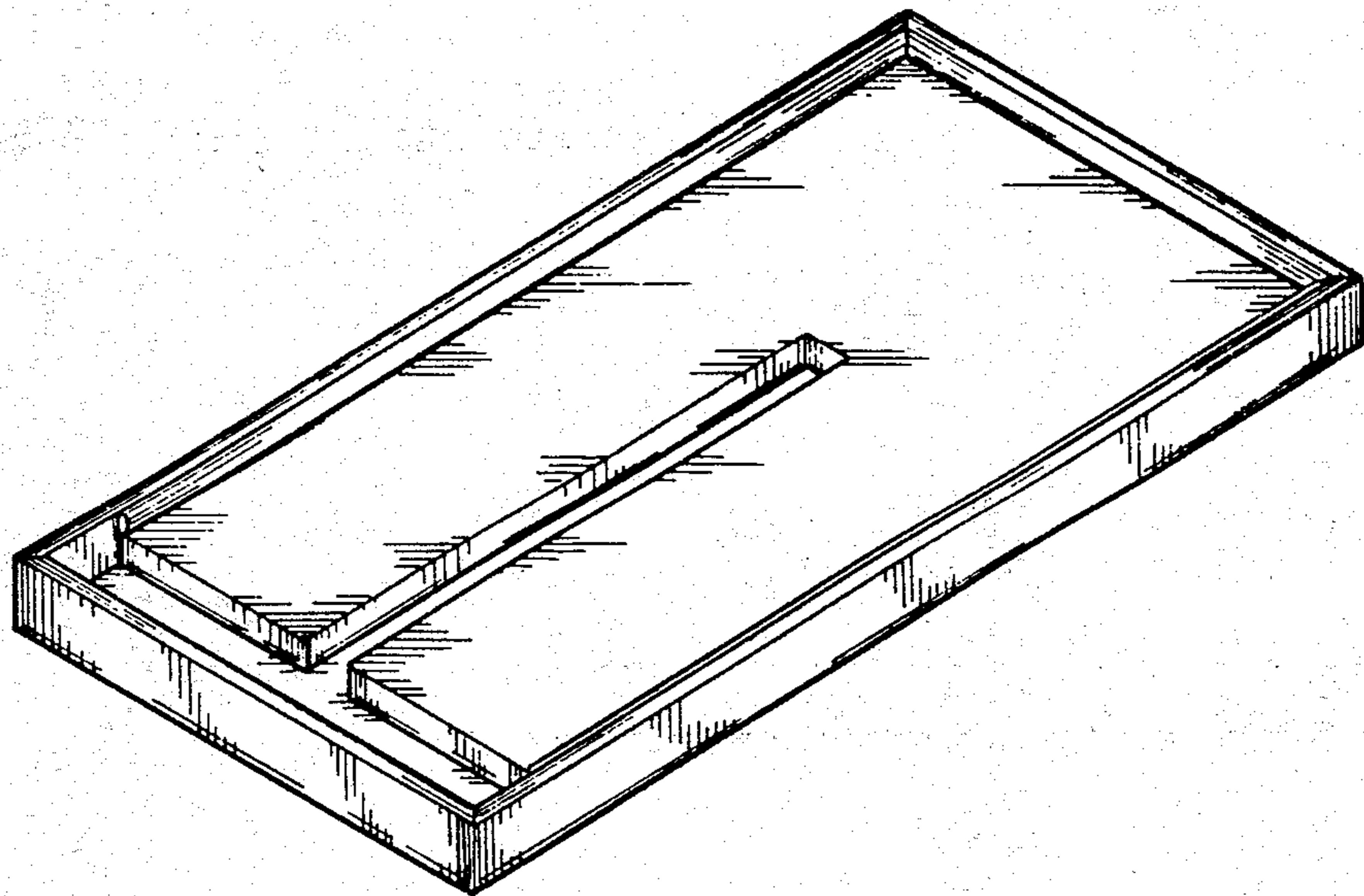

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shuffleboard game table top, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shuffleboard game table top showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof with reference to FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof with reference to FIG. 1, the left side thereof being identical to FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a left side end view thereof with reference to FIG. 1, the right side thereof being identical to FIG. 4.



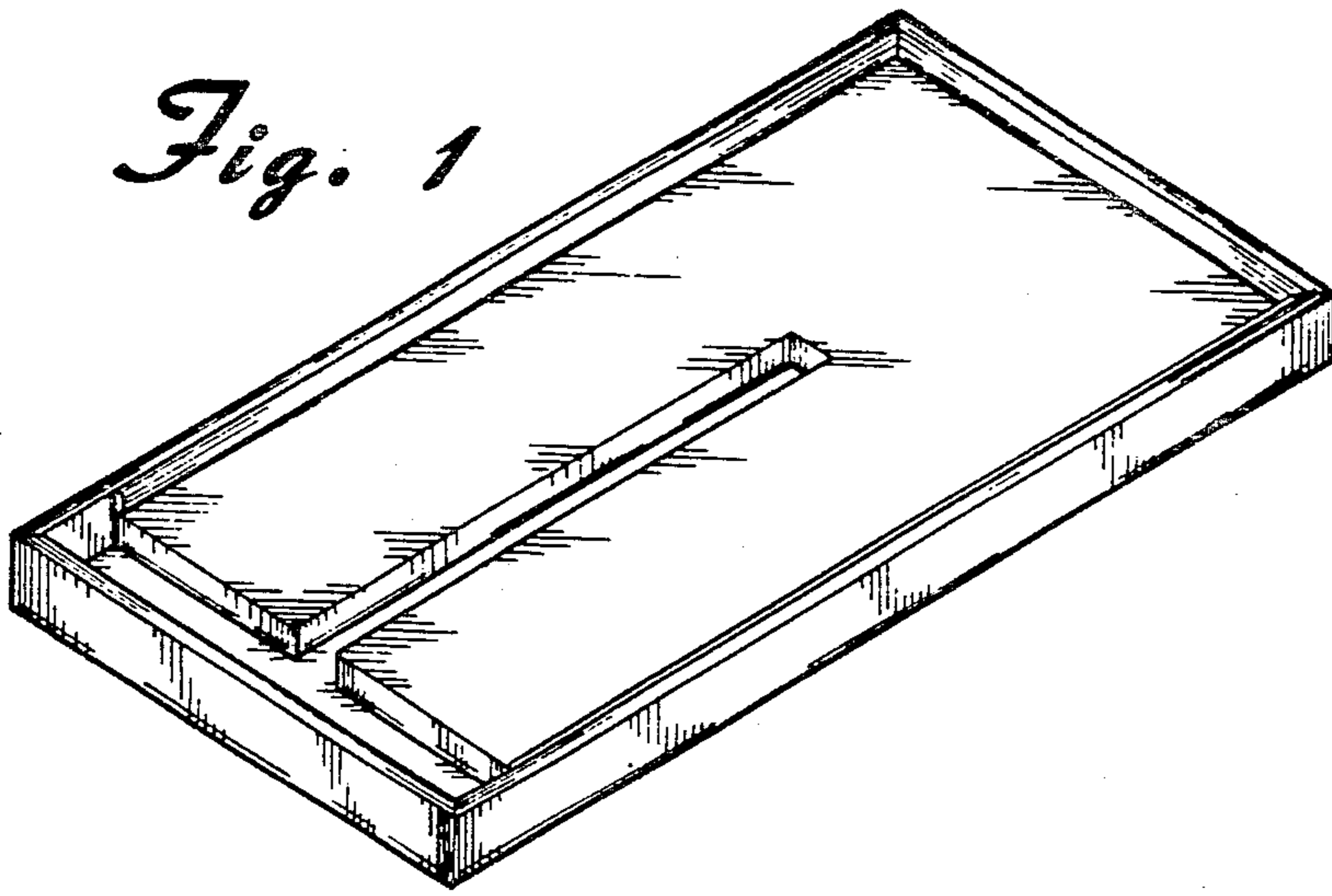

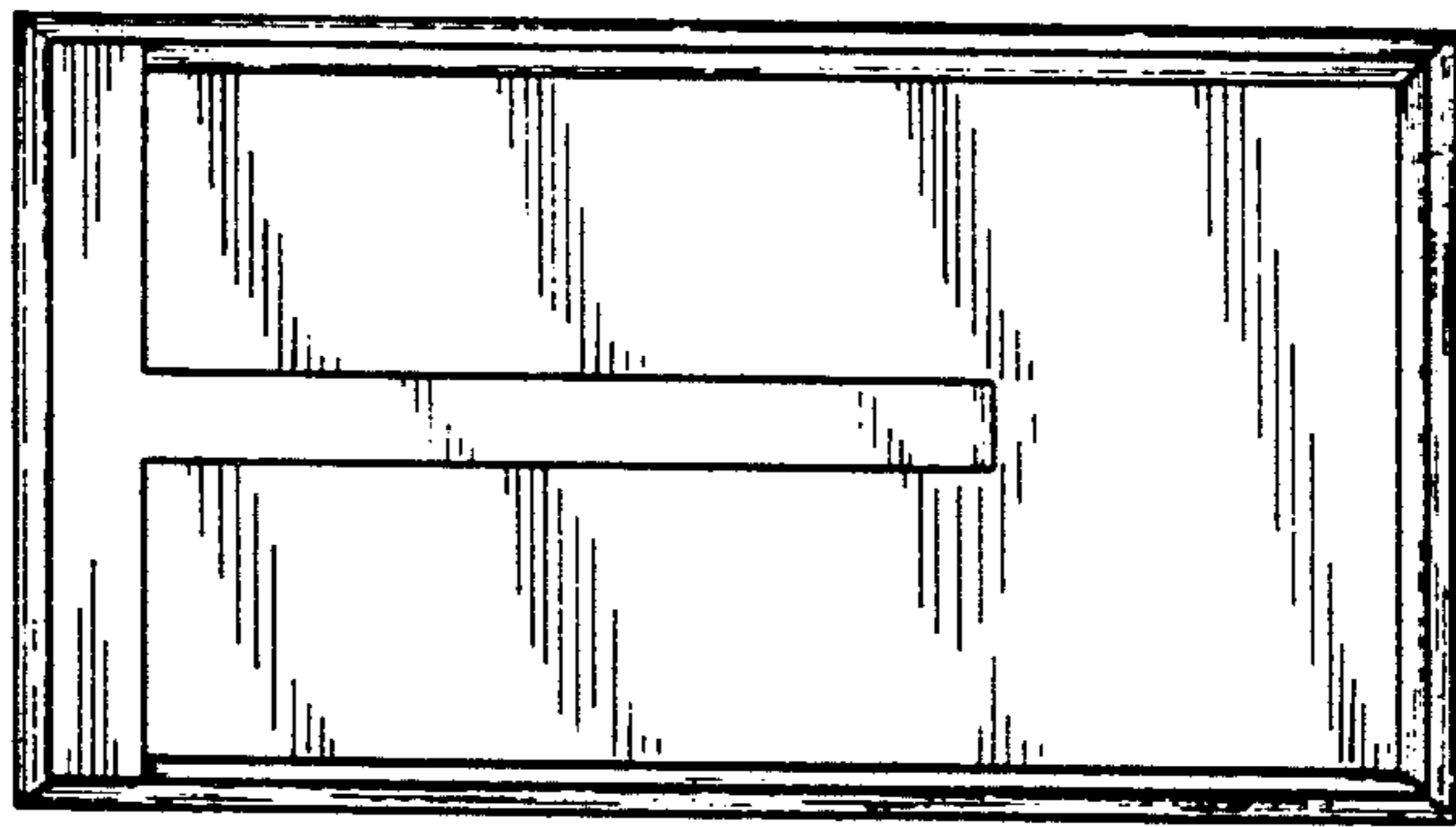

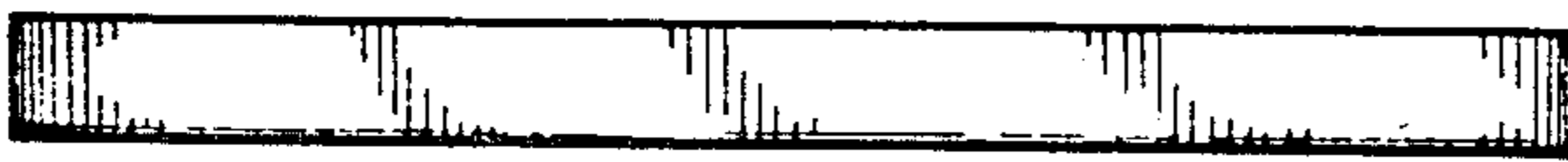
