**DESCRIPTION**

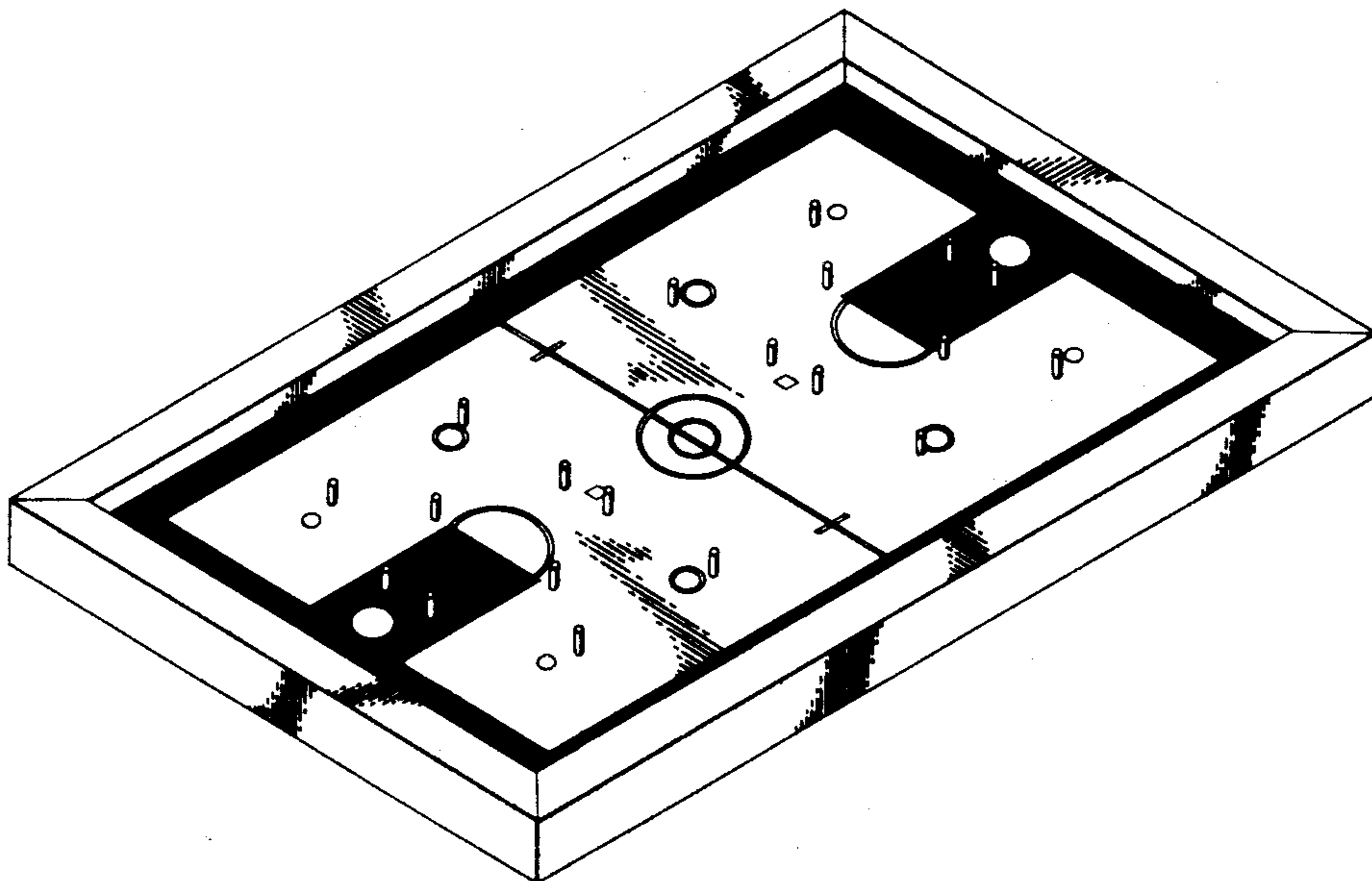
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a gameboard showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.



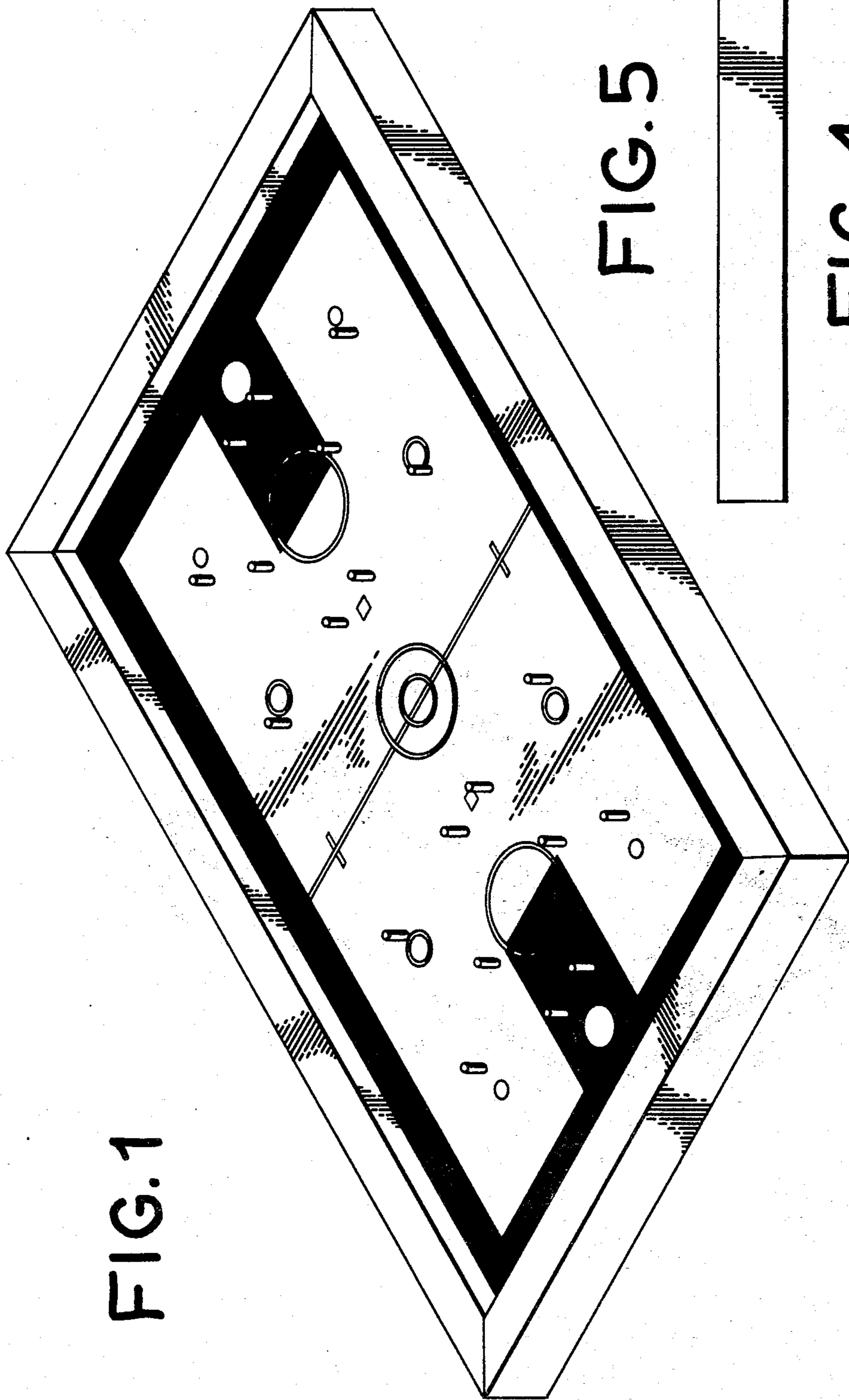

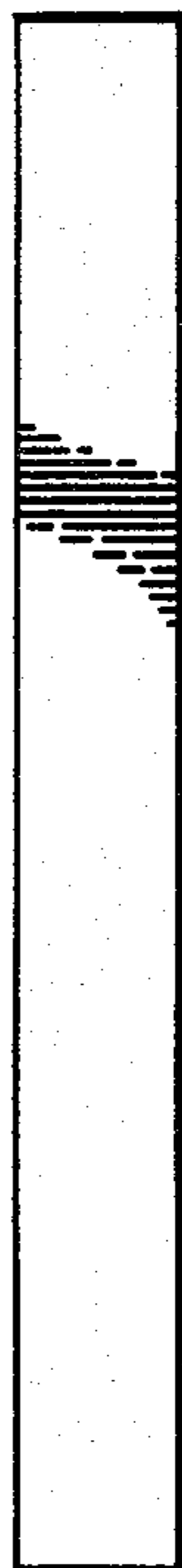

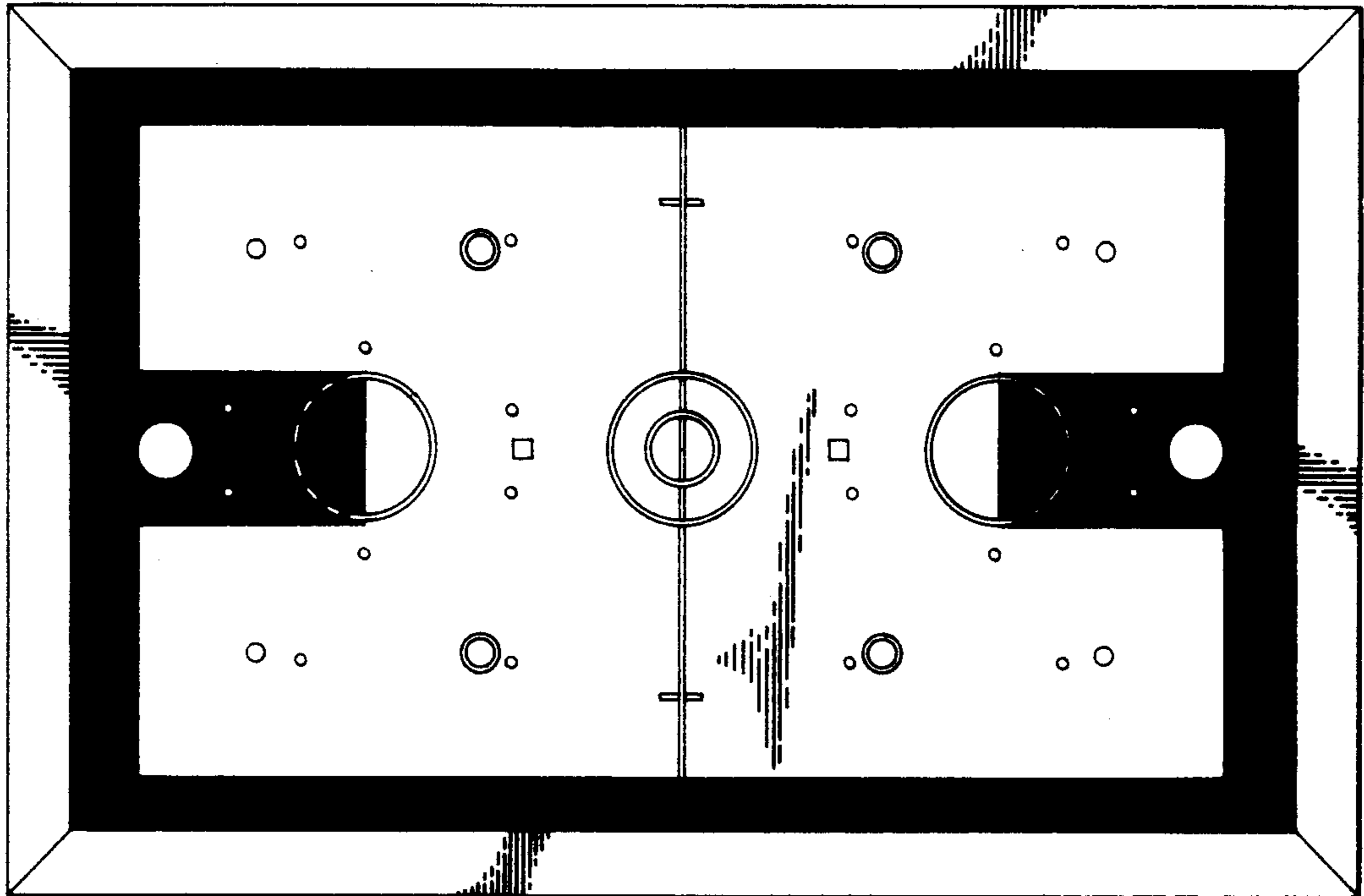
