**DESCRIPTION**

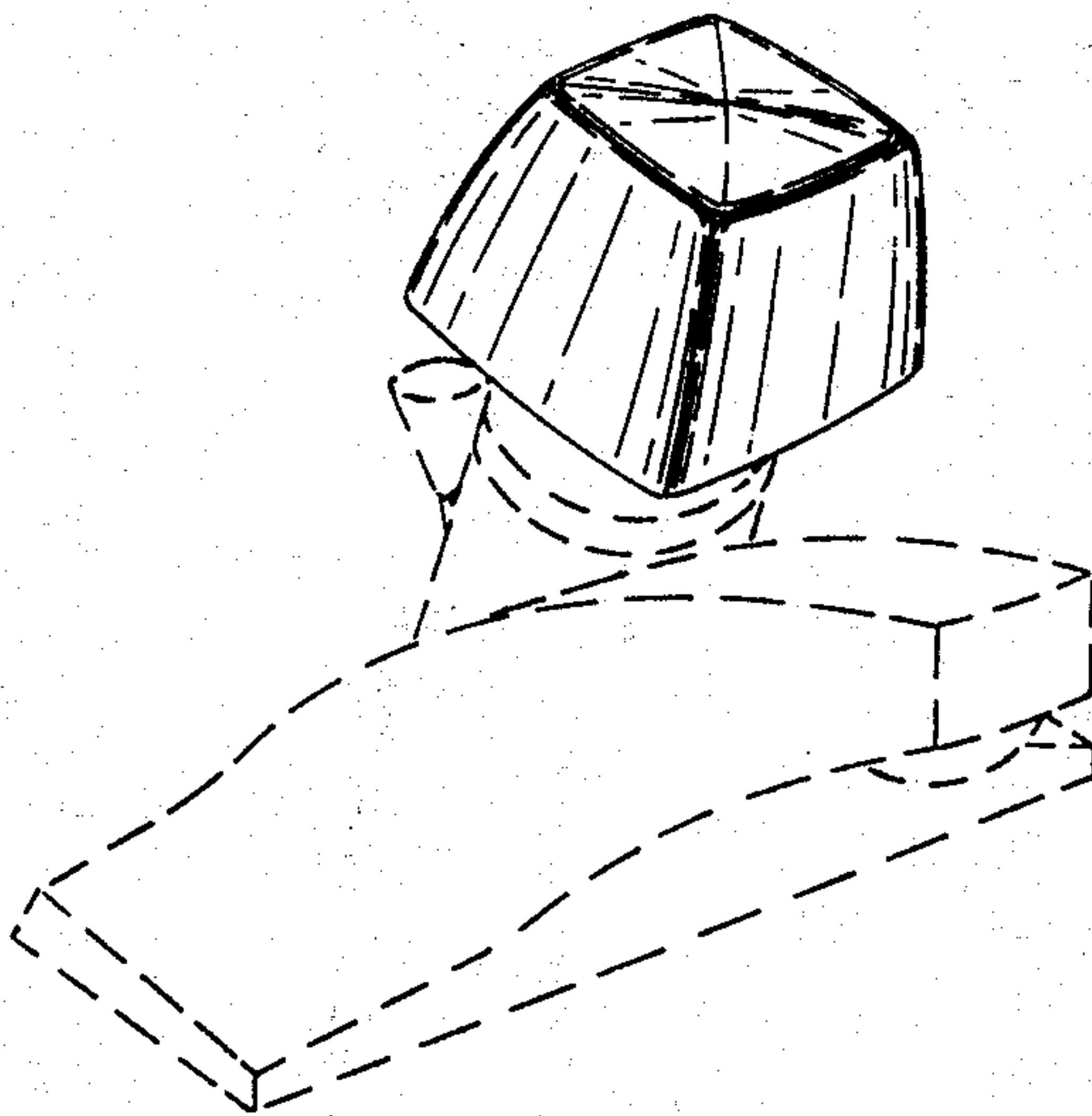
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a faucet handle showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the other sides being the same as the side shown.

The broken line representation of a lavatory faucet in FIG. 1 and of a single valve in FIG. 2 is for purposes of illustration only.



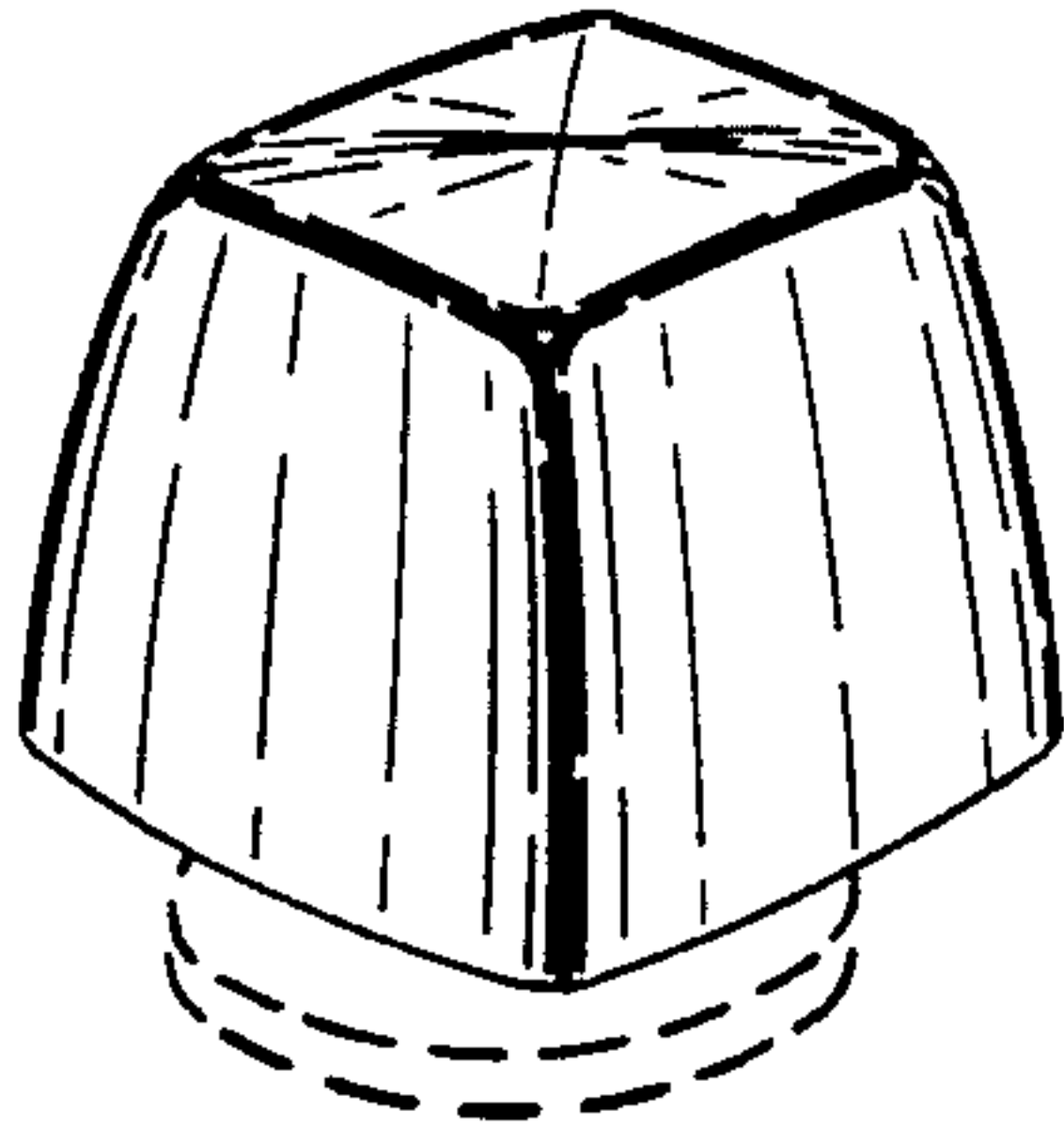

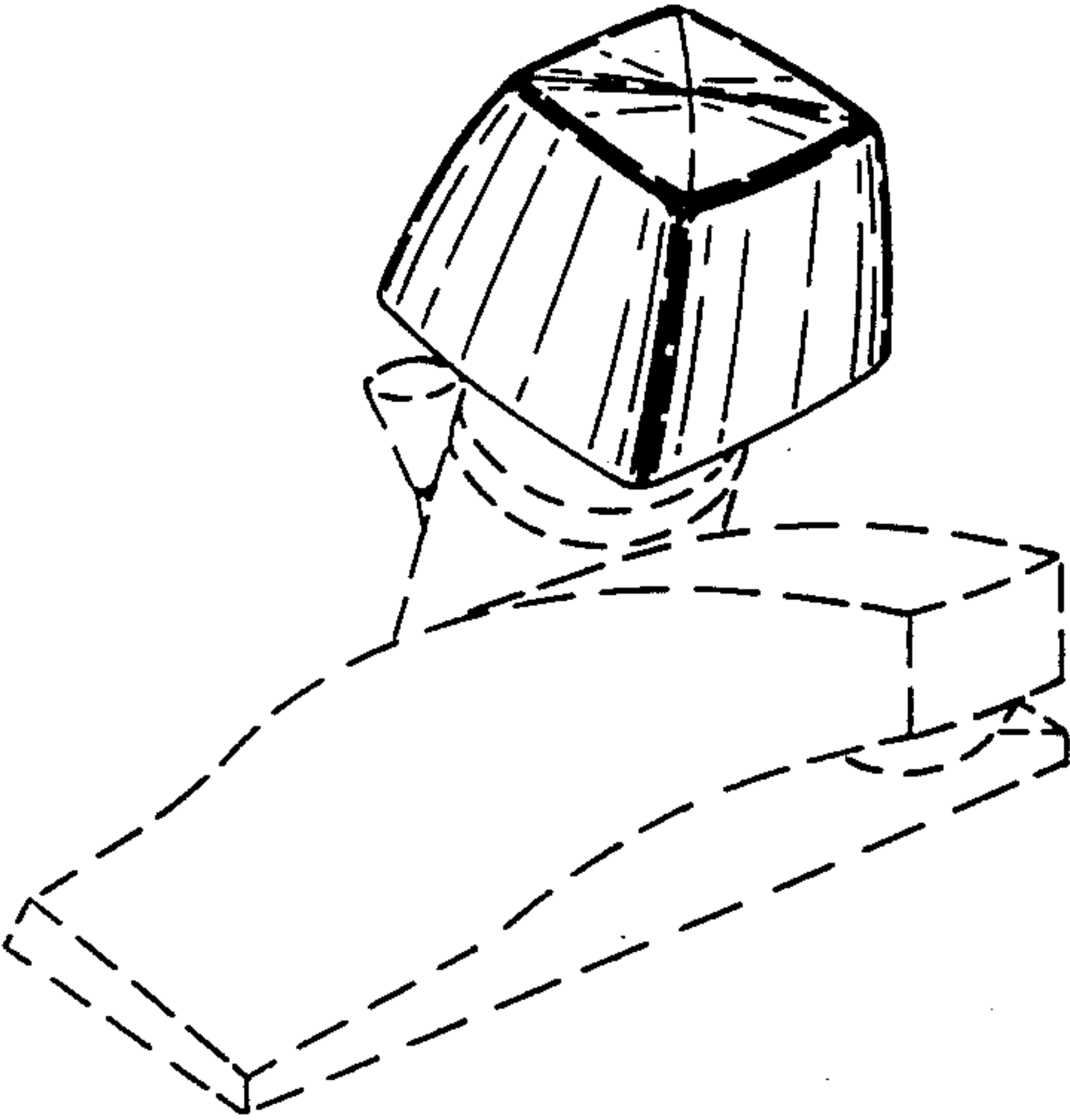

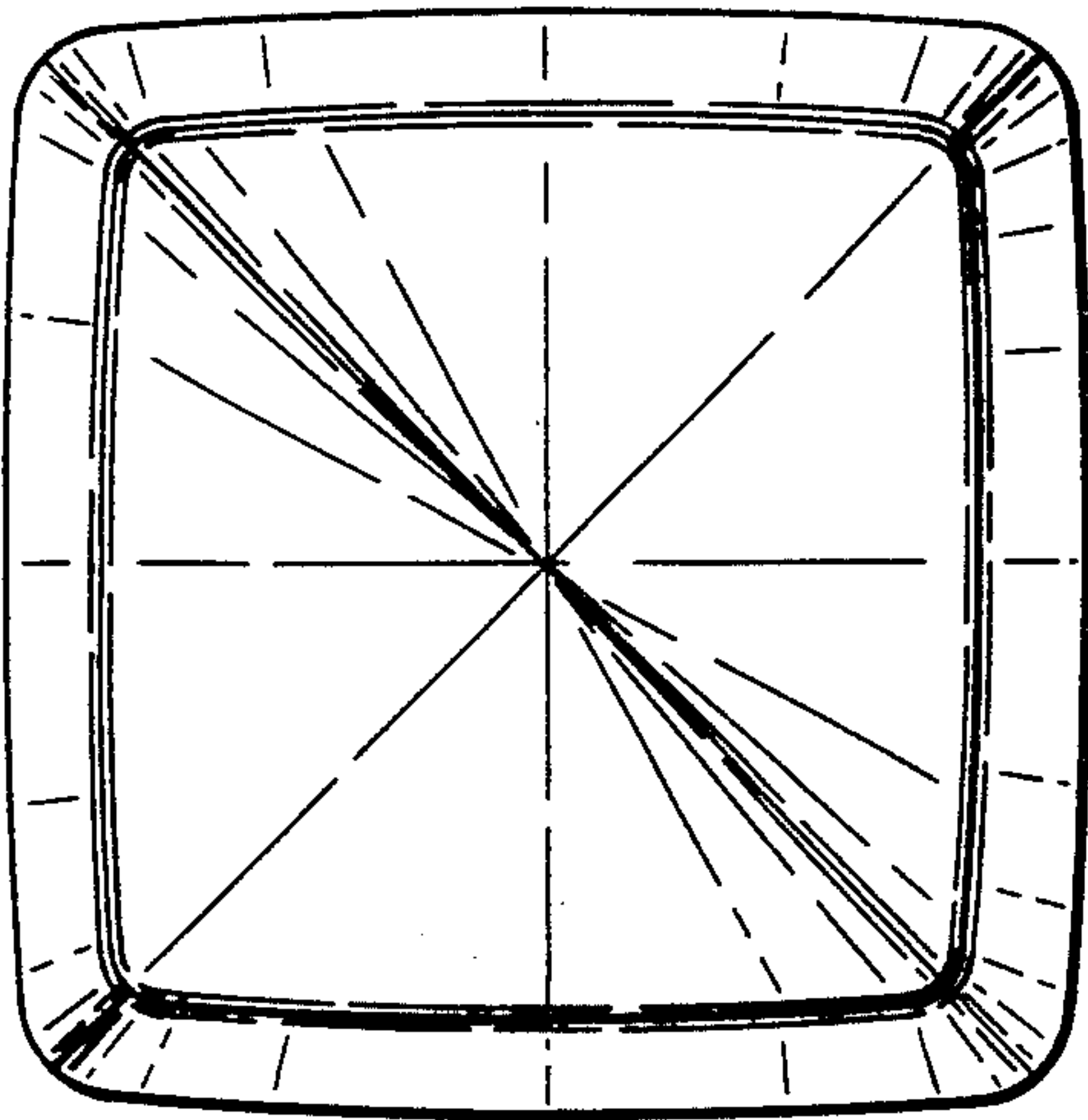

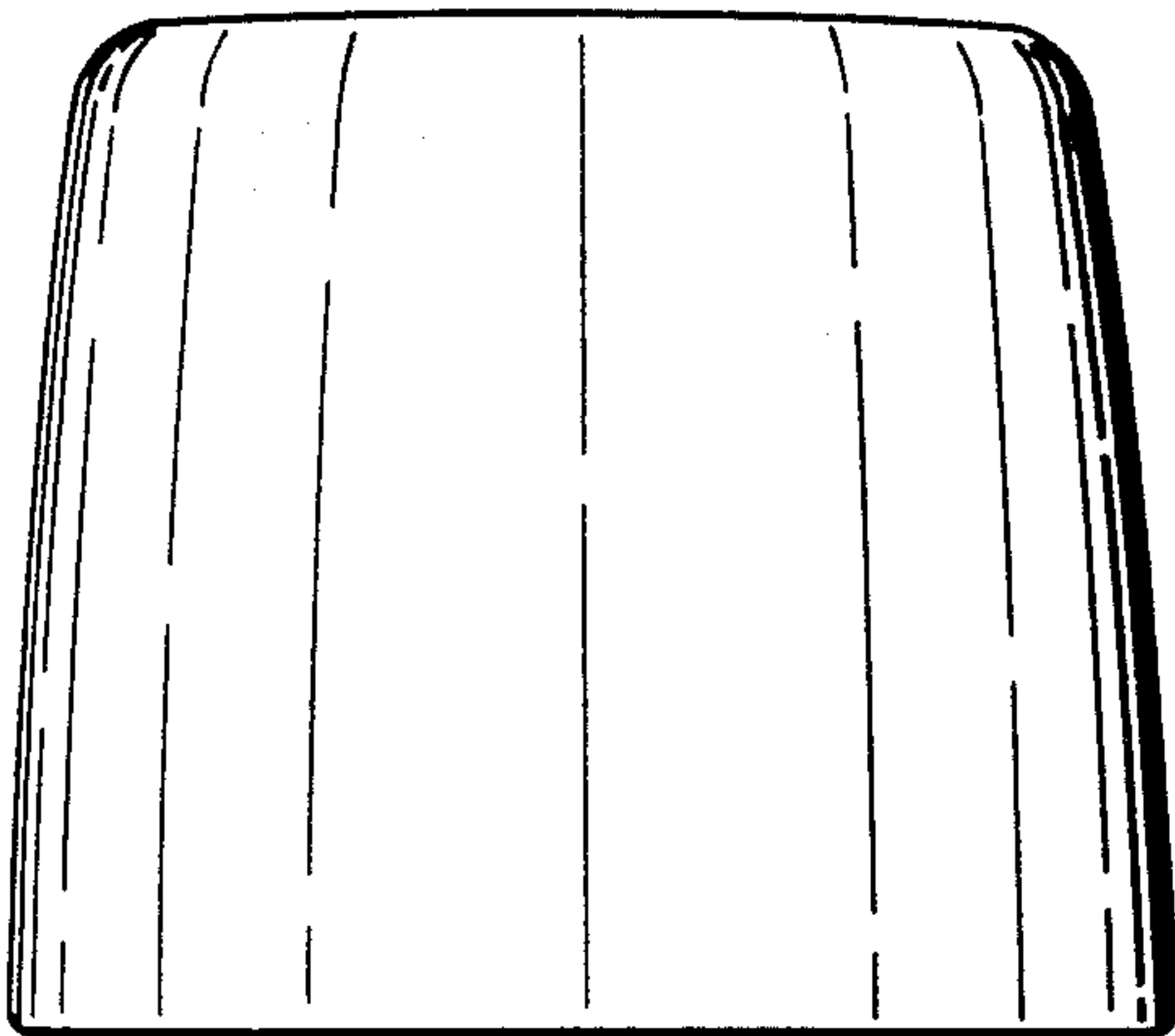
