[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined thermal hood and face mask for scuba divers, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined thermal hood and face mask for a scuba diver, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 4; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 4.
