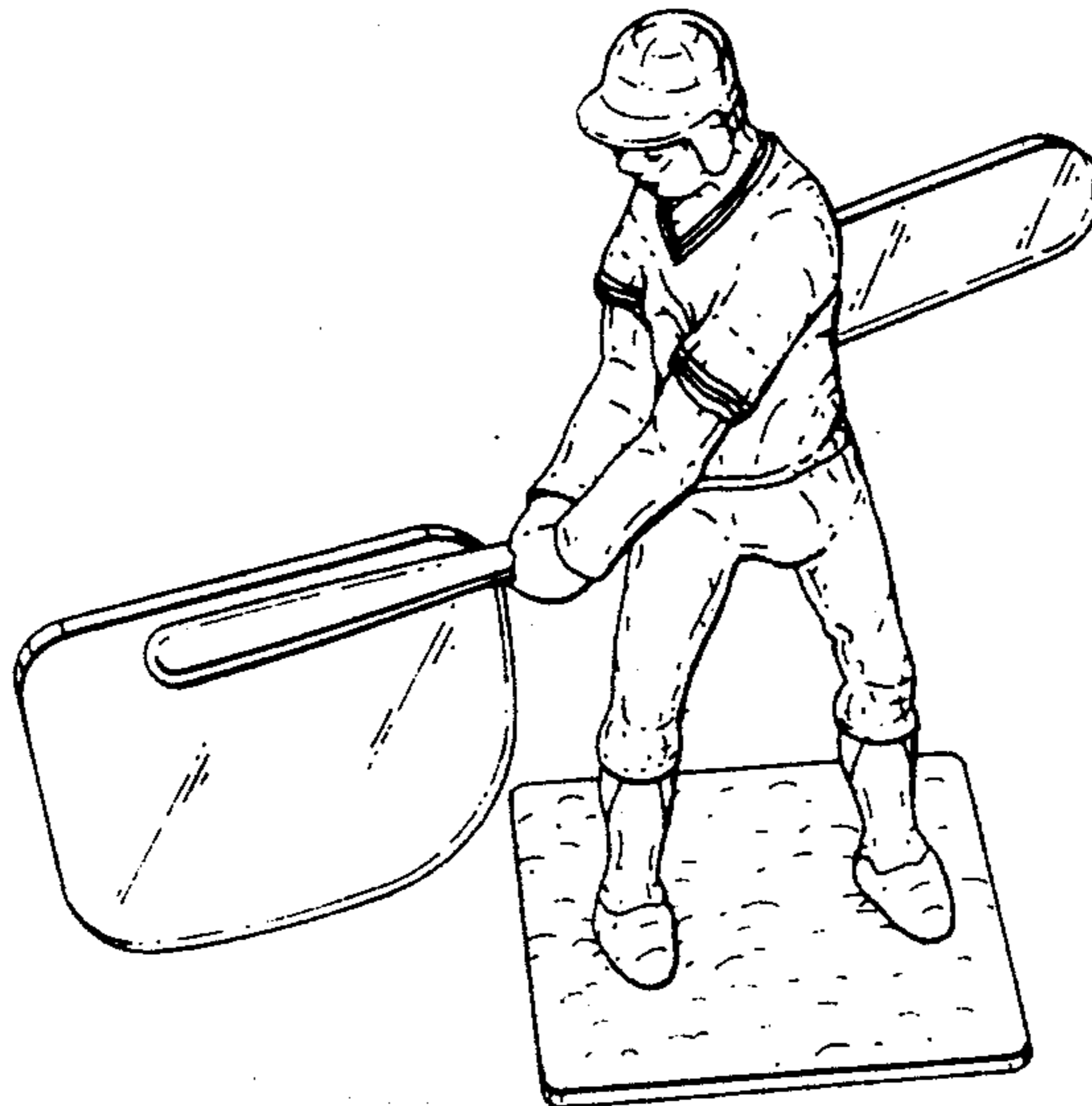

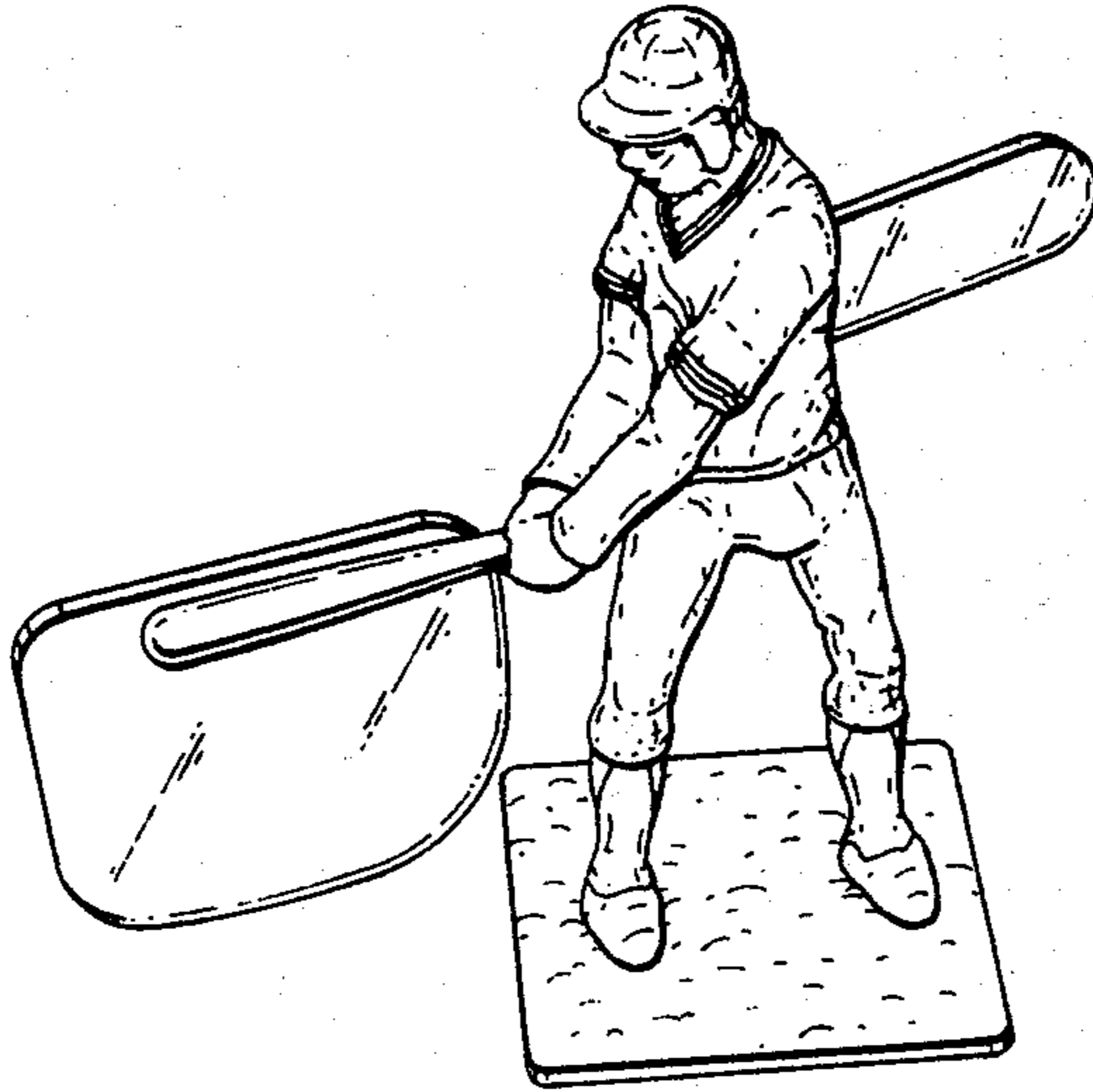
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy baseball batter, substantially as shown.

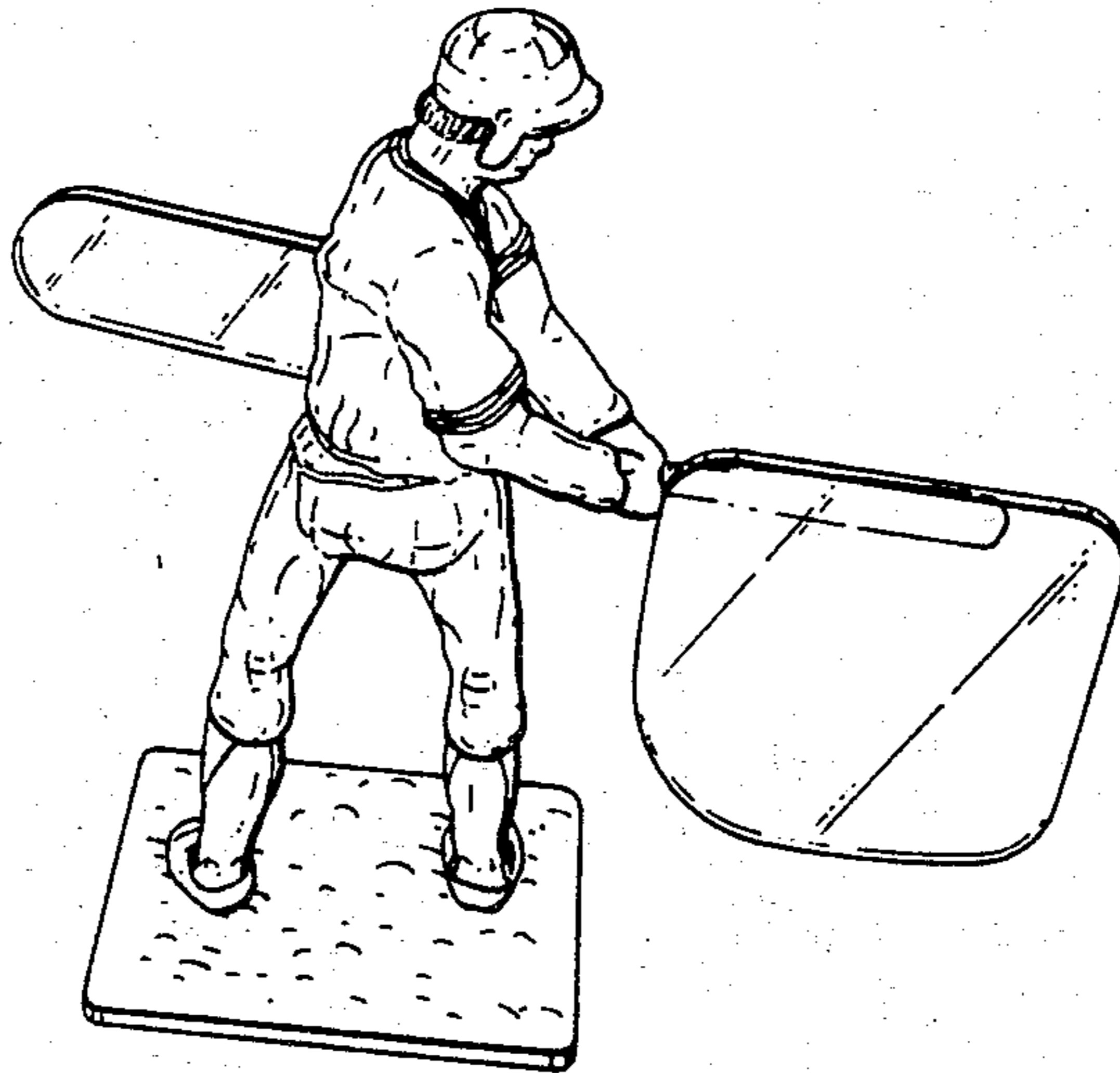
**DESCRIPTION**
