The ornamental design for a T-SHIRT, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a T-SHIRT showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a sixth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a seventh embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of an eighth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a ninth embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the measuring tape logo across the chest of the T-SHIRT.
