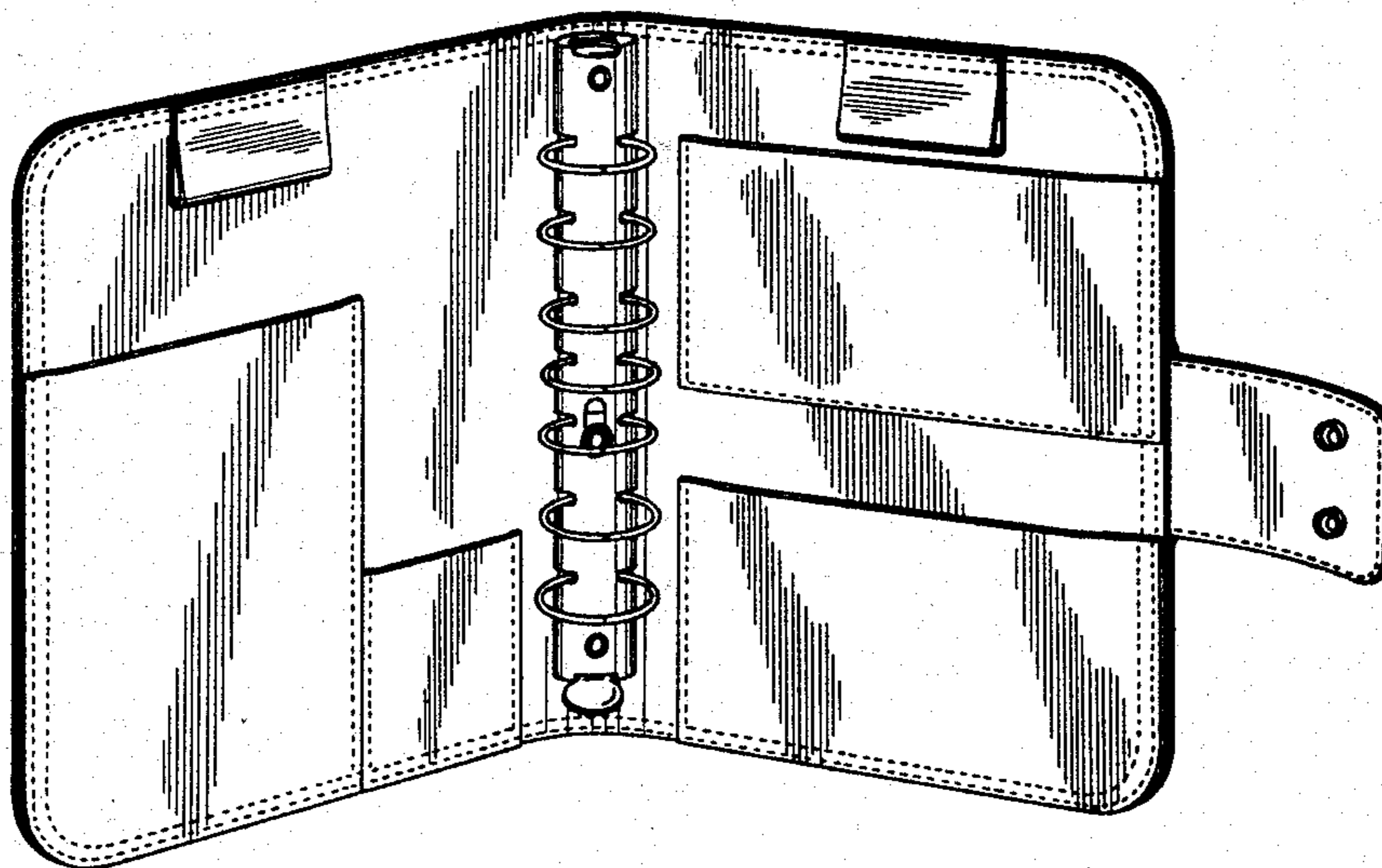

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined organizer pouch and loose leaf binder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one side of a combined organizer pouch and loose leaf binder, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the other side thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the pouch opened to reveal the interior.



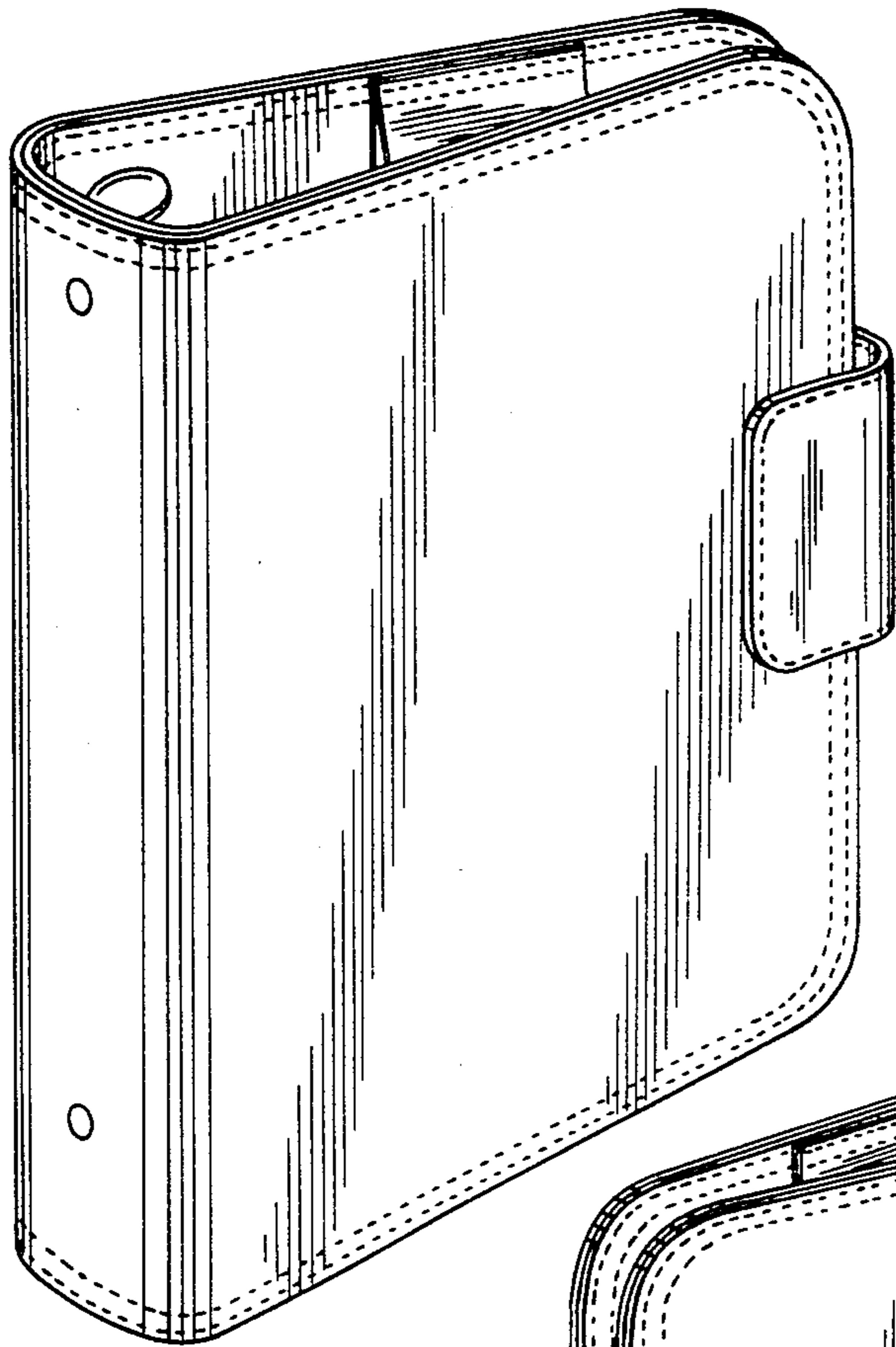

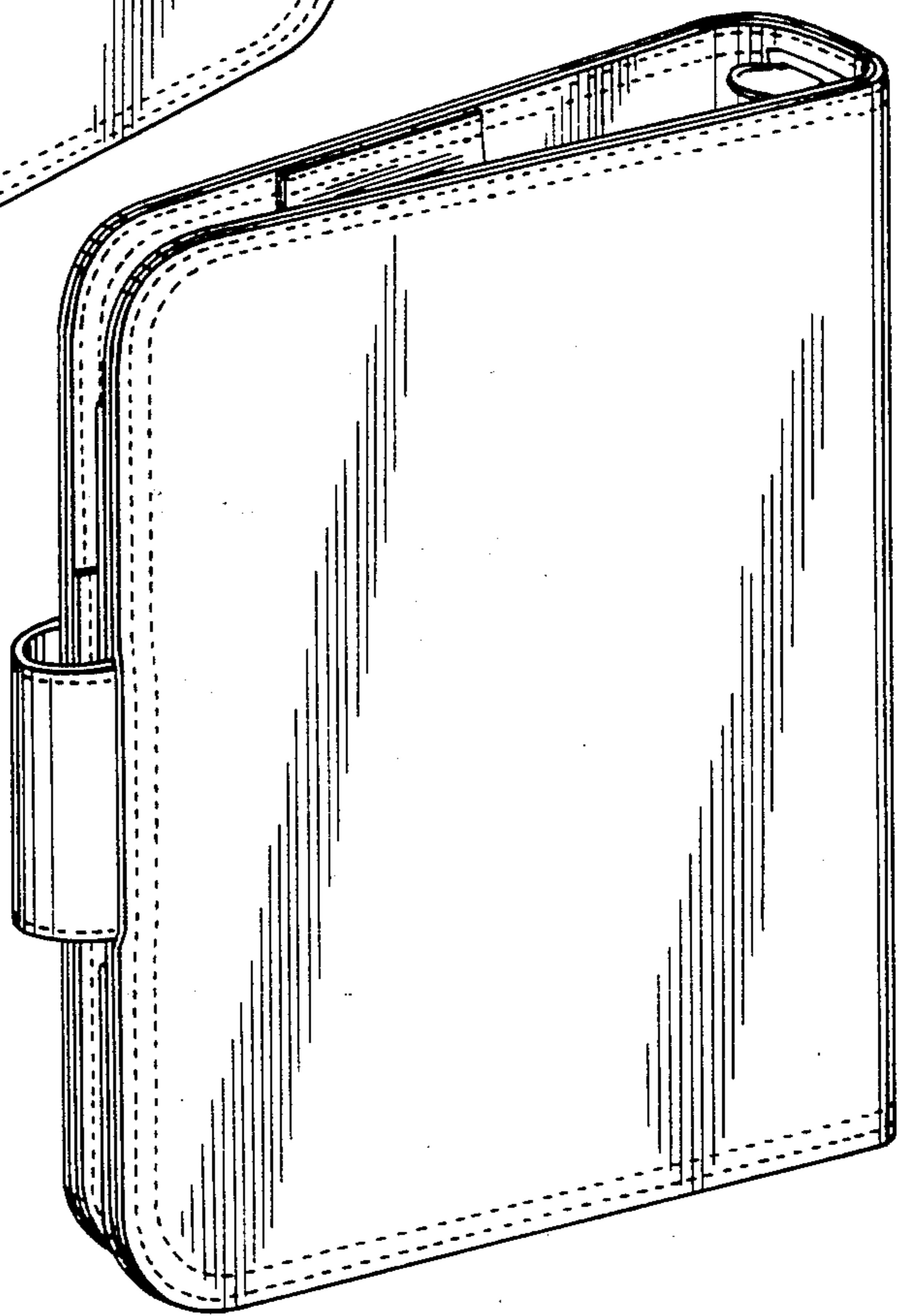

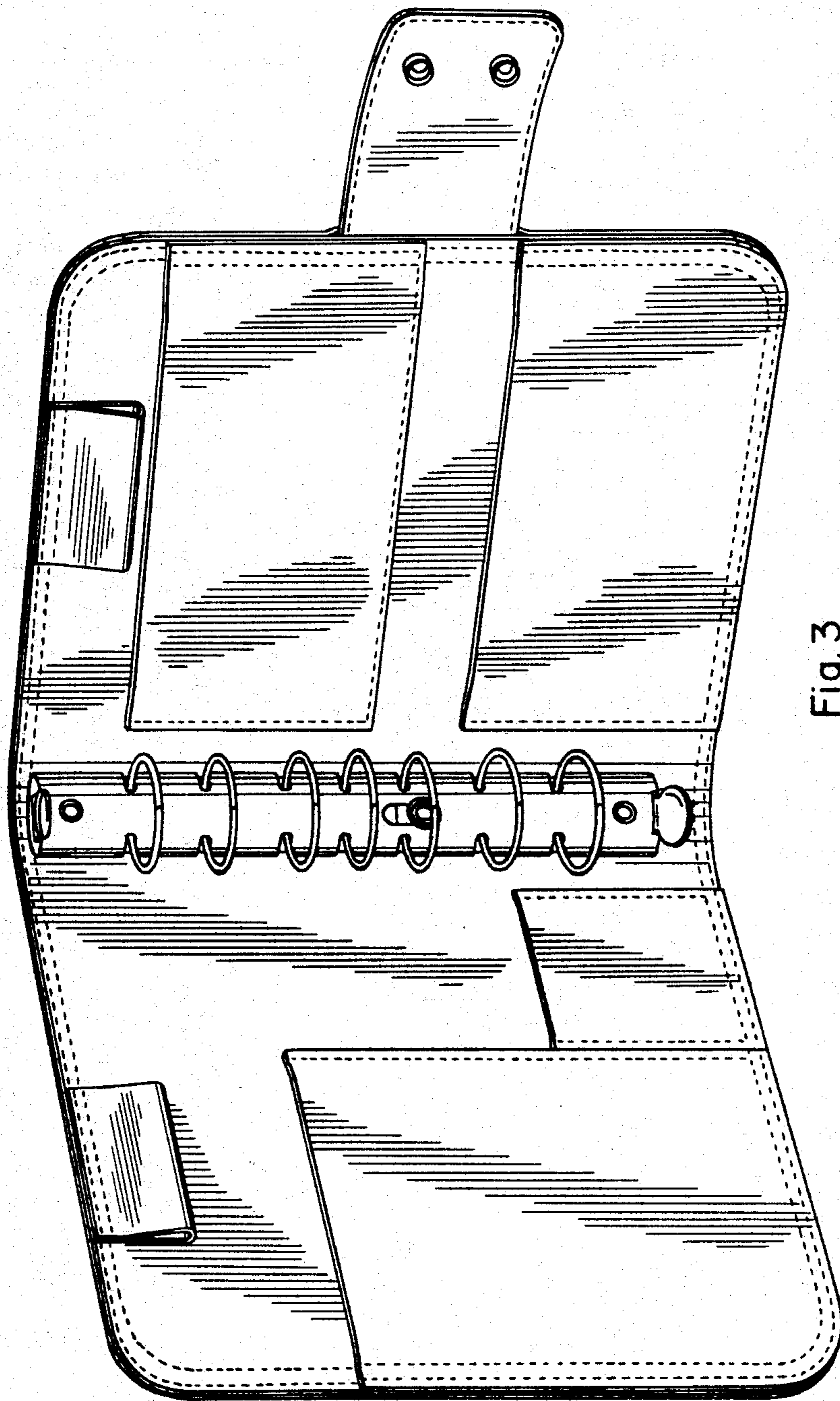
