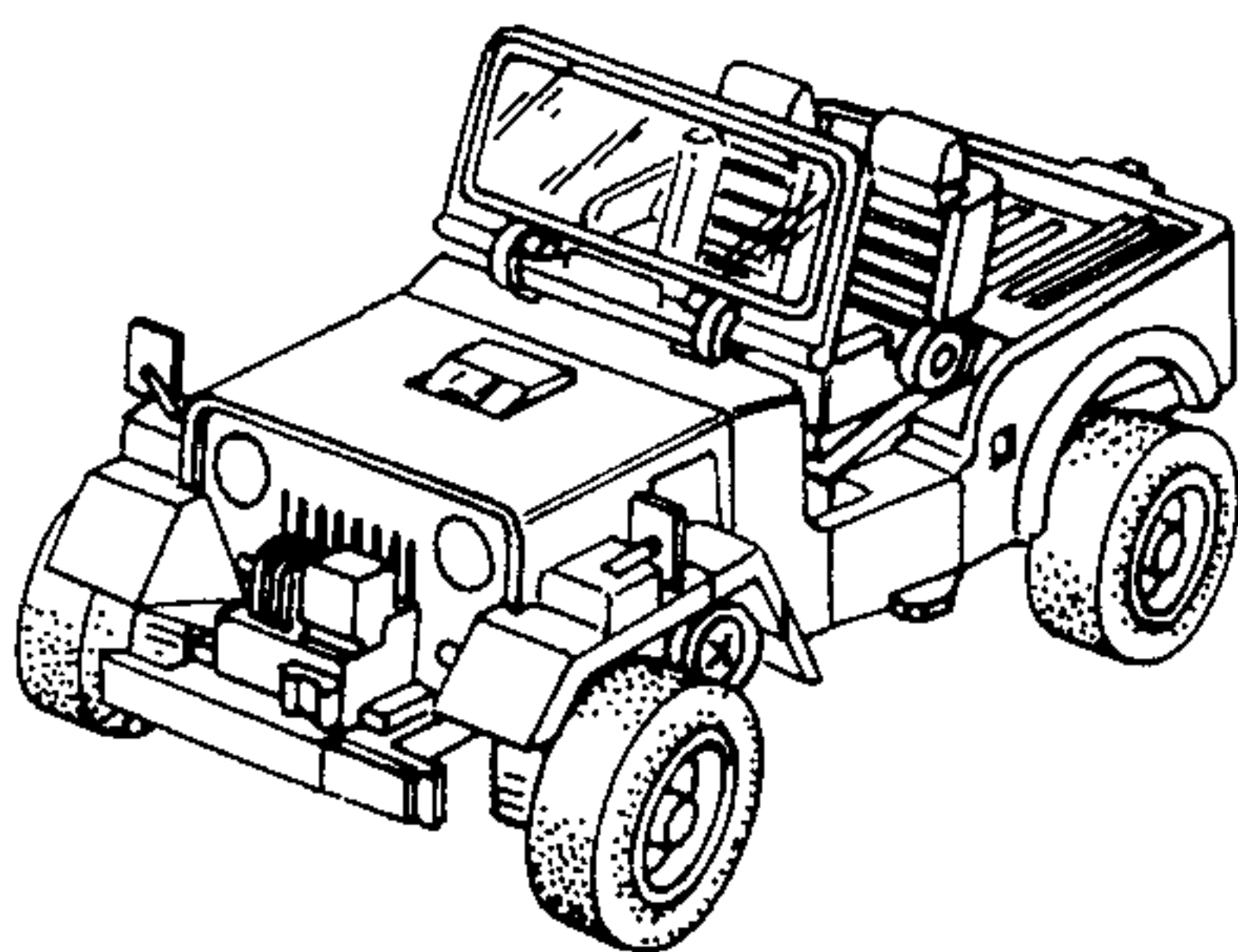
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a reconfigurable toy vehicle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a reconfigurable toy vehicle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 6 reconfigured in a humanoid condition;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof.



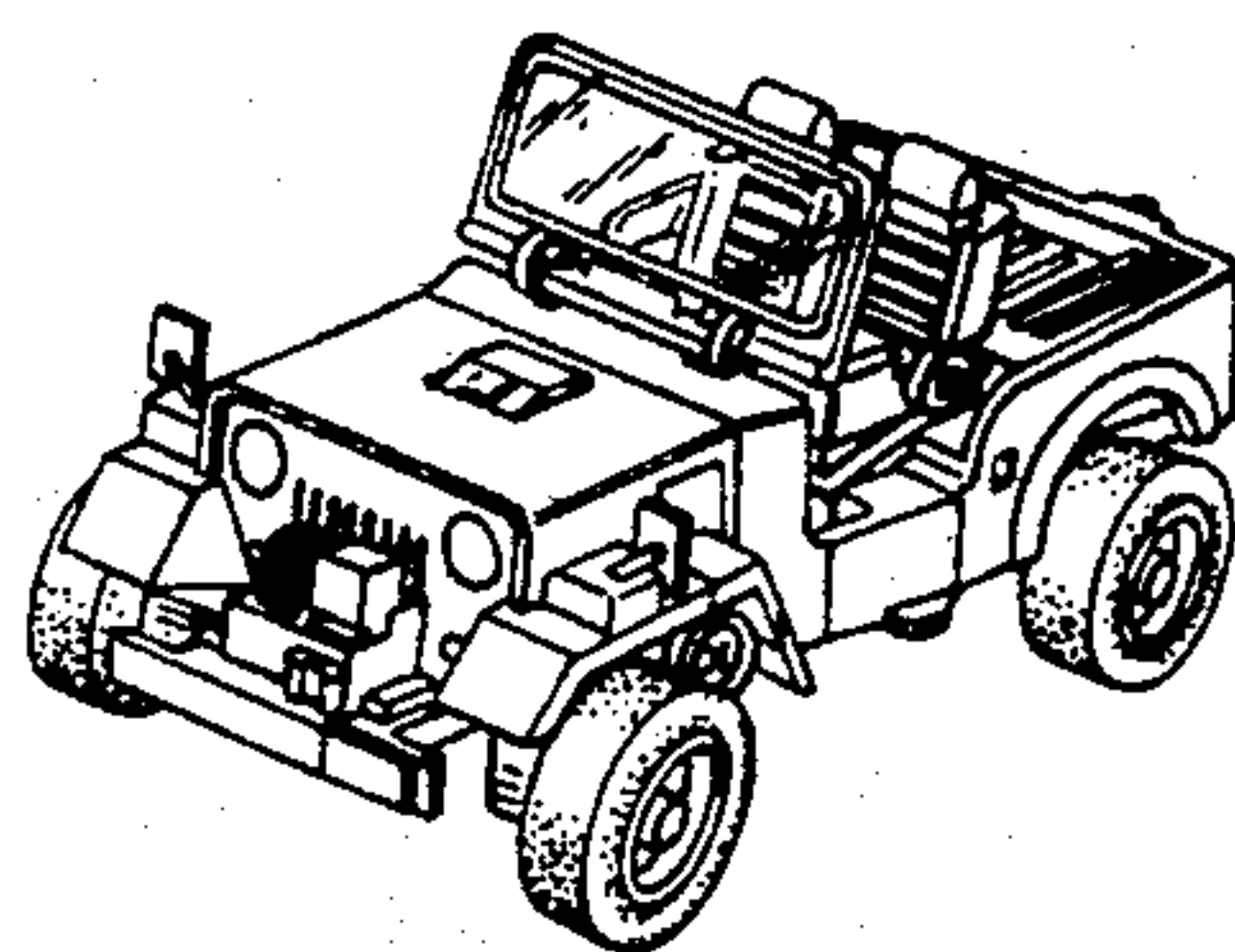

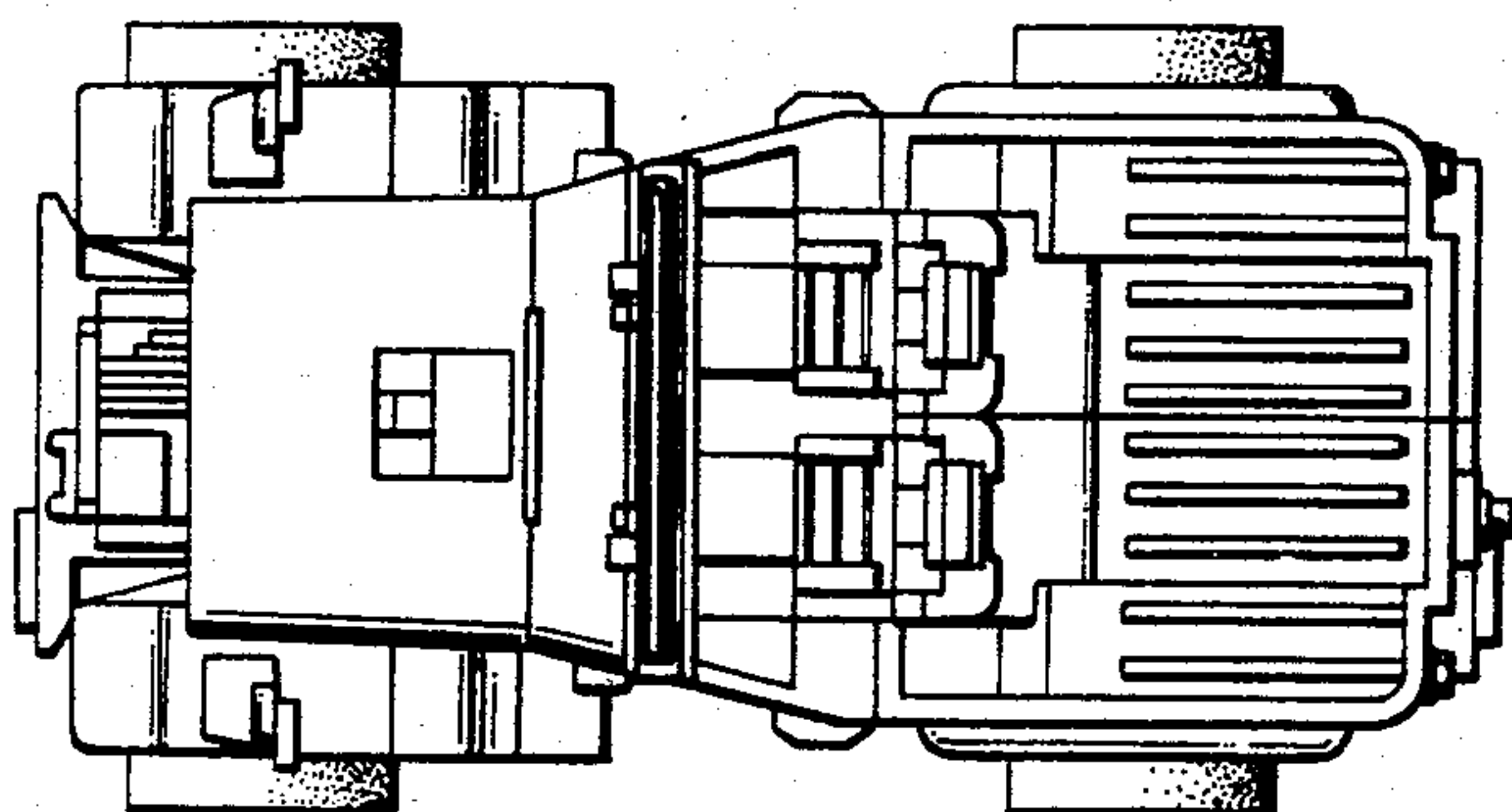

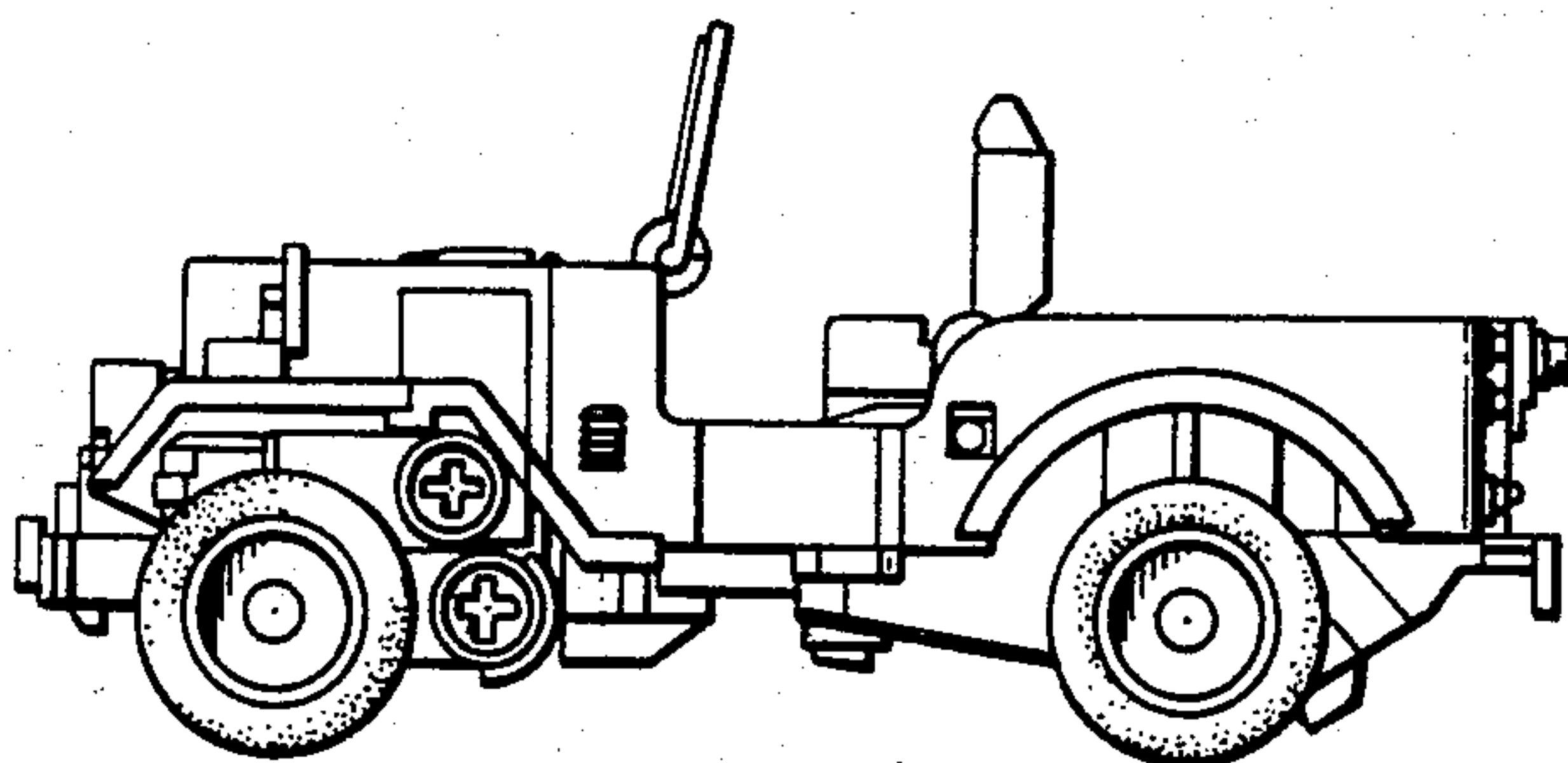

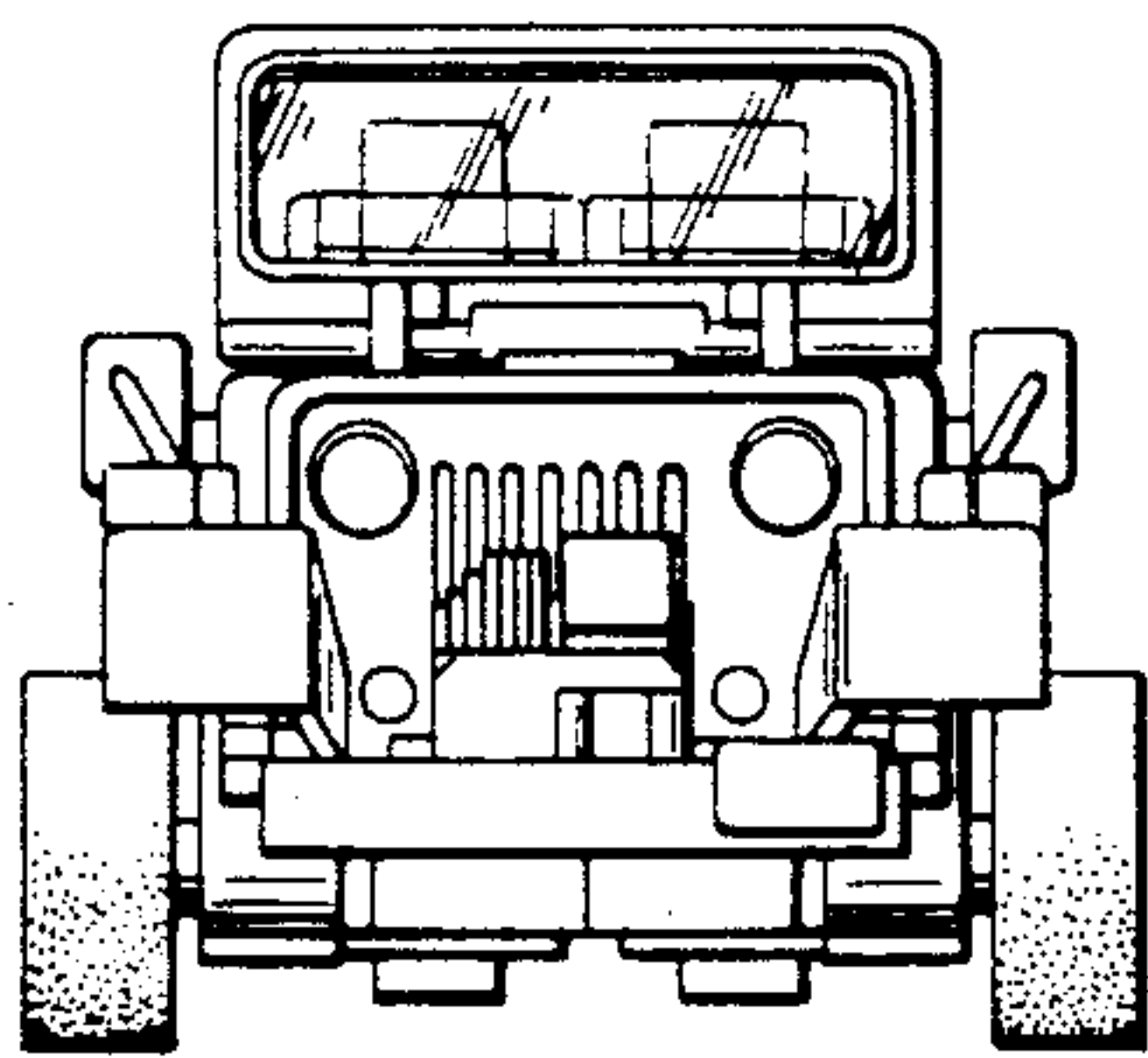

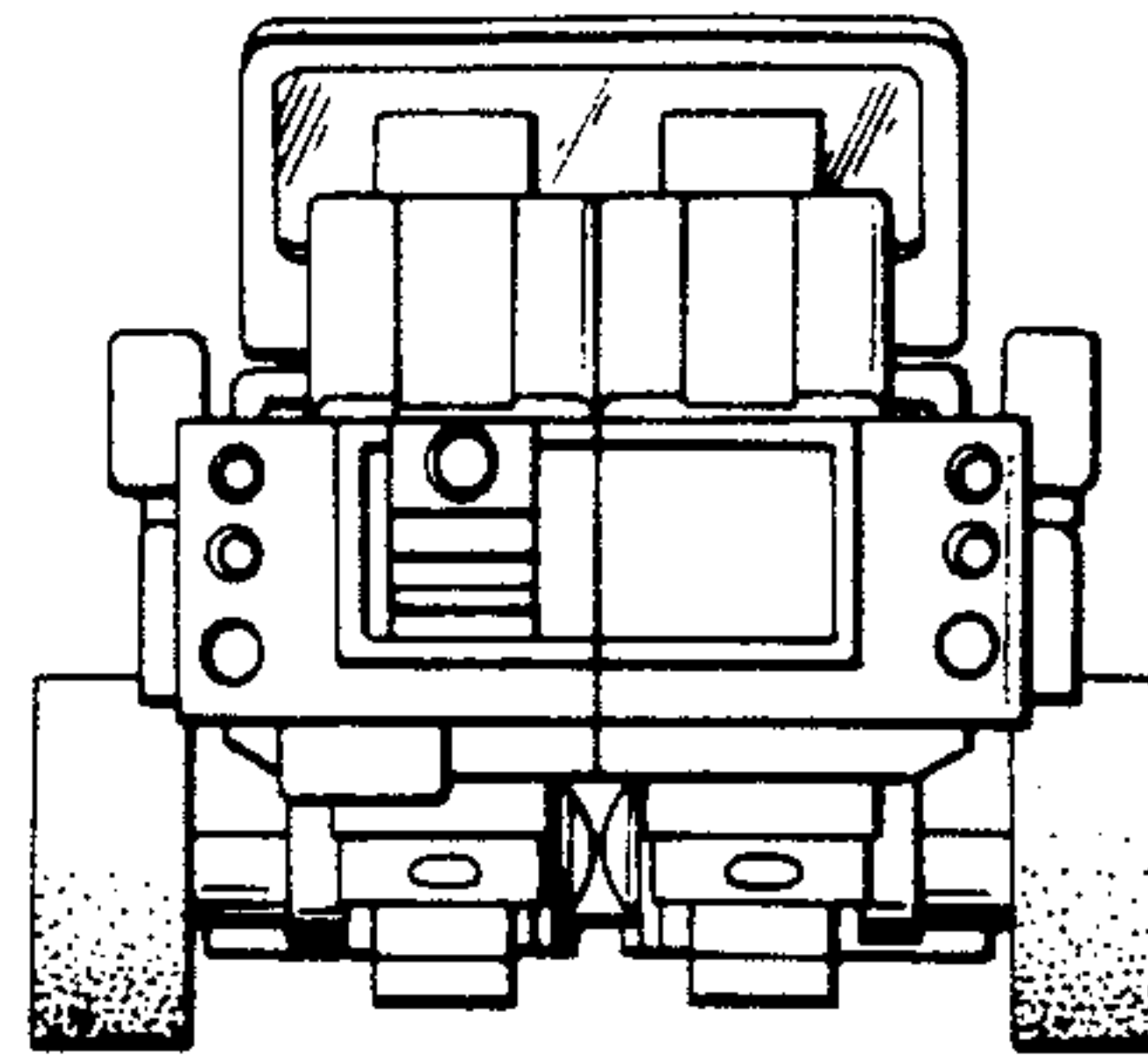

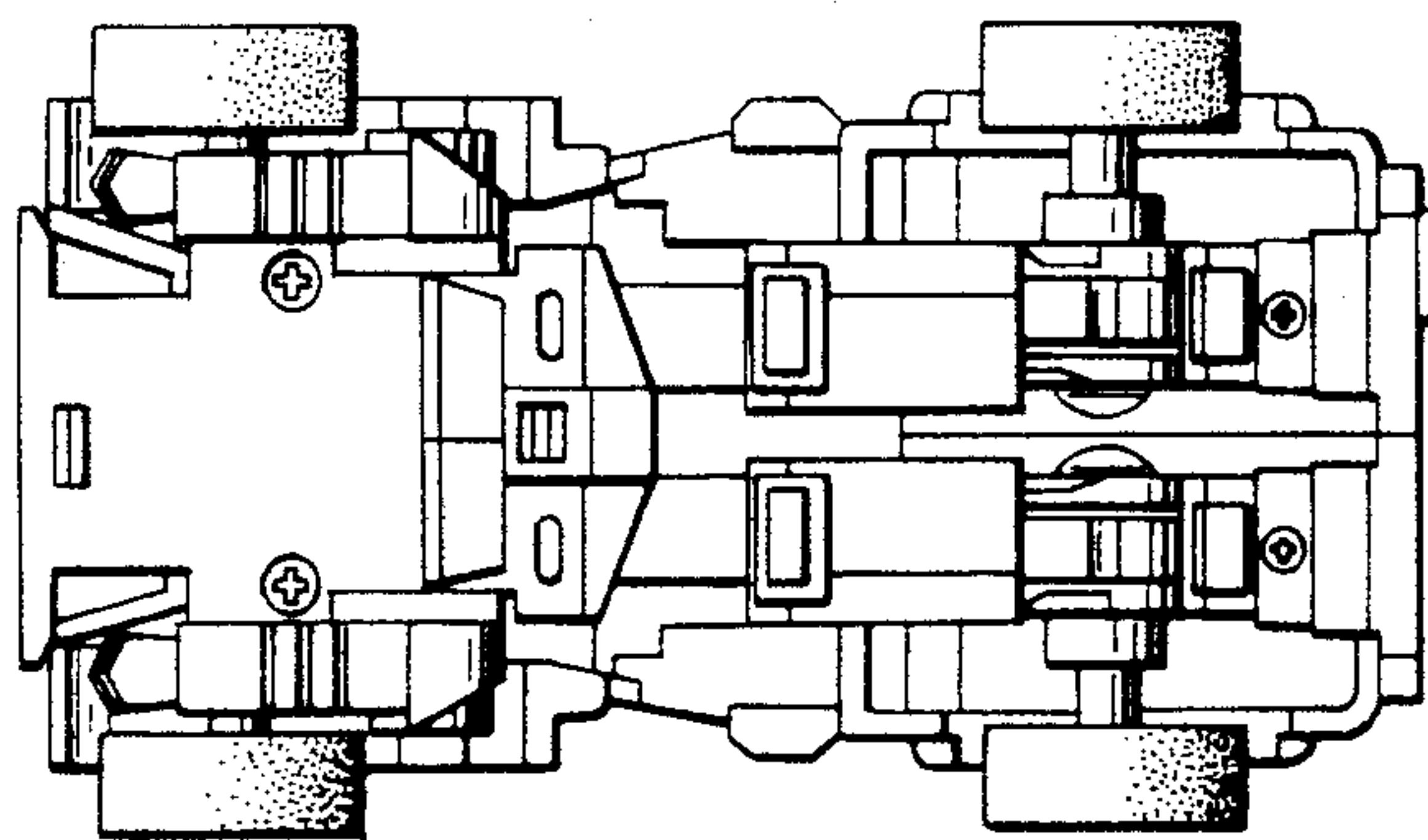

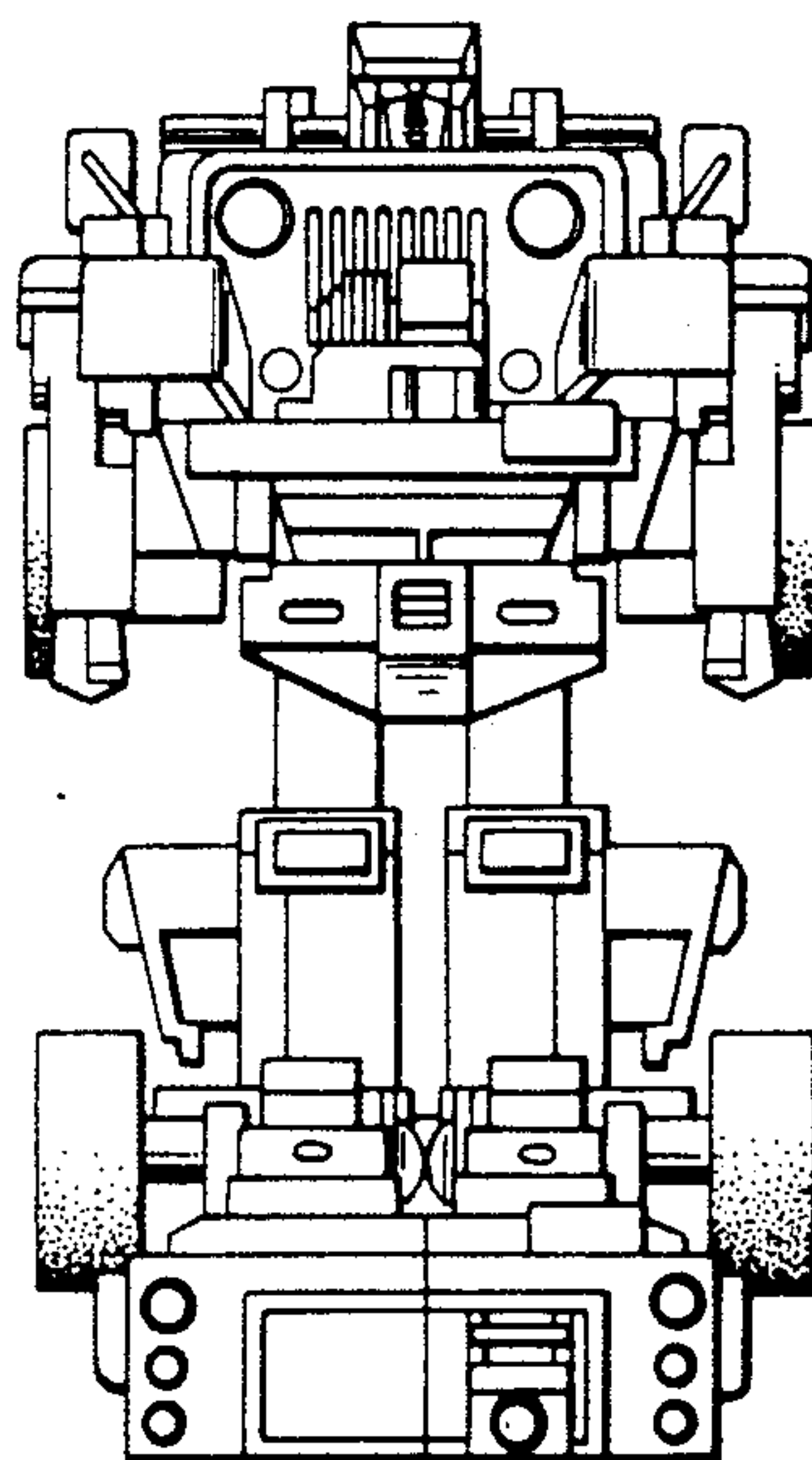

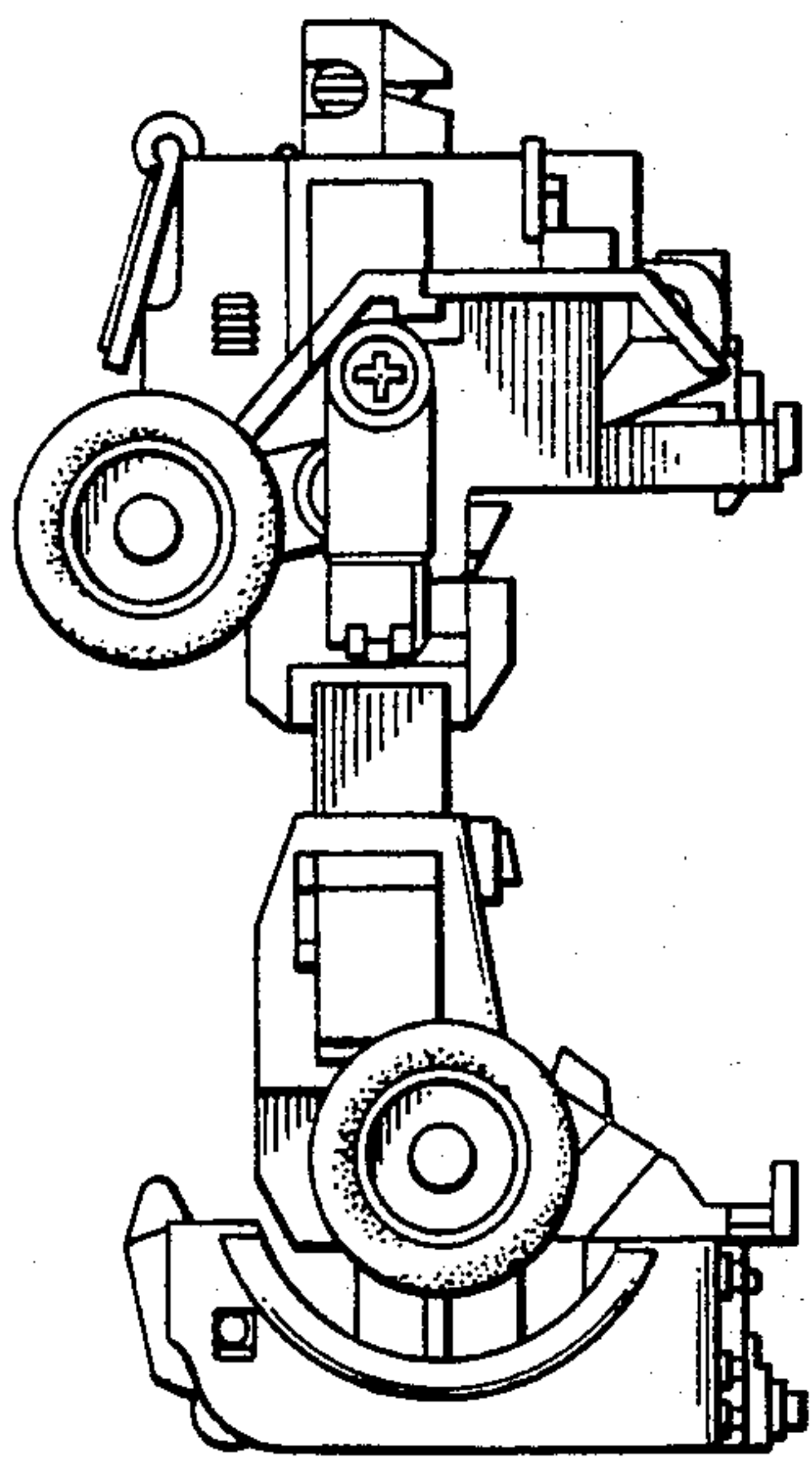

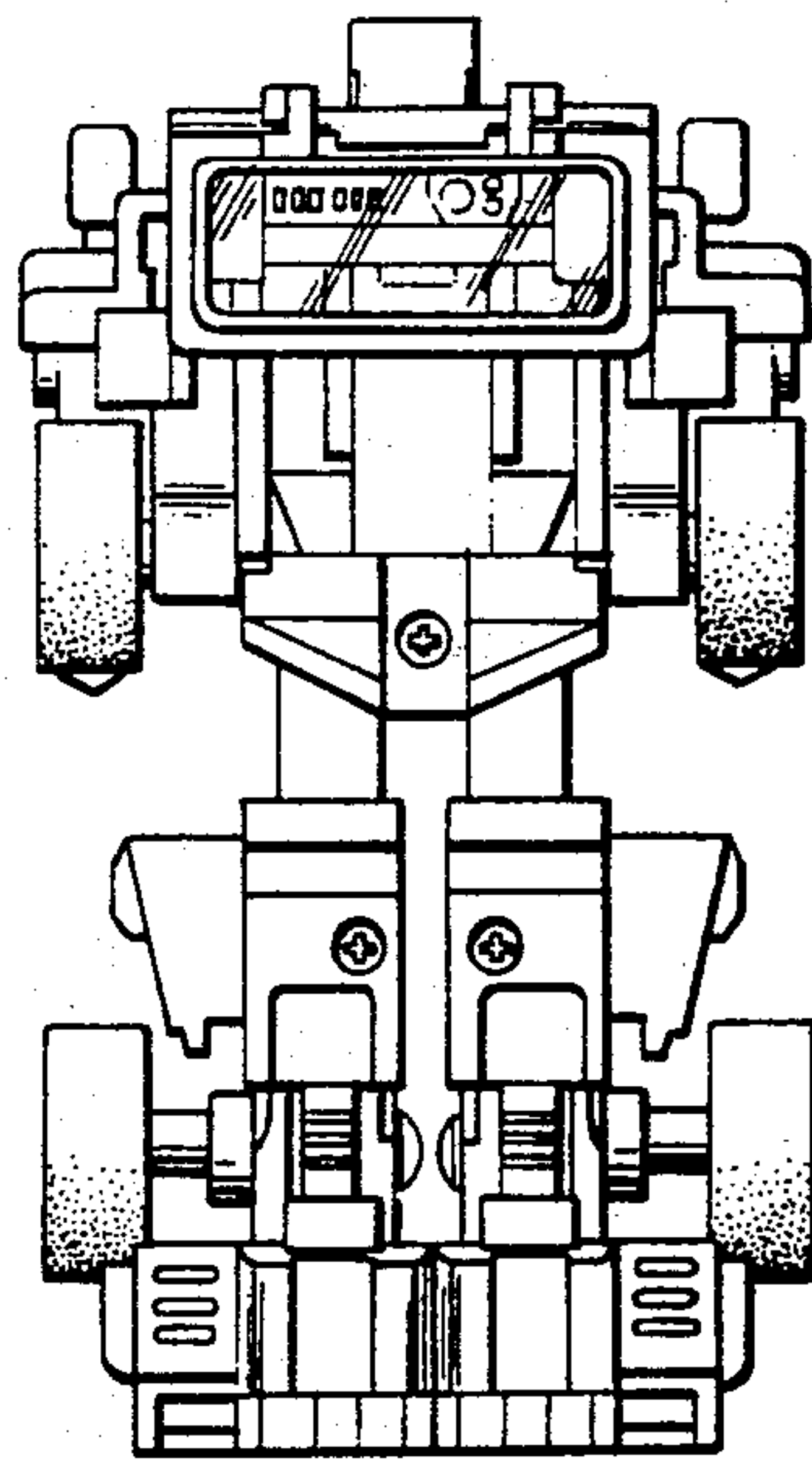

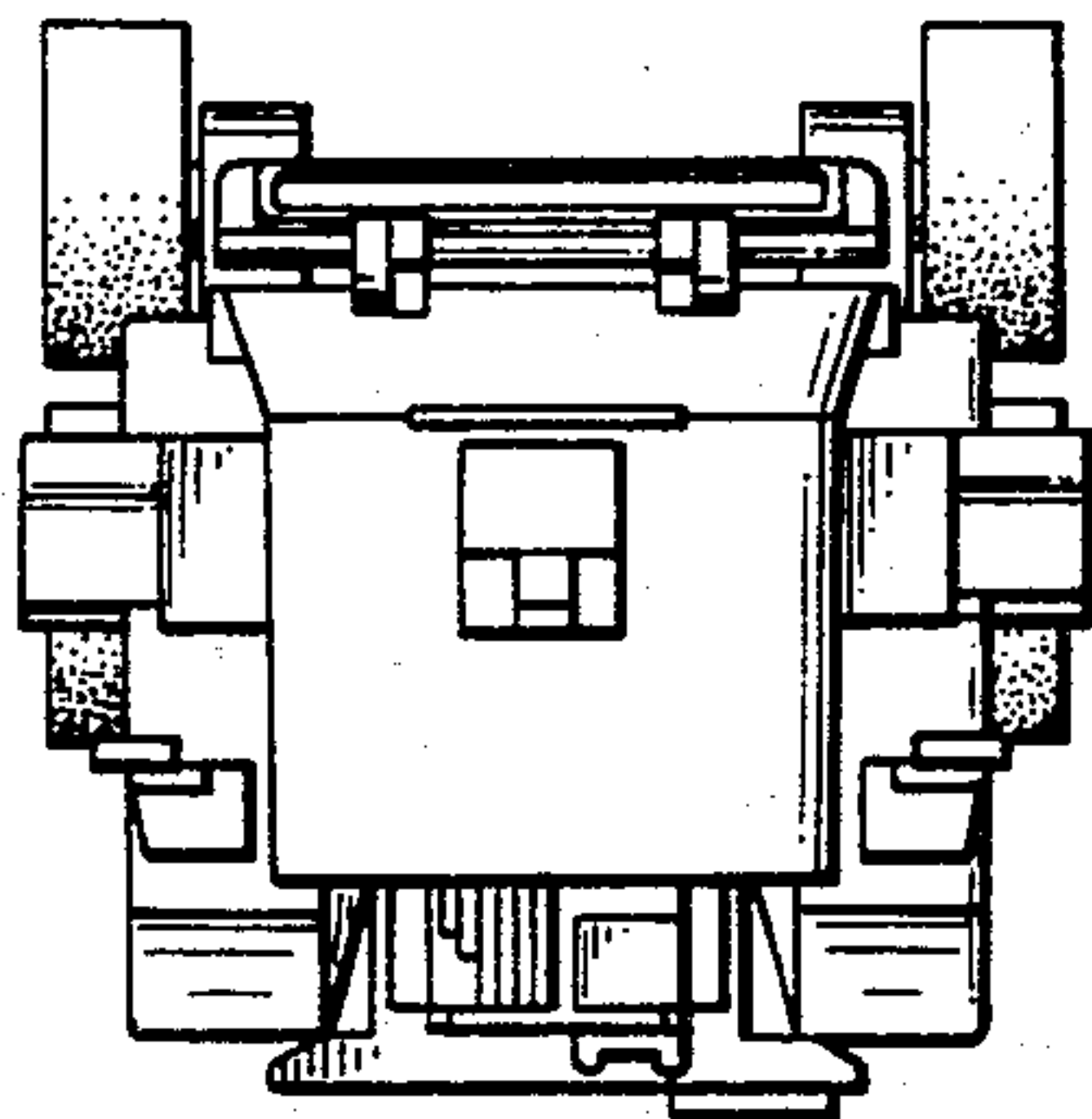

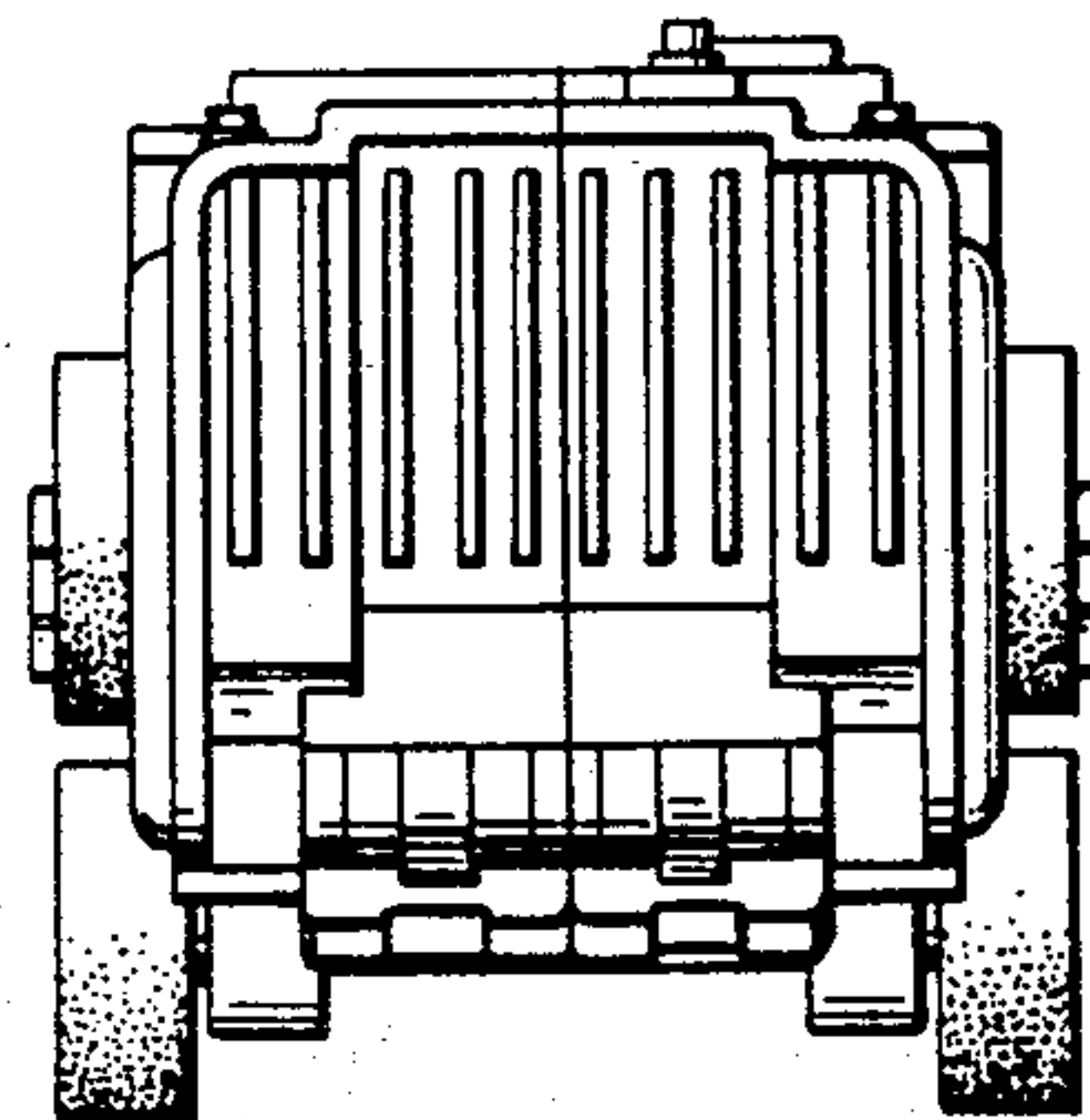
