The ornamental design for a chaise, as shown and described.

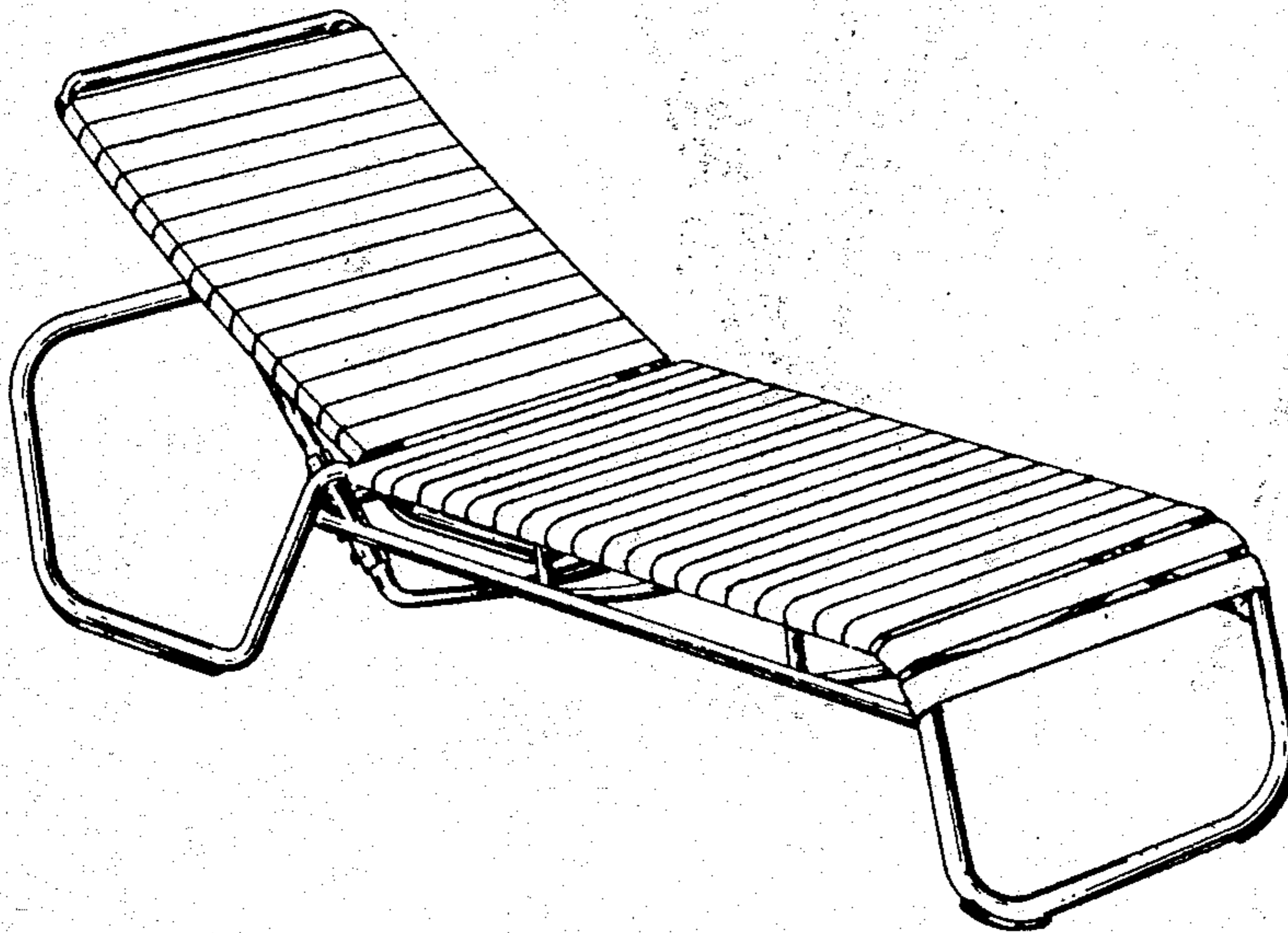
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chaise showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chaise; the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the chaise.



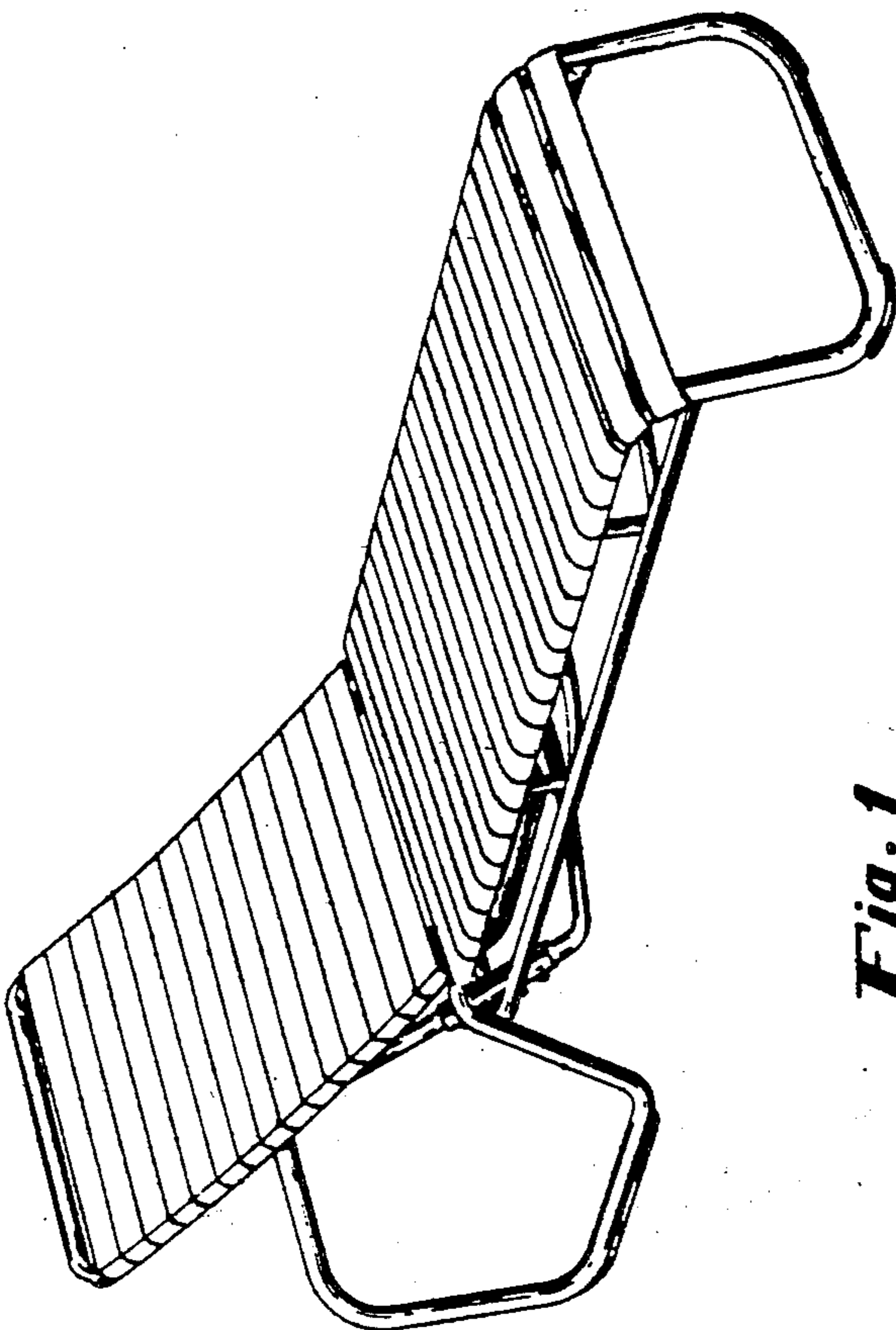

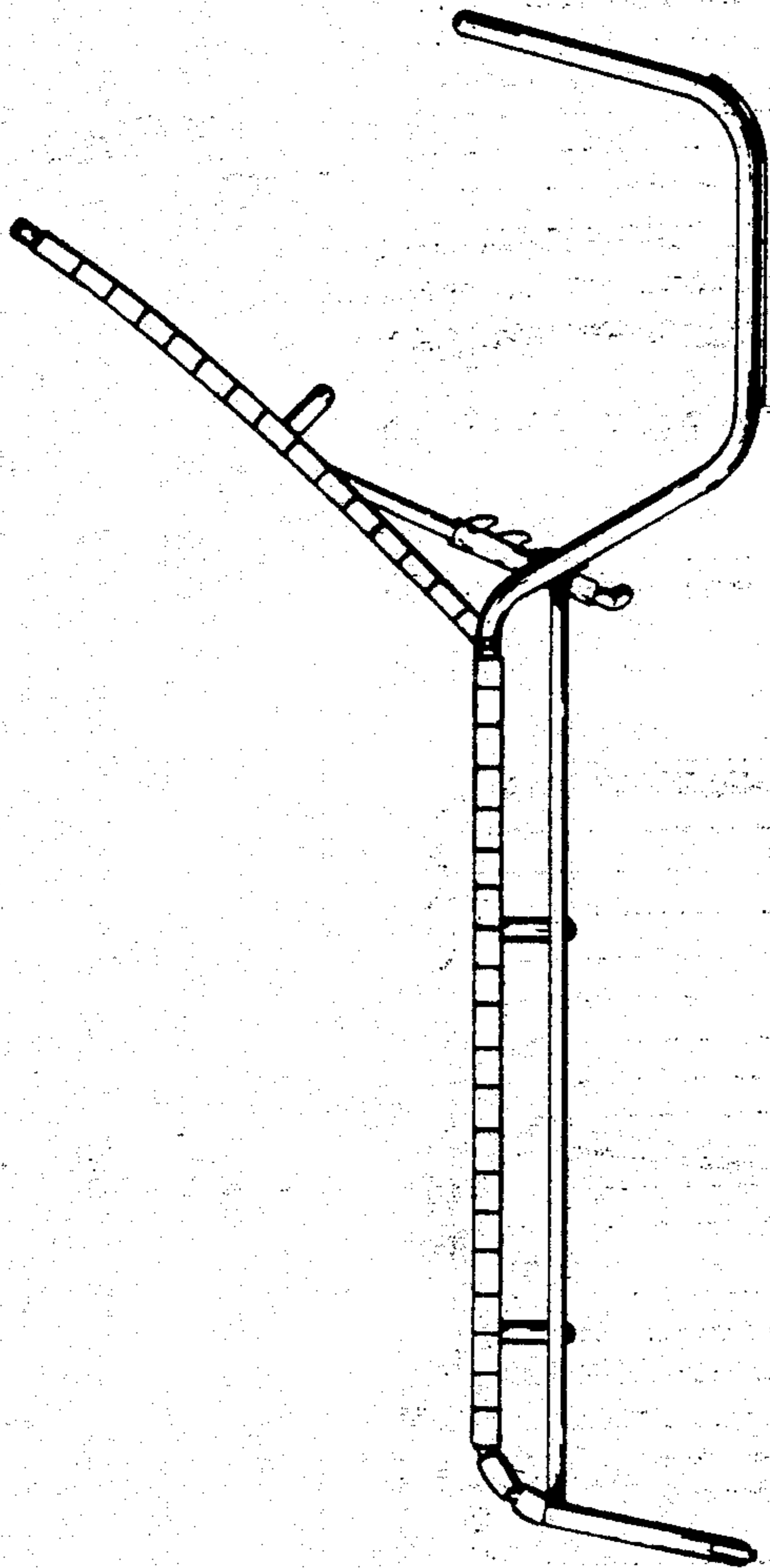

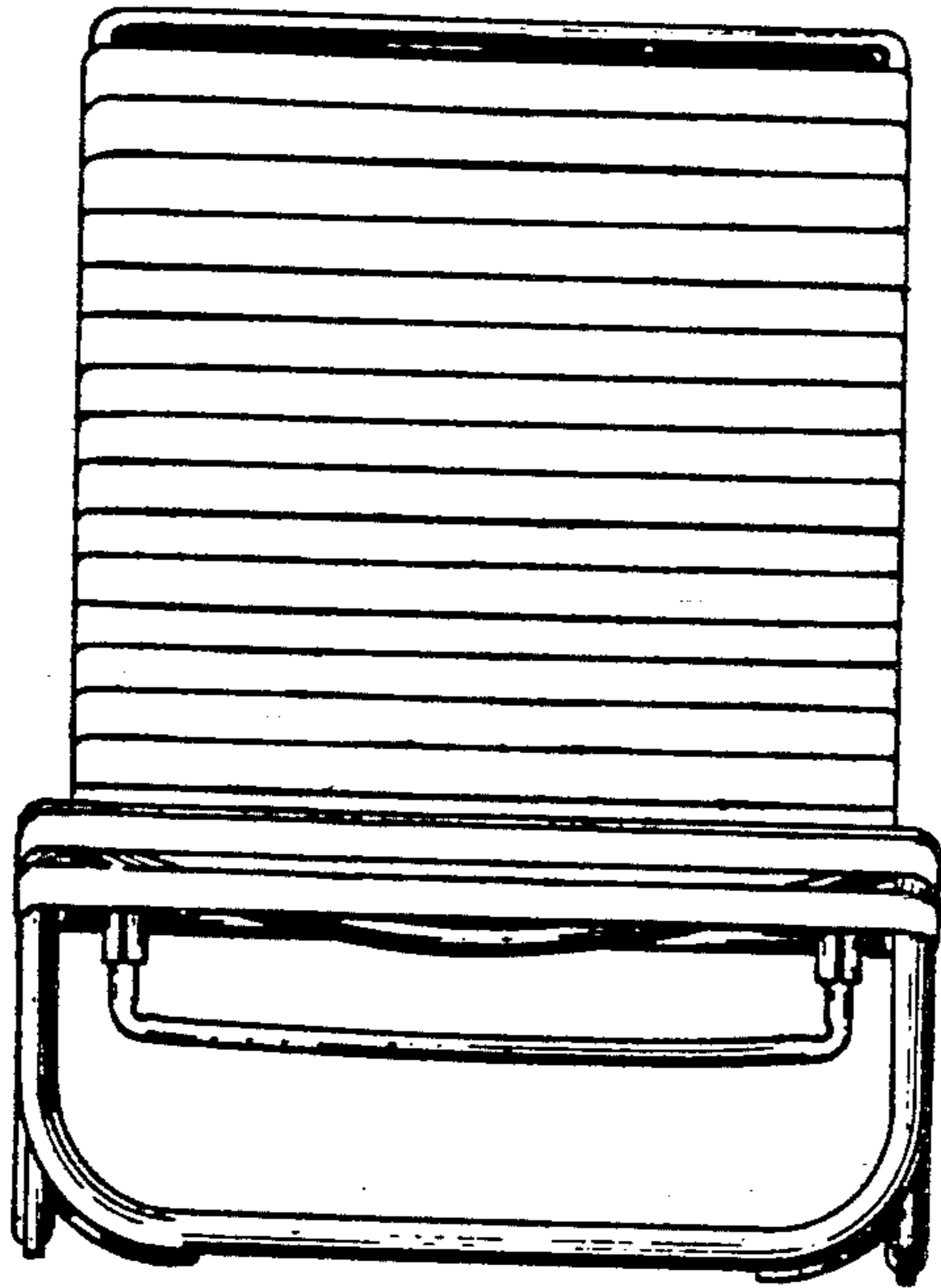

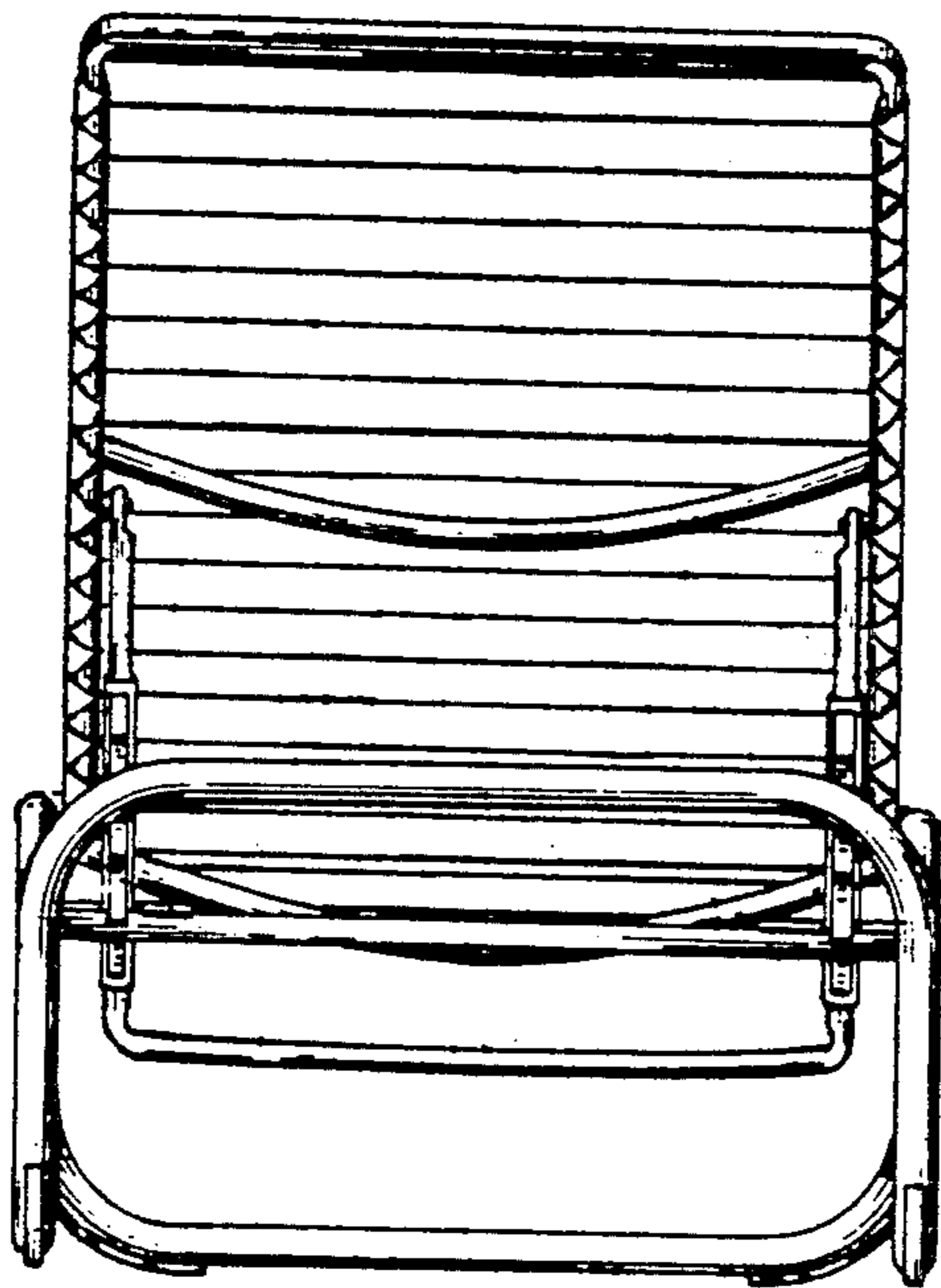
