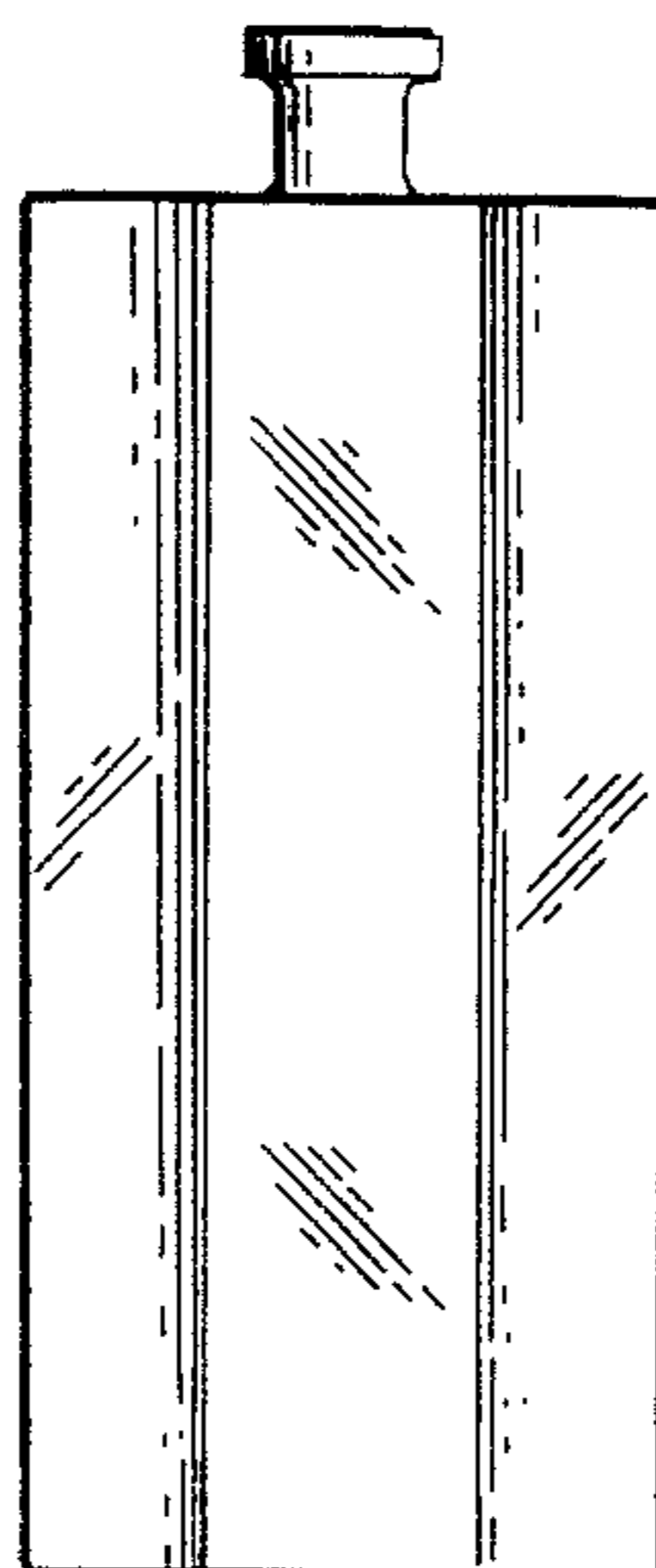

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle embodying and showing my new design, the left side, right side and opposite side views being the same in appearance; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is an elevational similar to FIG. 1 but on a reduced scale and showing a water cooler in broken lines for the purpose of illustrating environmental use only.



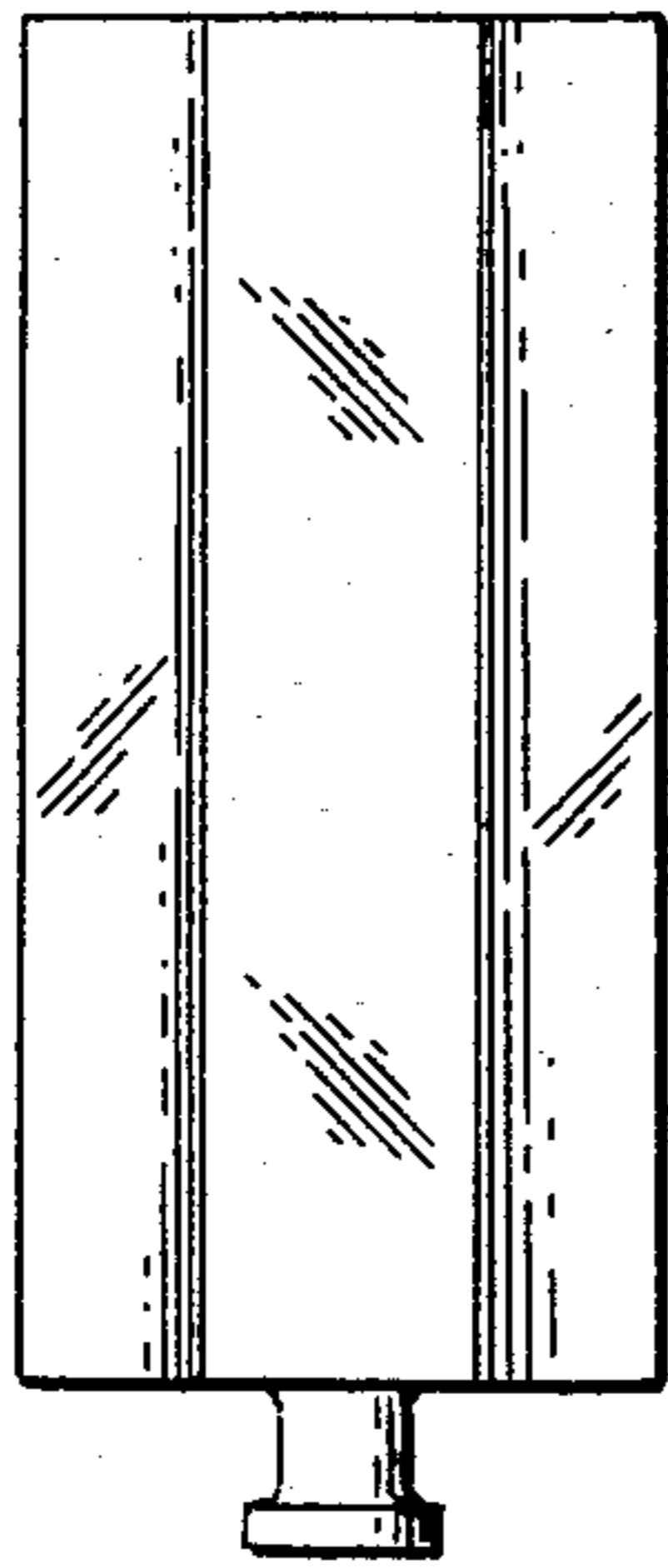

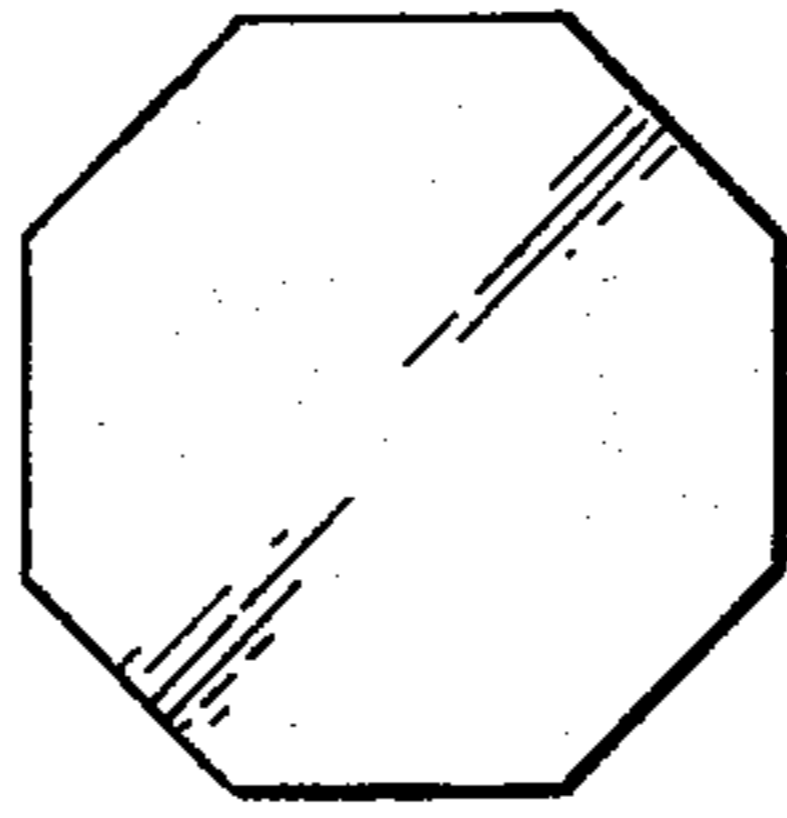

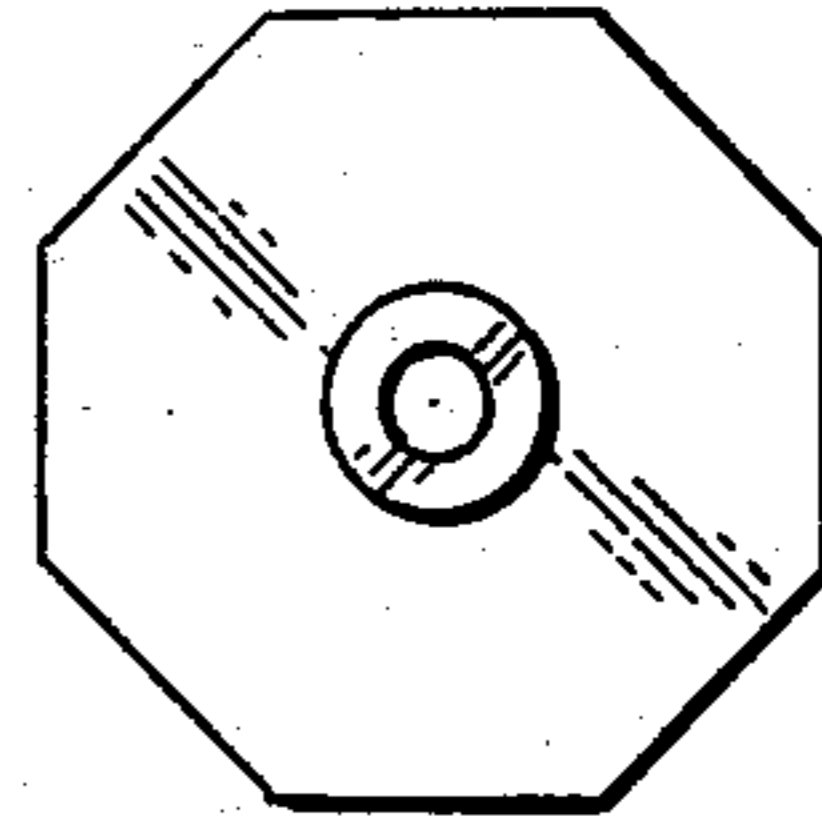

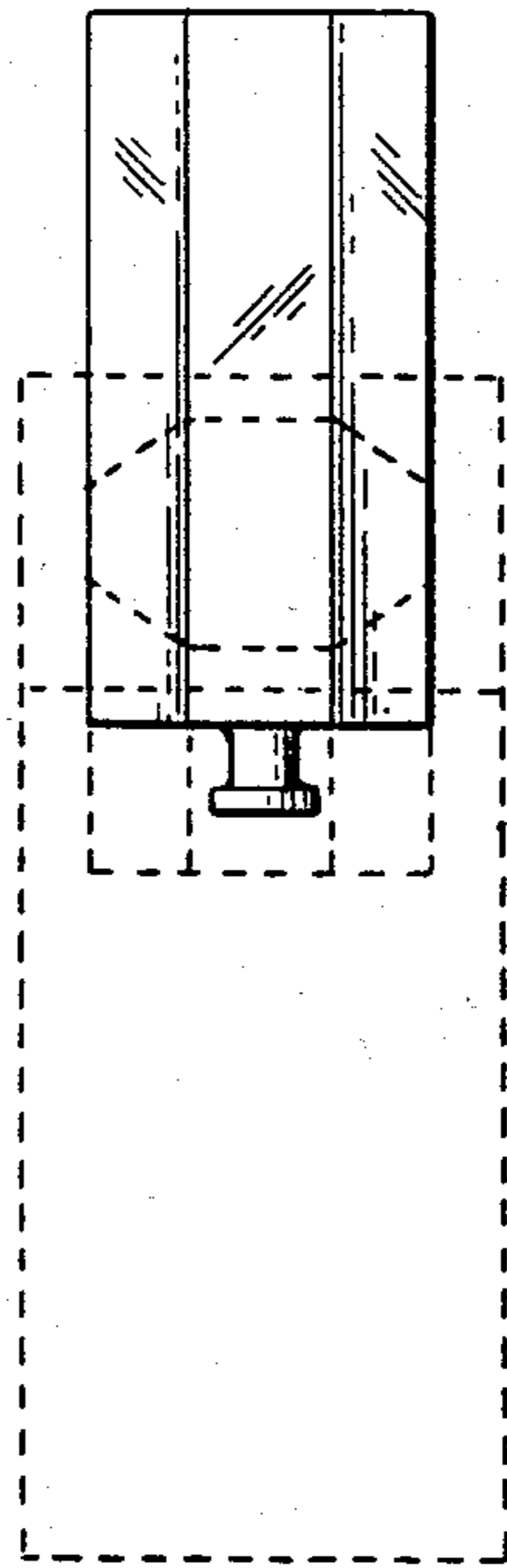
