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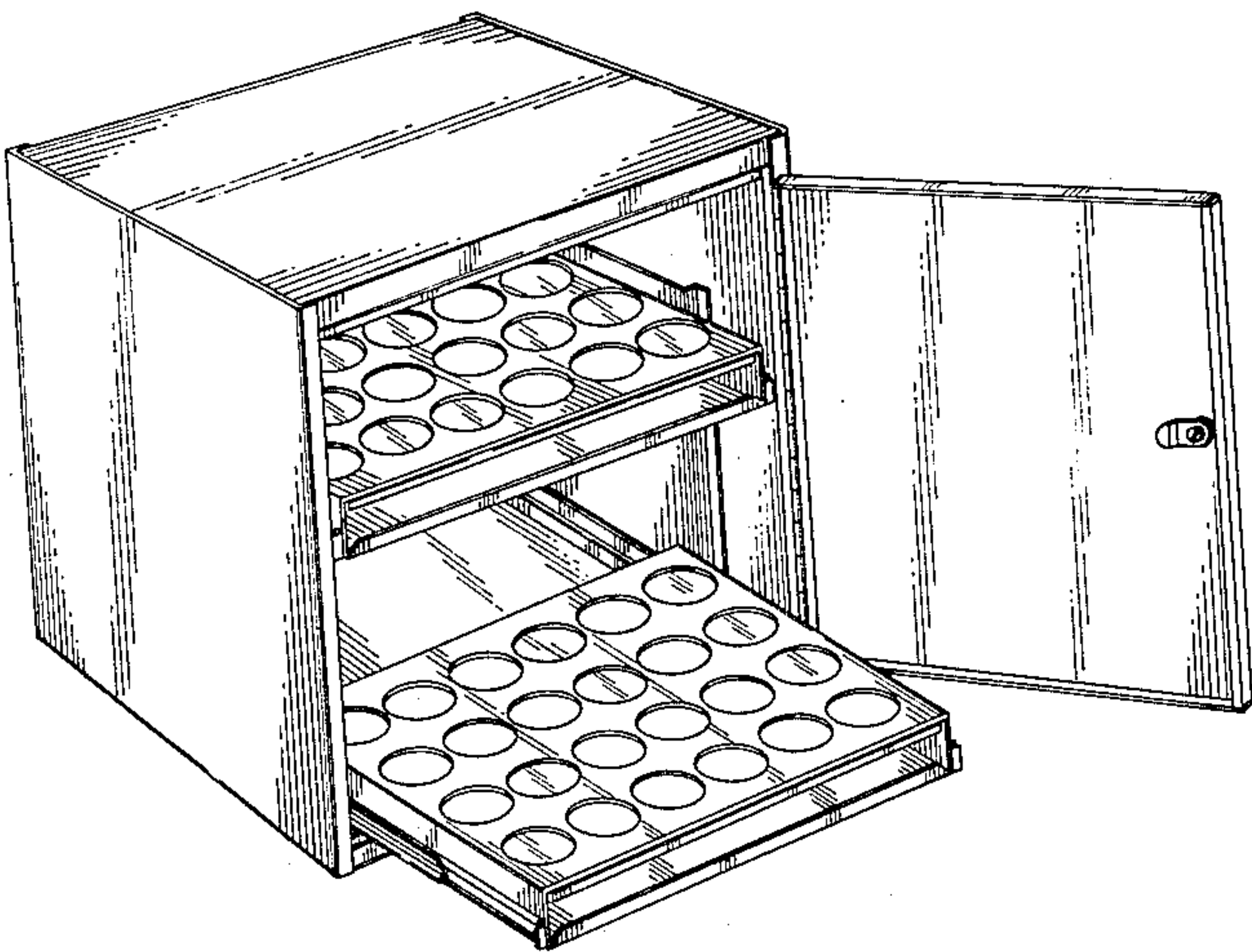
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an aerosol can display cabinet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an aerosol can display cabinet showing my new design; the lower drawer in extended position;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view with the door in closed position;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a plan view, the bottom being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 6 is an enlarged front elevational view with the door in open position.



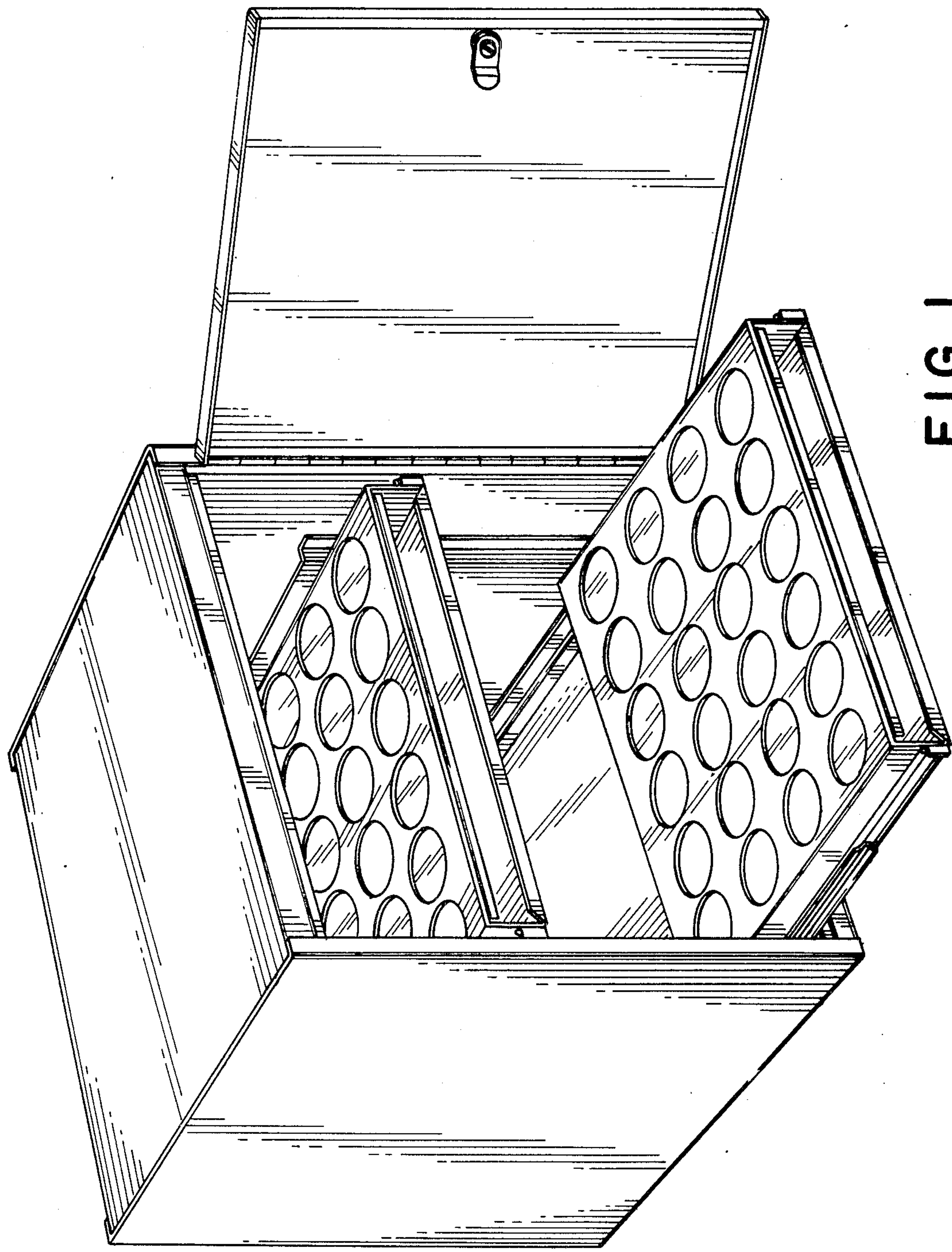

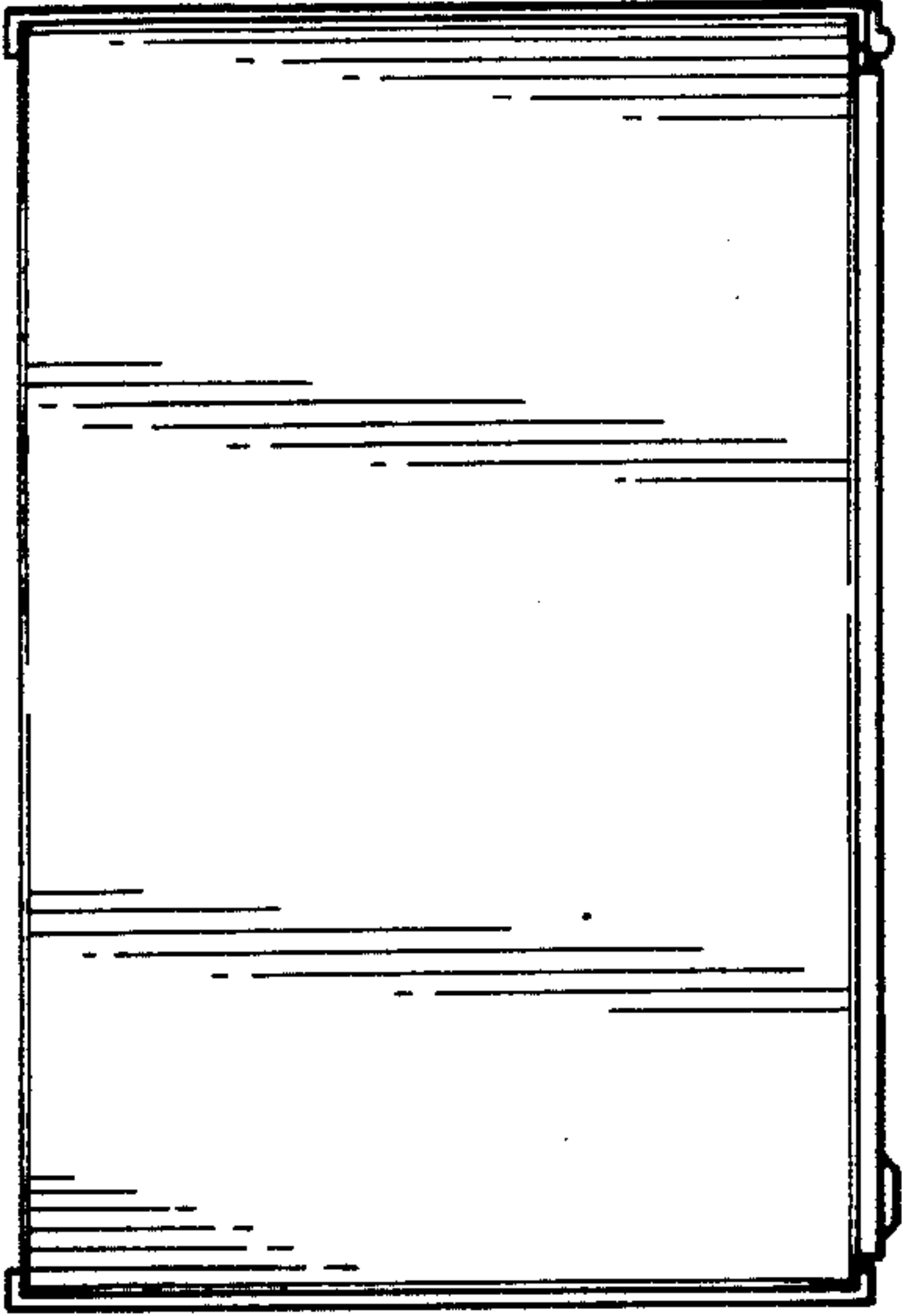

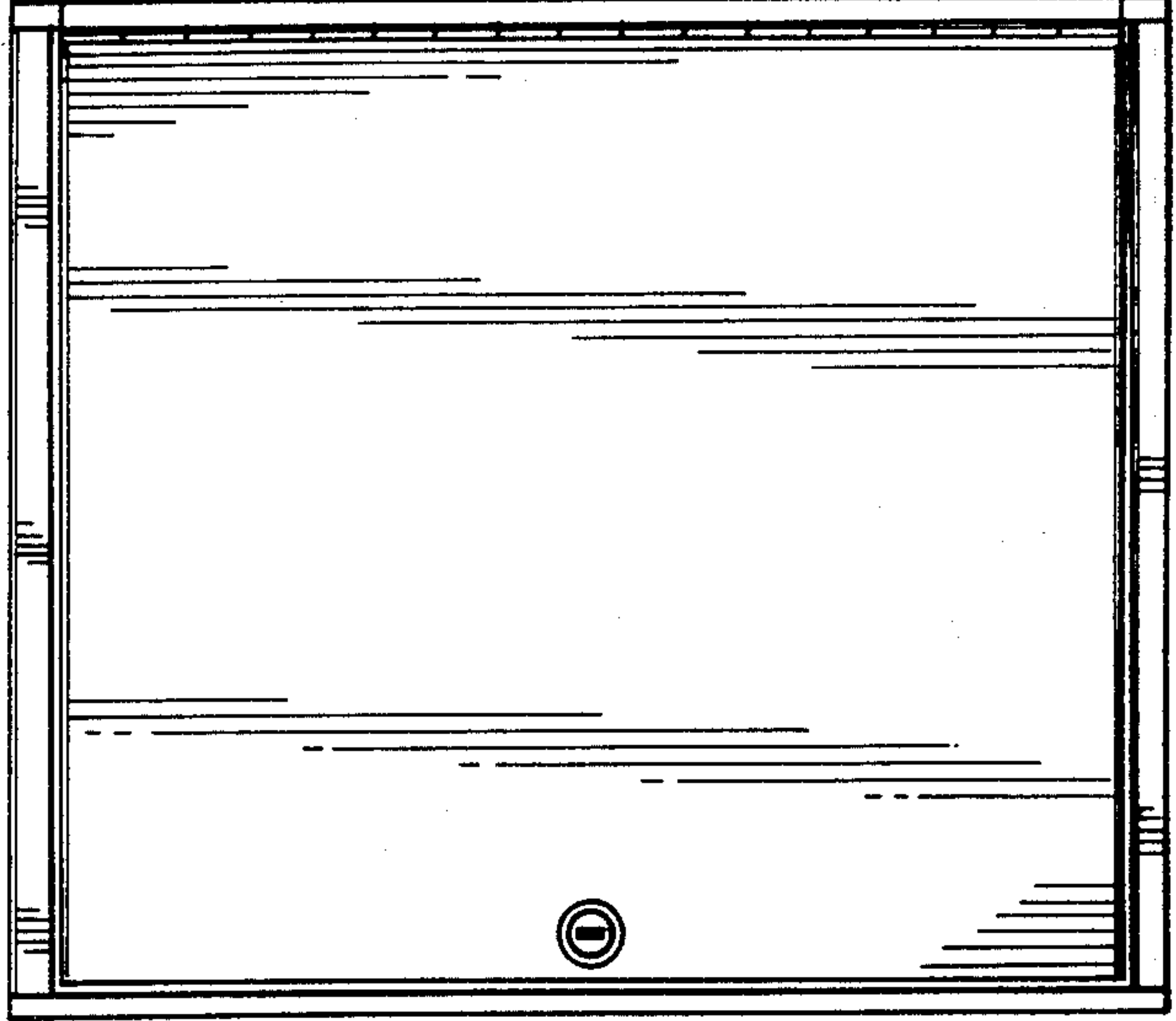

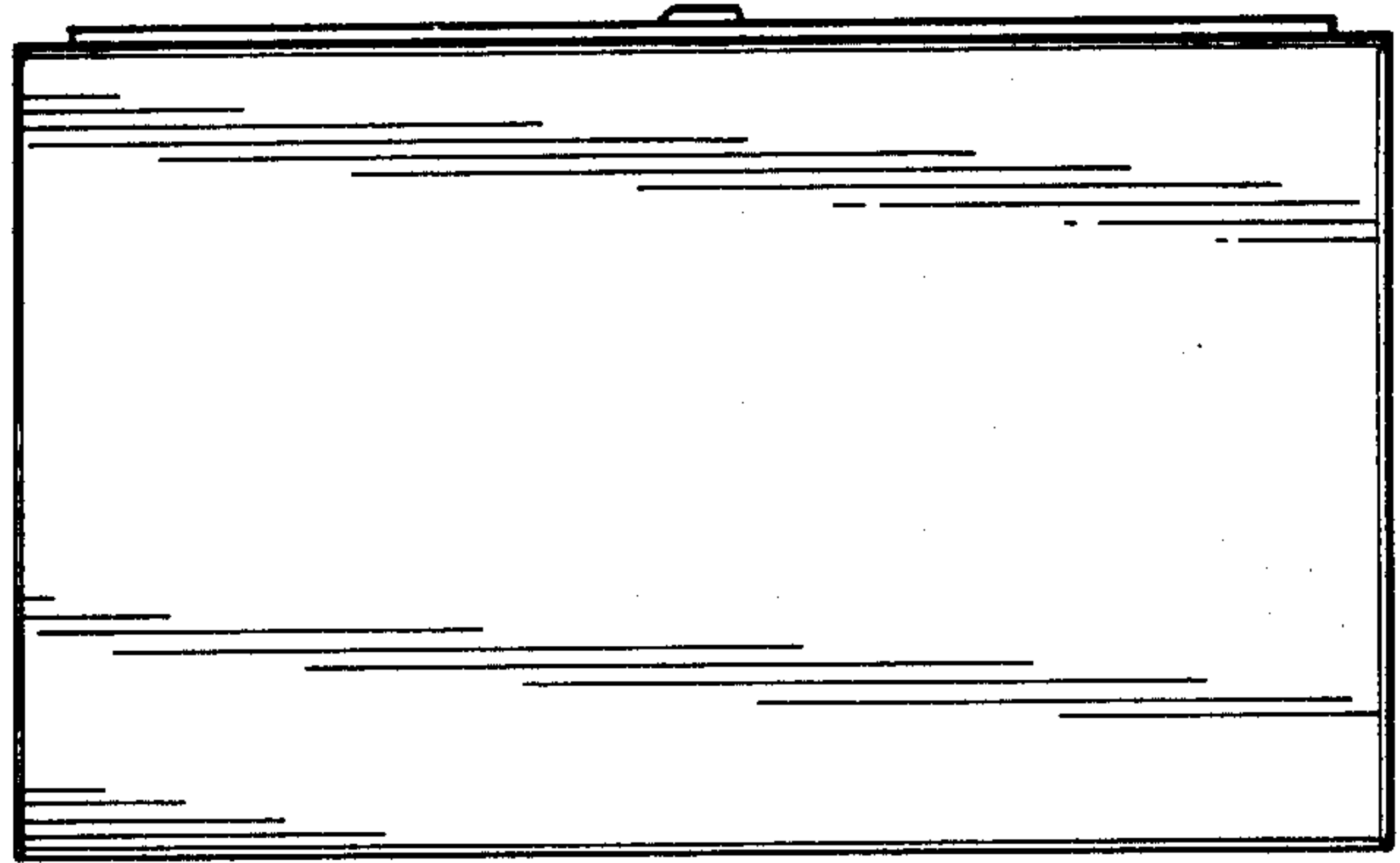

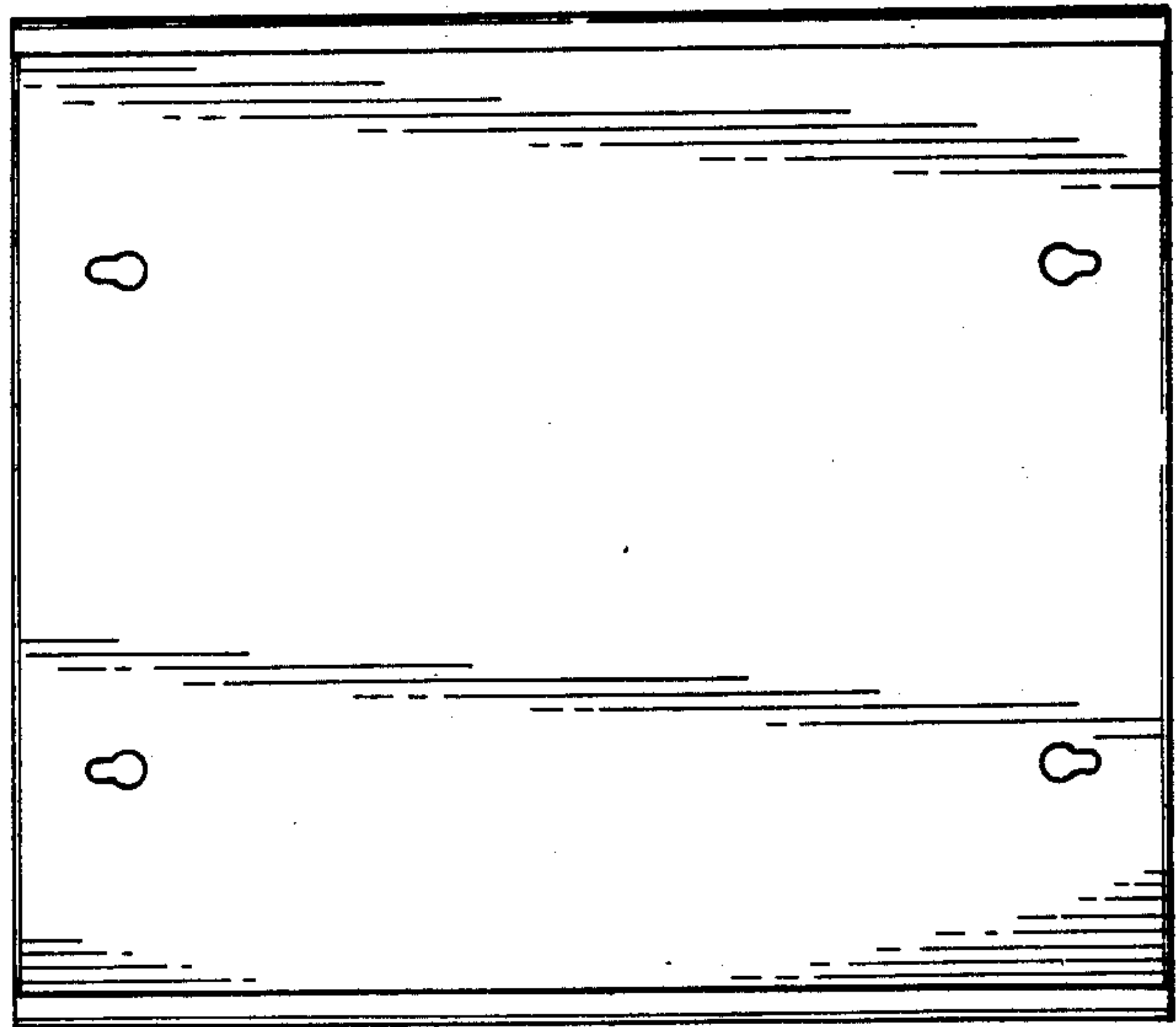

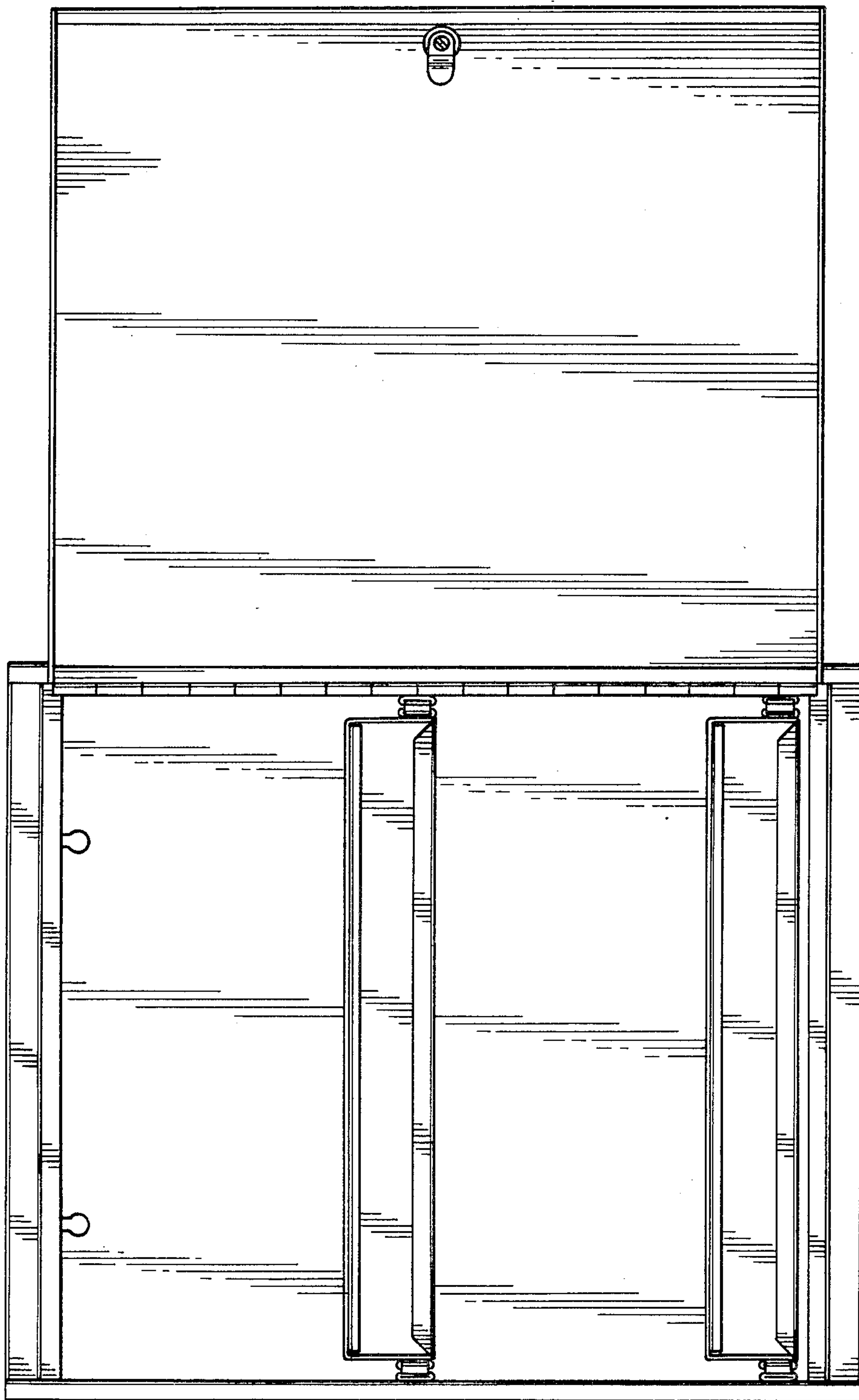
