The ornamental design for a lid for a container, substantially as shown and described.

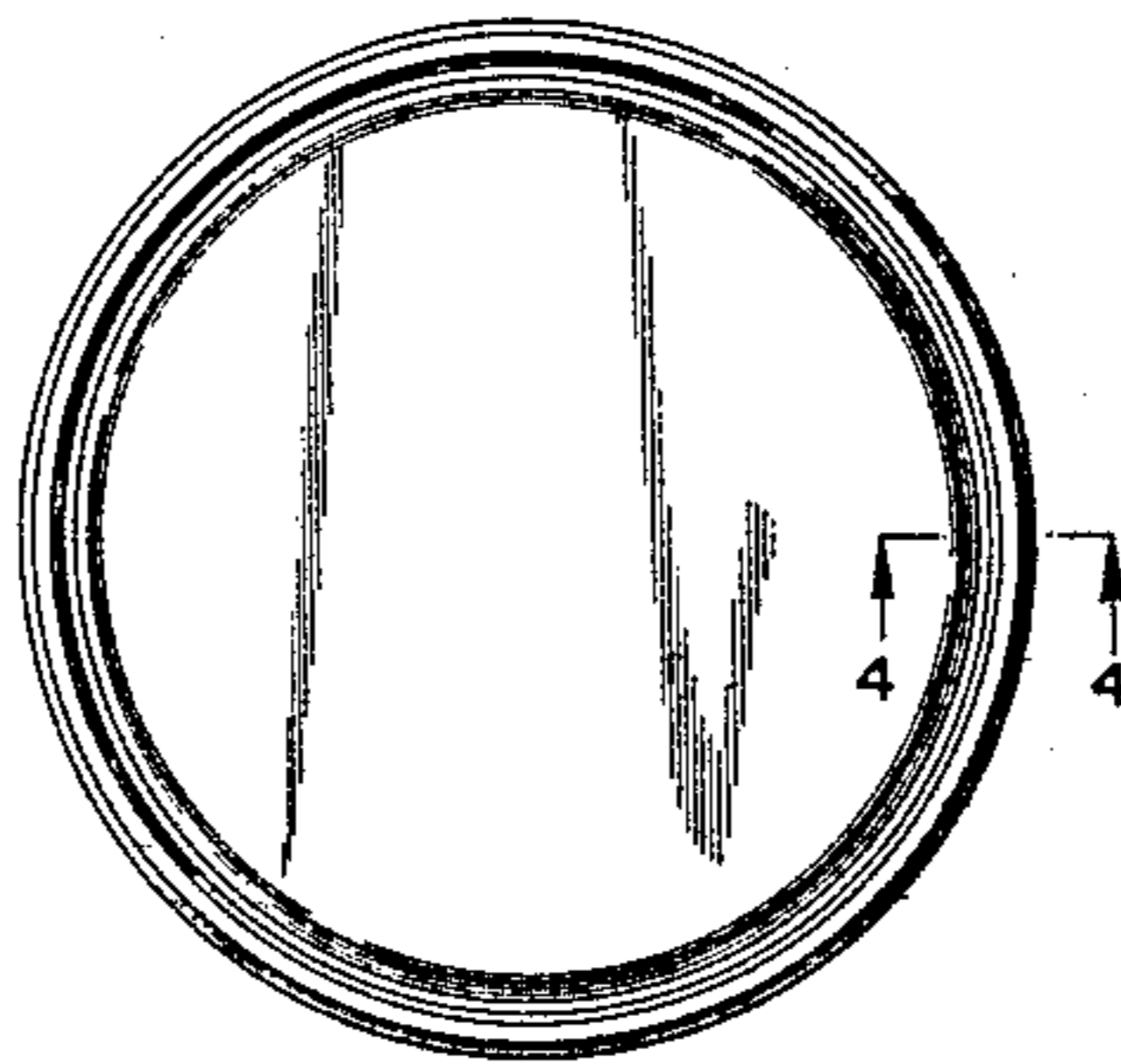
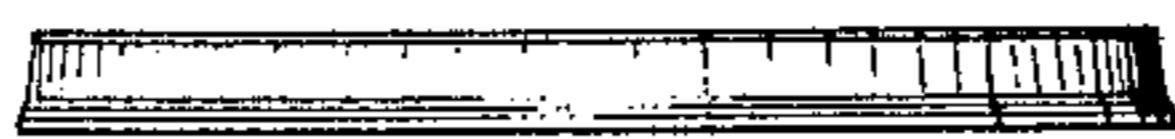
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a lid for a container showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2.



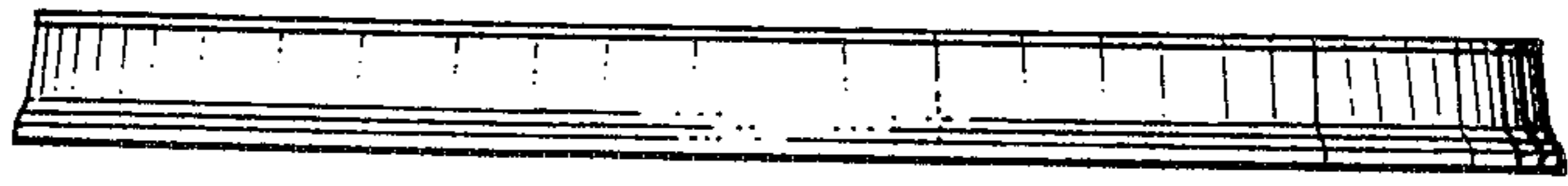

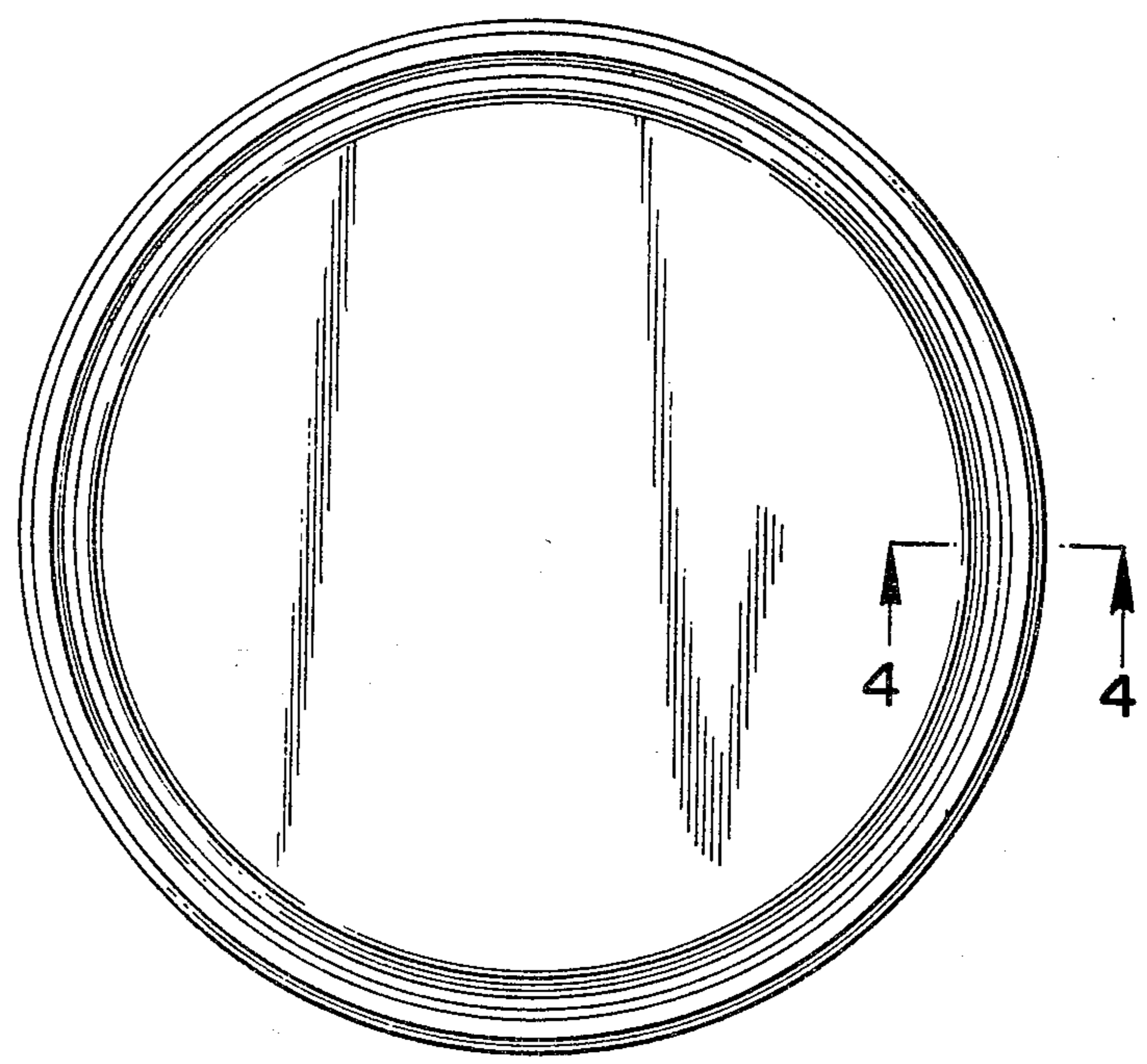

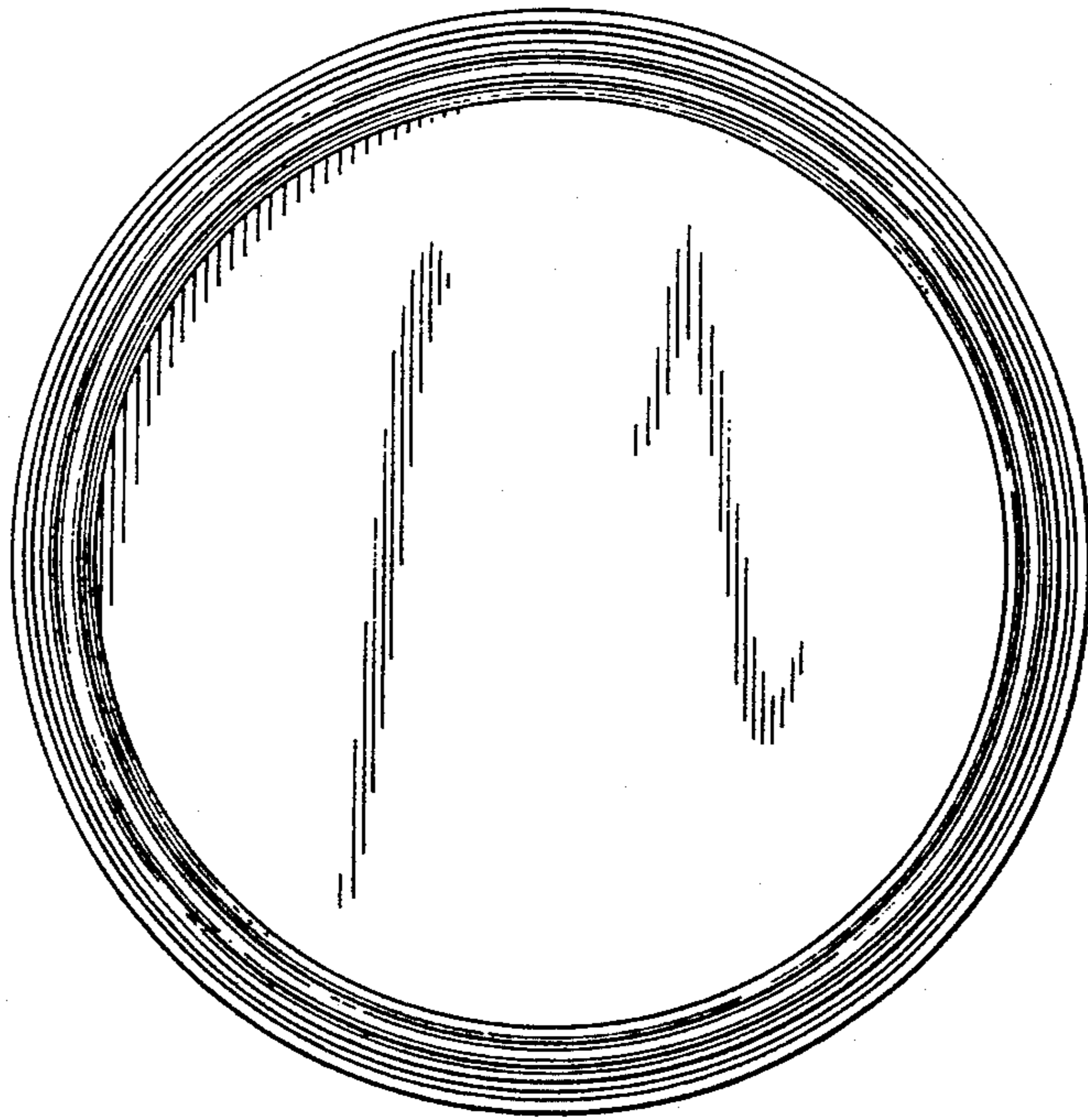

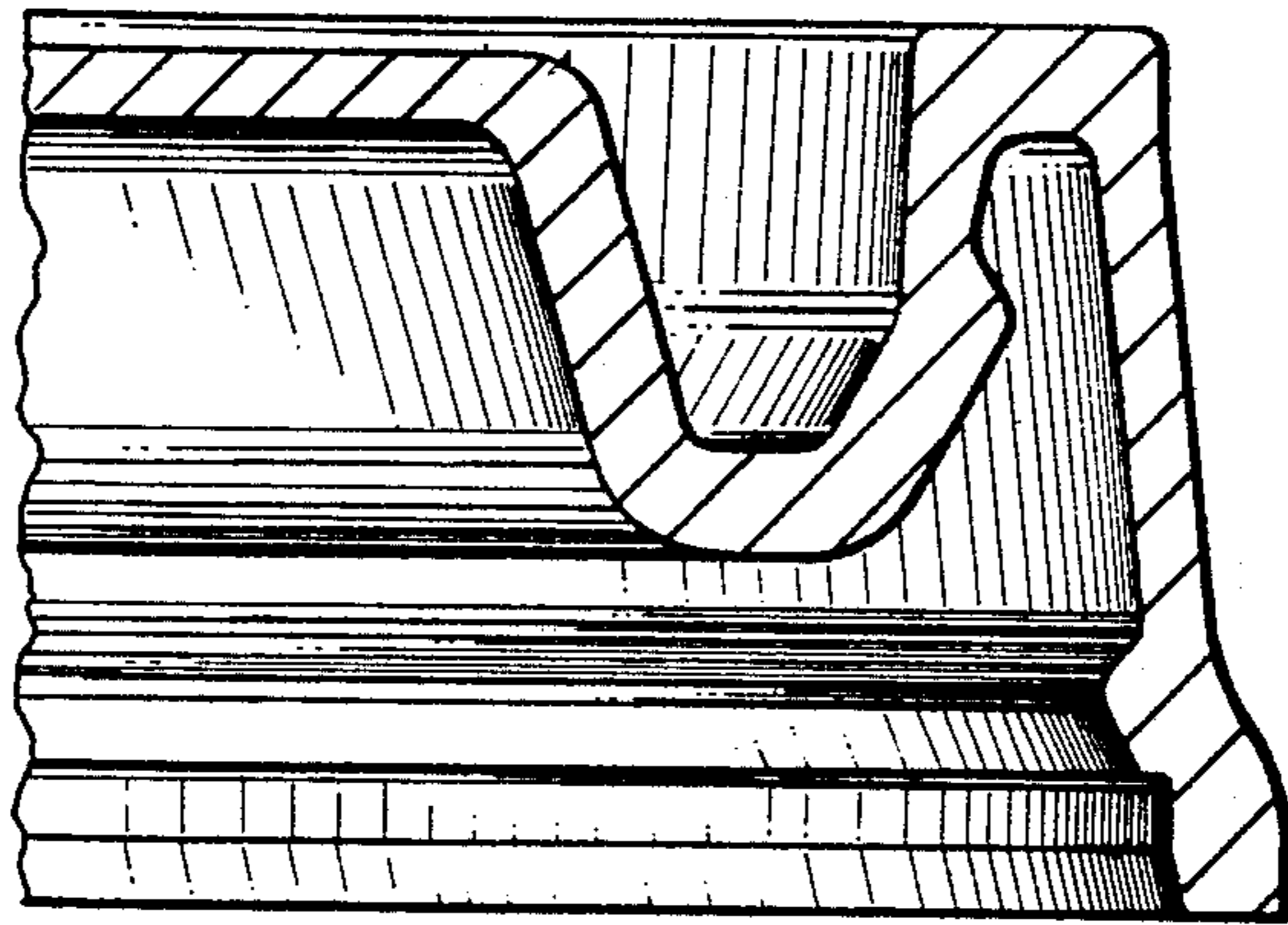
