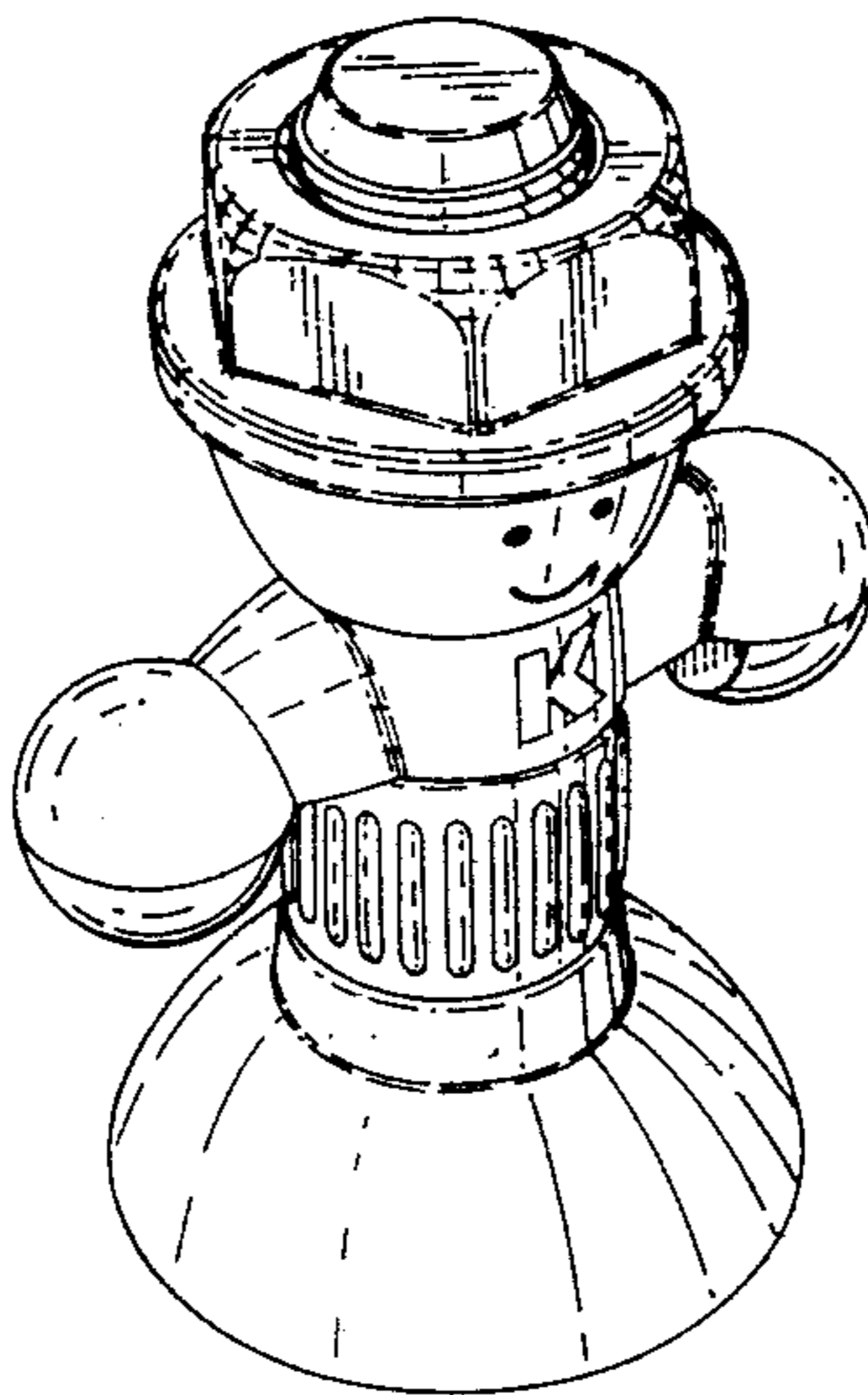

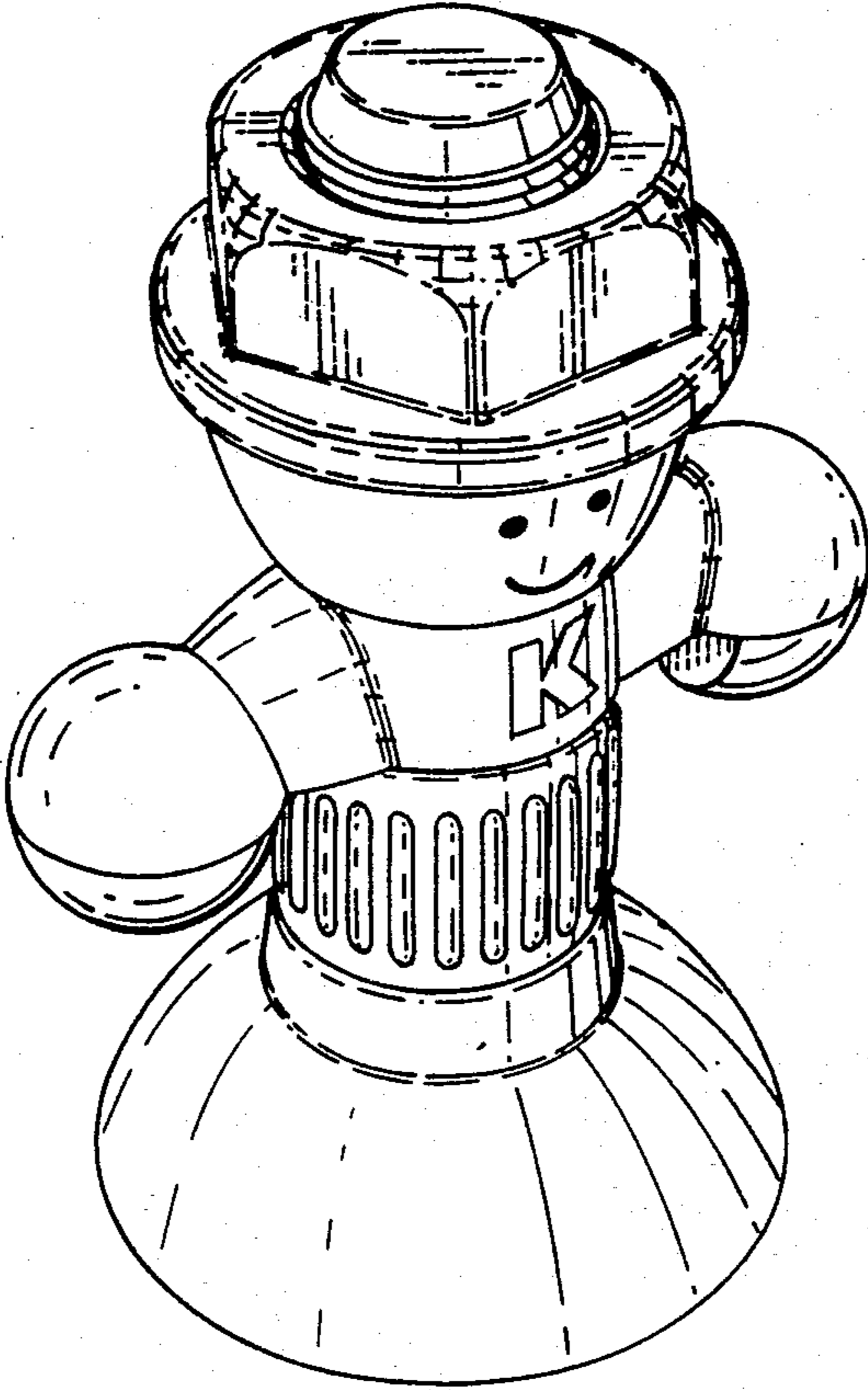
The ornamental design for a child's figure toy, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

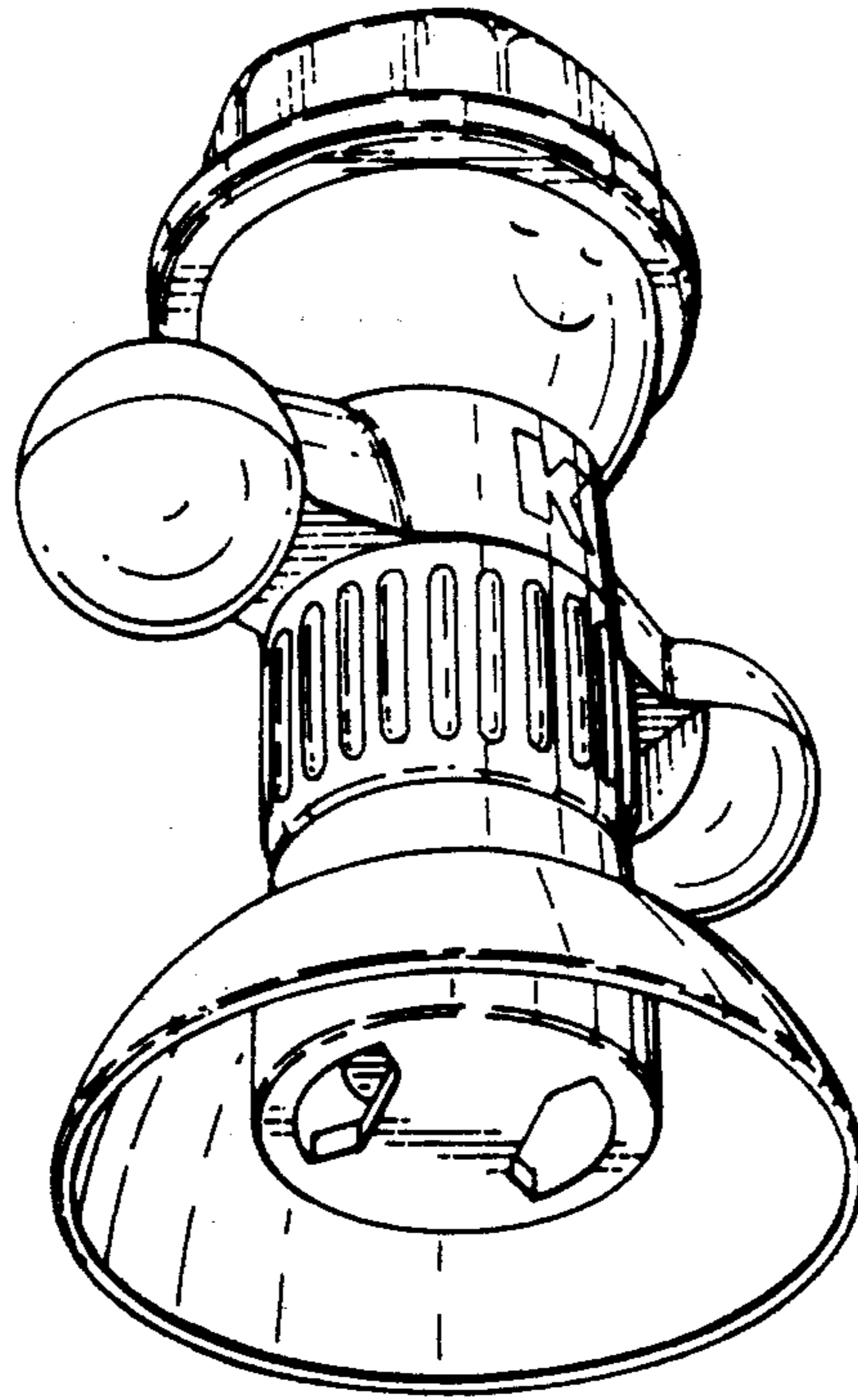
FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above and one side of a child's figure toy embodying our novel design.
