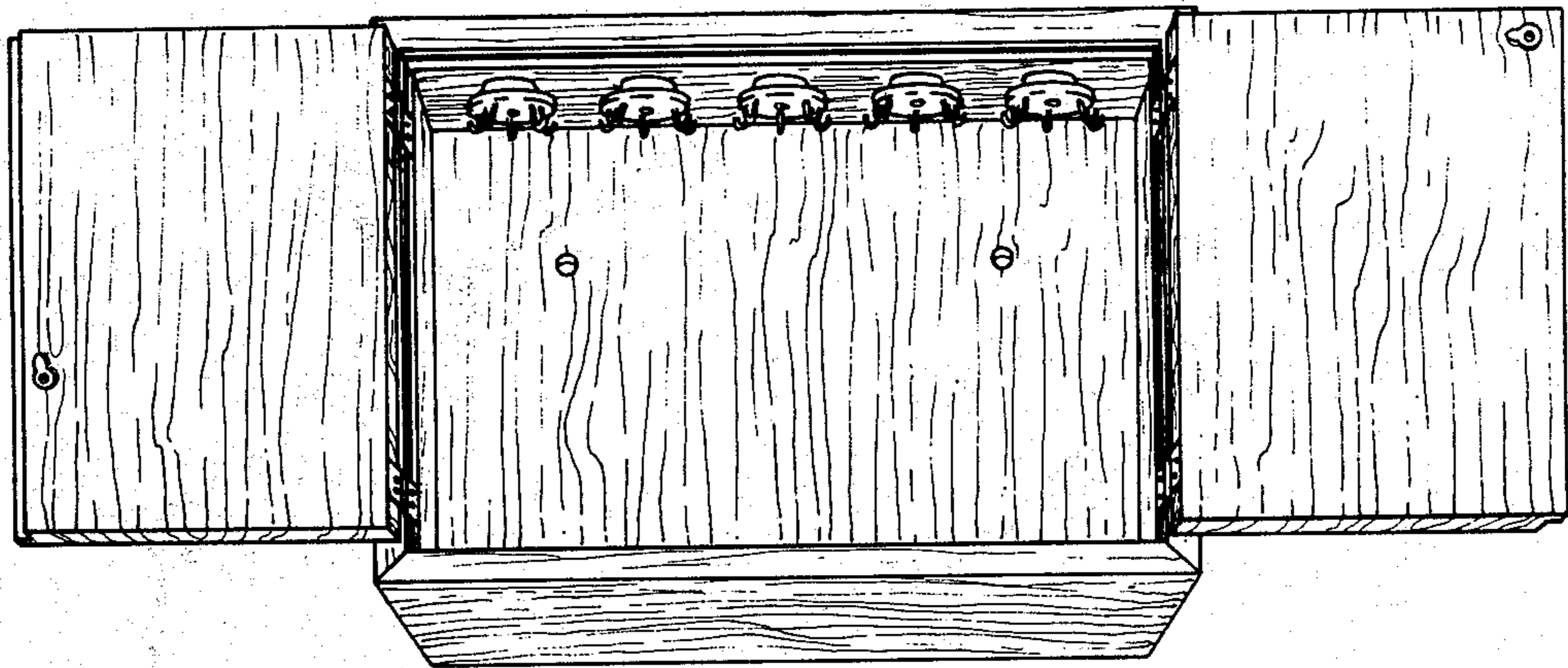

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a carousel jewelry box, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front bottom perspective view of a carousel jewelry box, showing my new design, with the doors in an open position;
FIG. 2 is a top right side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top front right side perspective view thereof with the doors in a closed position;
FIG. 4 is a bottom rear left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top front perspective view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is an enlarged front bottom perspective view of a carousel member with hook elements, shown separately for clarity of illustration.



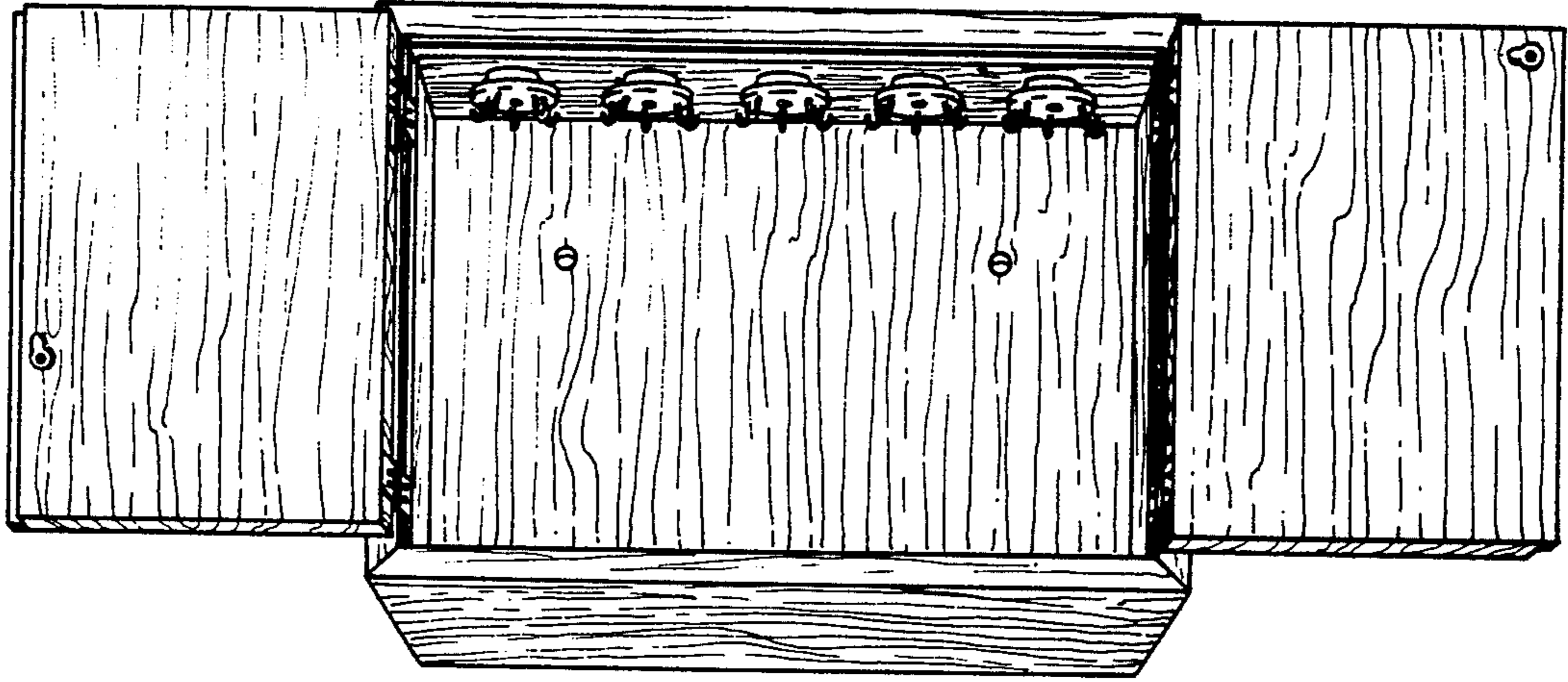

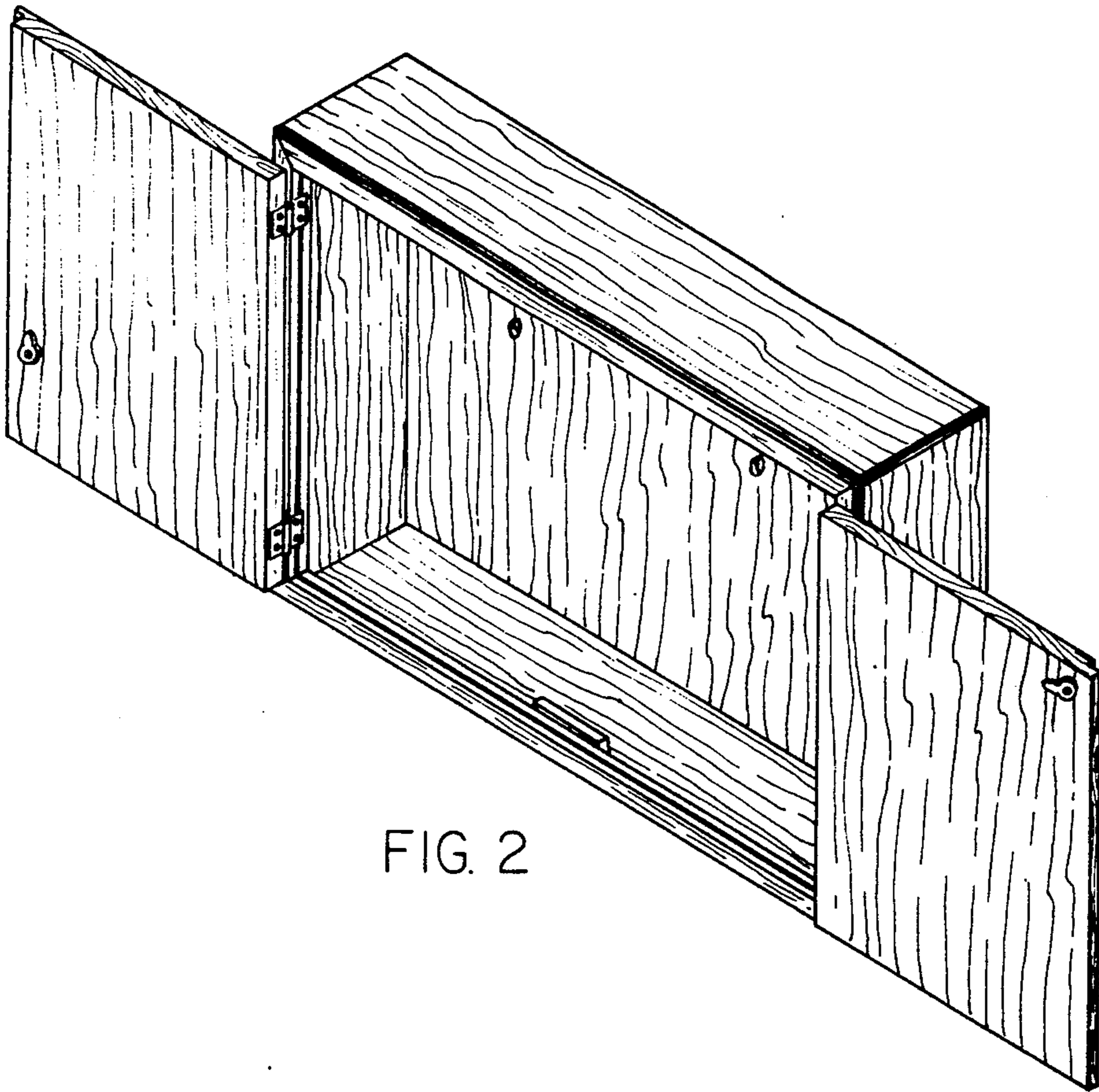

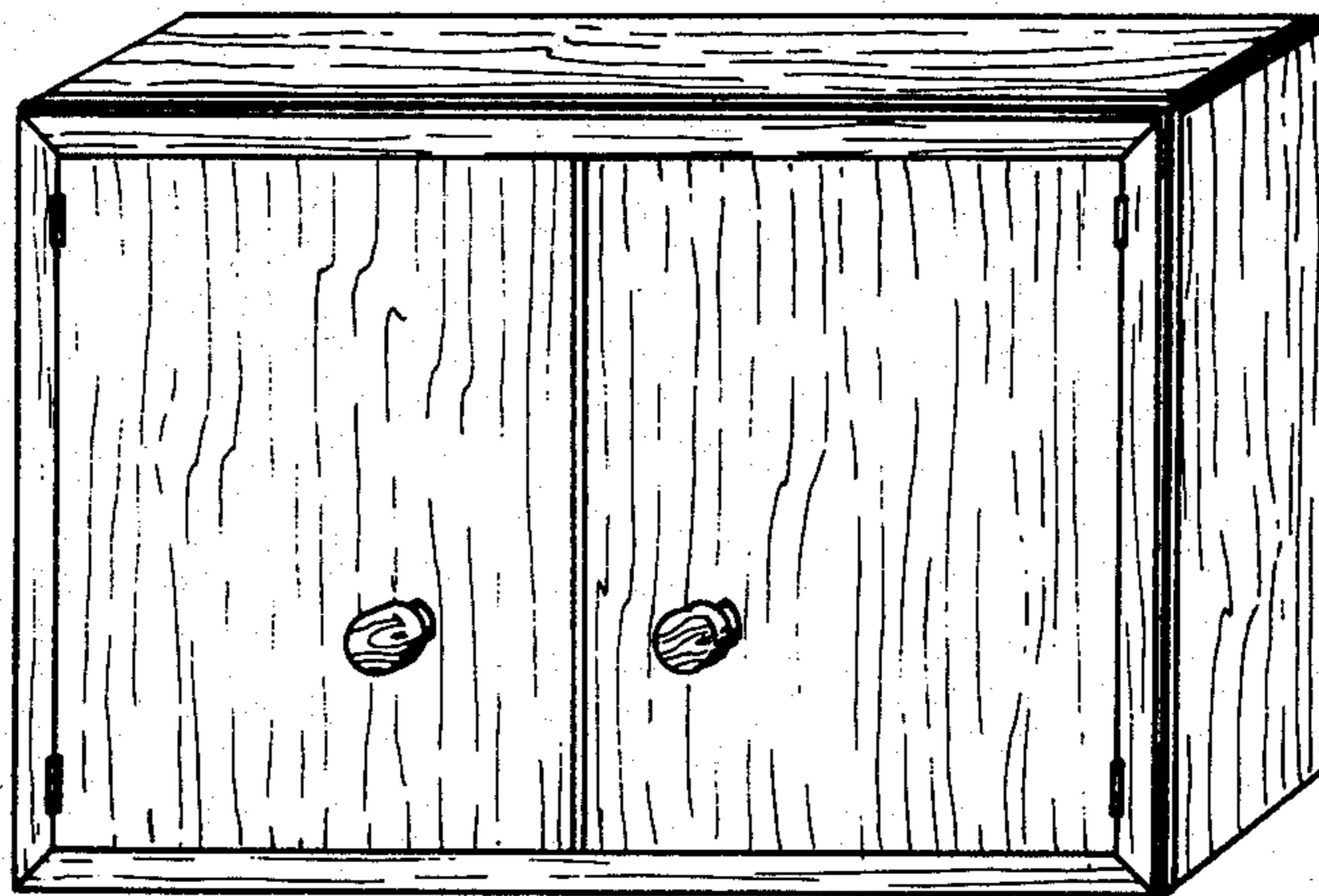

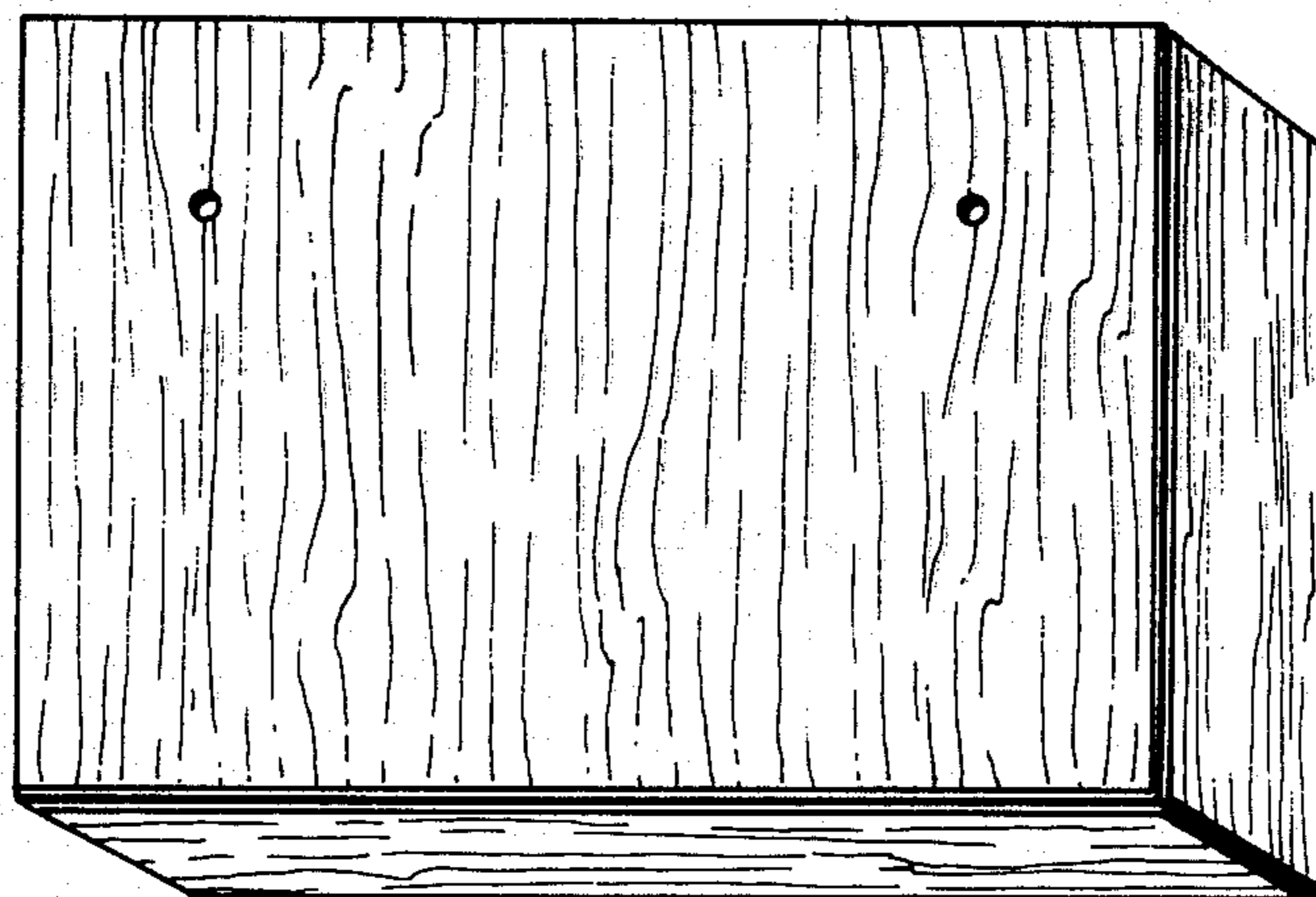

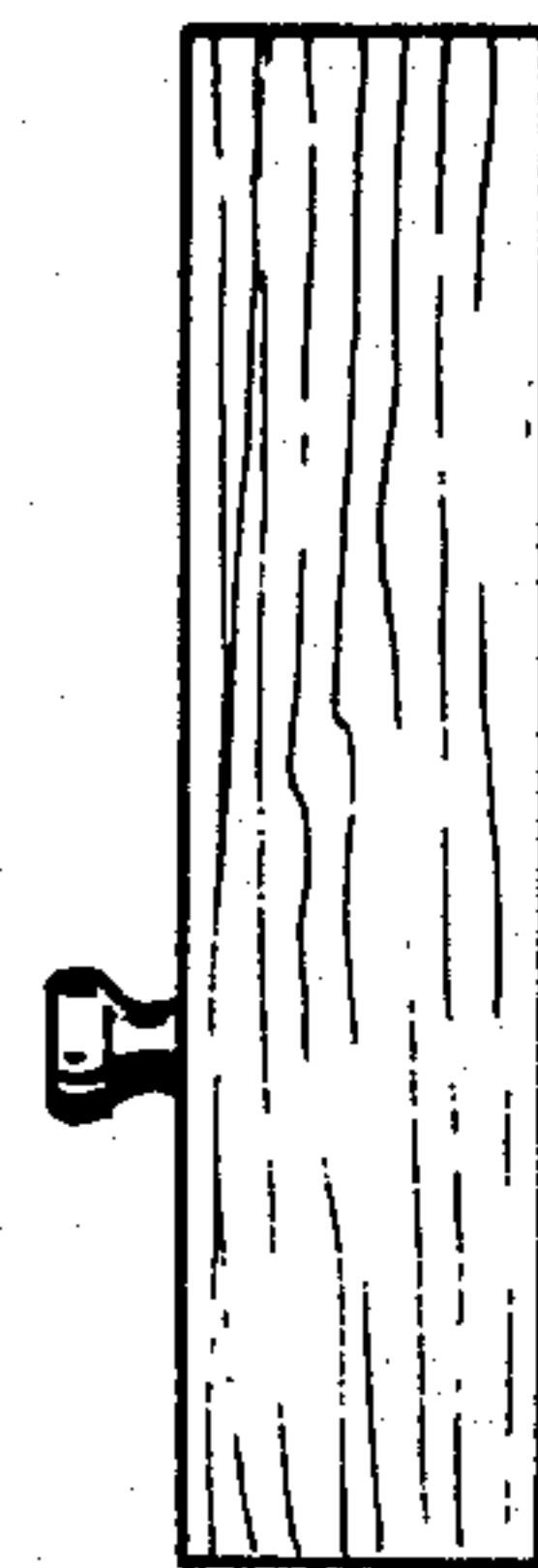

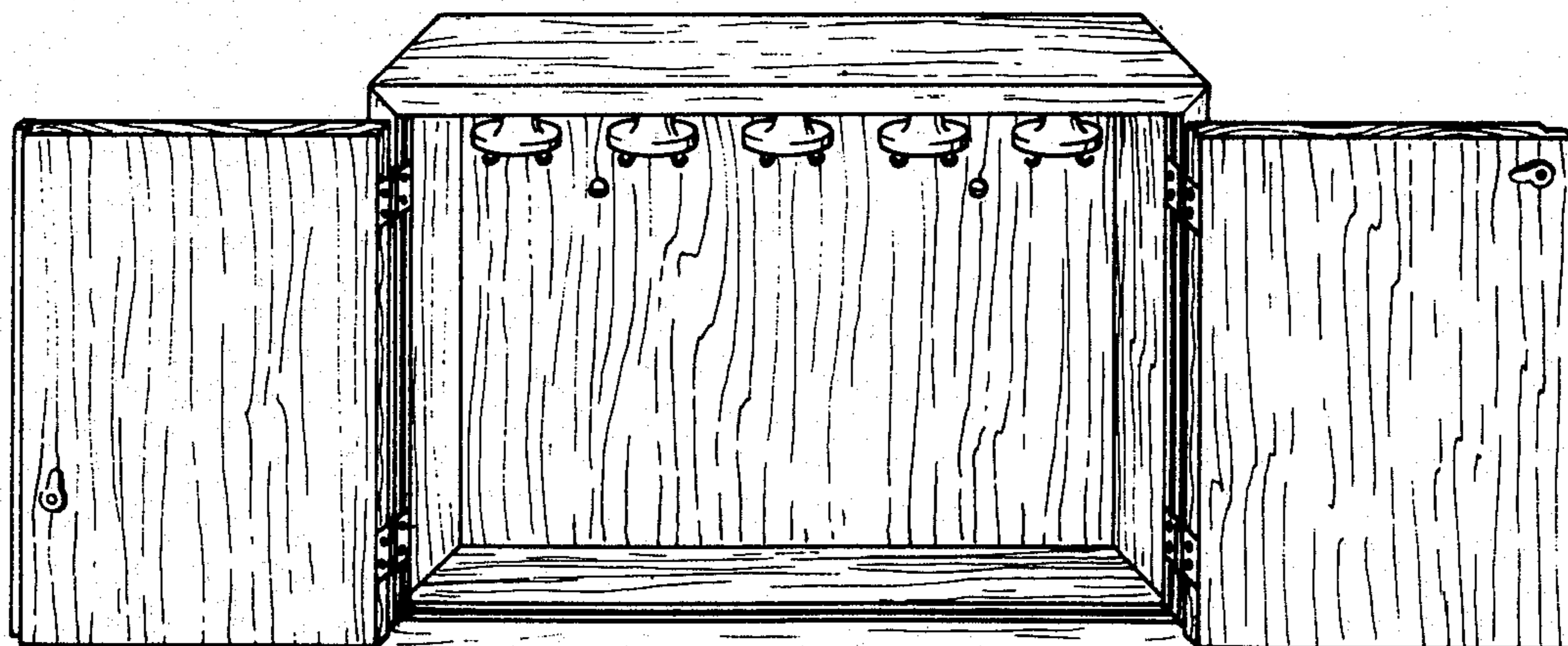

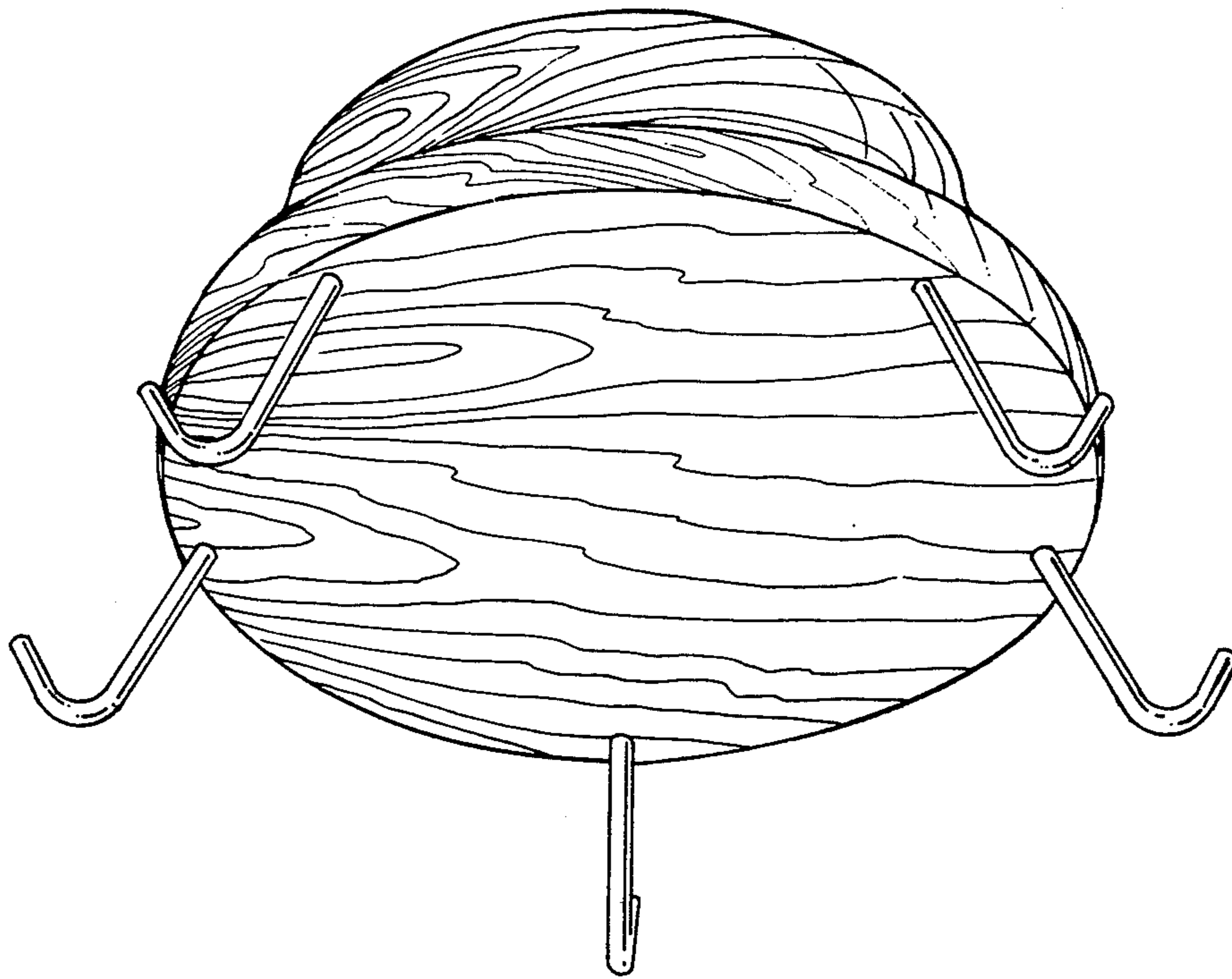
