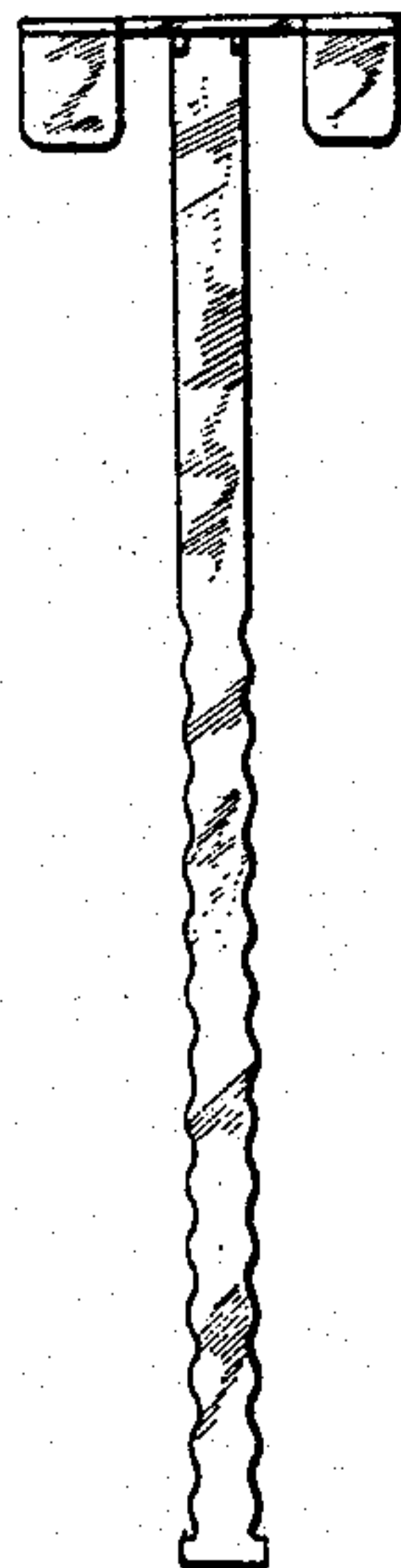

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable hanger for in-tank toilet cleaning devices, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of an adjustable hanger for in-tank toilet cleaning devices showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof, the opposite side being identical in appearance; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



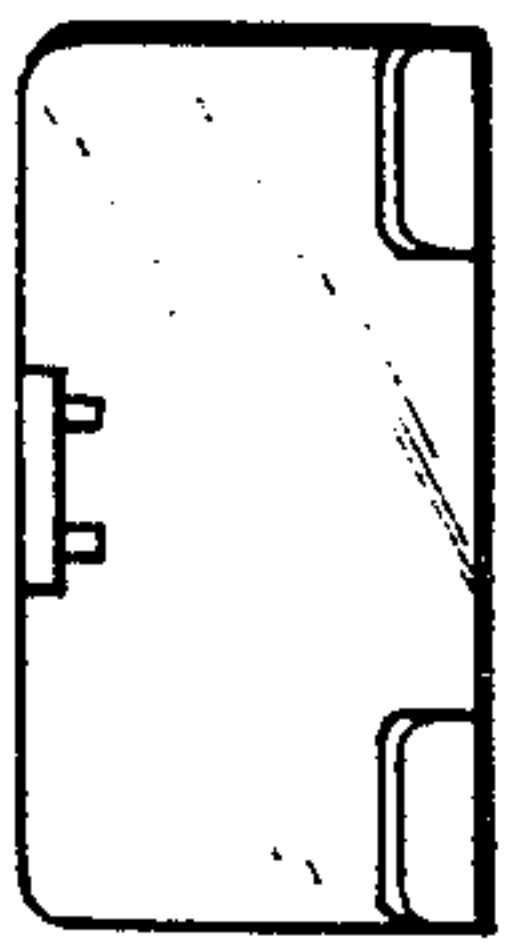

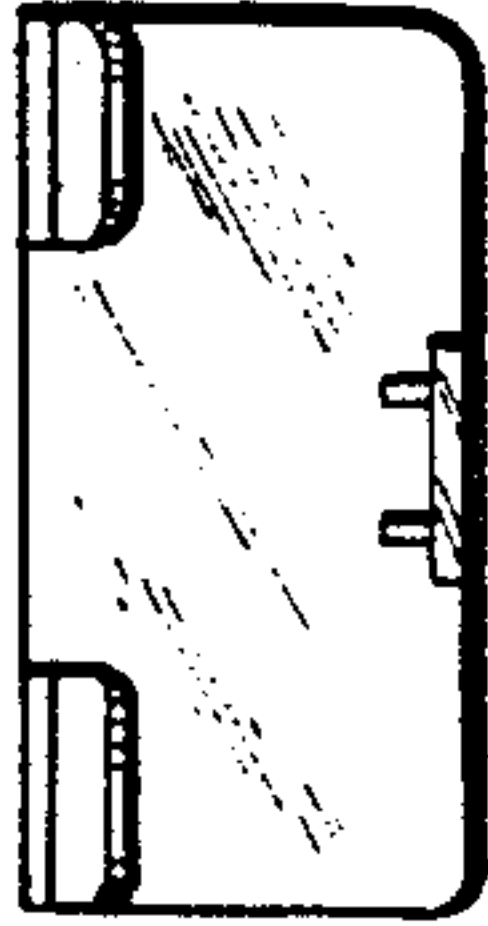

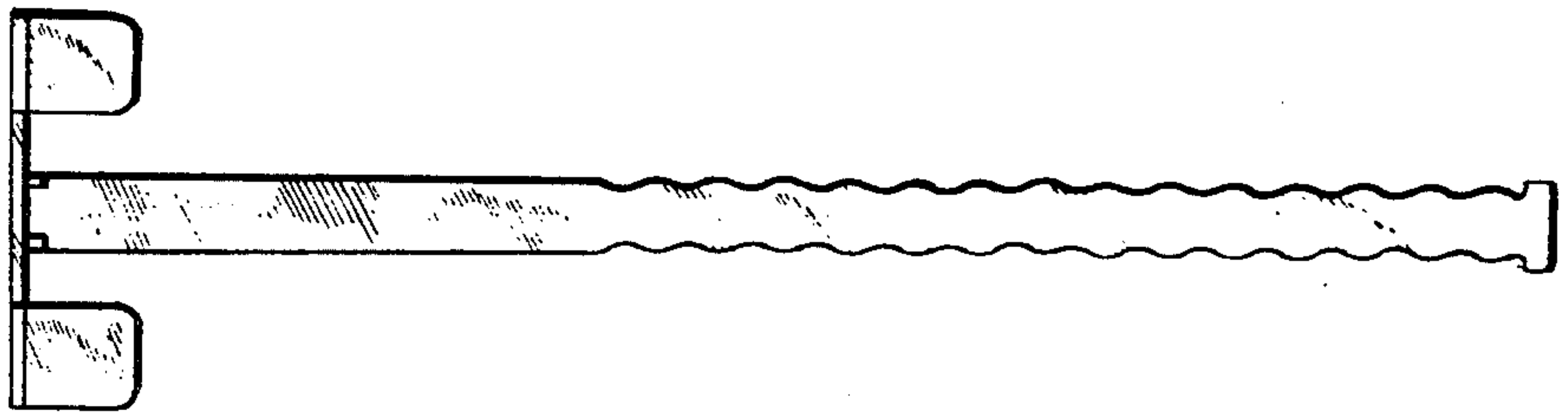

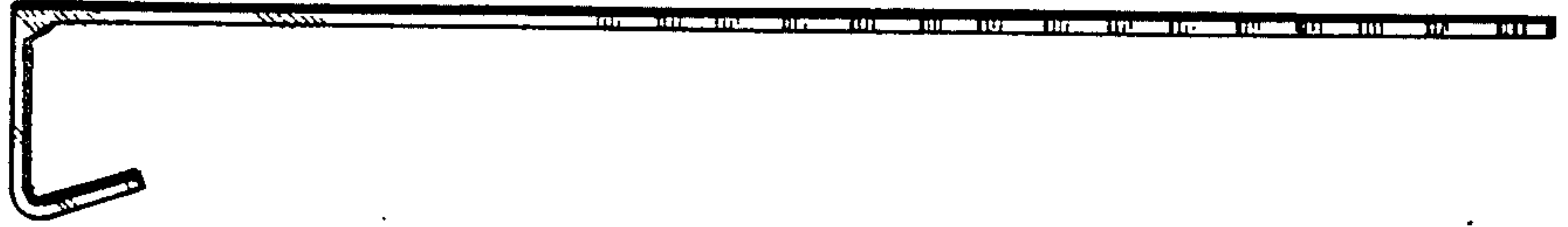
