[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy weapon, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy weapon showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a side elevation view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 2.

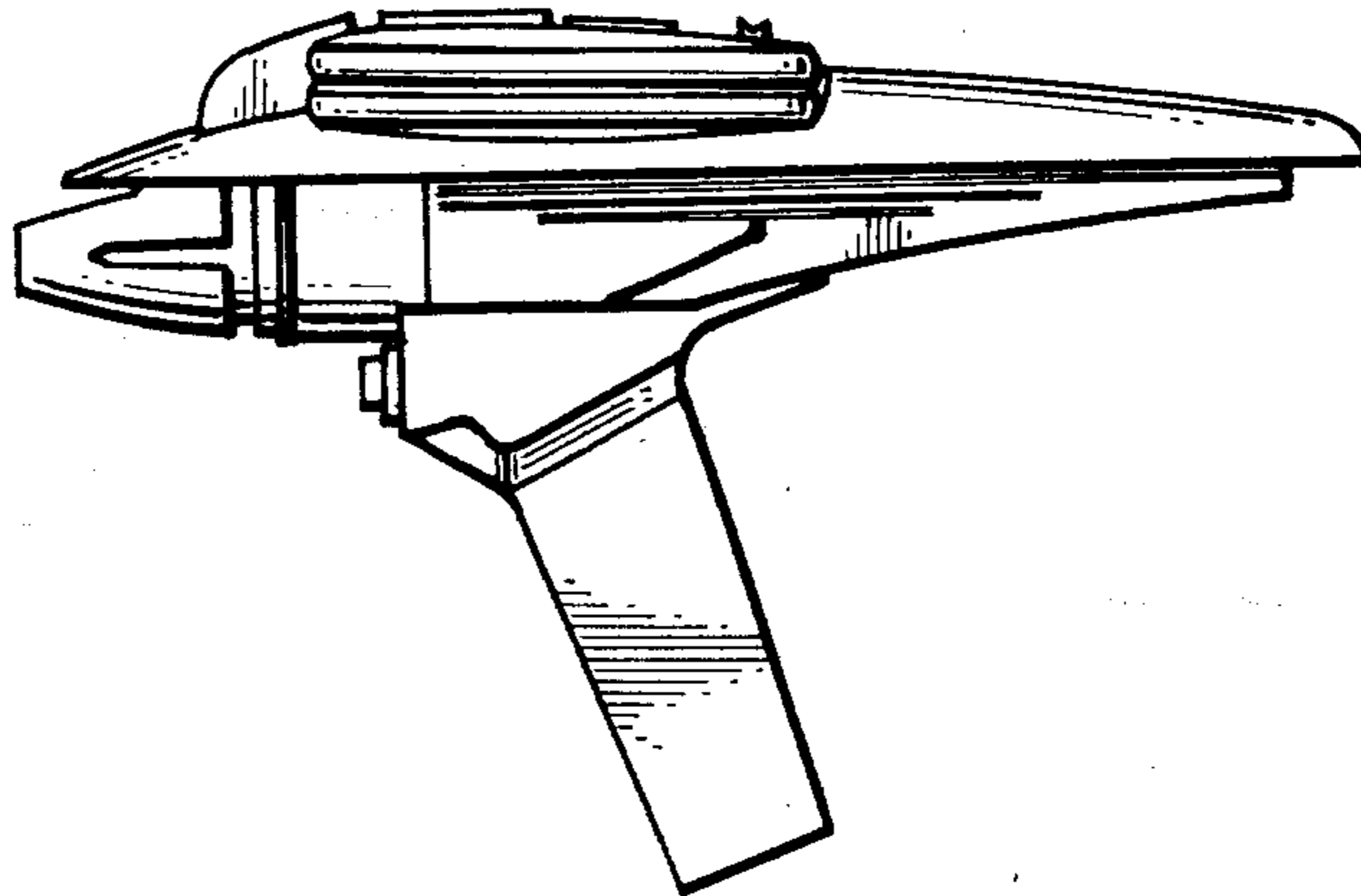

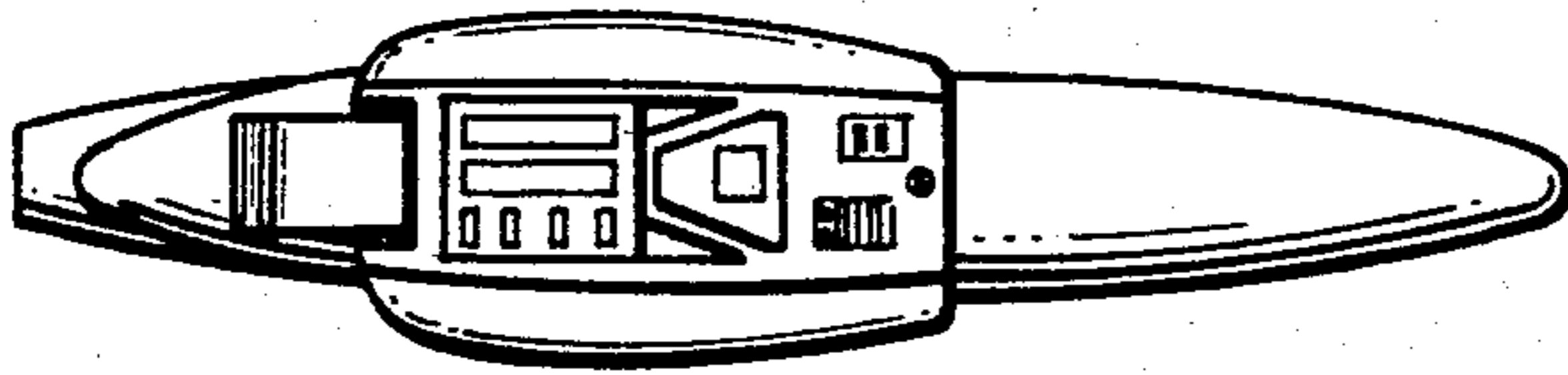

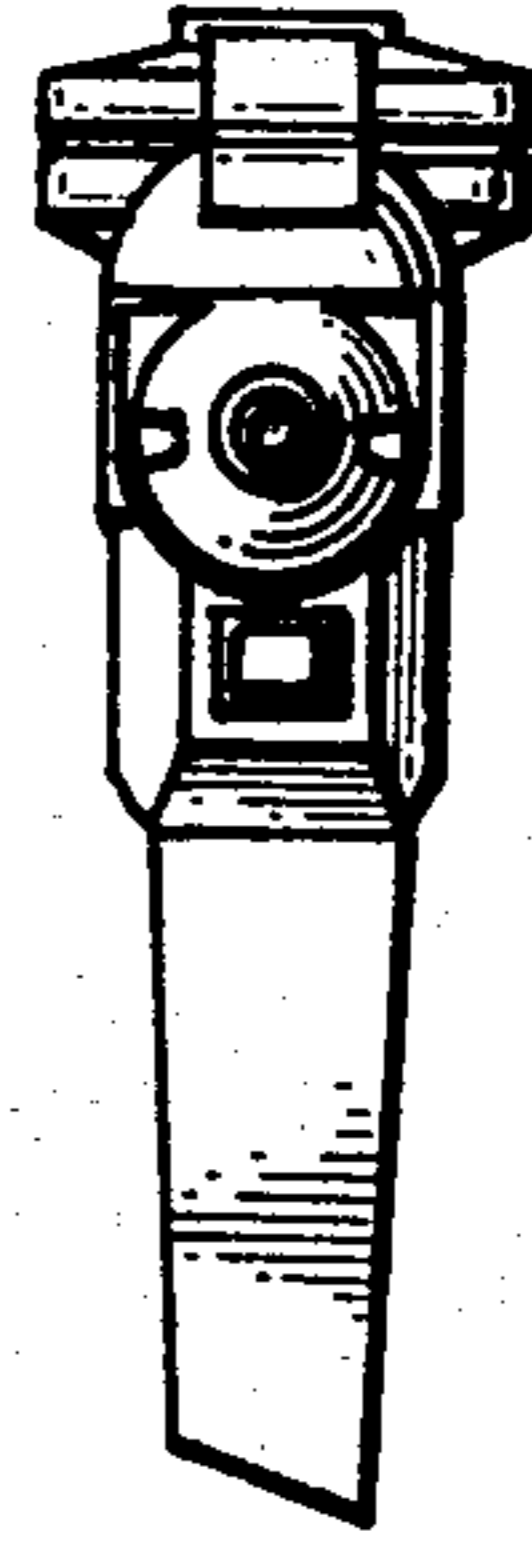

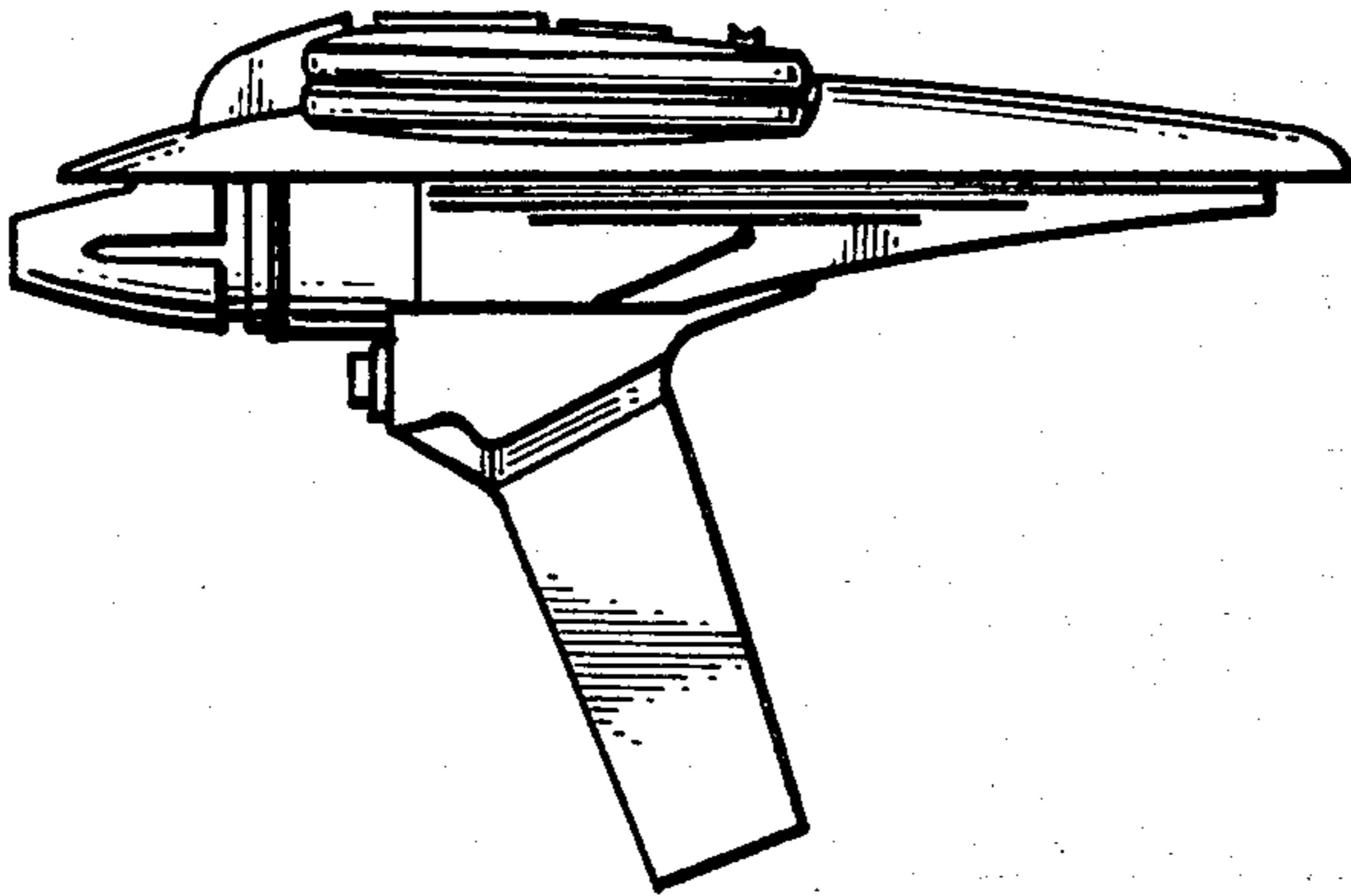

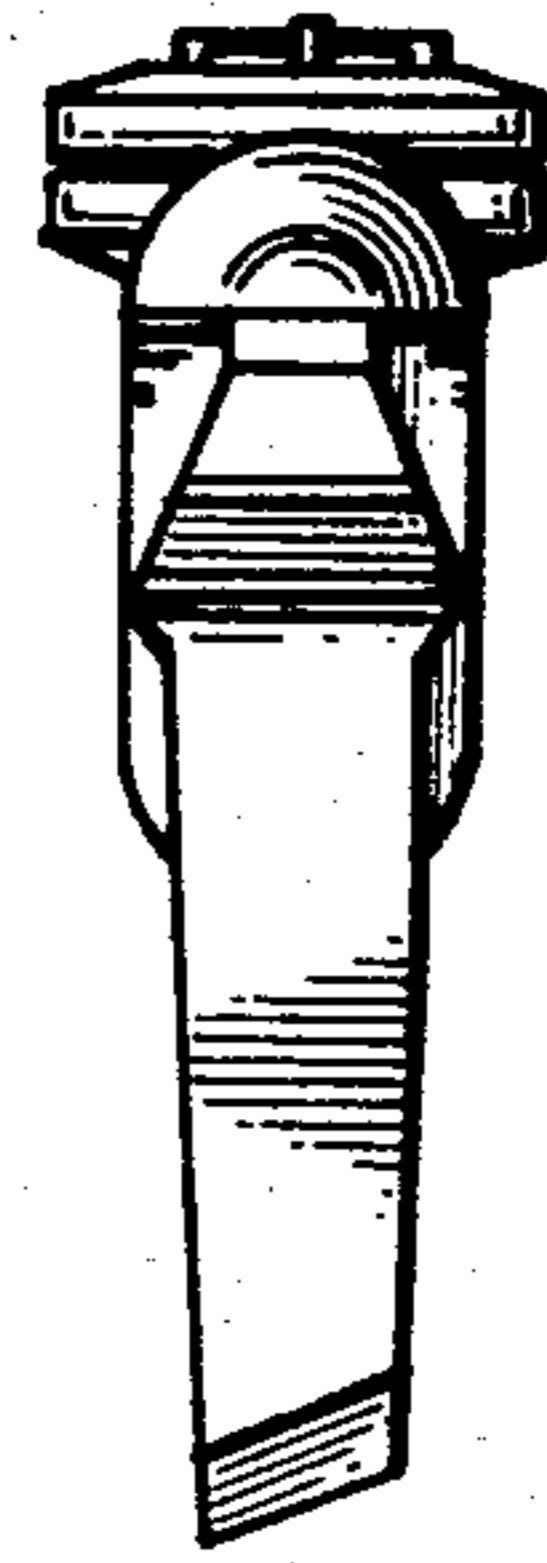

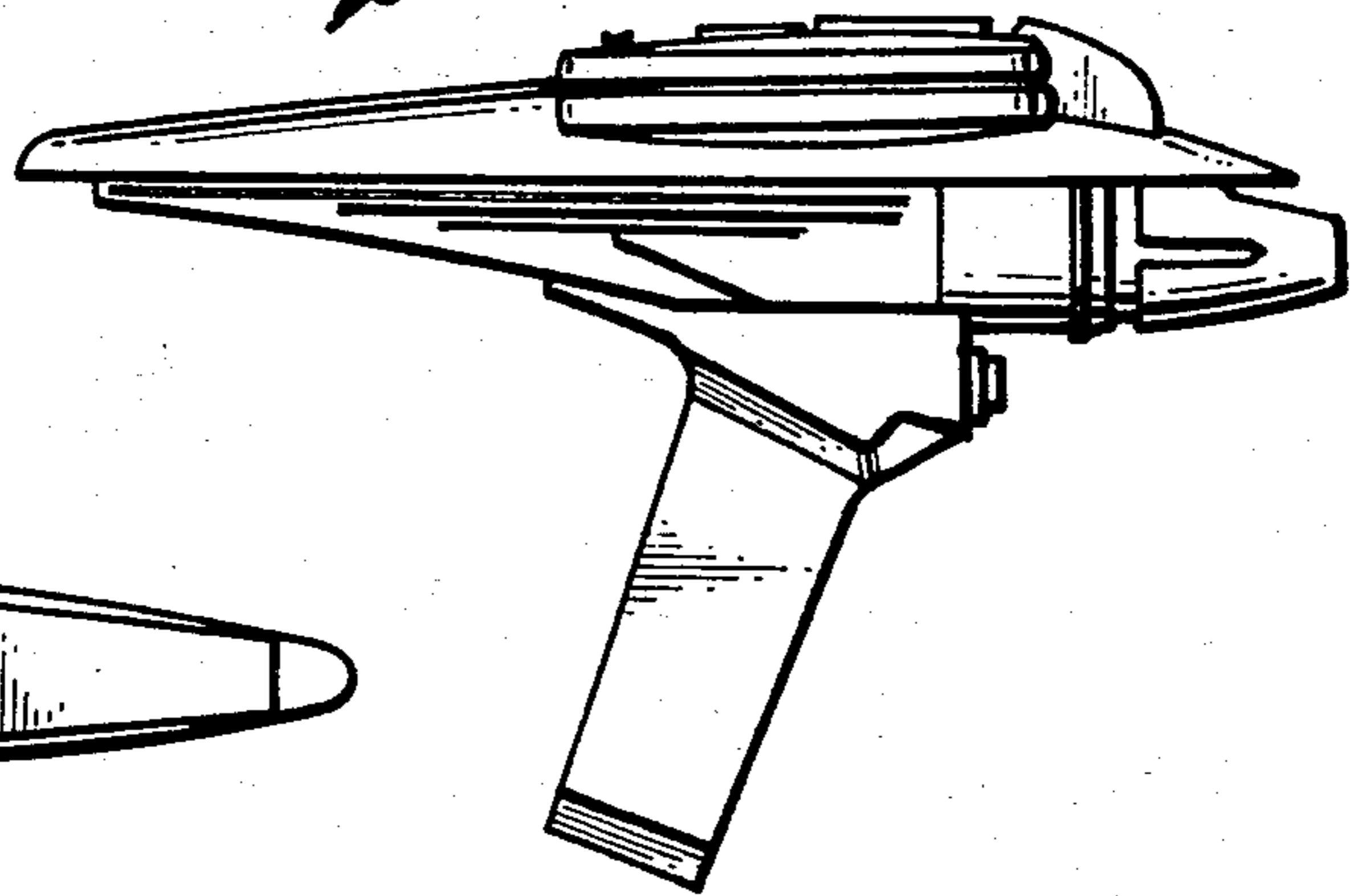
