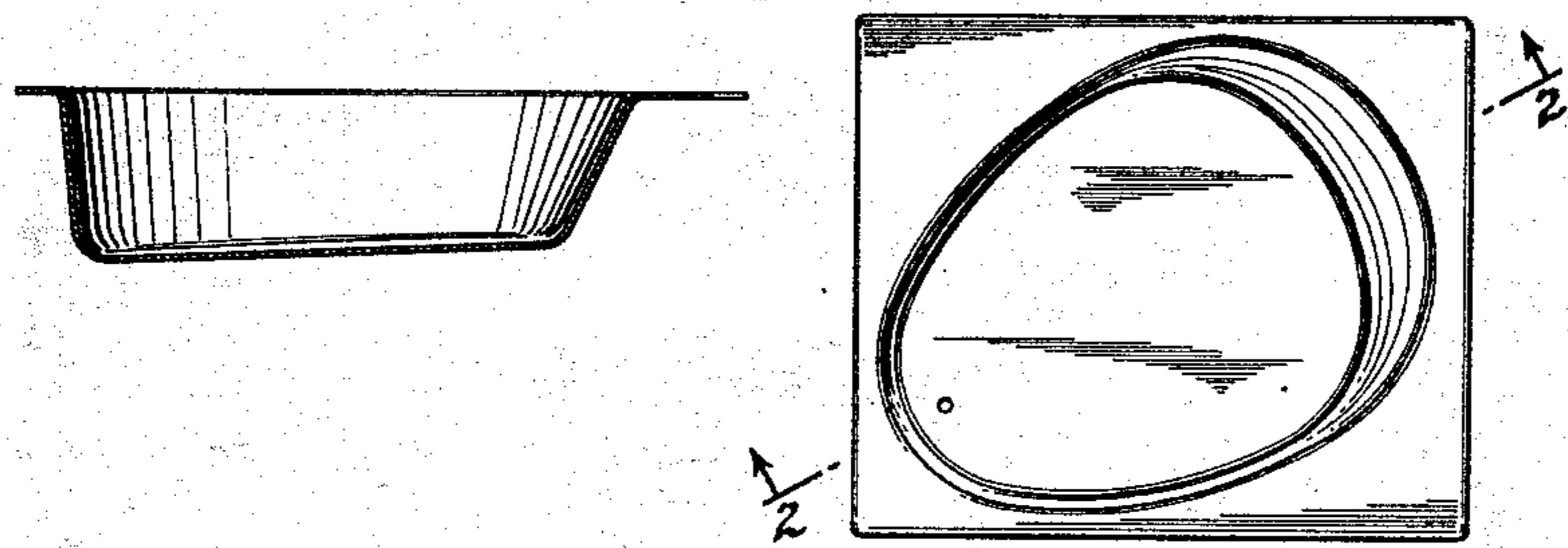

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sunken tub showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a cross sectional view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



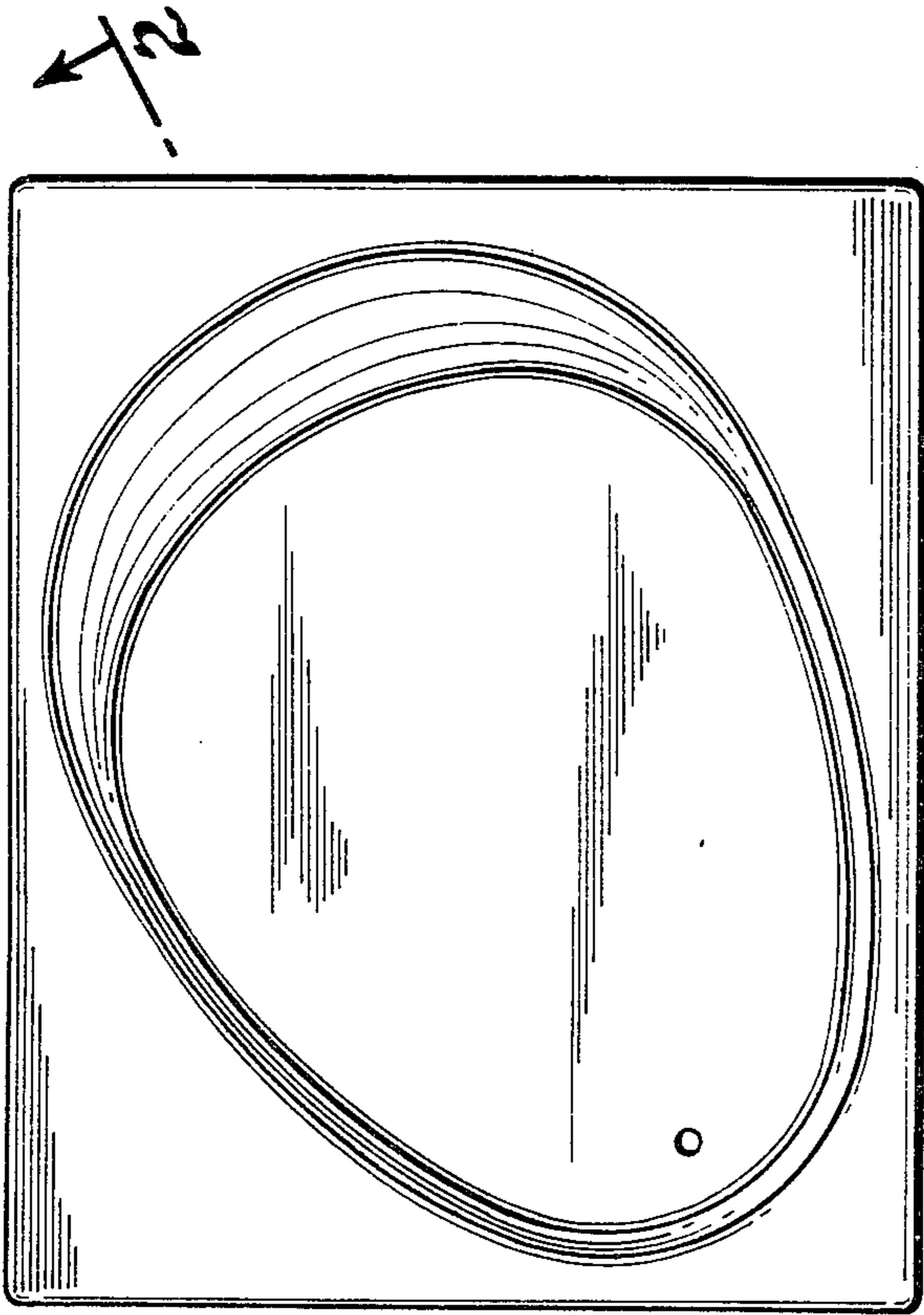

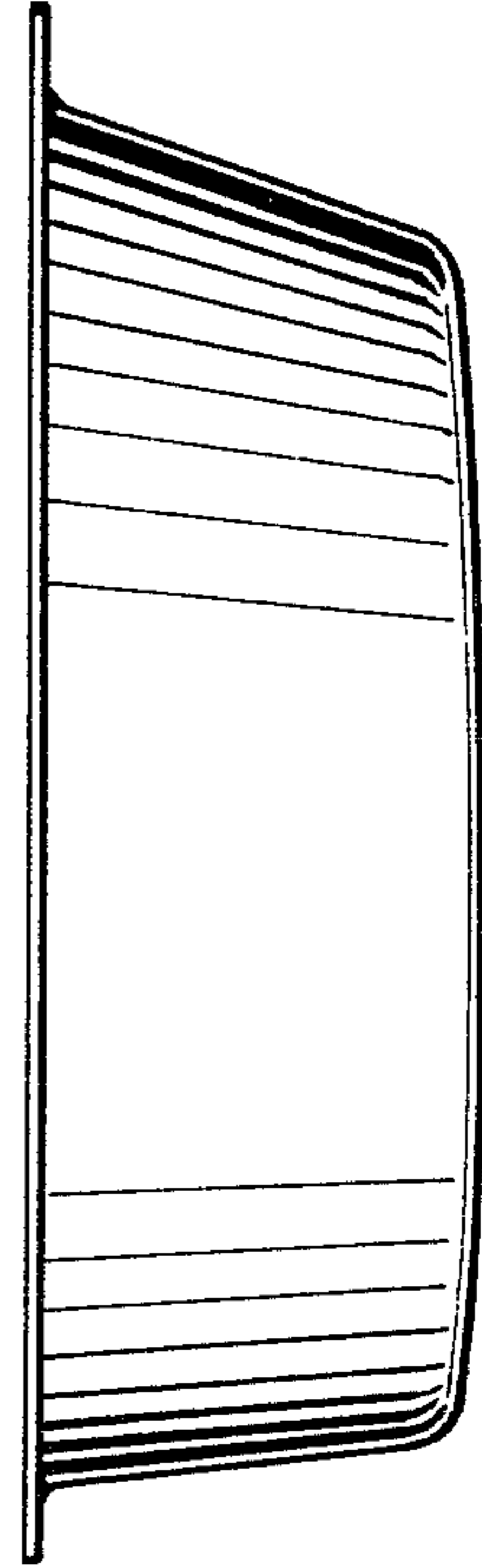

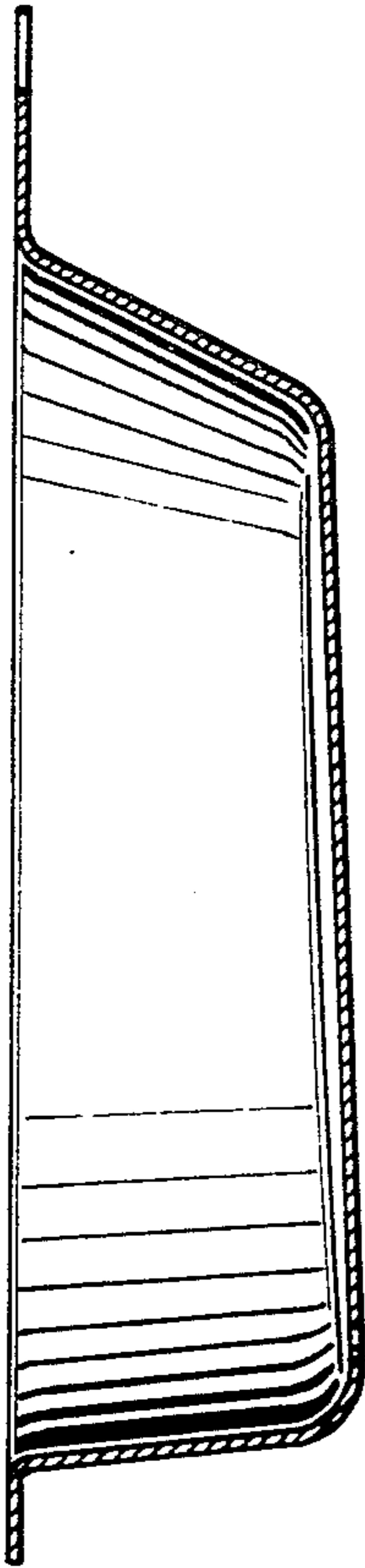

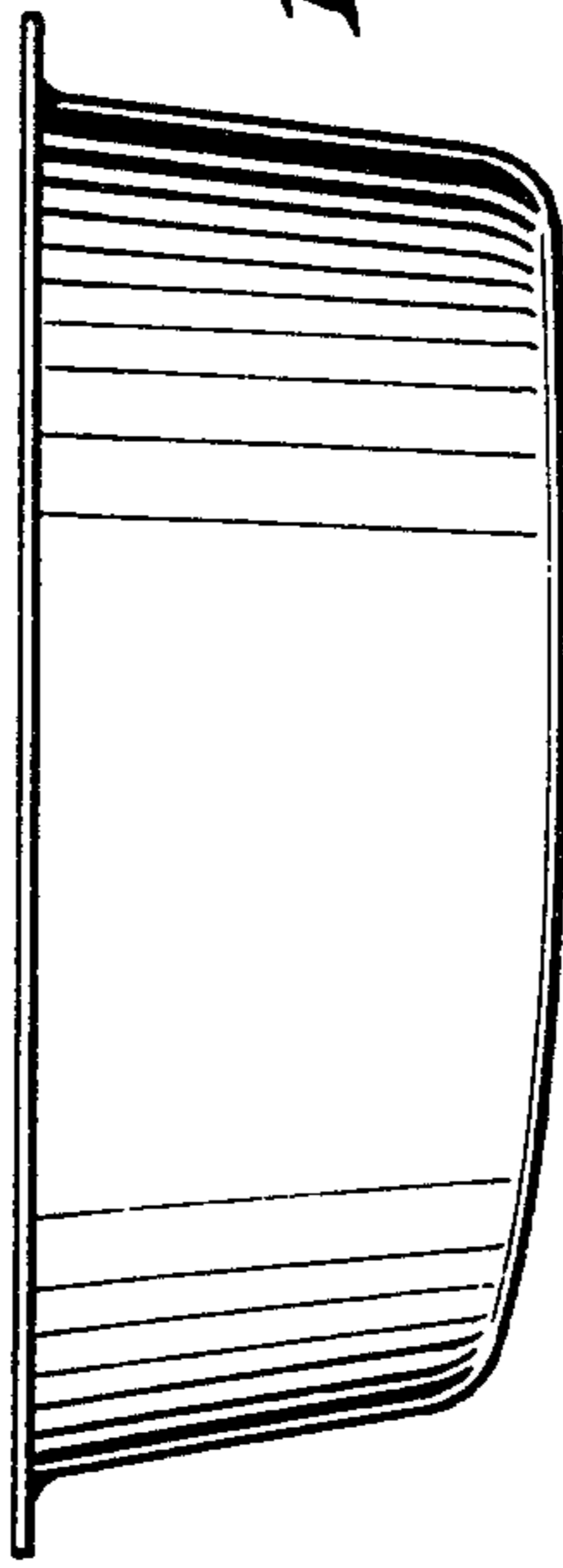

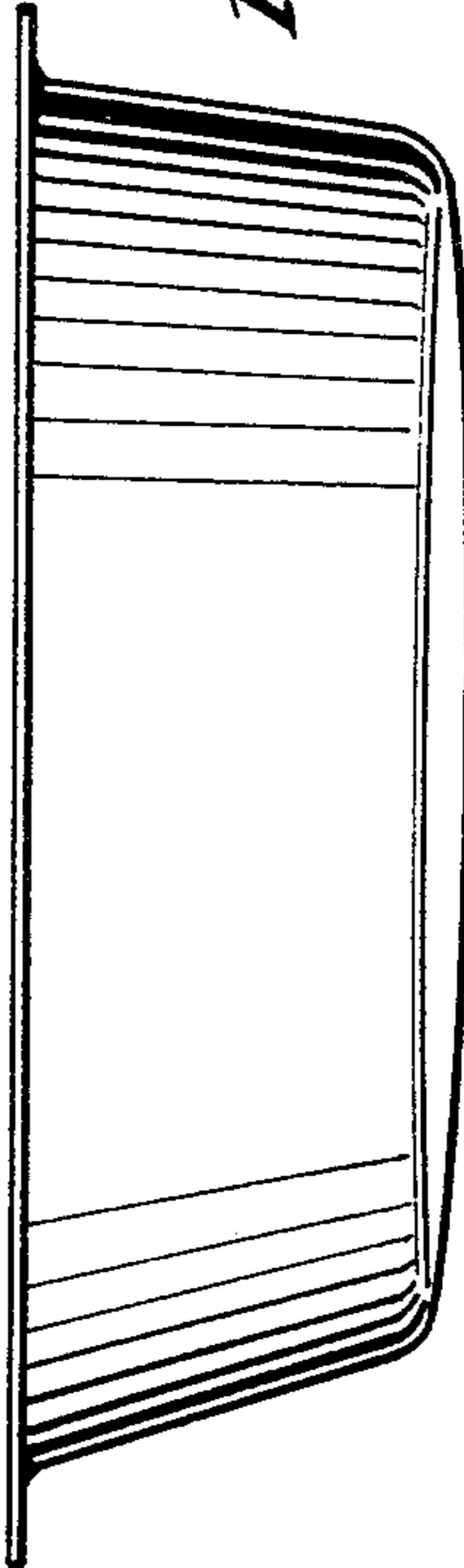
