DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an adjustable armchair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the adjustable armchair of FIG. 1;

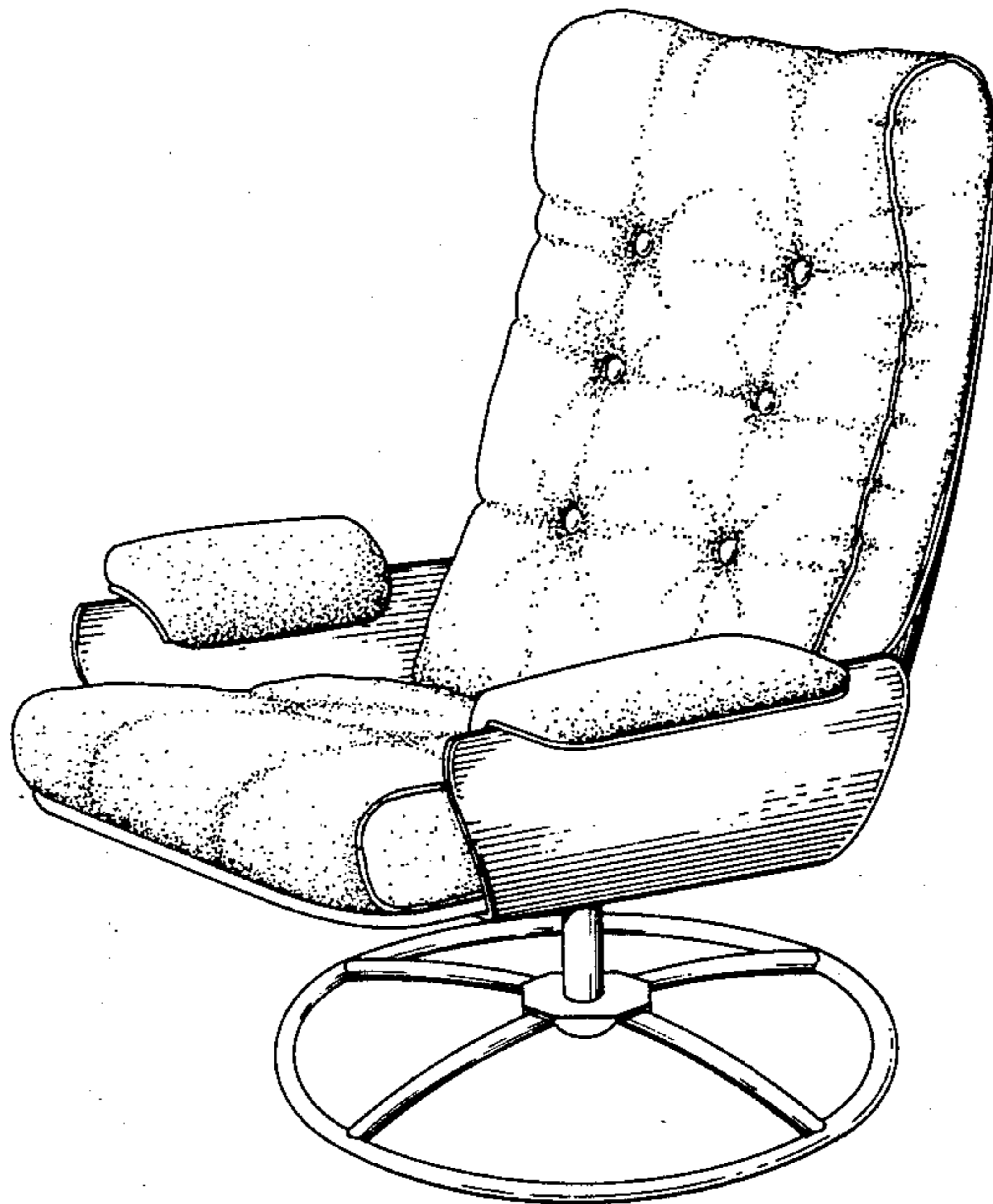

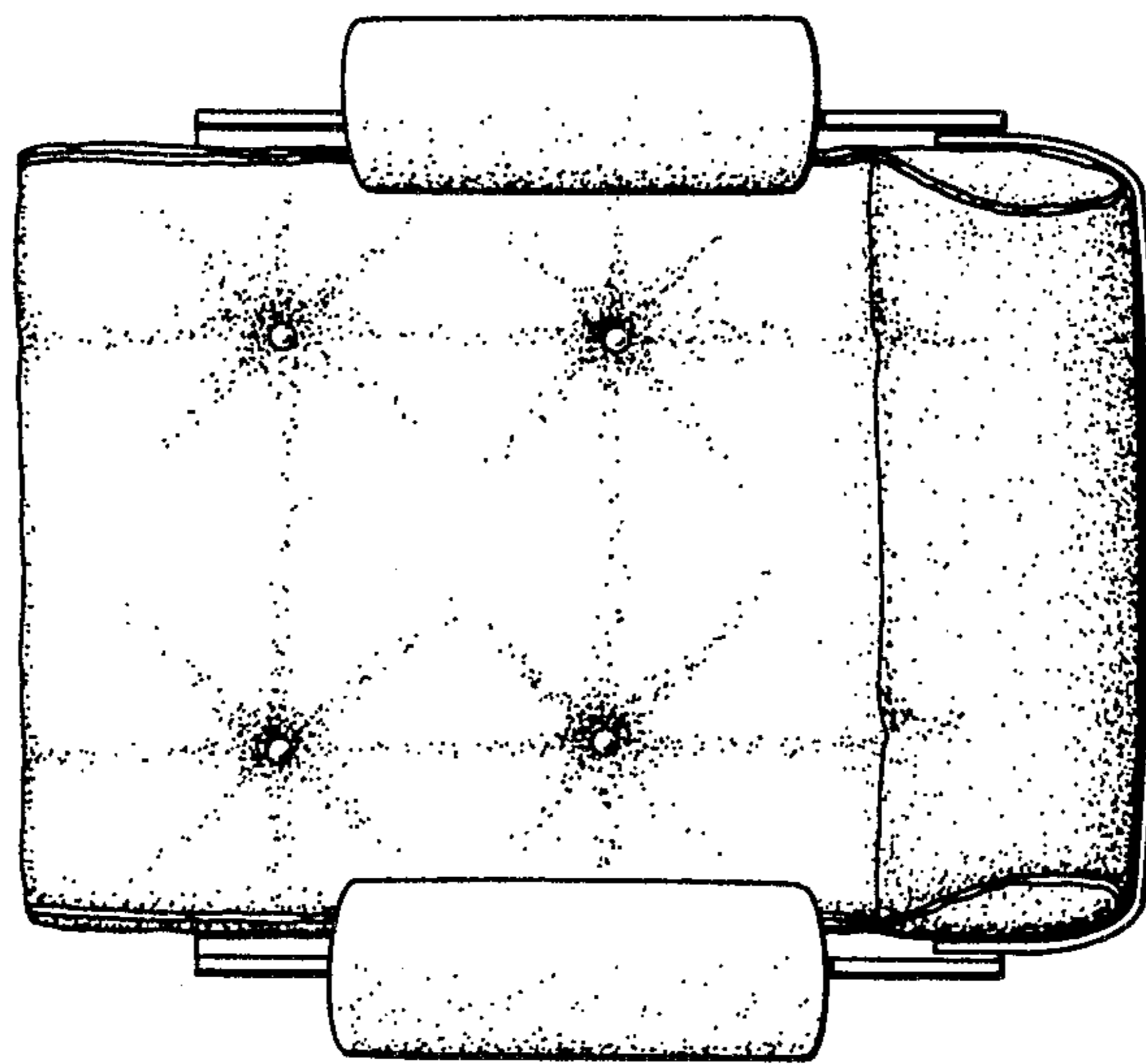

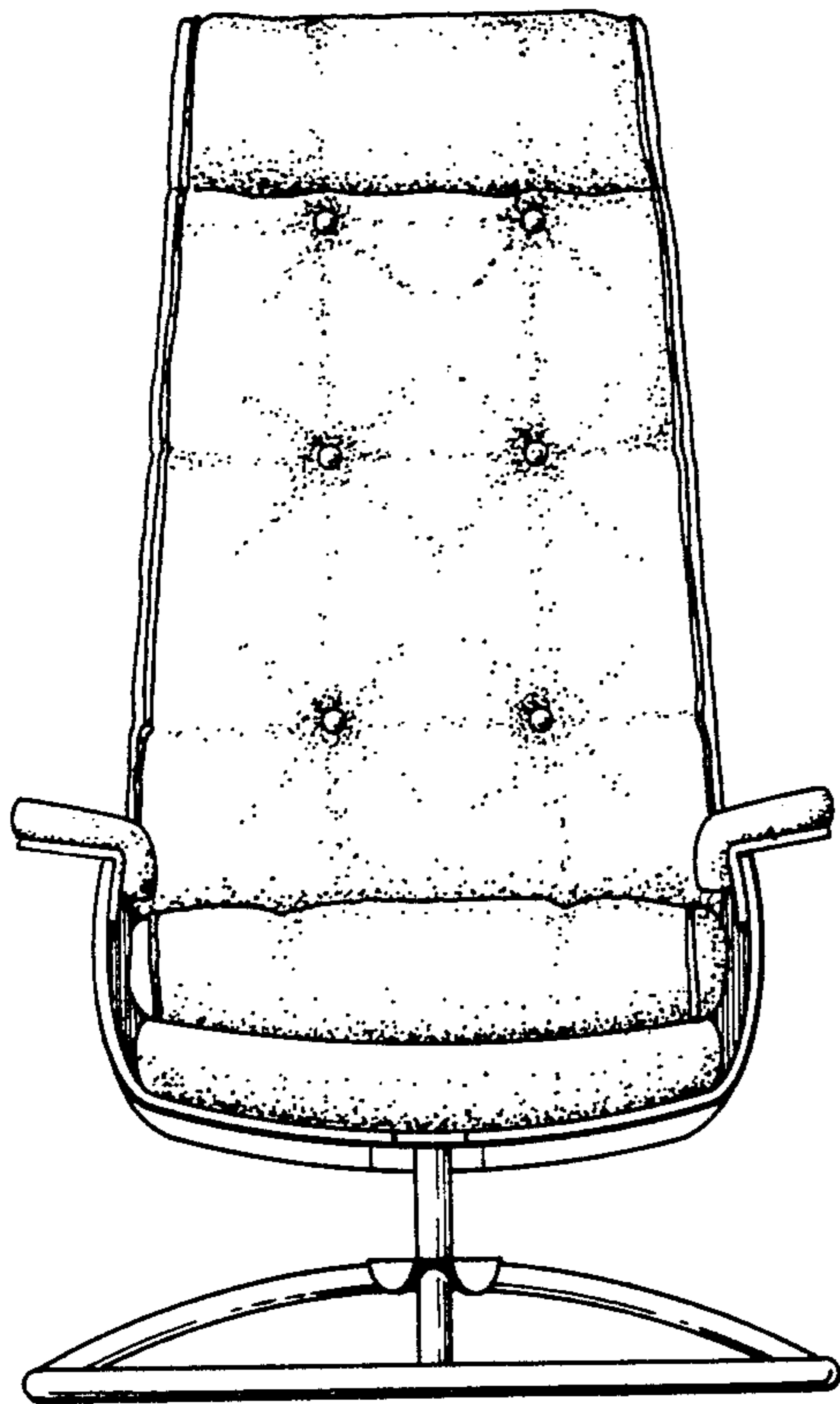
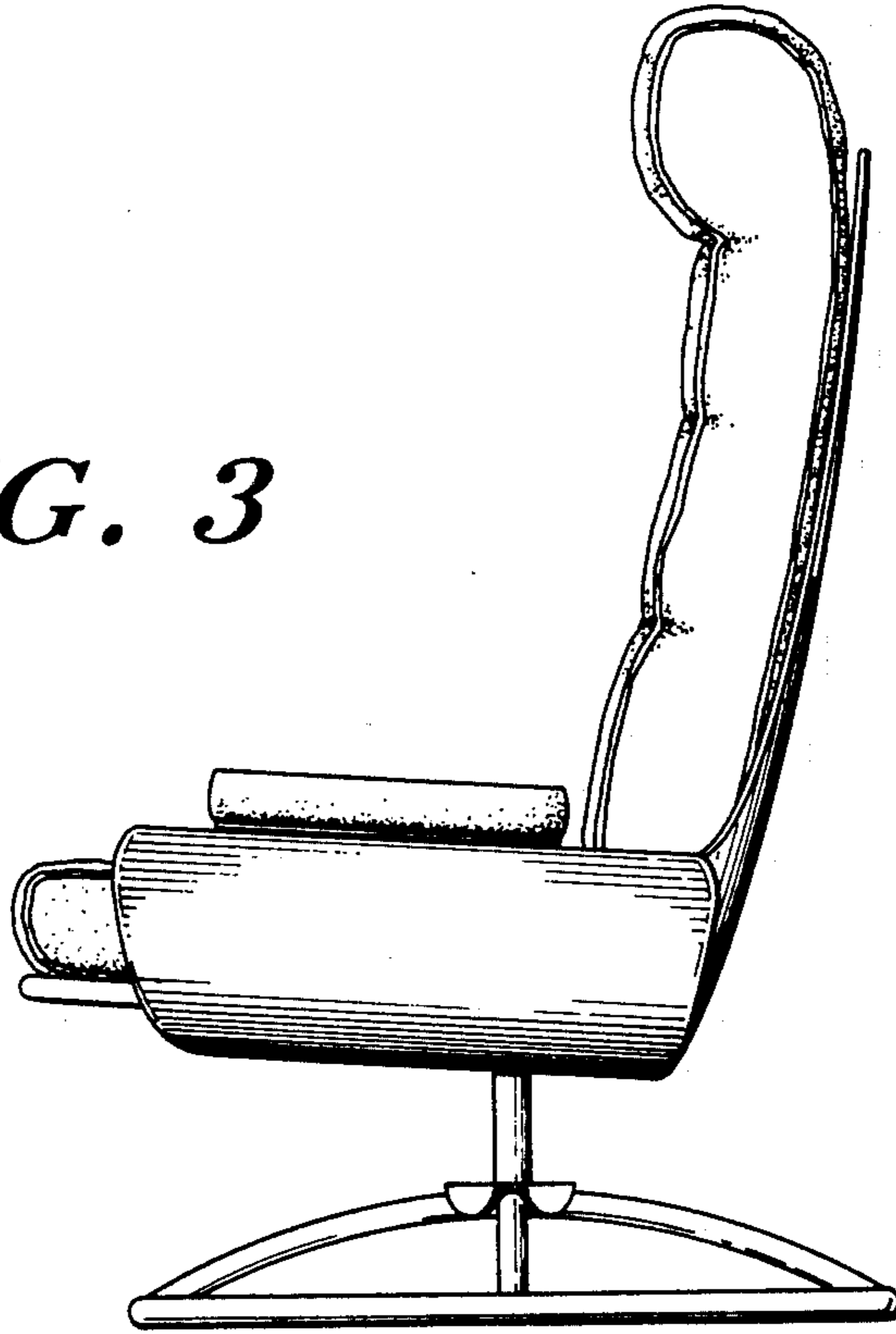

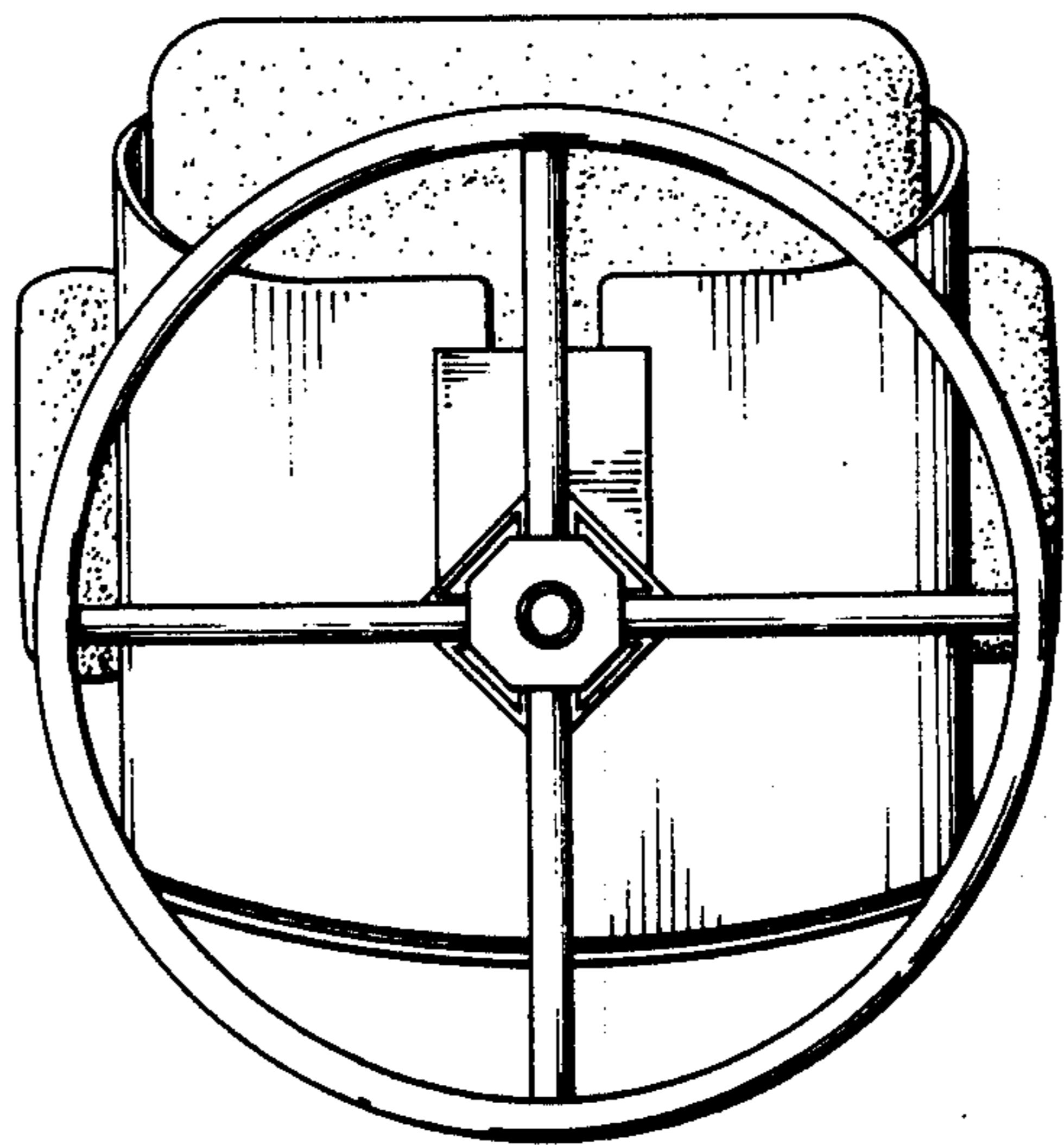
