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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bracket for a hanging plant, or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bracket for a hanging plant or similar article showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, opposite that seen in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1.
