The ornamental design for a riding toy vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a riding toy vehicle showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

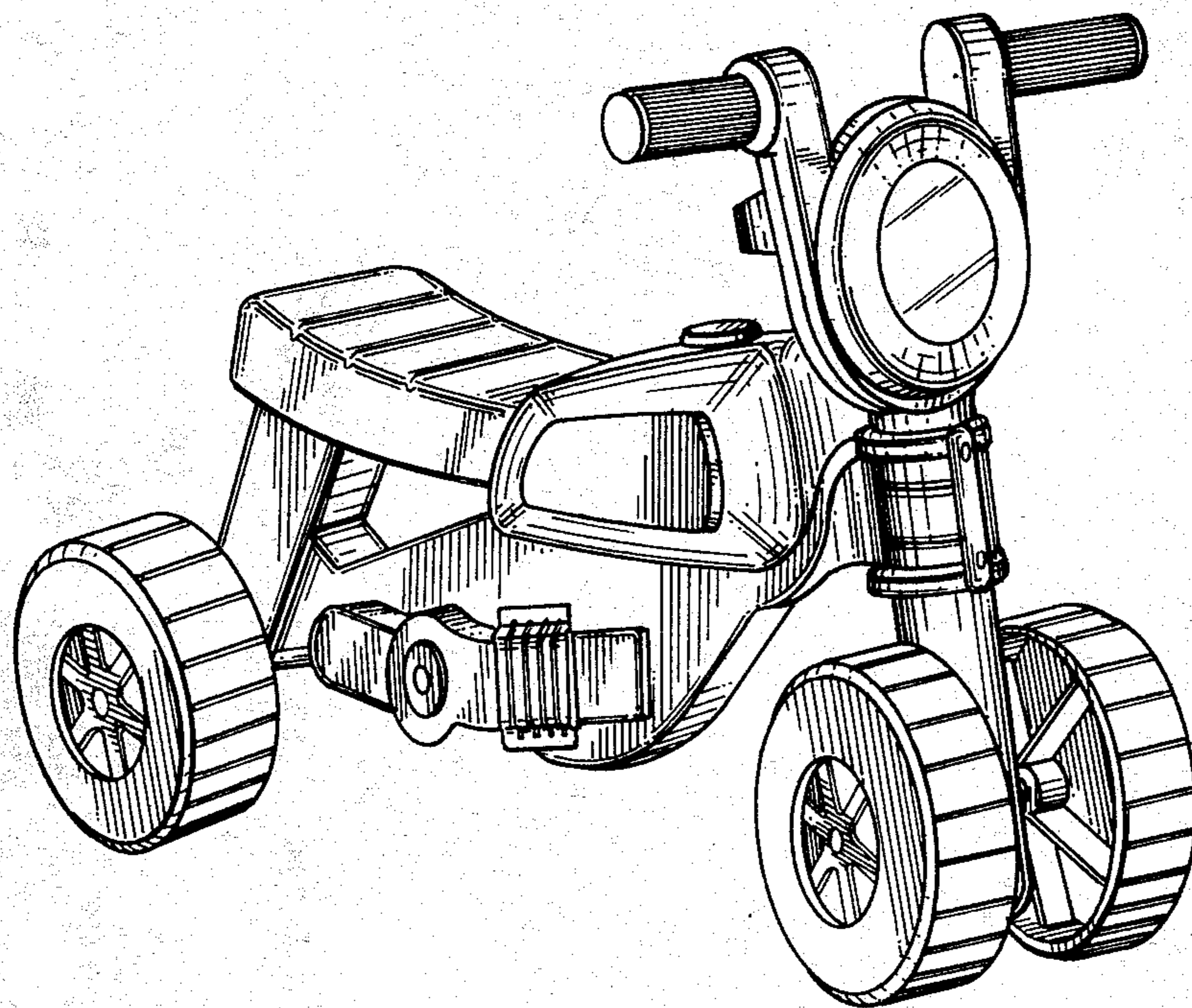
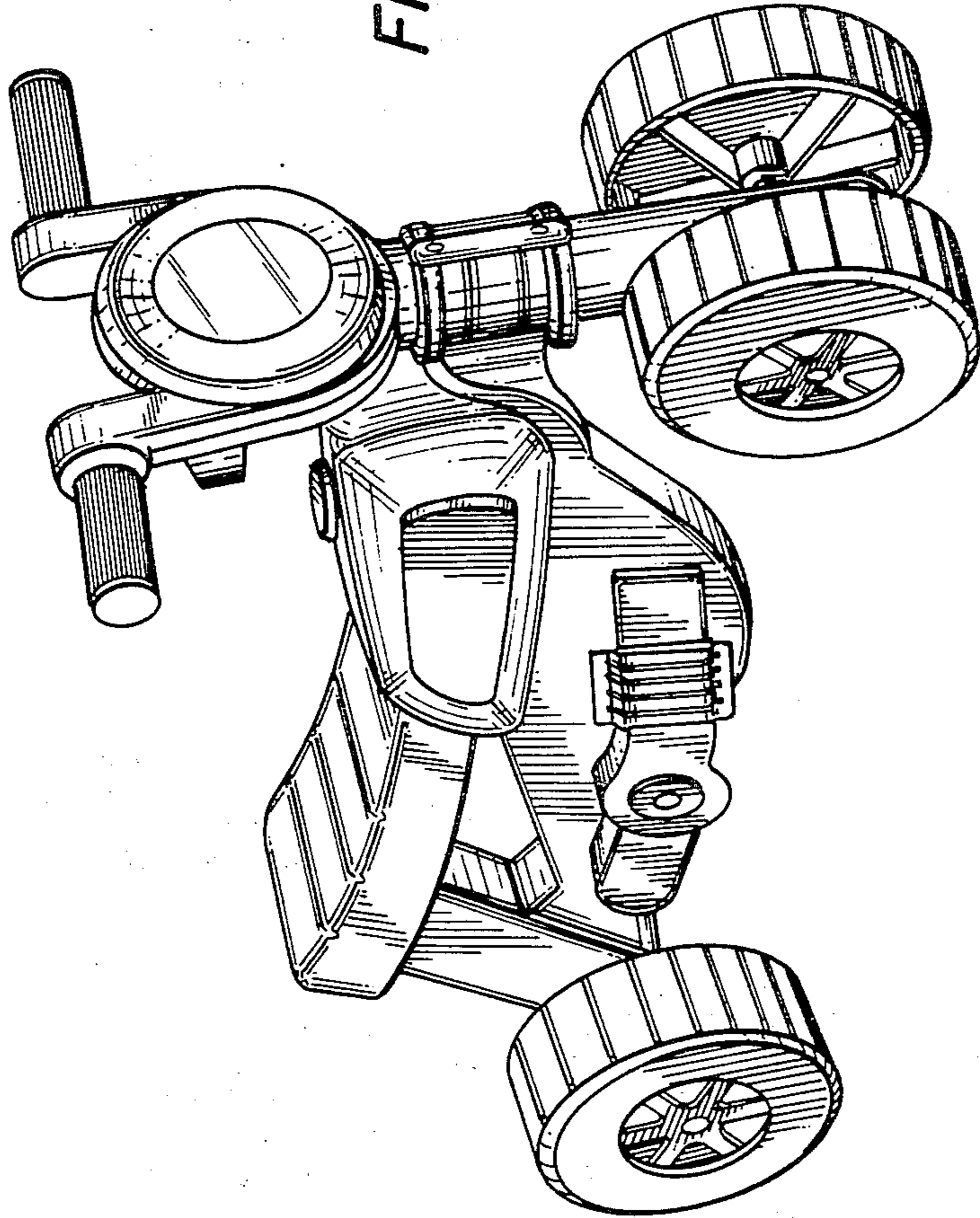

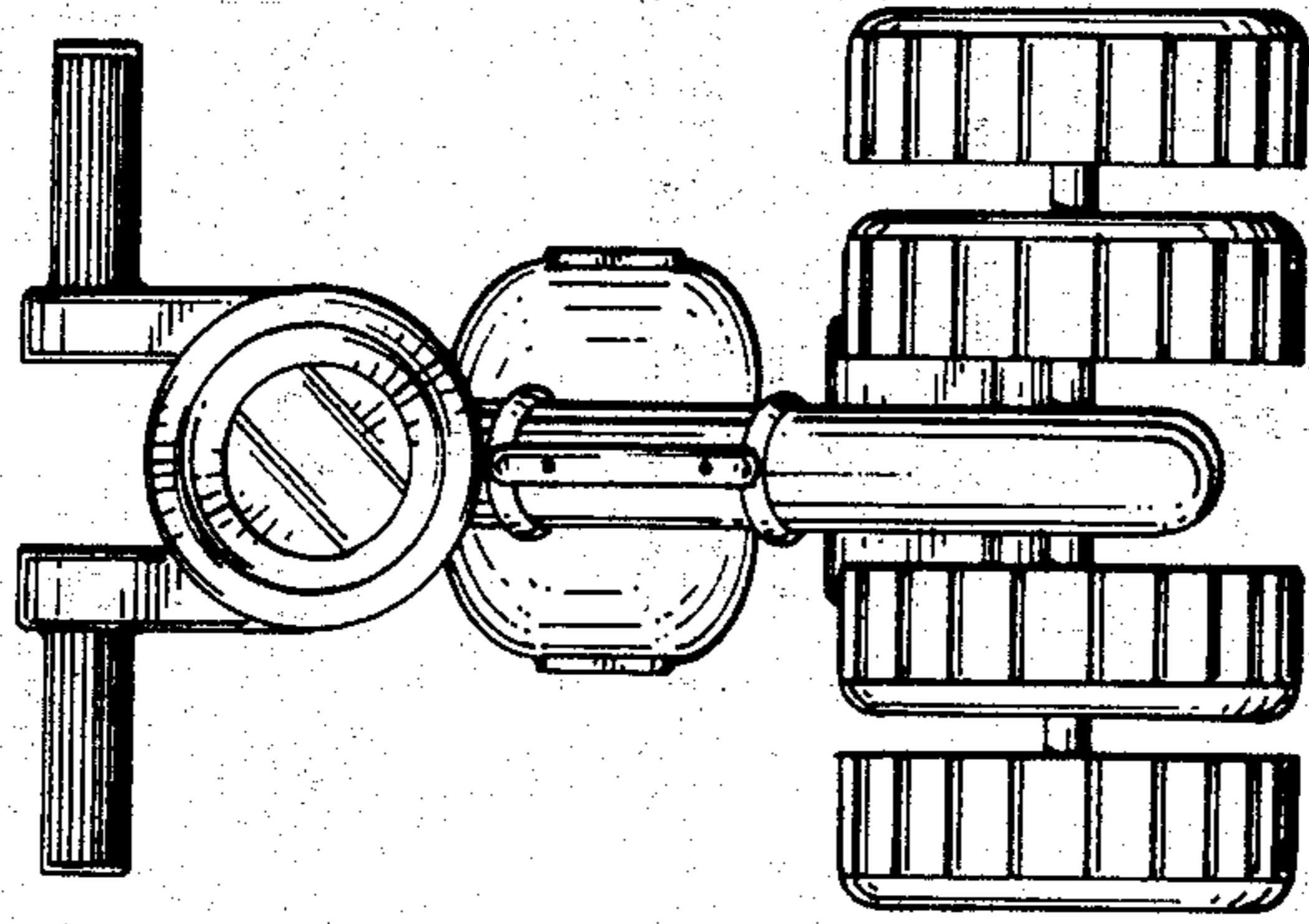

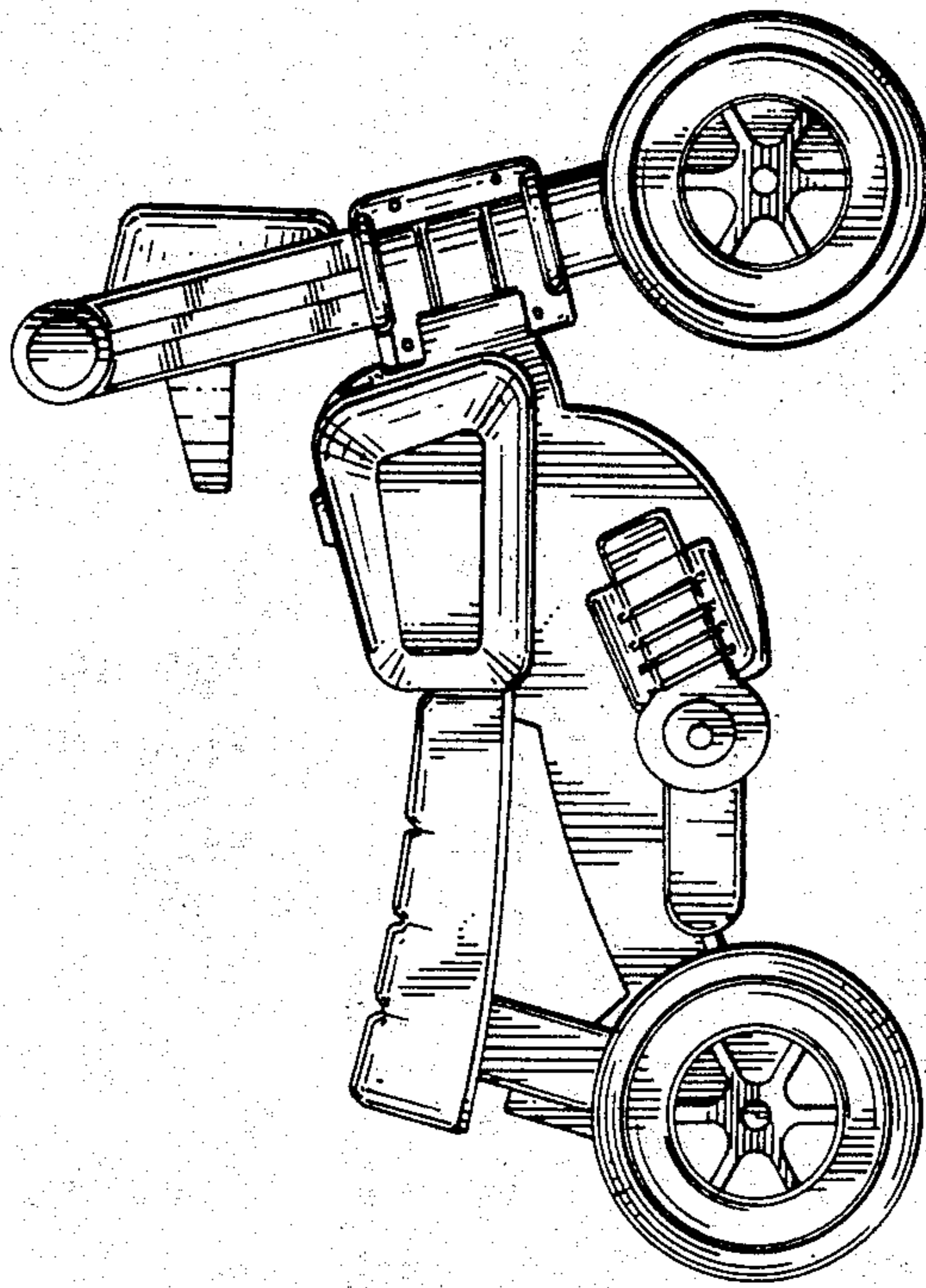

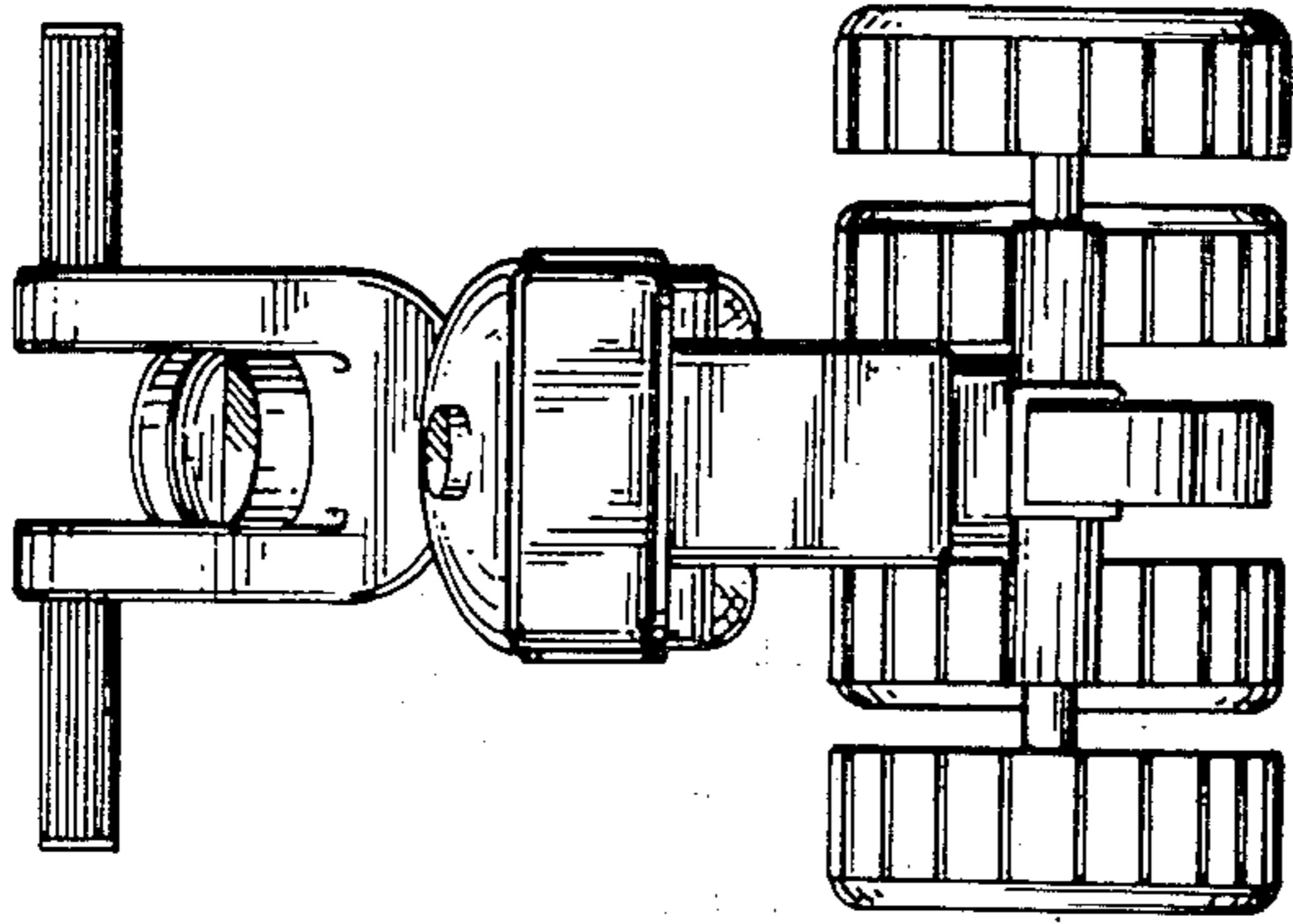

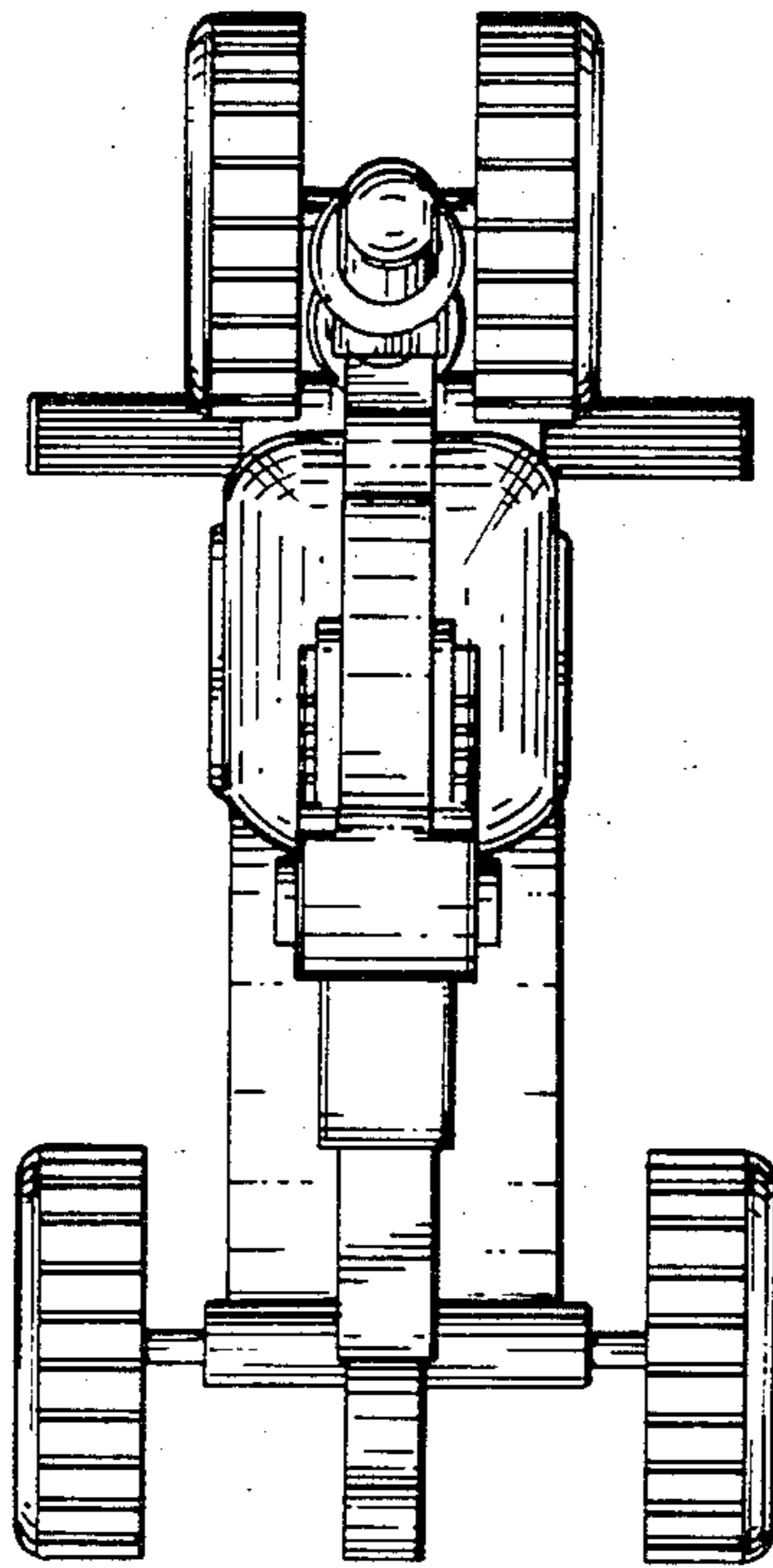
