DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mirror frame showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

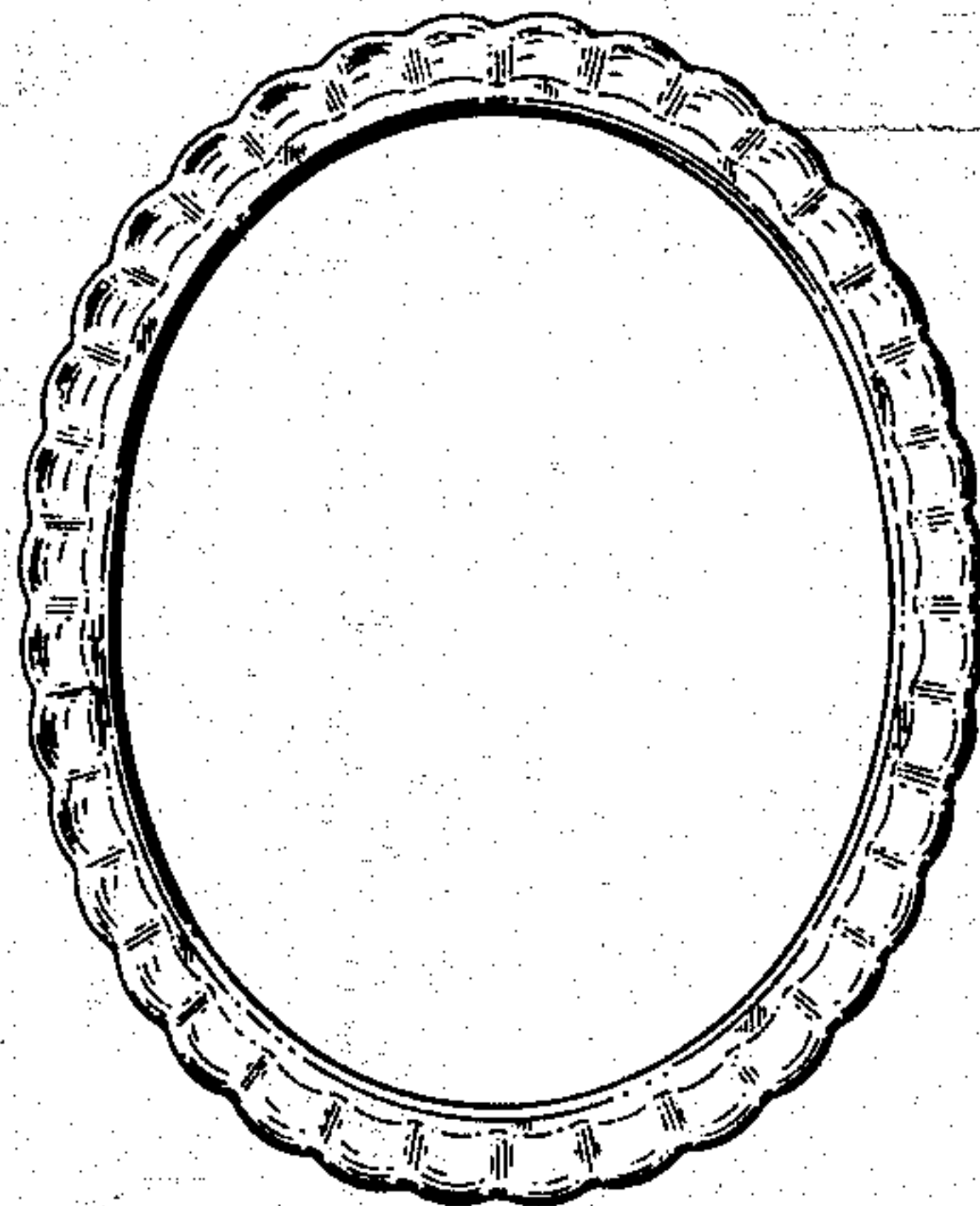

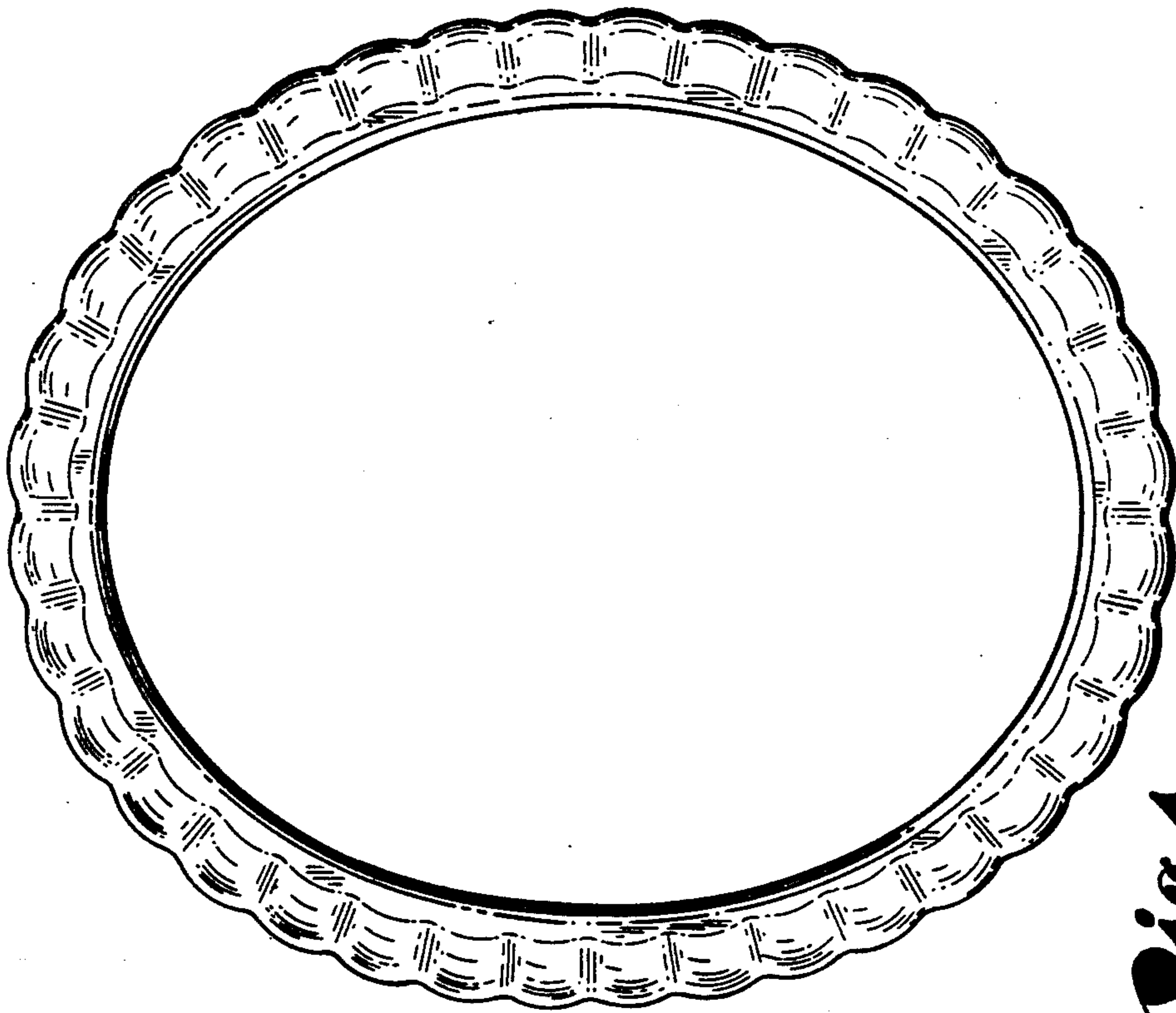

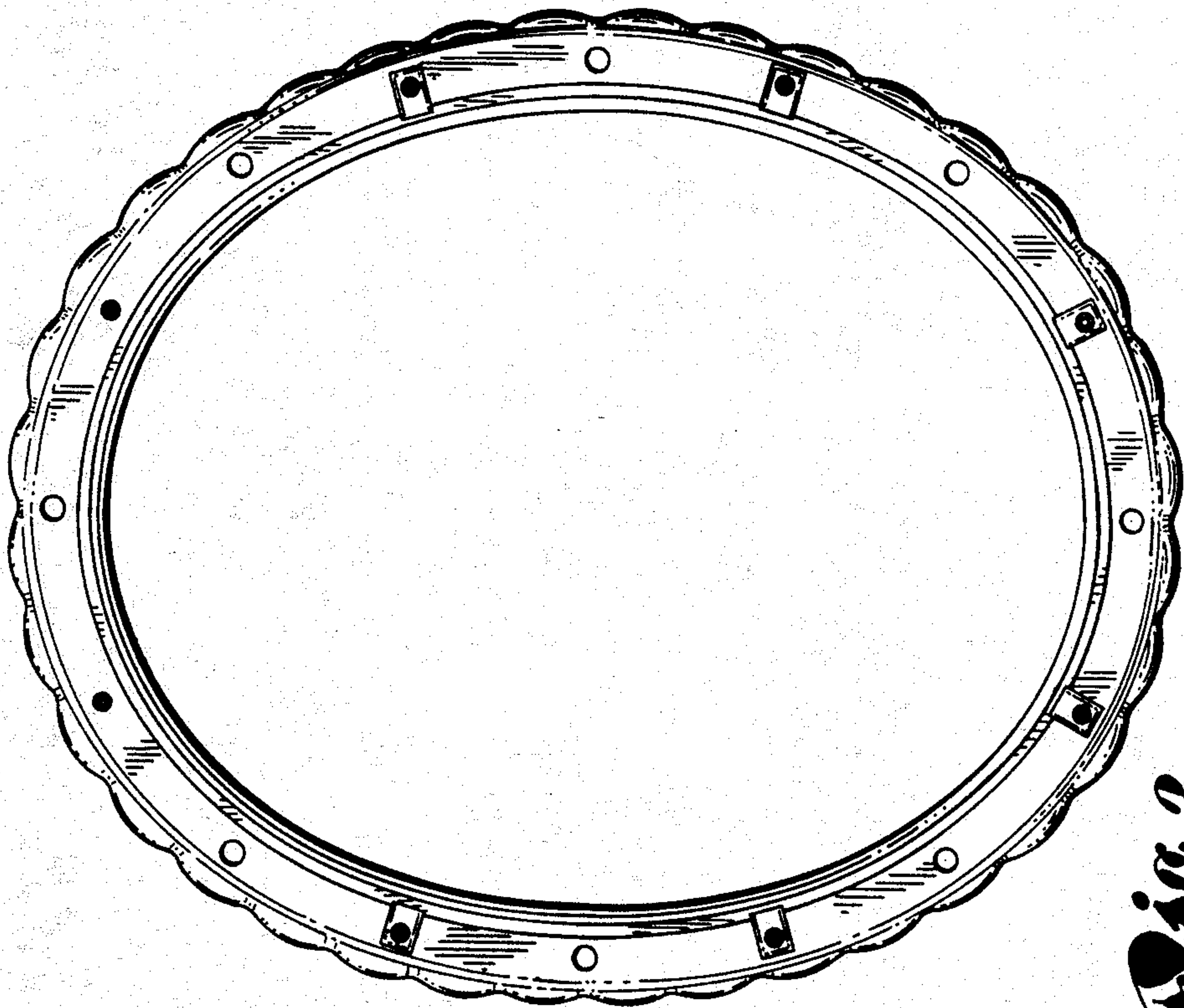
