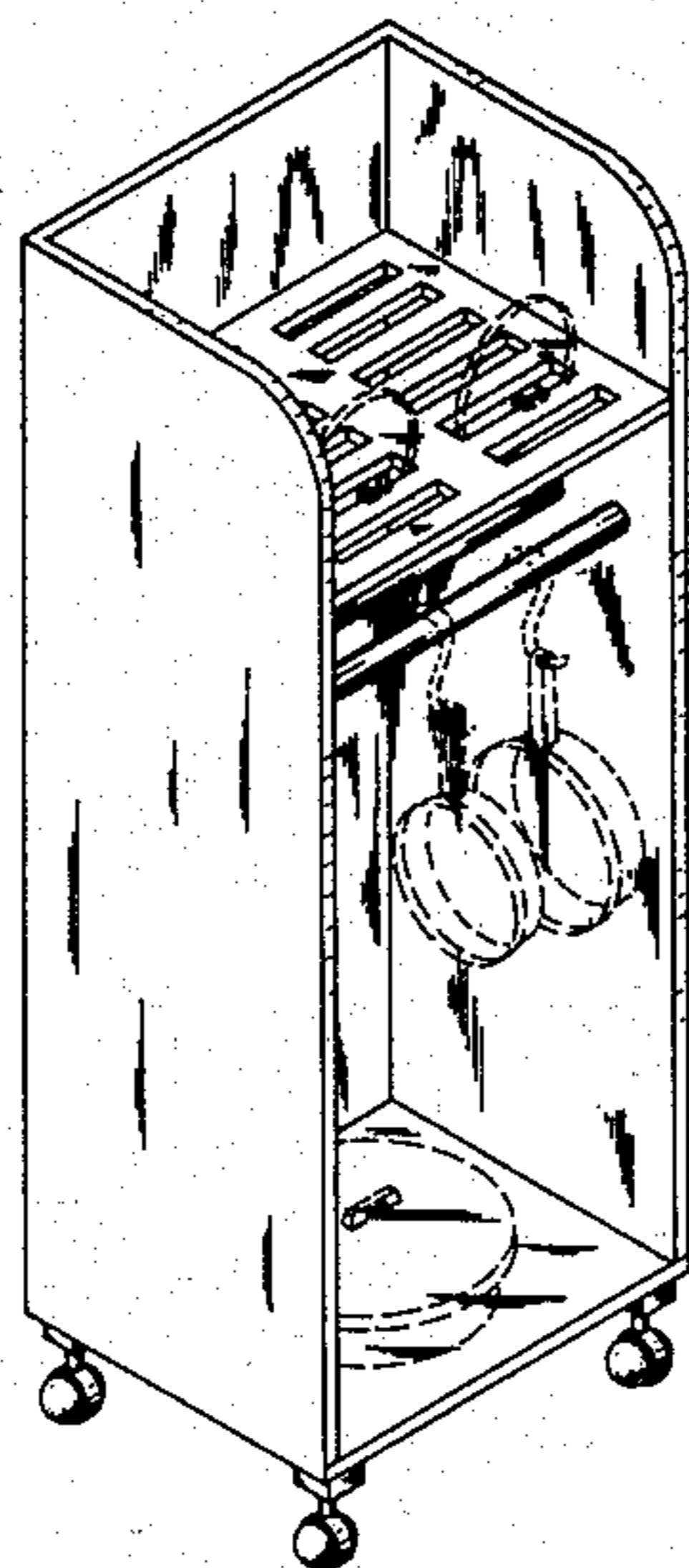
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a cart for pots, pans, lids, and other kitchen utensils showing my new design.

The bottom and rear of the cart are understood to be flat and unornamented.



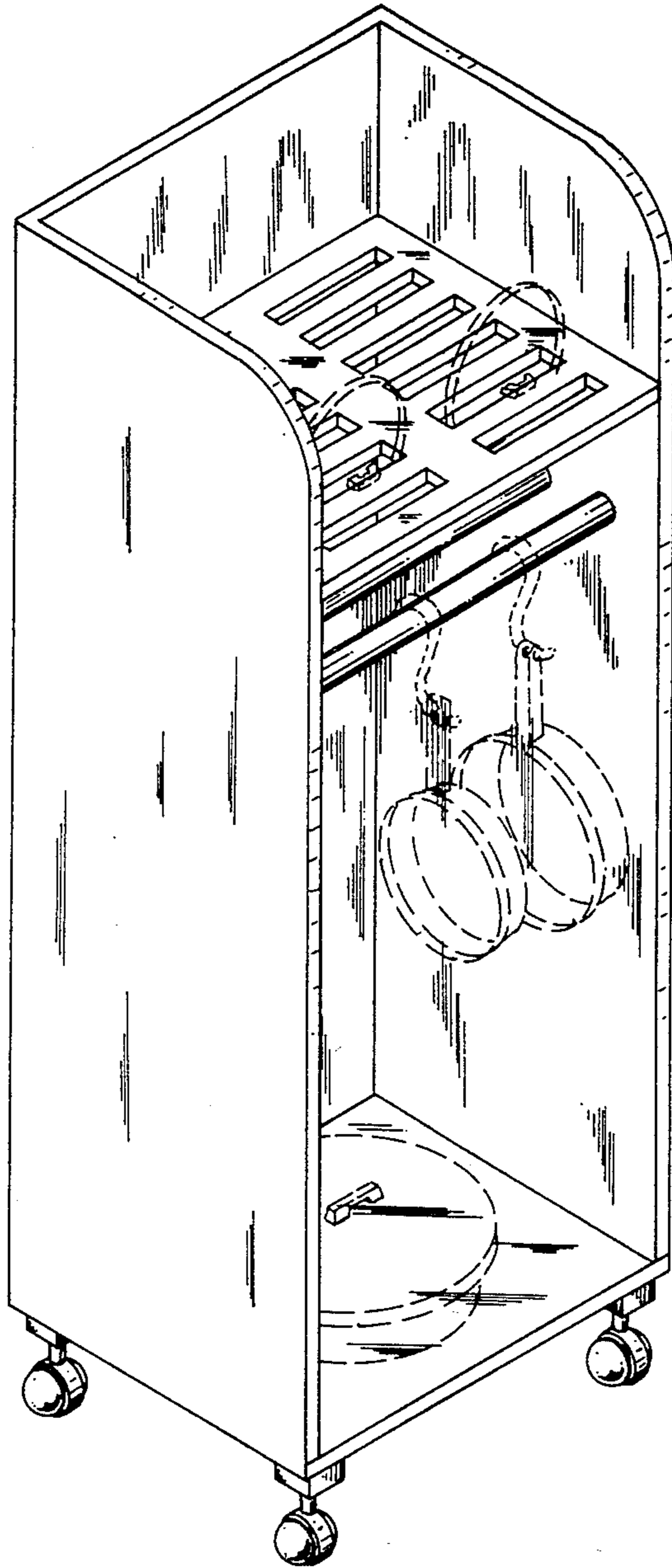

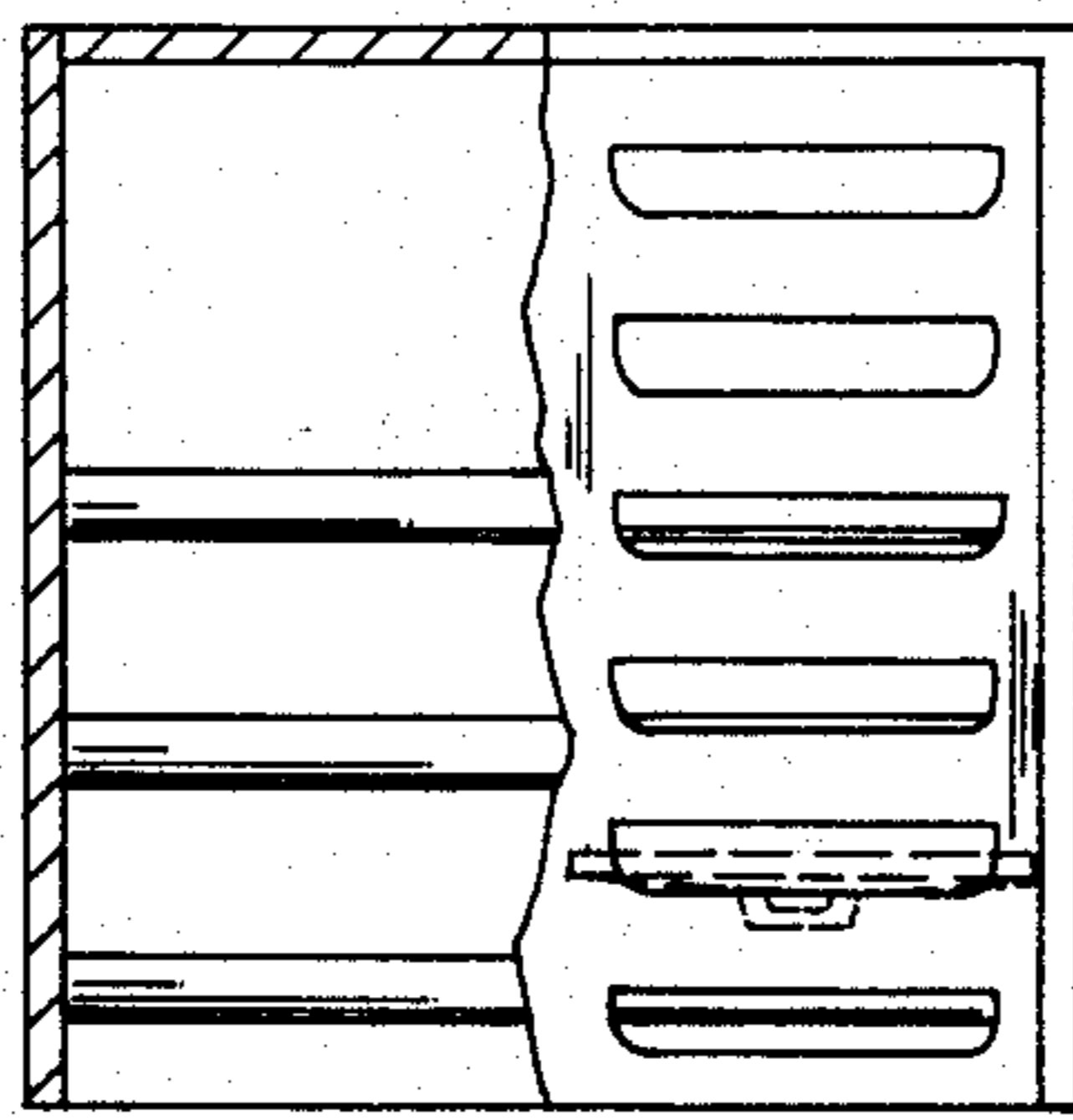

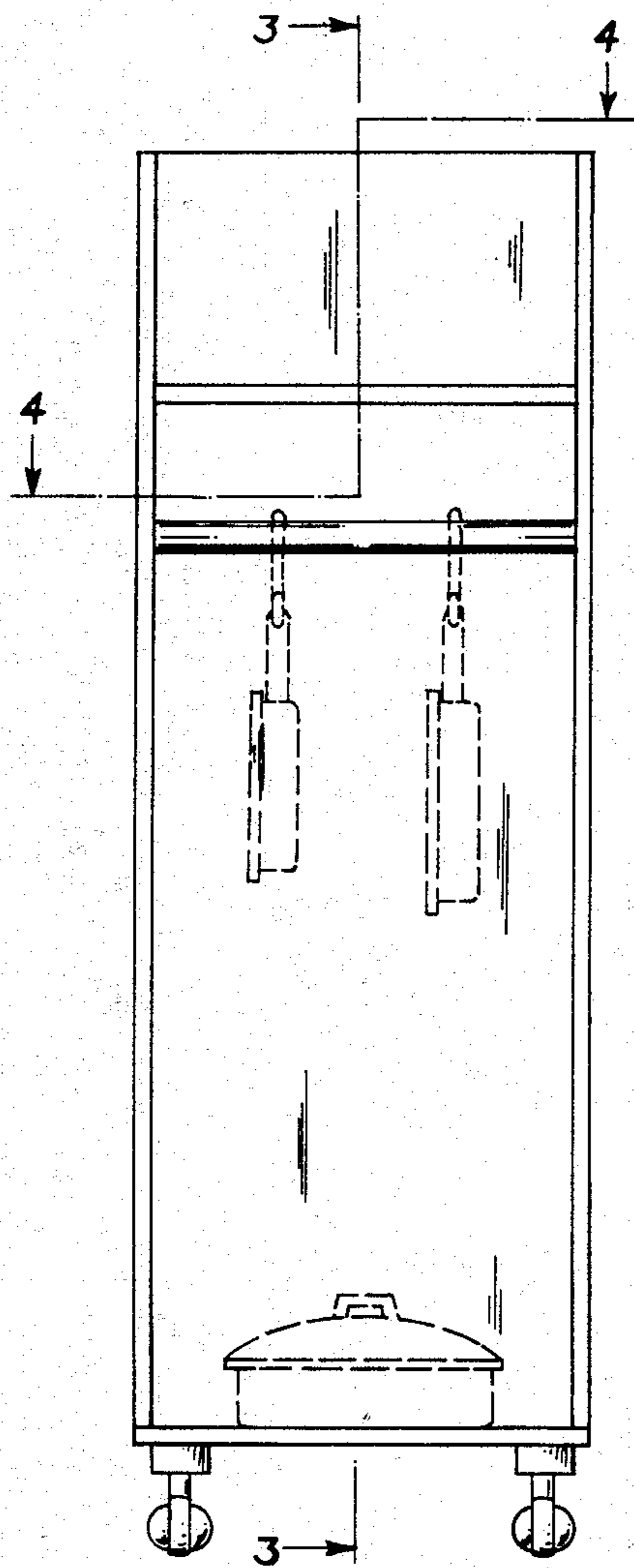

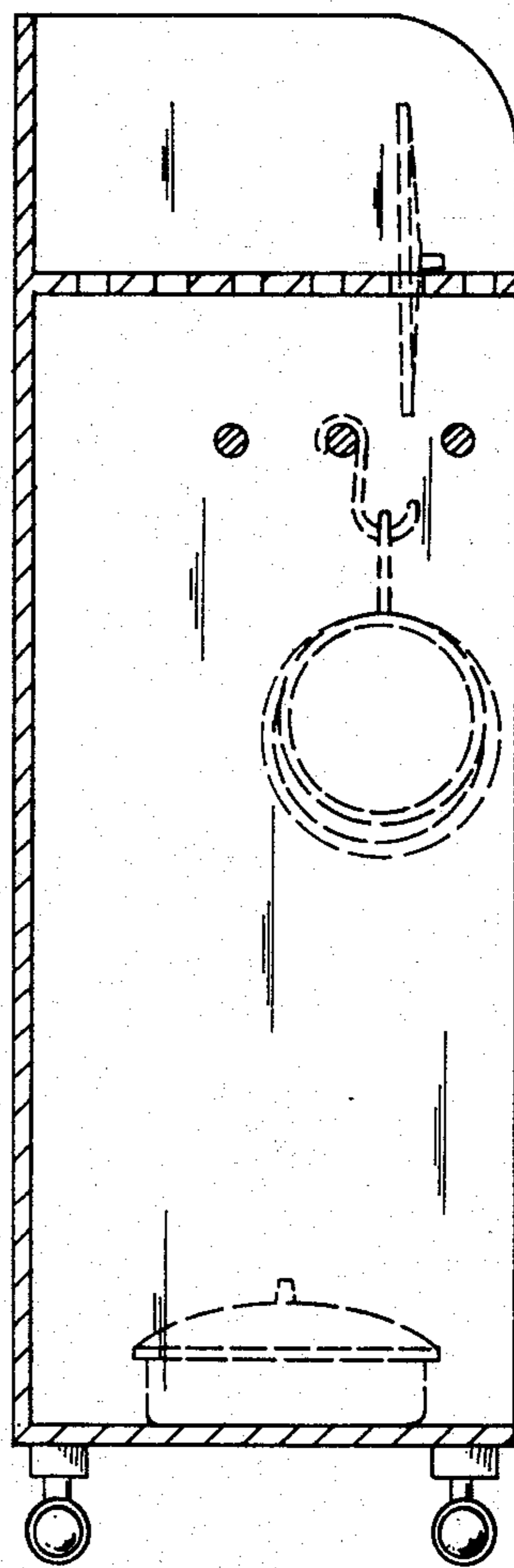
