

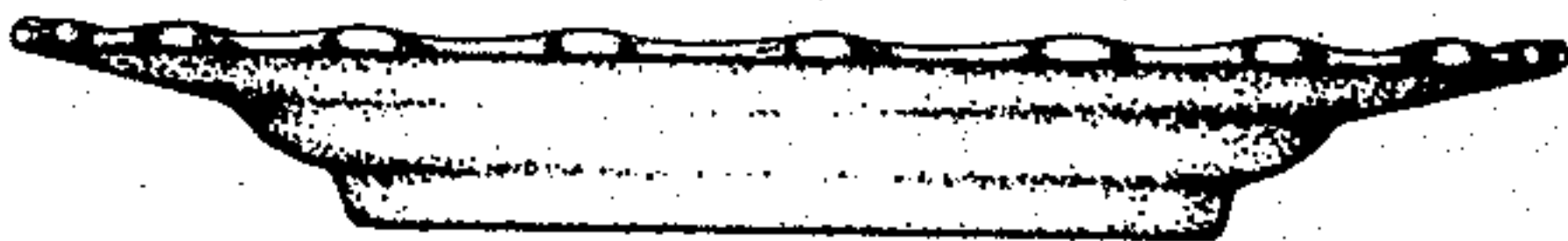
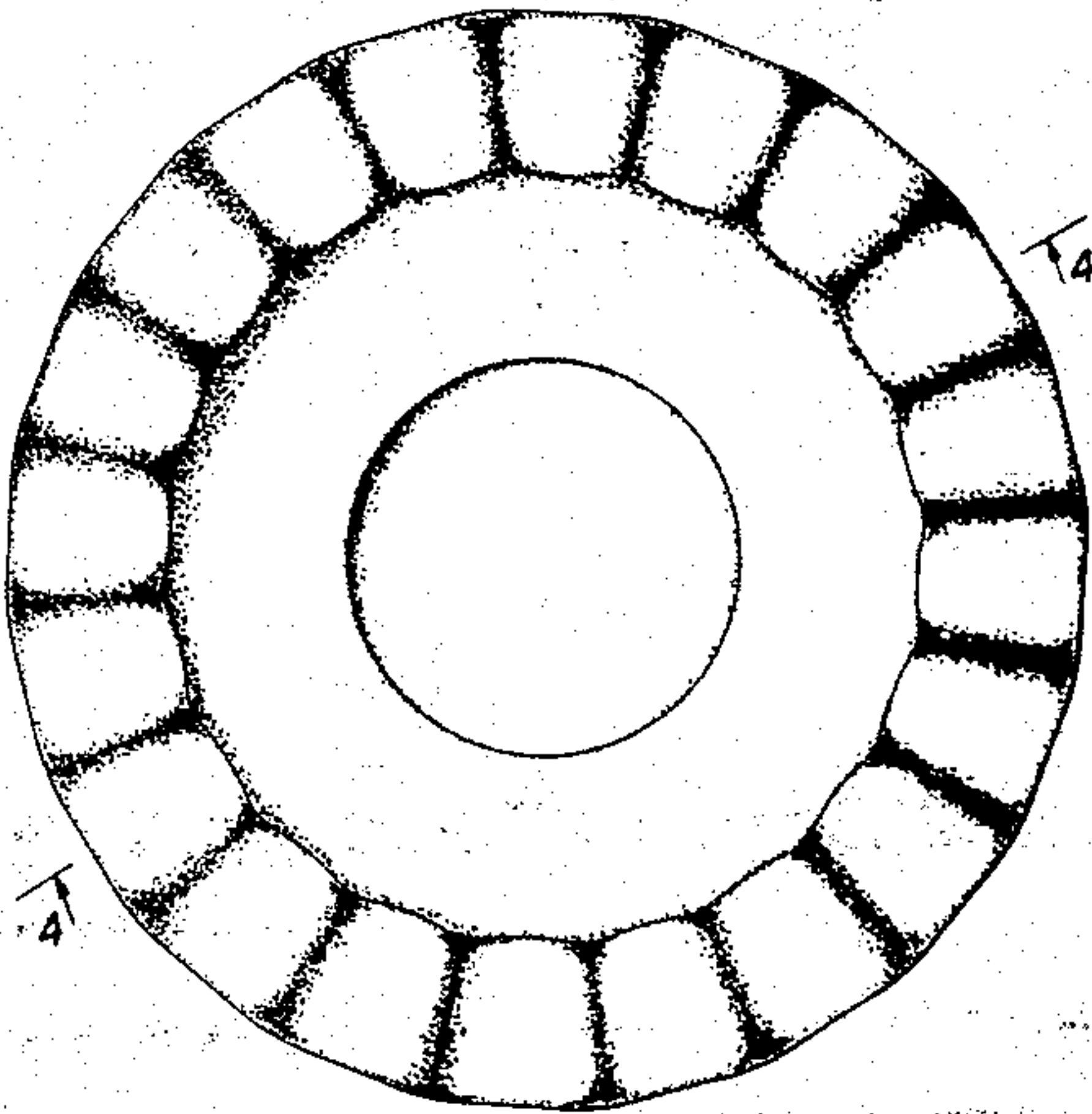
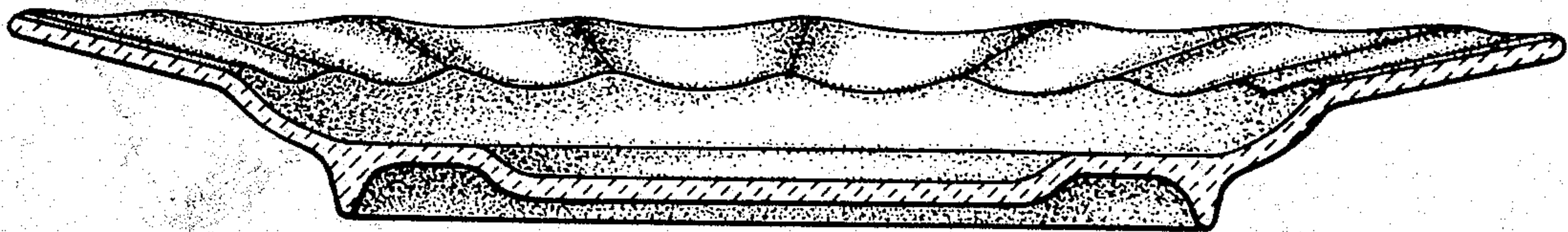

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a saucer showing my new
design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear
side, and left and right sides being identical in appear-
ances; and
FIG. 4 is a sectional view as taken along the line 4—4 in
FIG. 1.



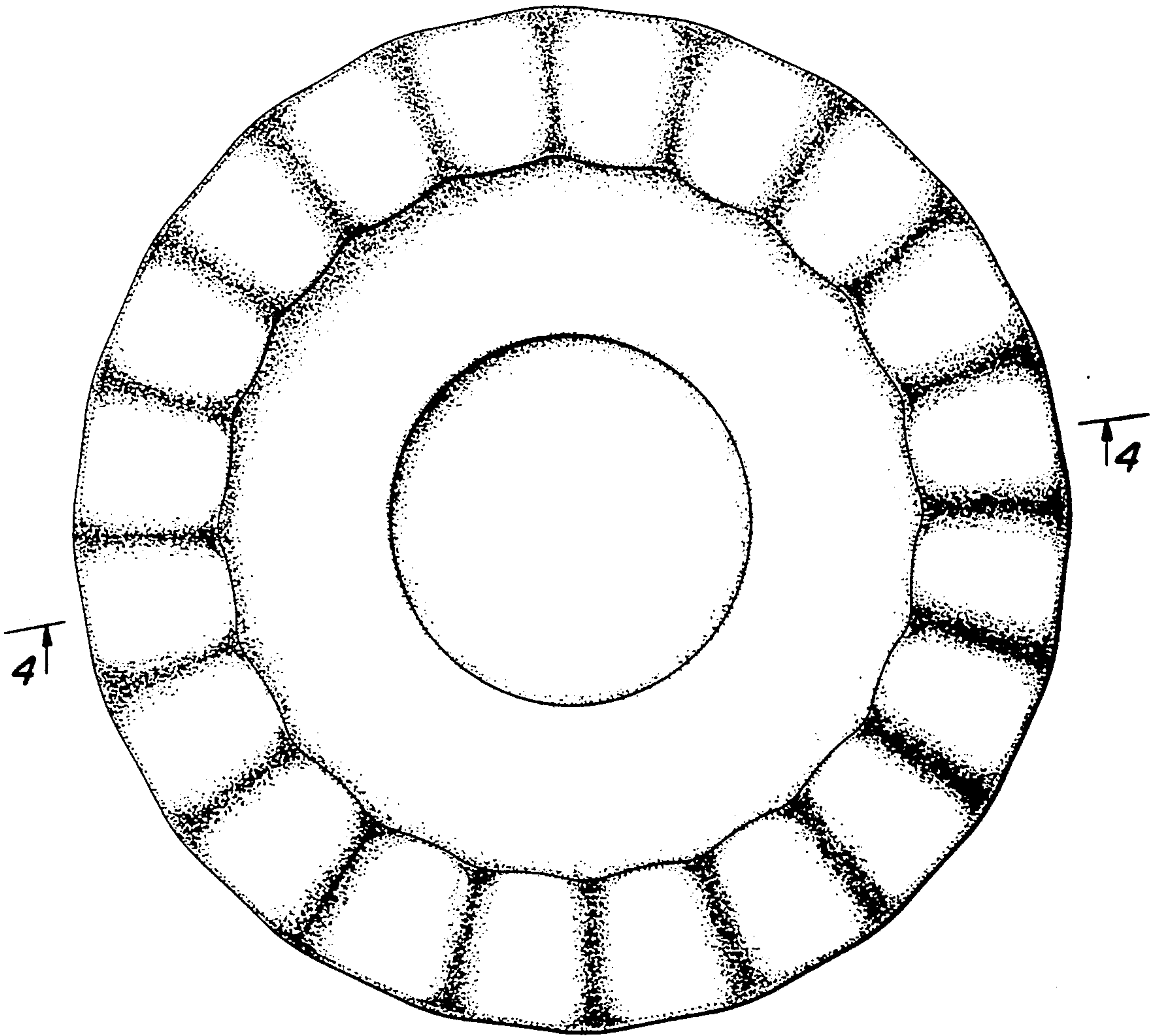

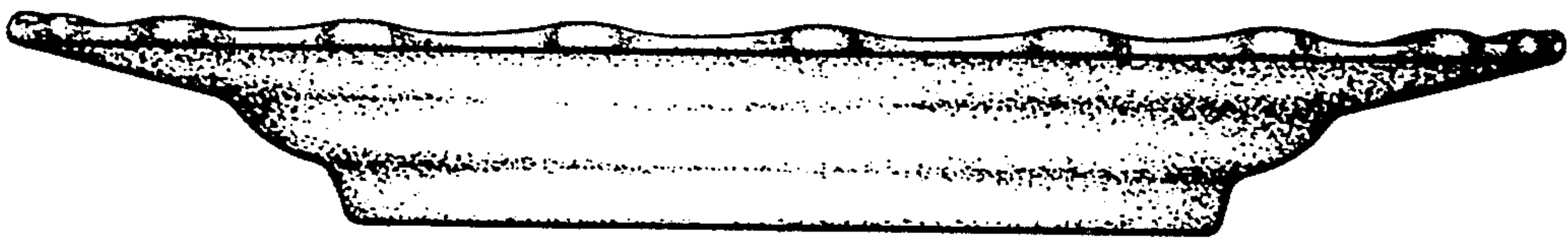

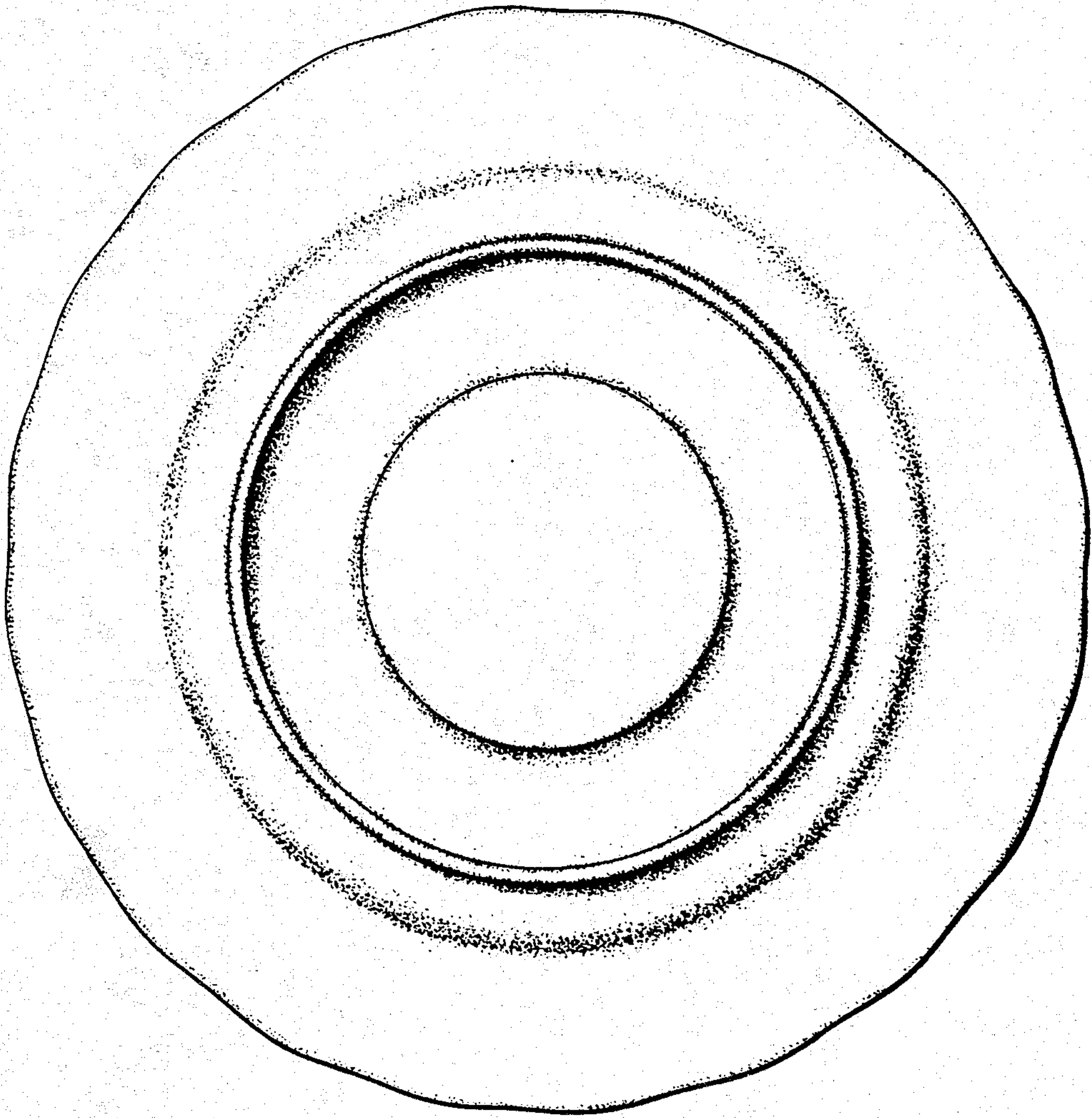
