[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a doll clown head and body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a doll clown head and body showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view.

The essential feature of my design resides in the facial representation shown.

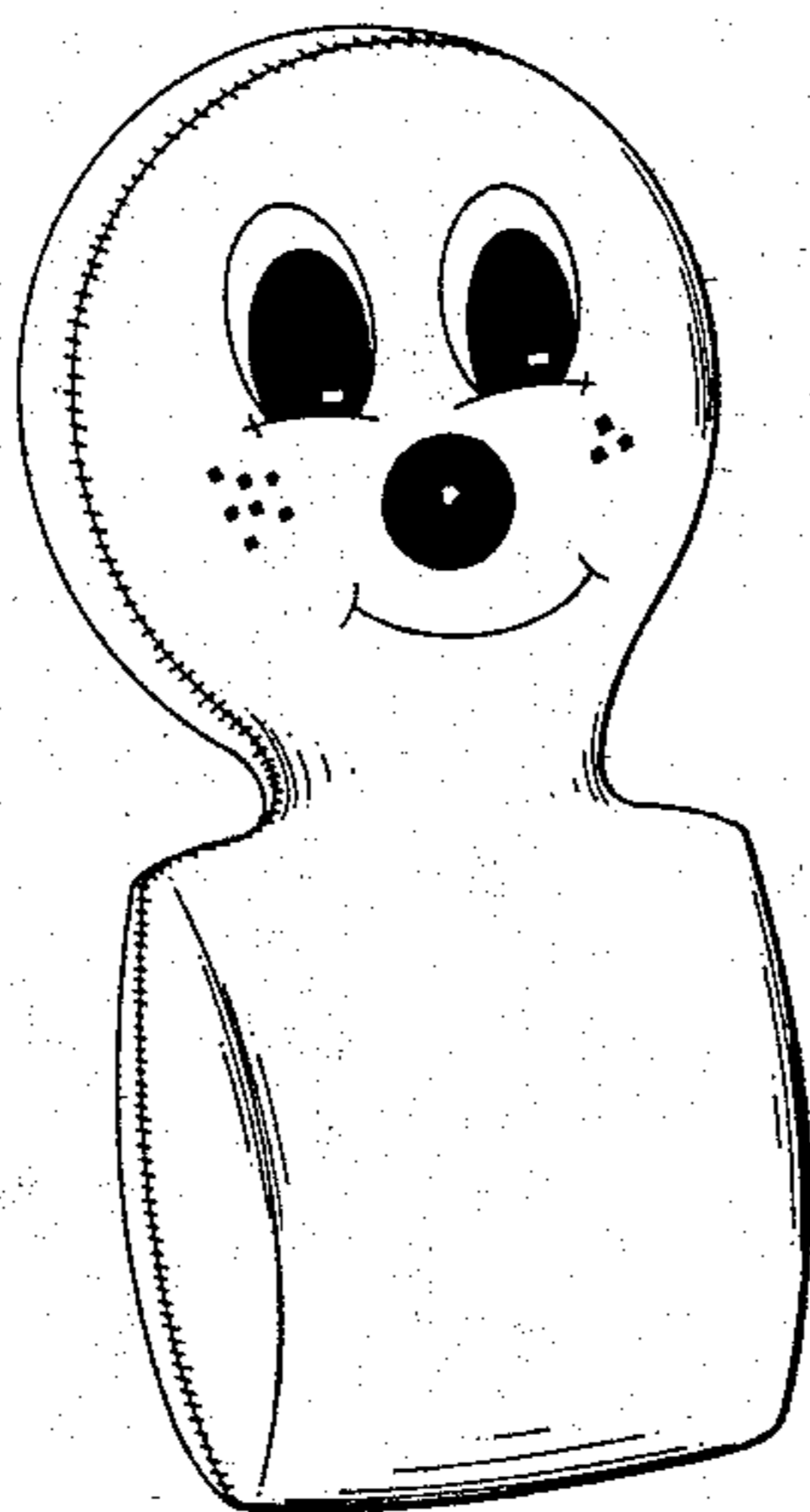

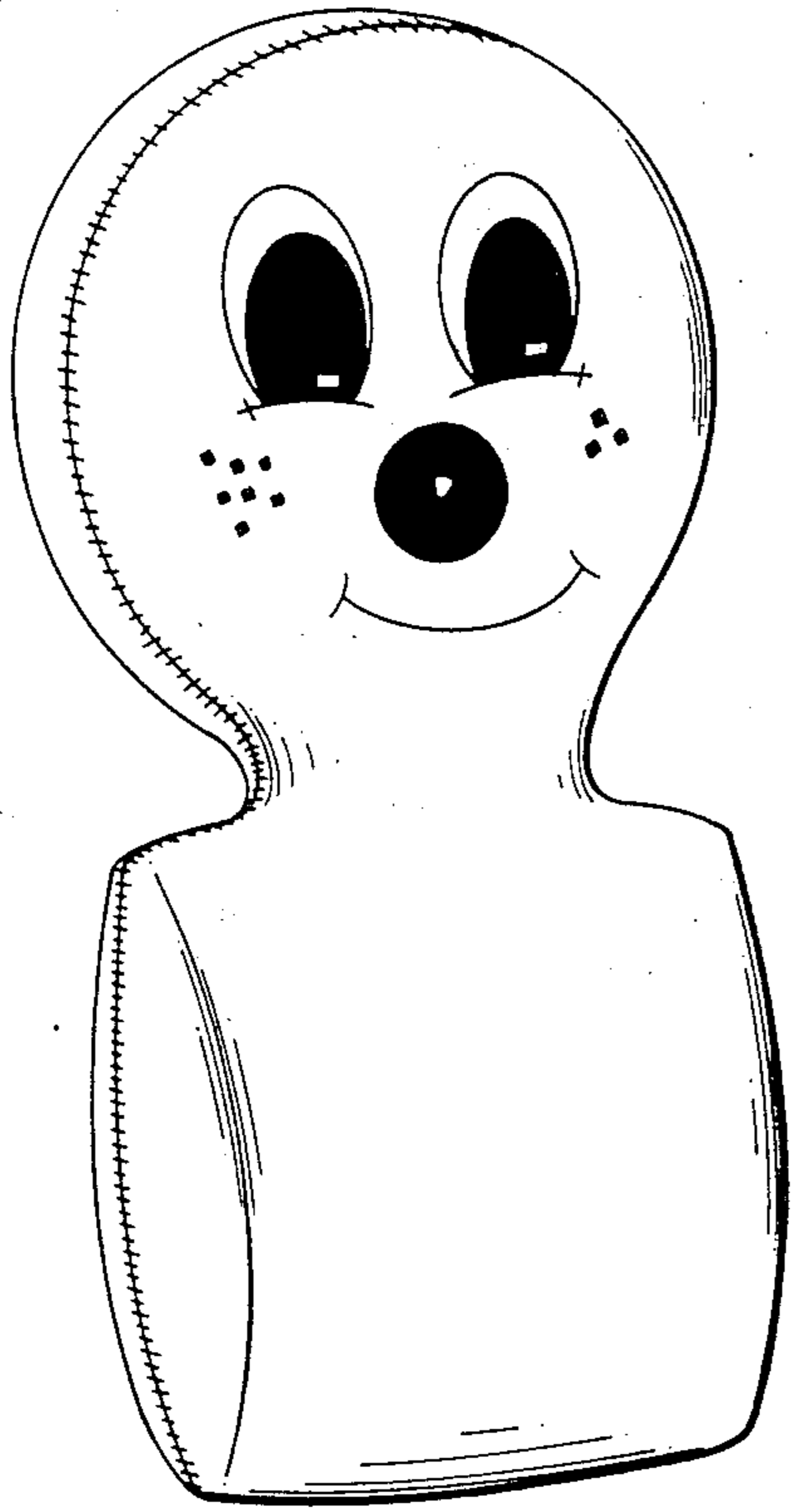

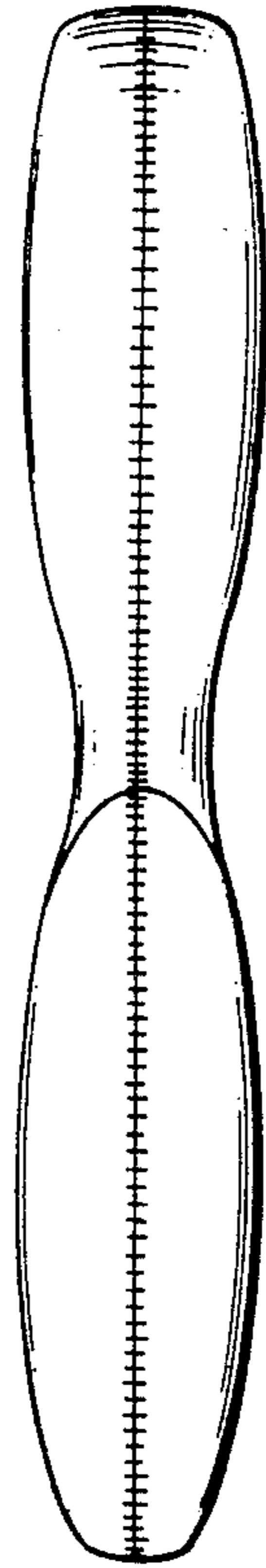
