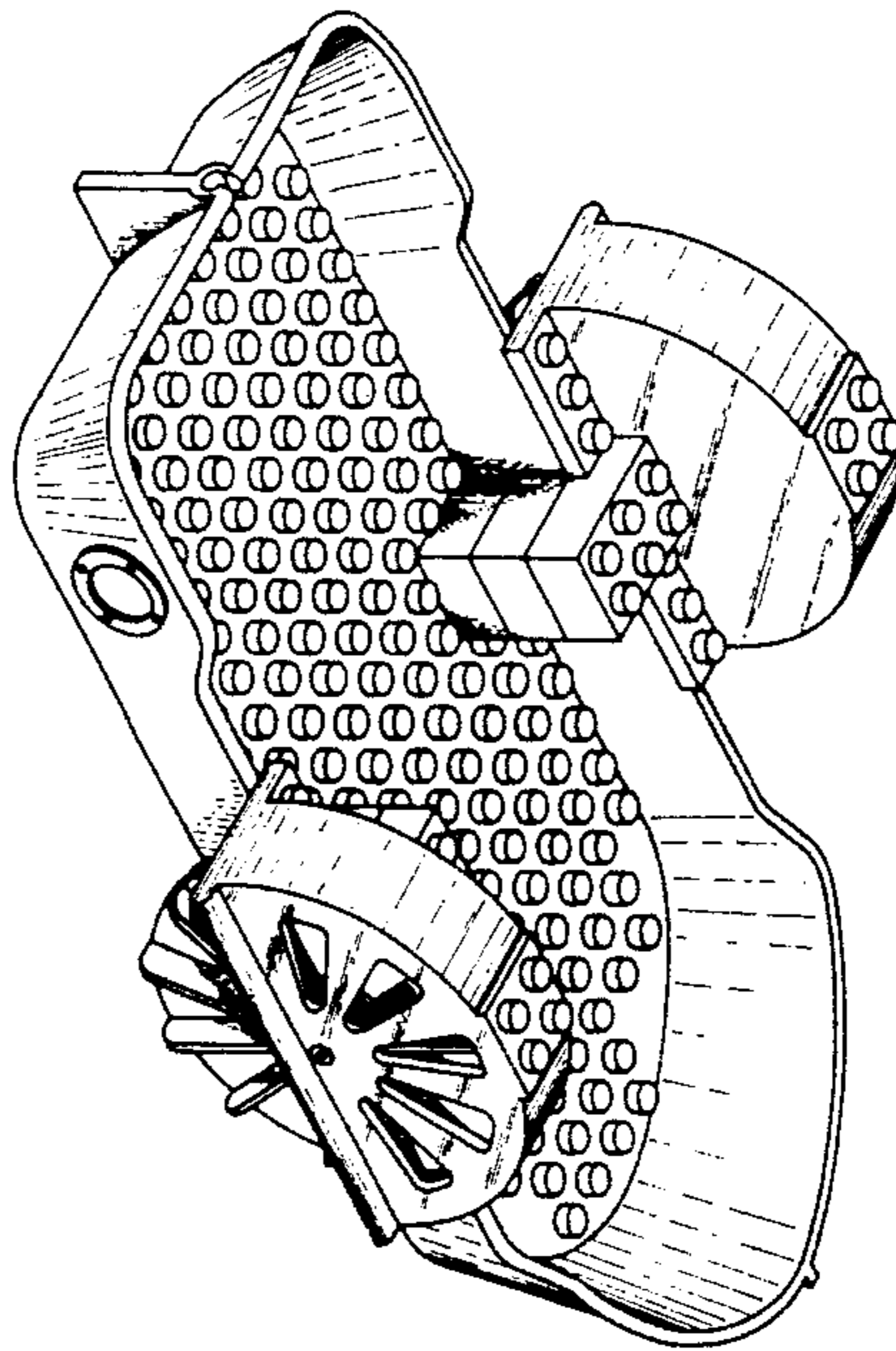

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy construction boat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy construction boat showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image.



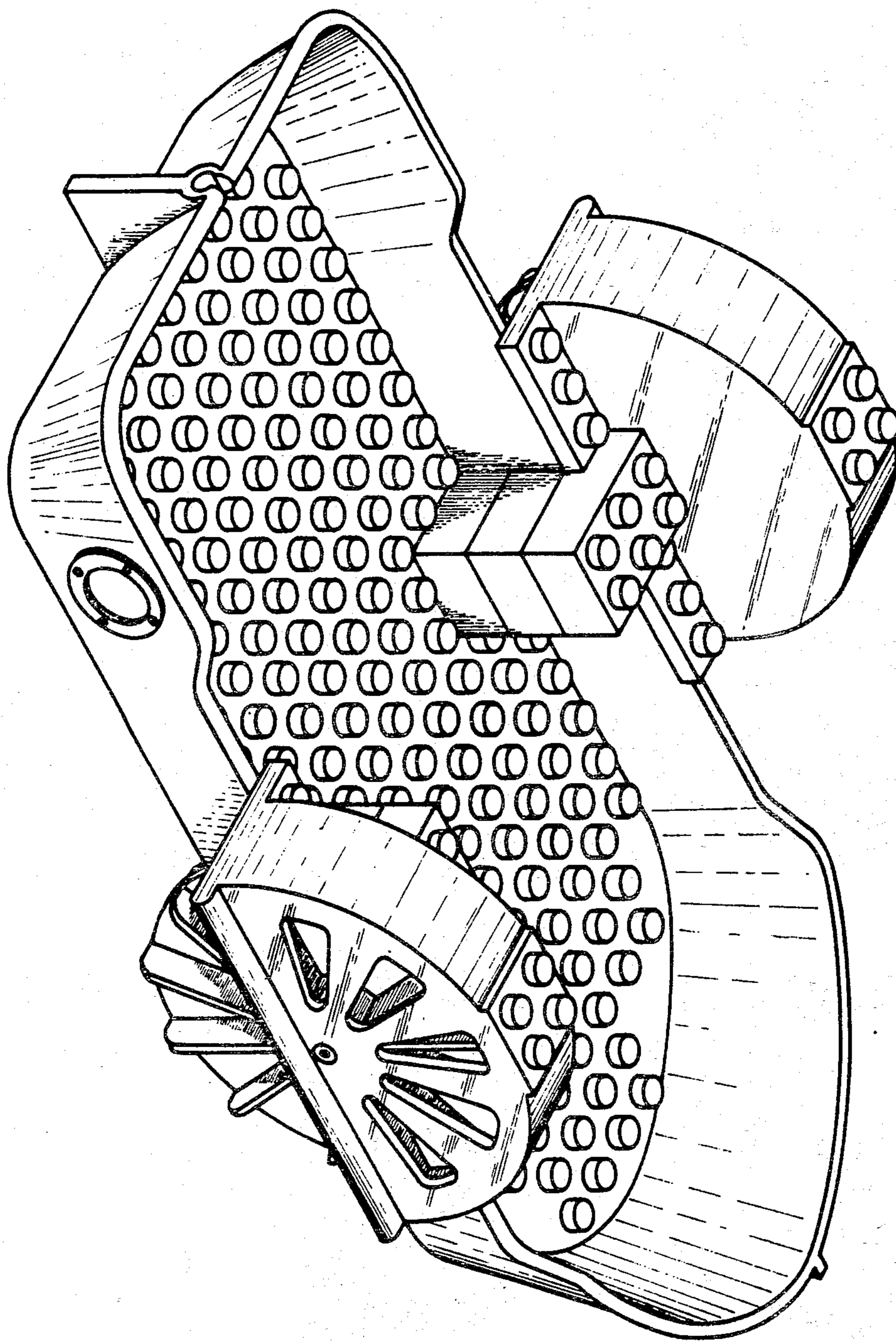

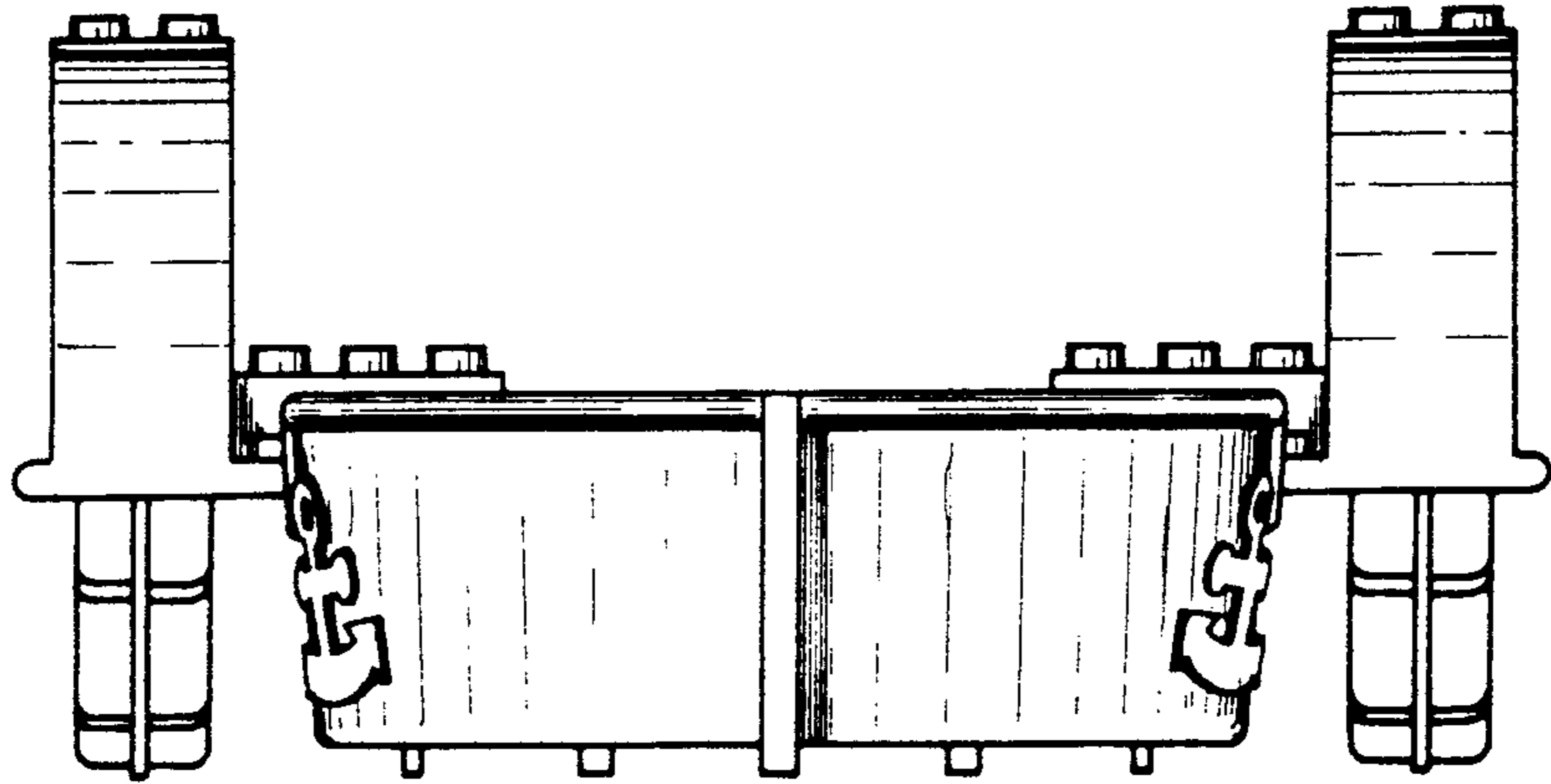

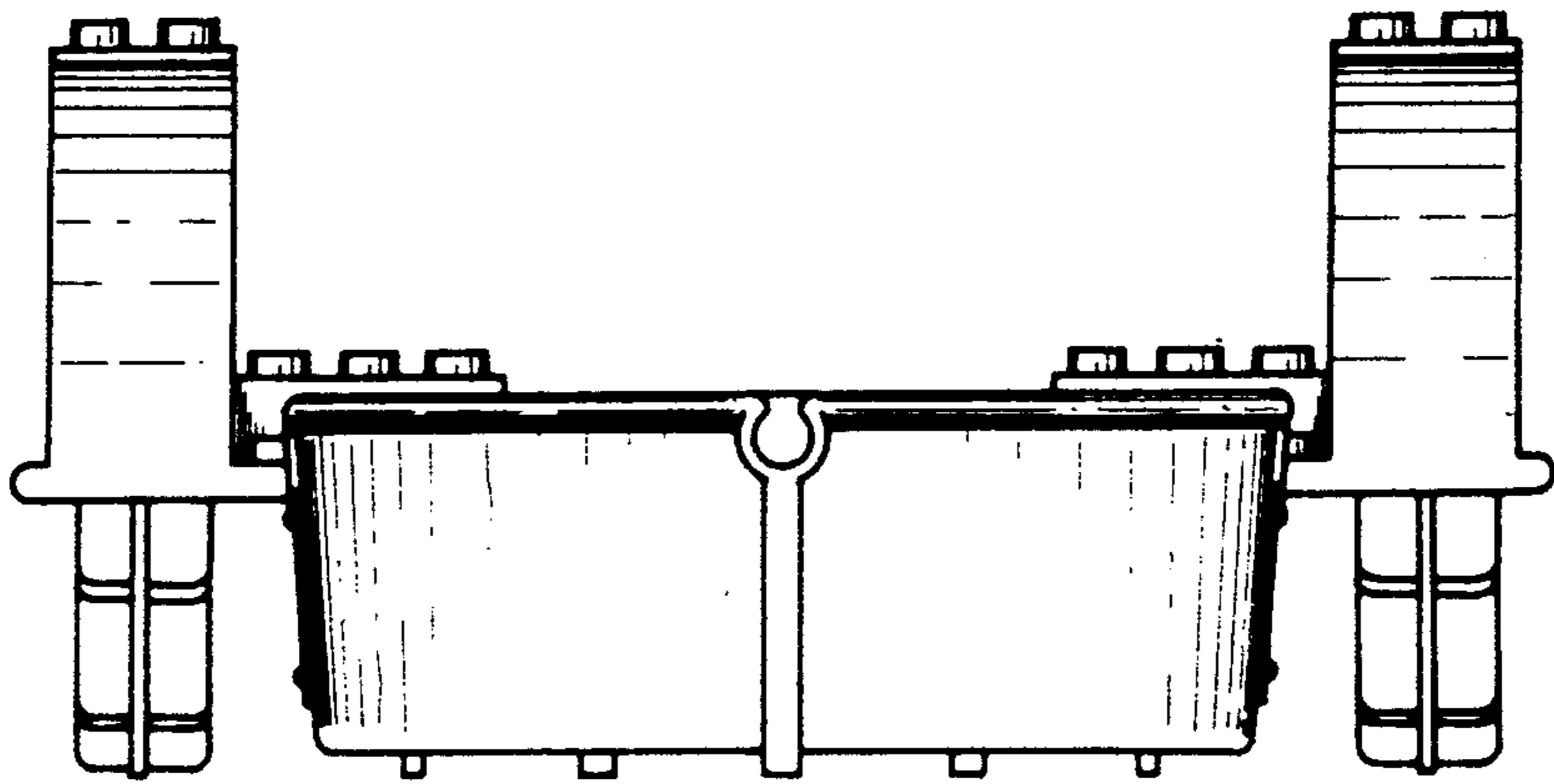

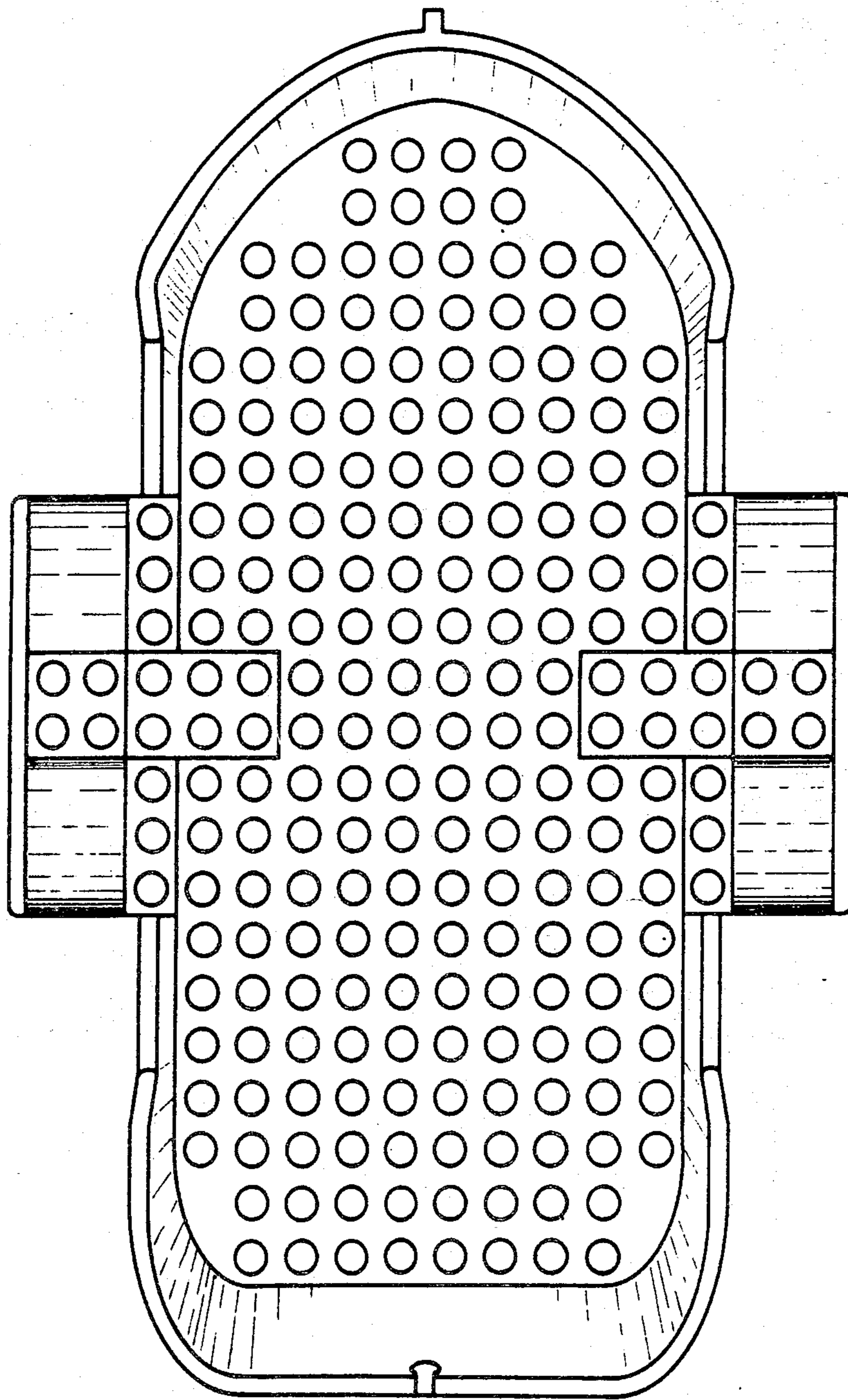

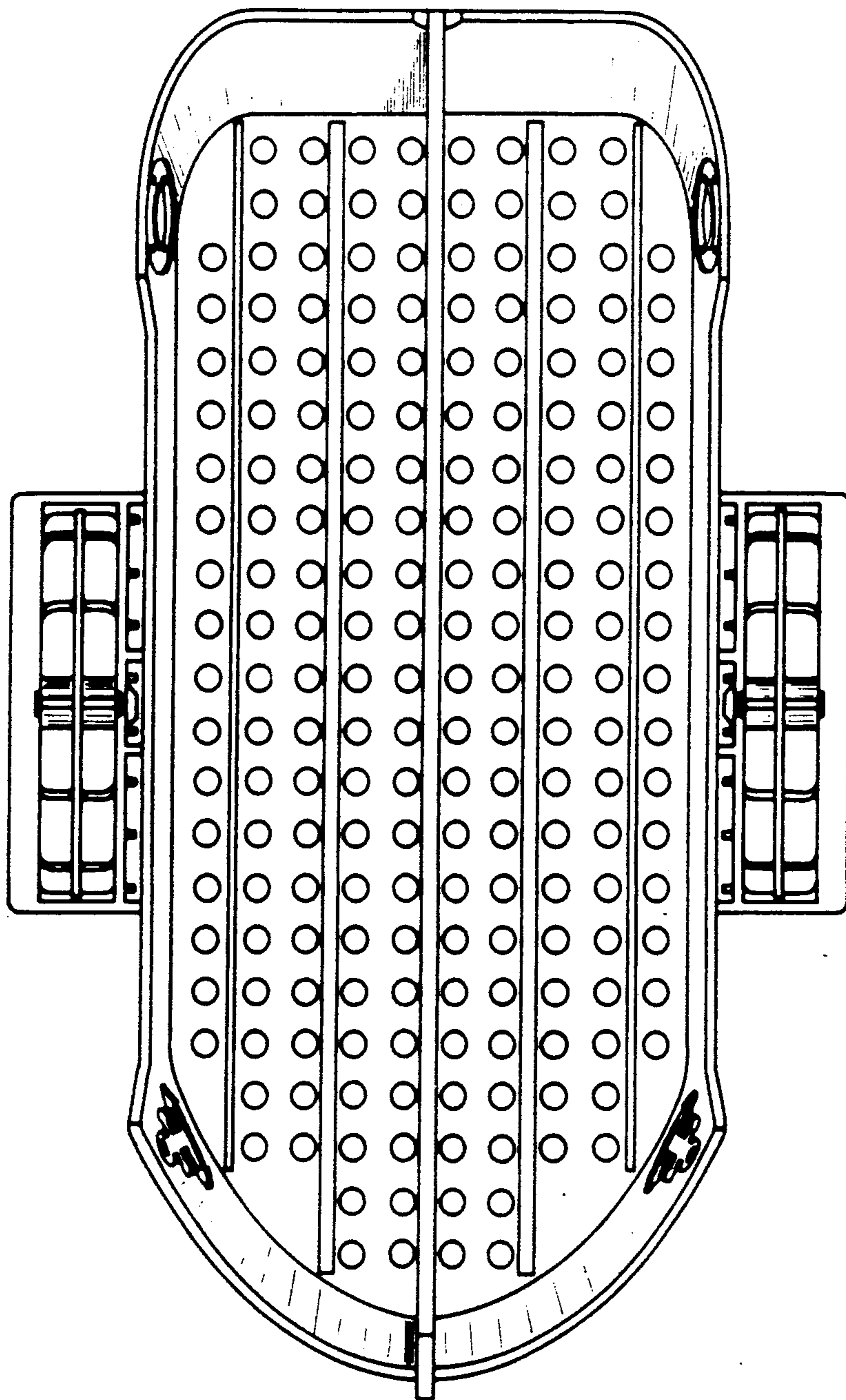

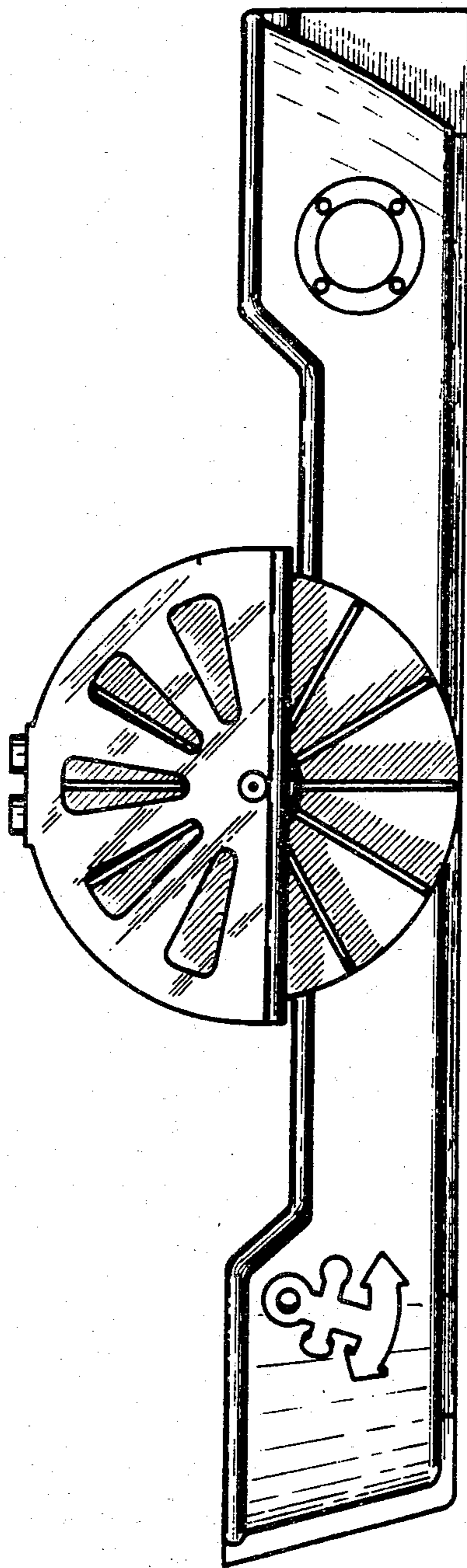
