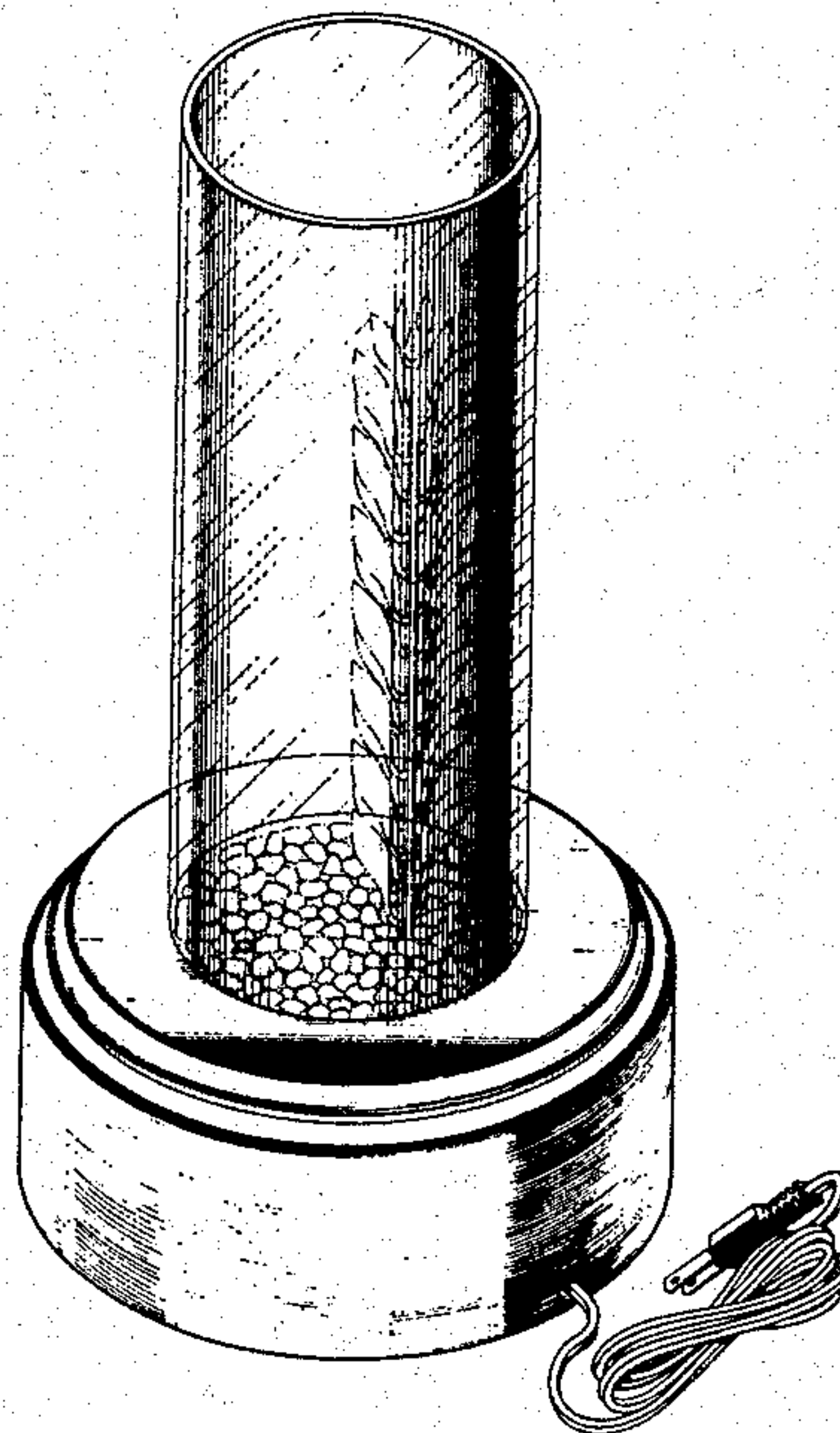
The ornamental design for an aquarium, as shown and described.

The broken-line representation of gravel and a plant in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



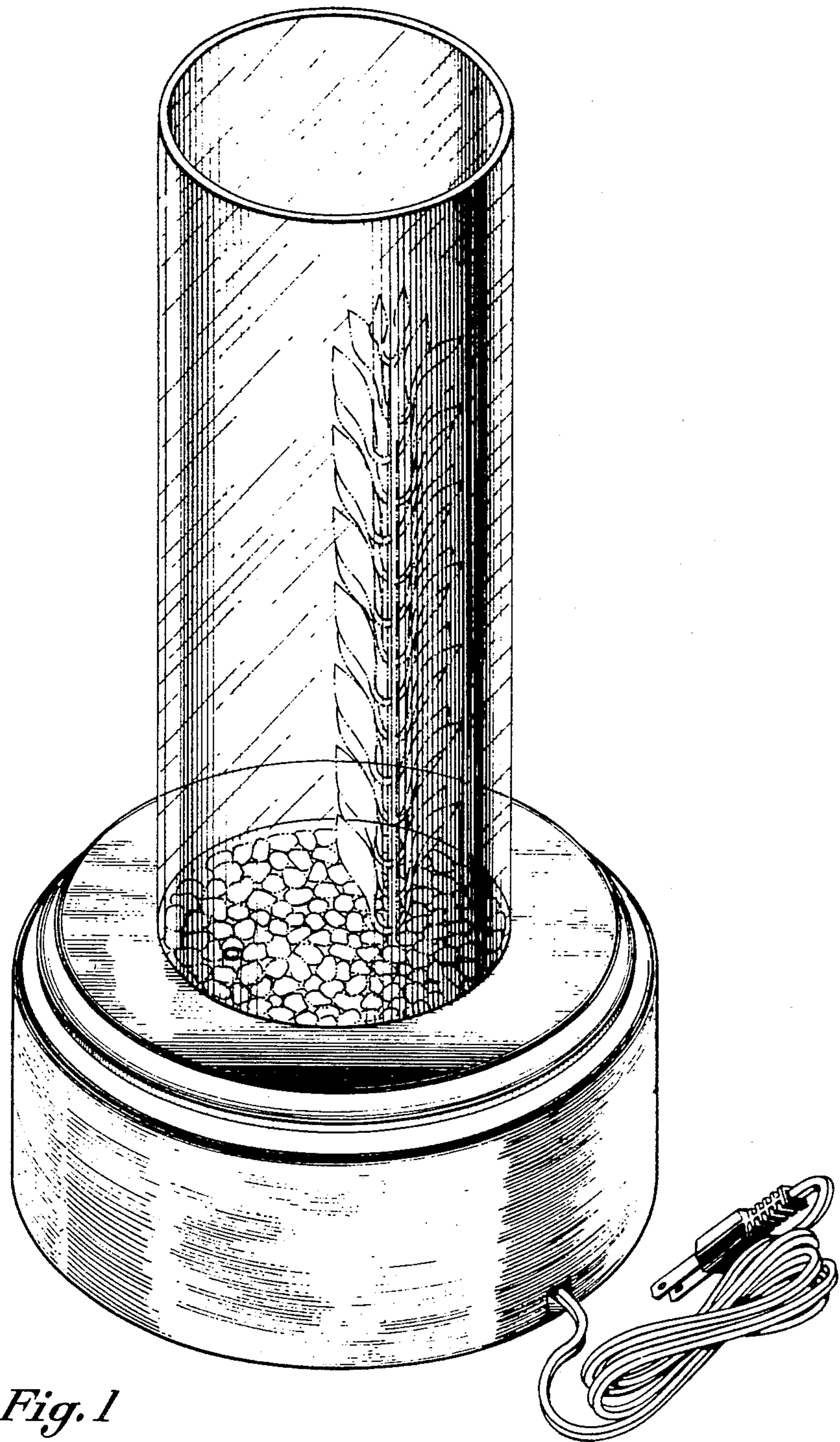

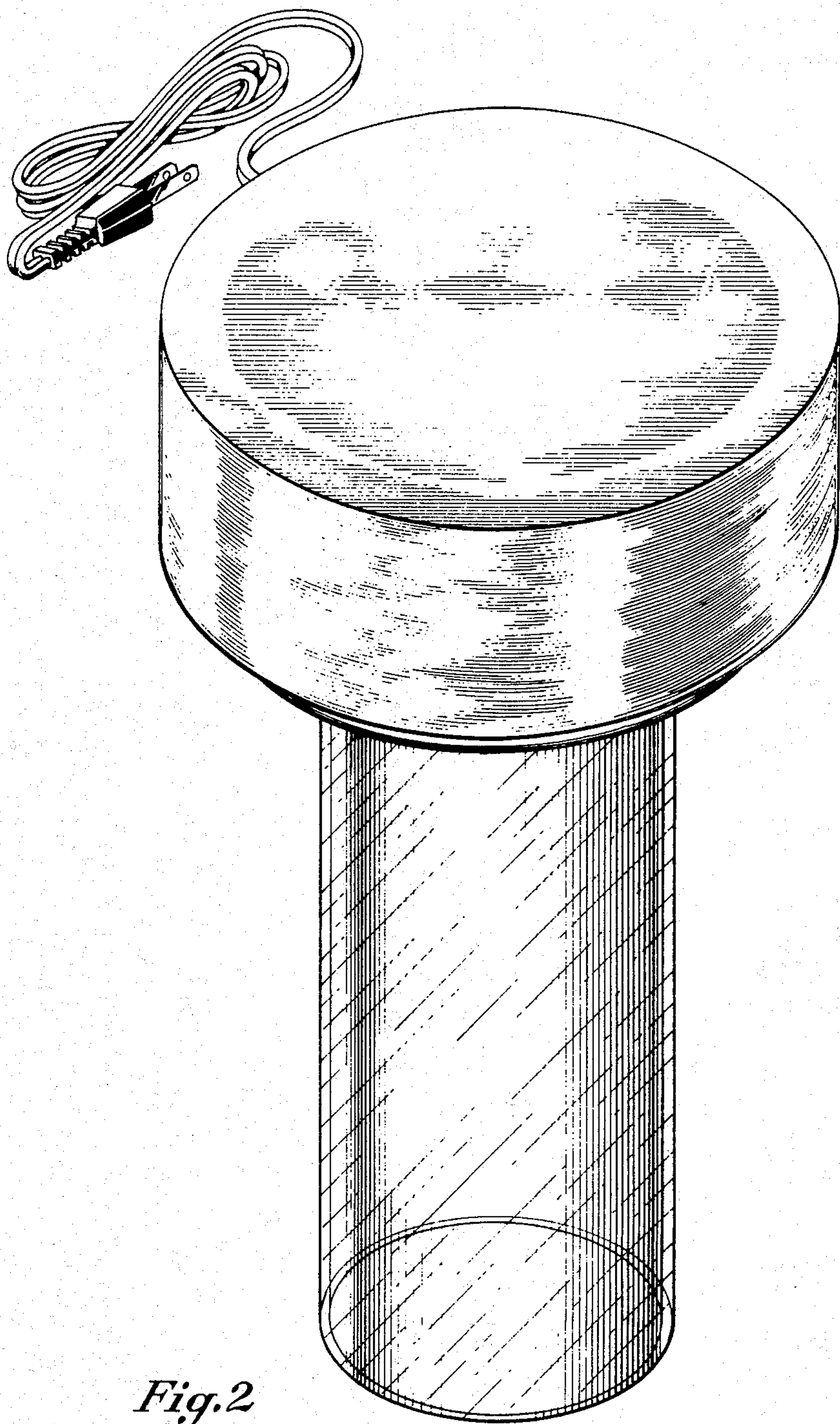
