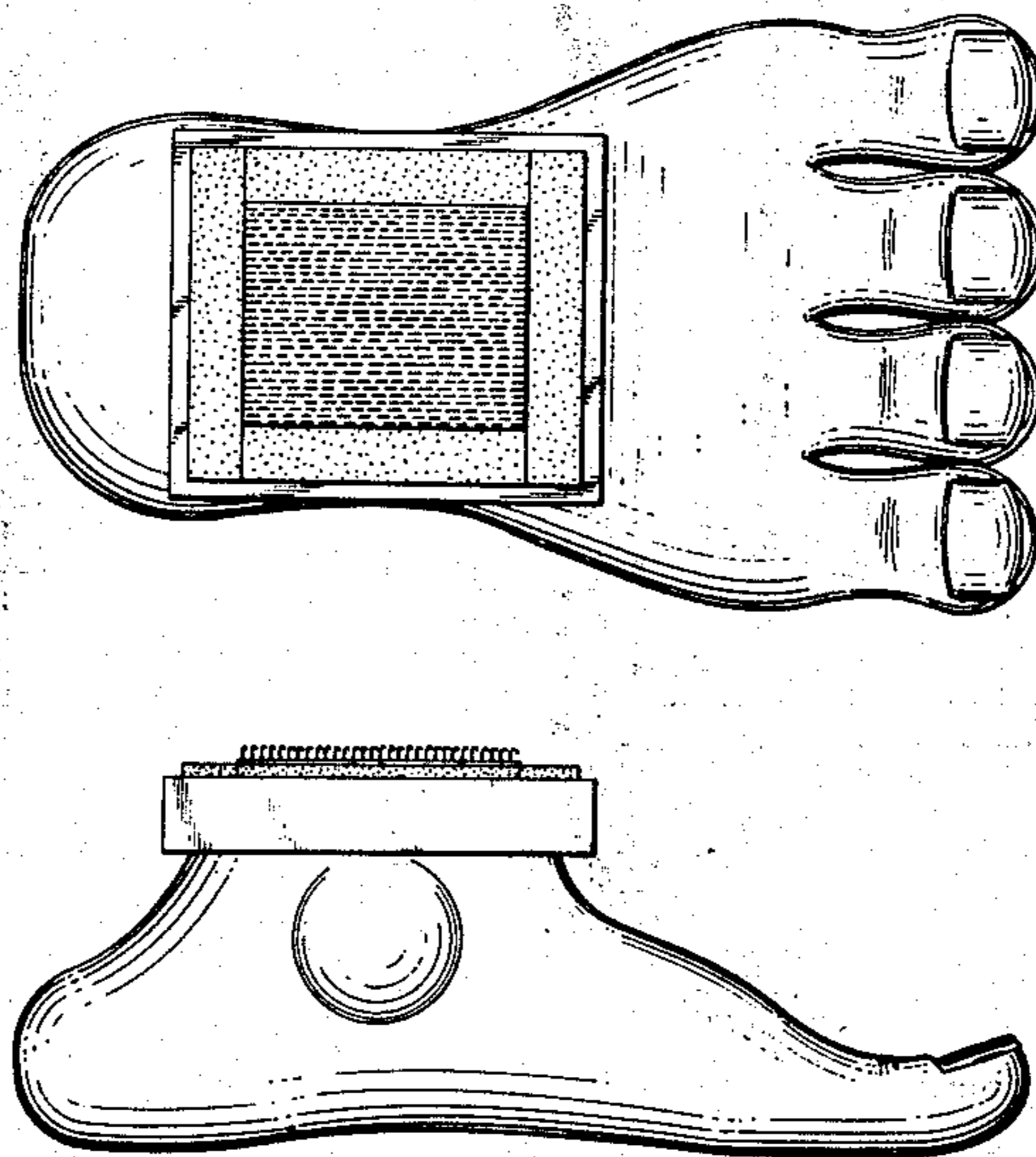

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a portable electronic equipment stand showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



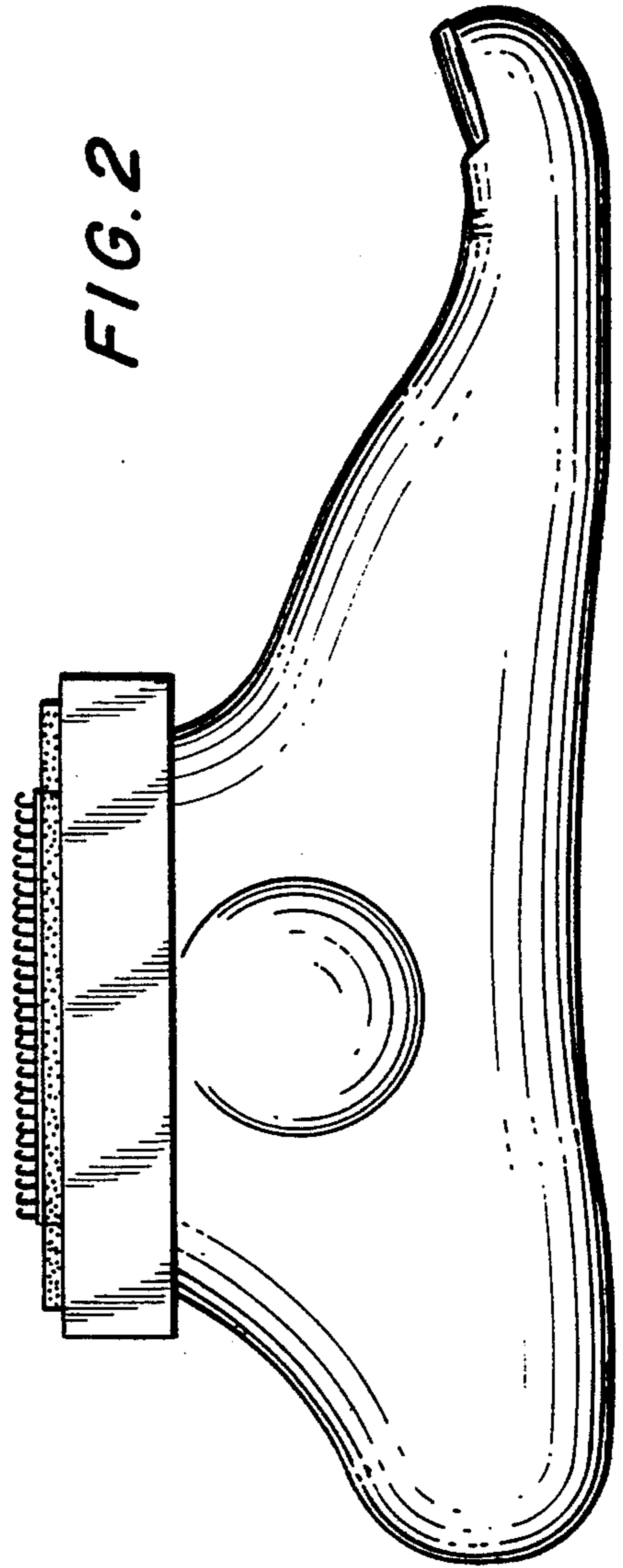
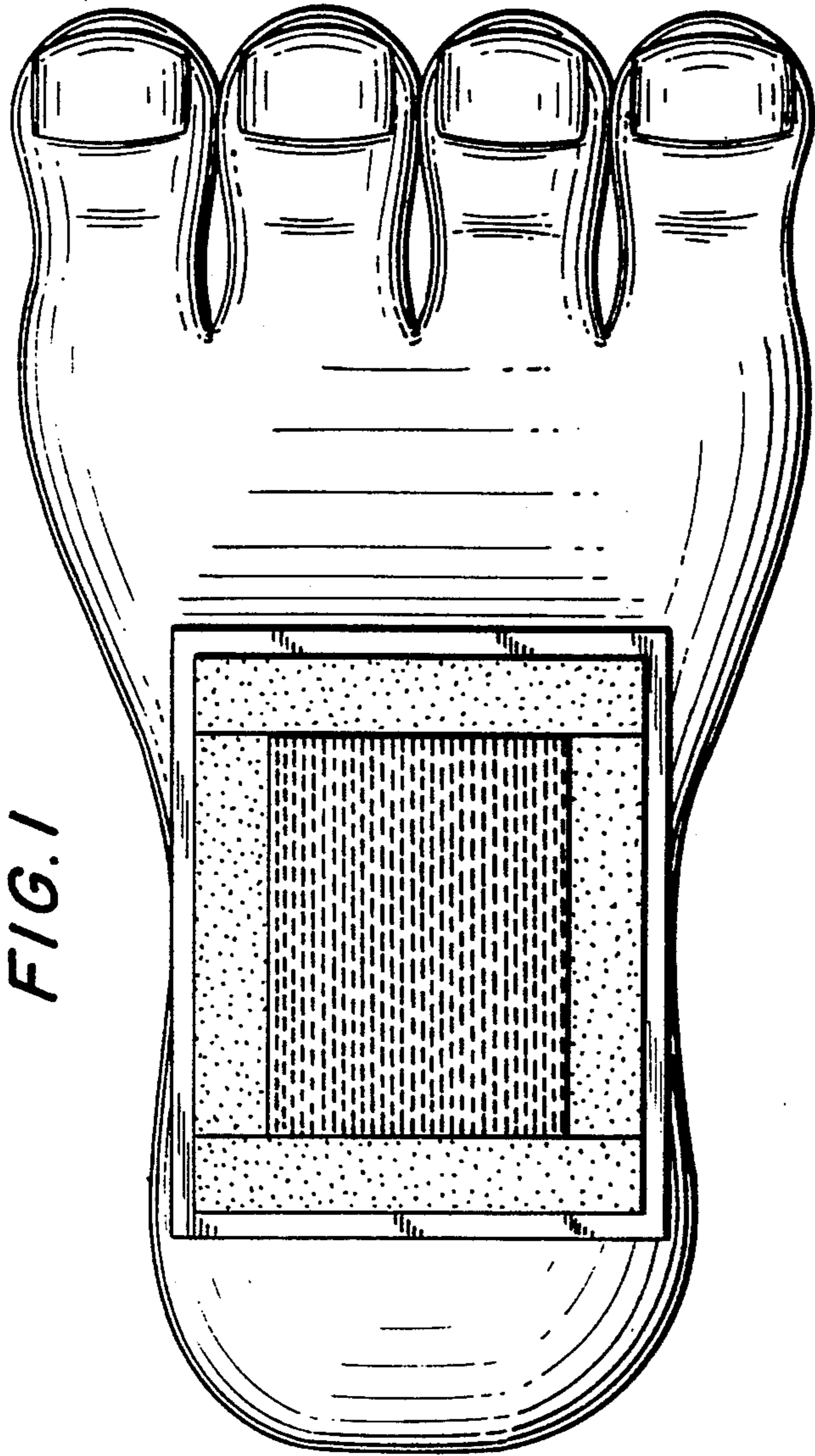

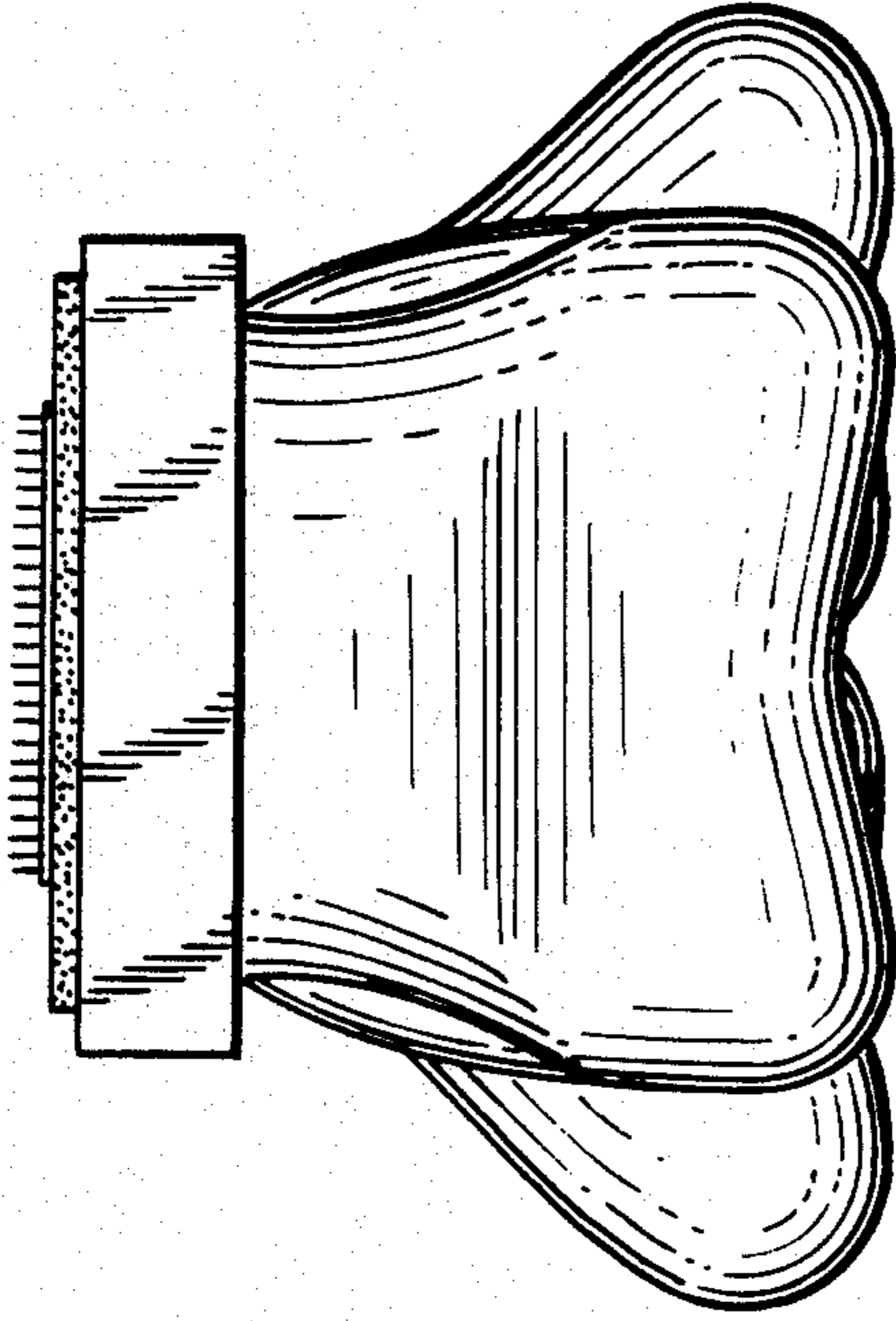

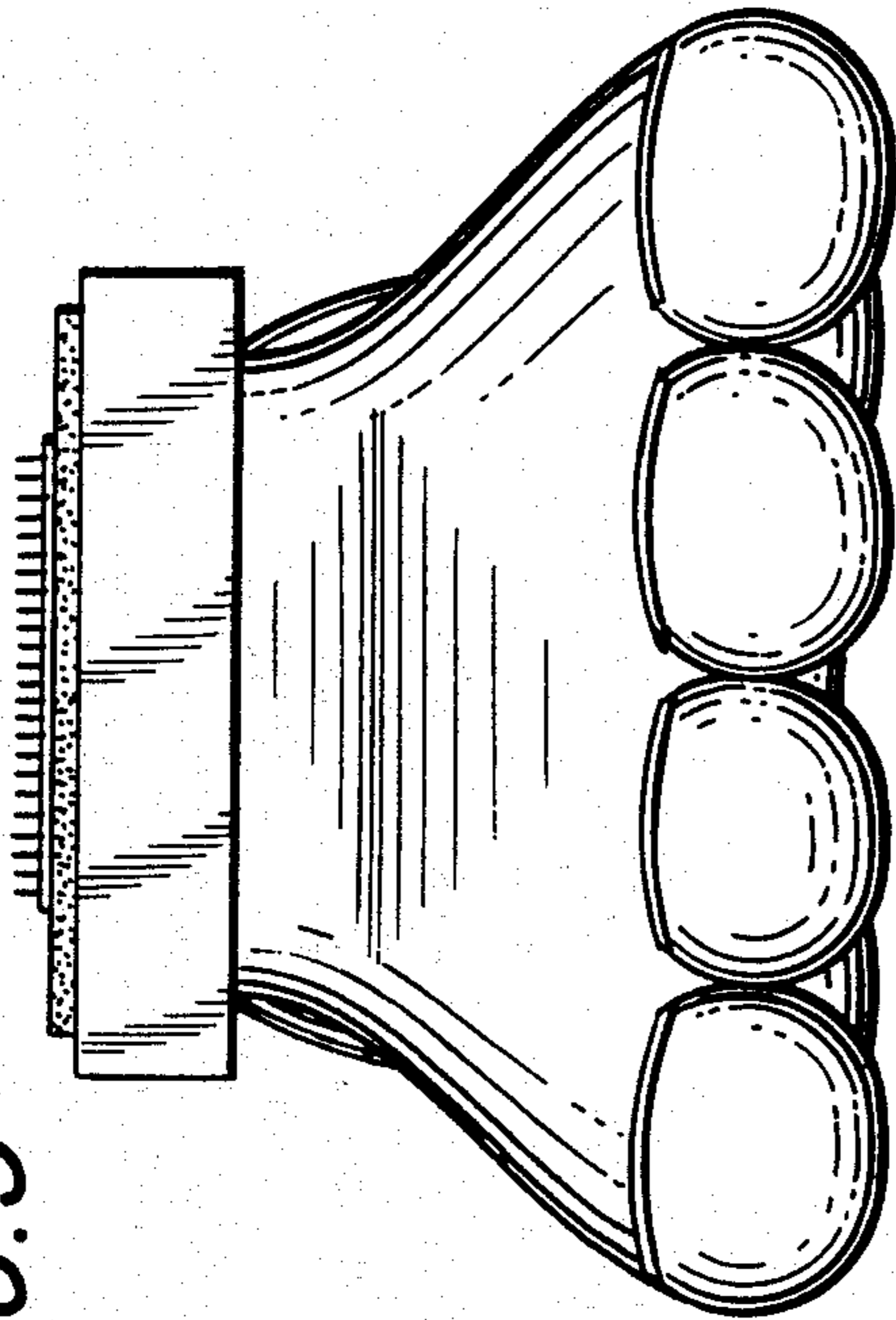
