DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a support for drill pow-
ered abrasive apparatus showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side
opposite being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being
unornamented;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof showing the drill,
grinding wheel and mounting strap in broken lines for
illustrative purposes only;
FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof.

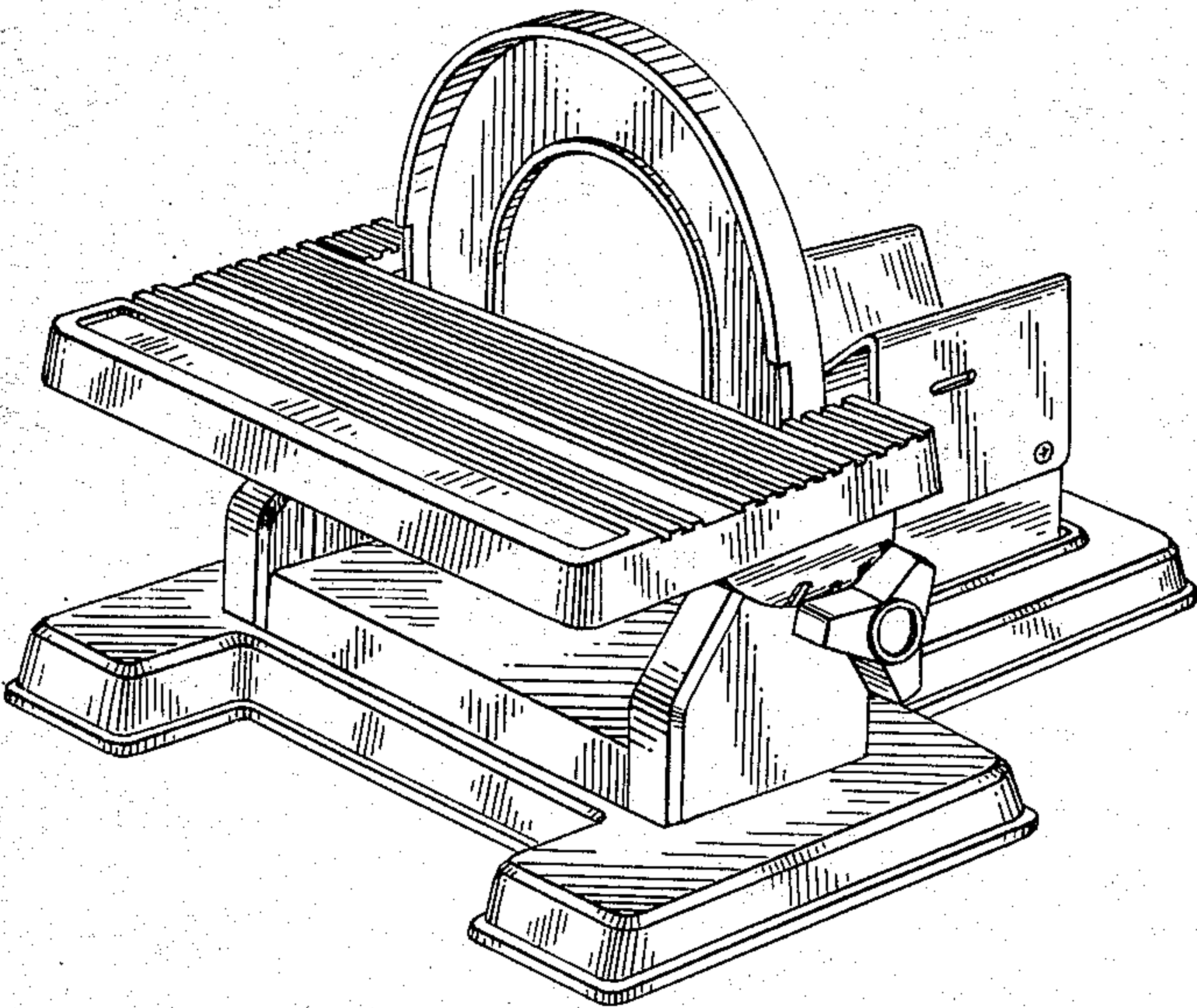

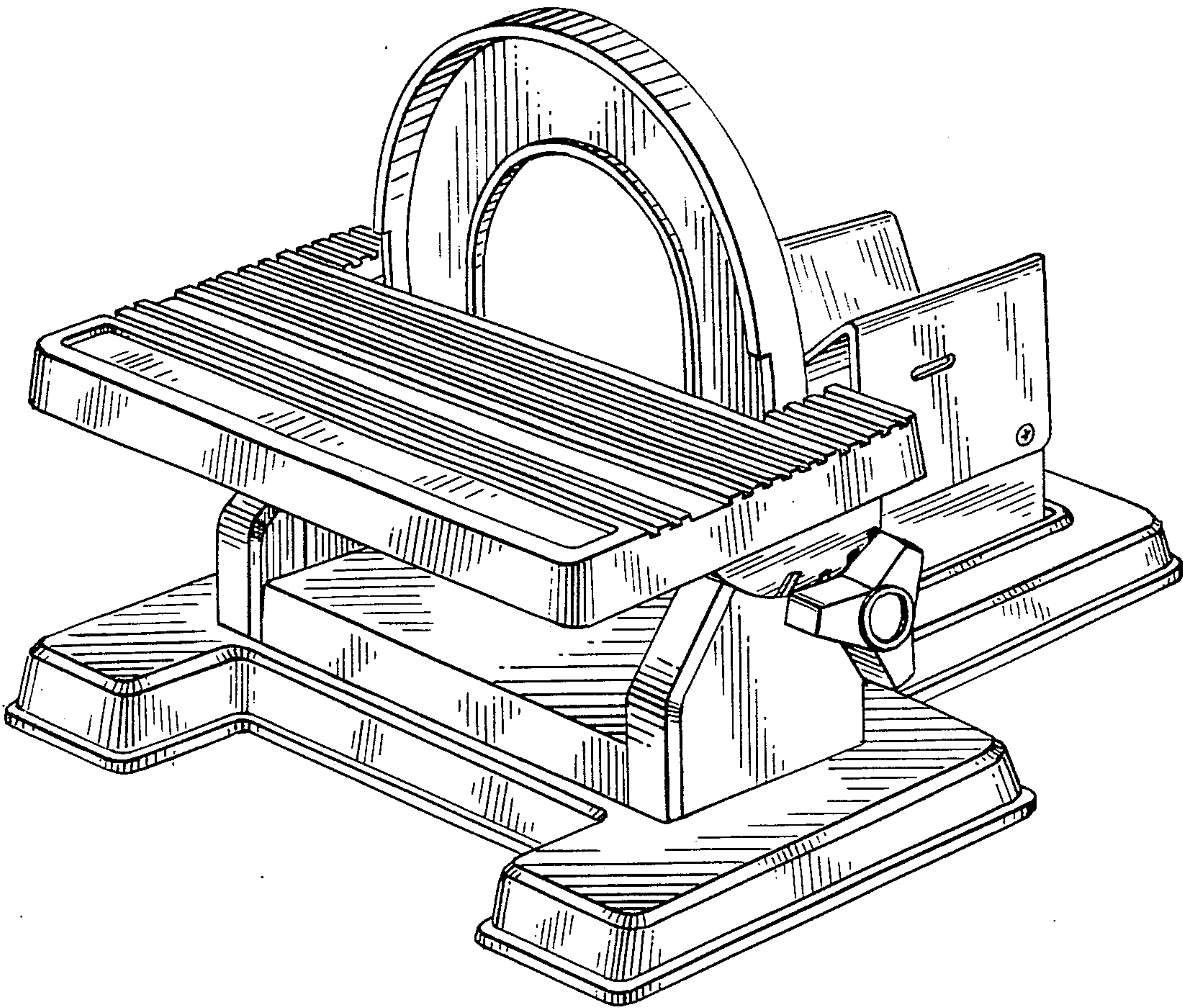

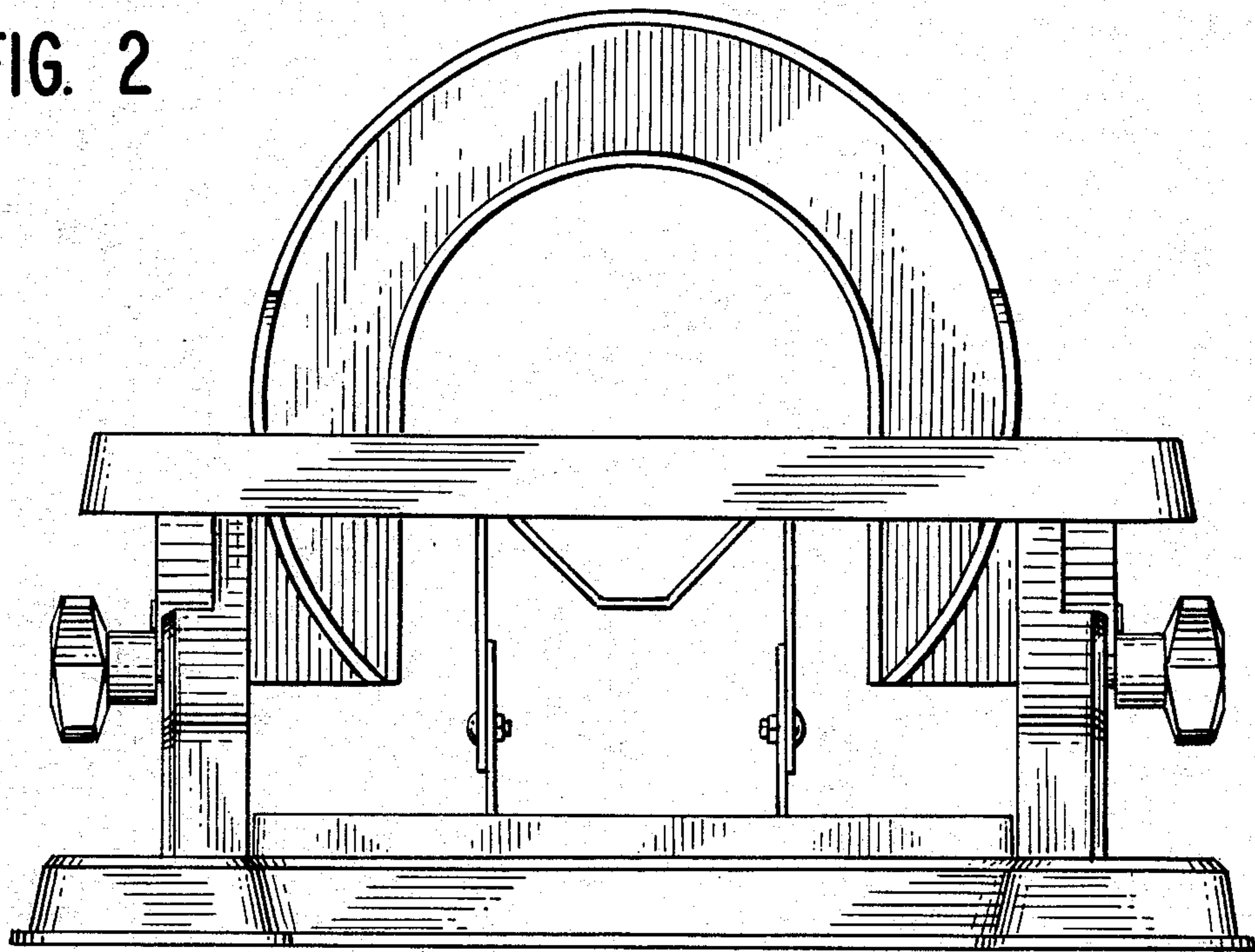

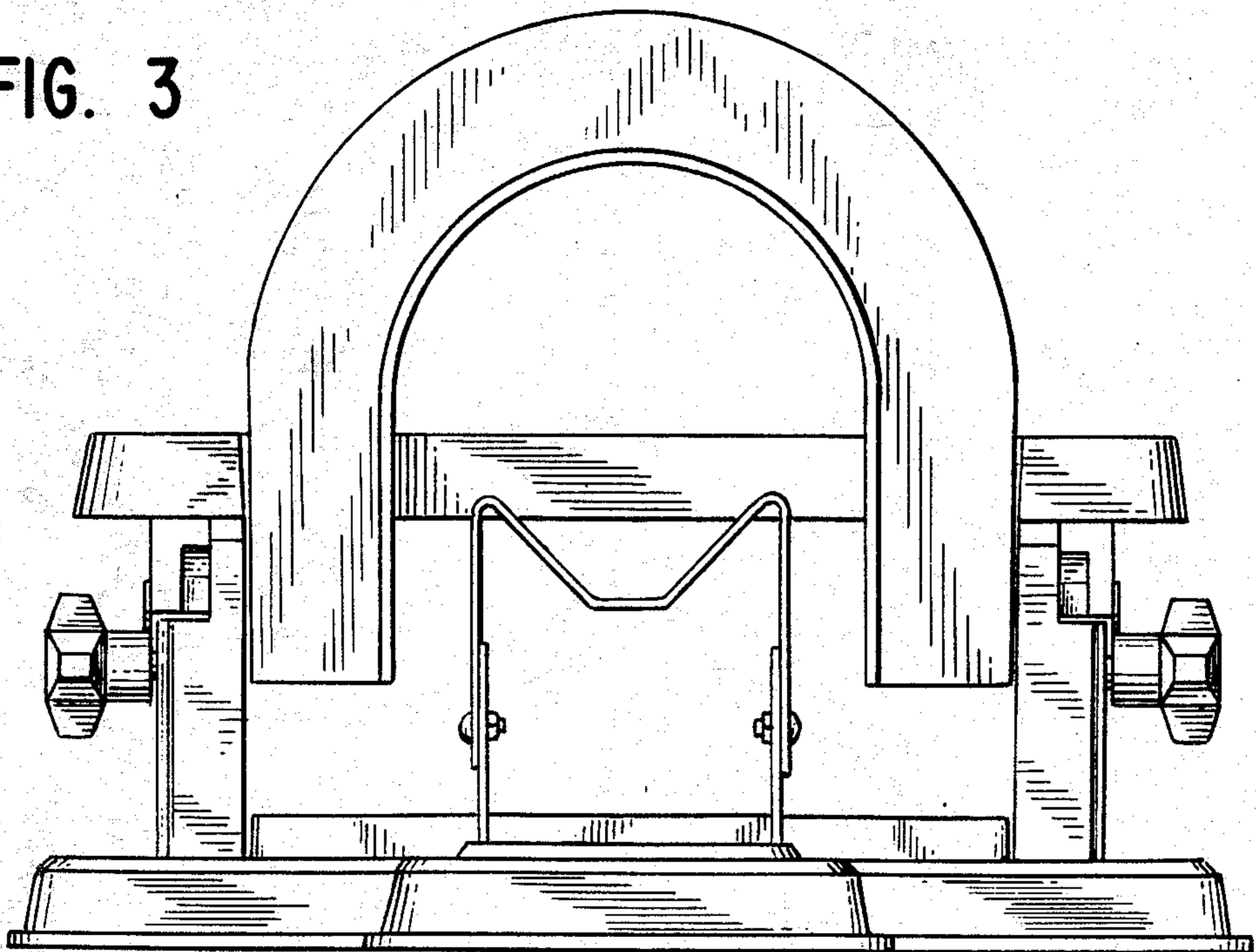

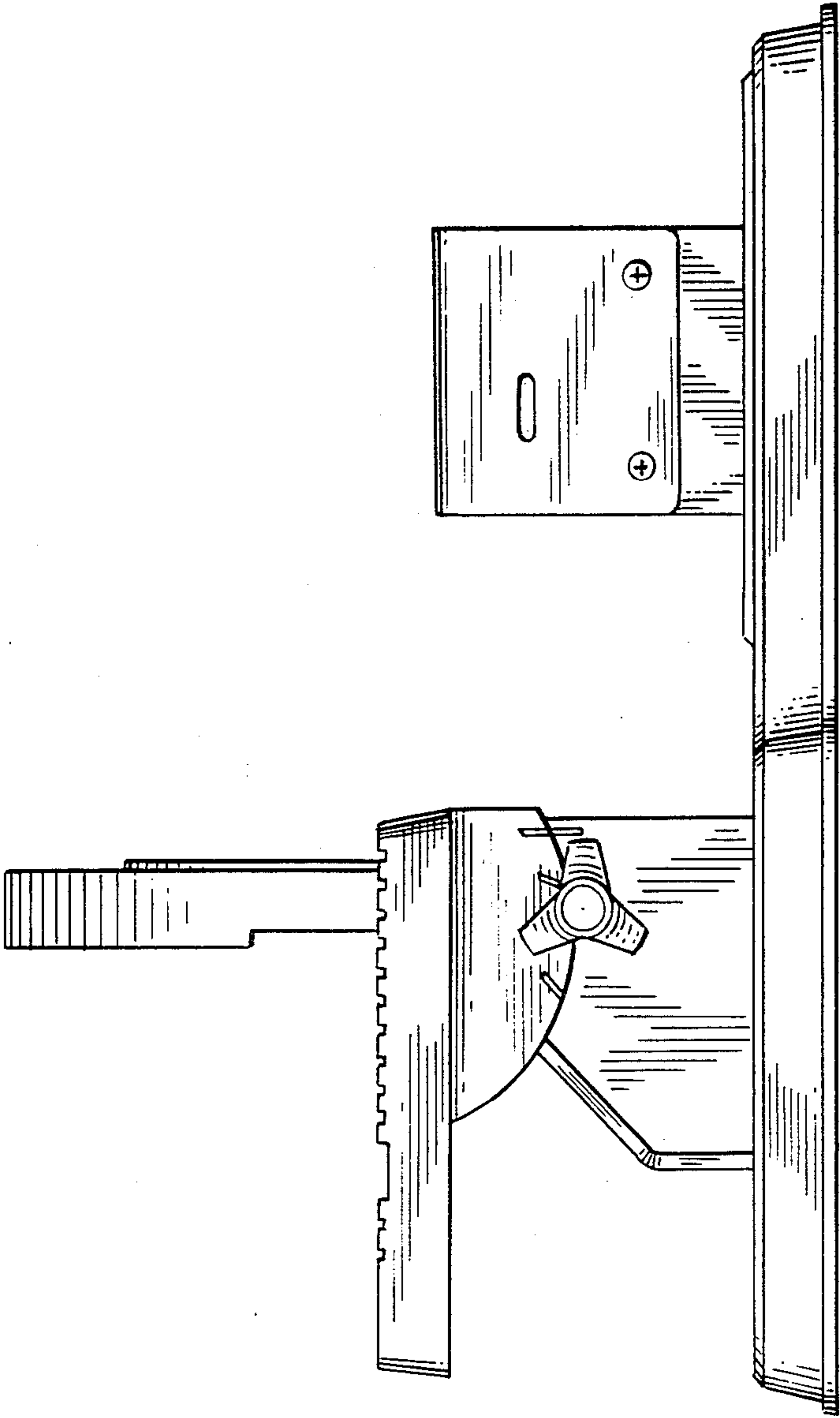

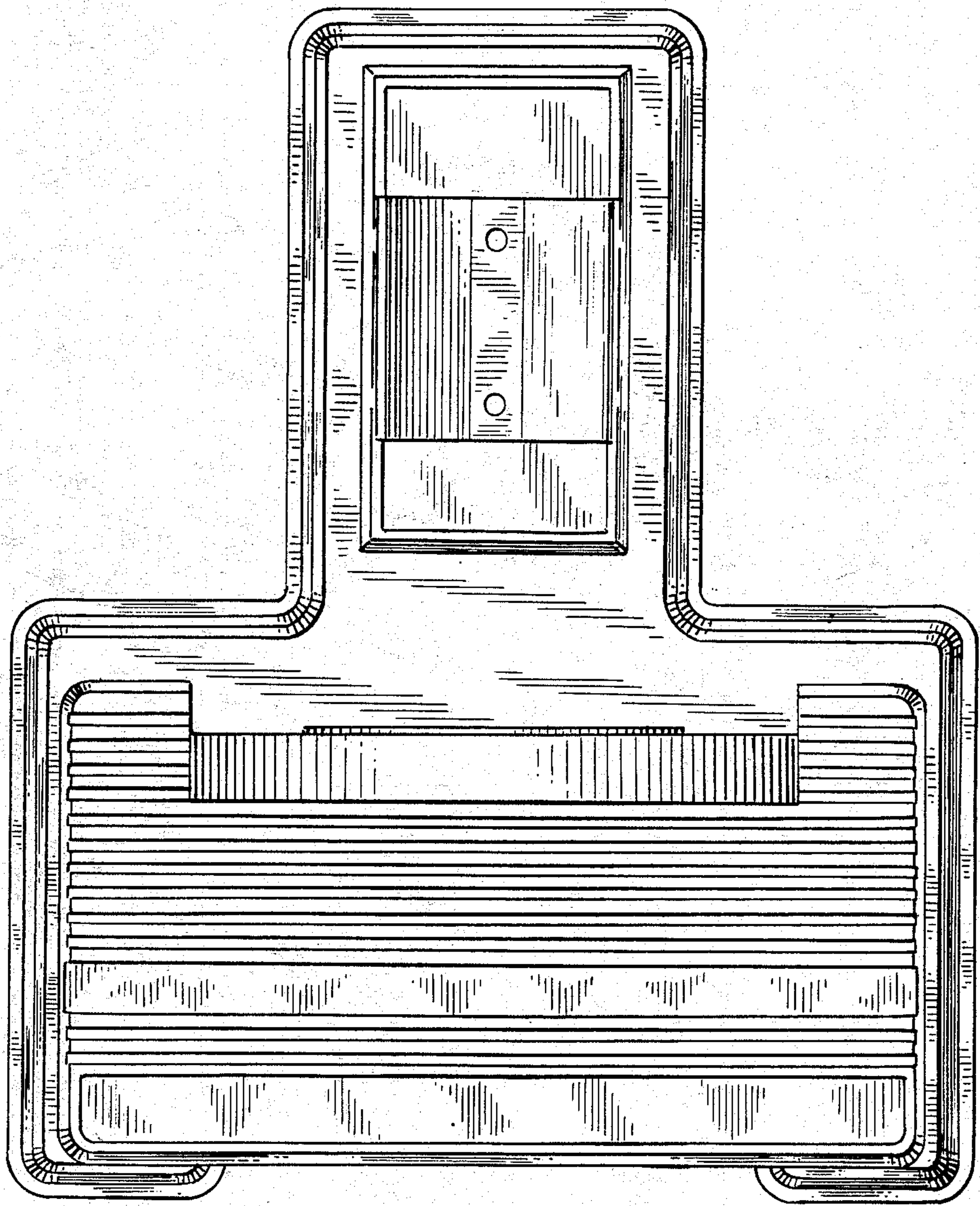

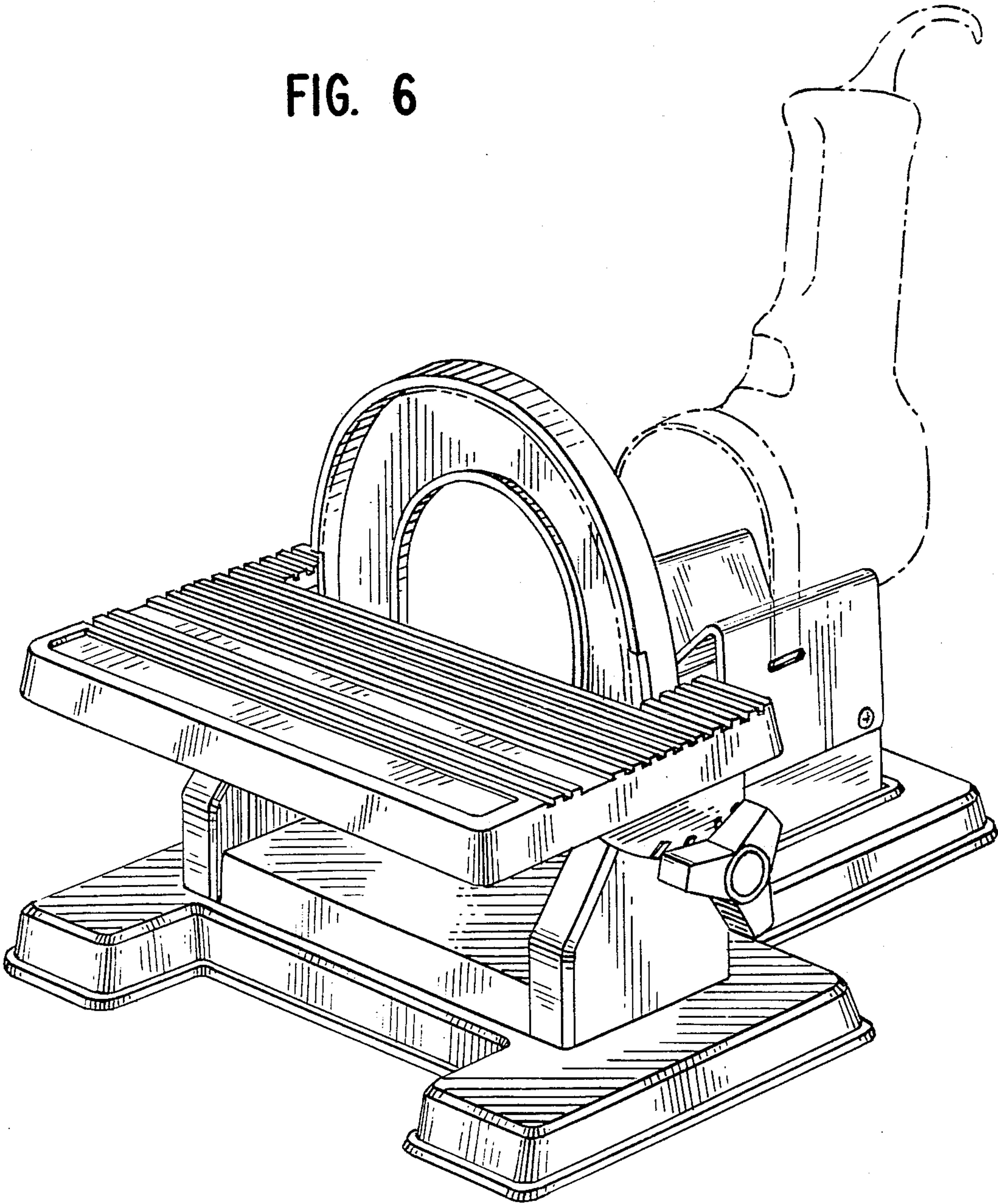
