The ornamental design for combined children's bed, storage unit and amusement center, as shown and described.

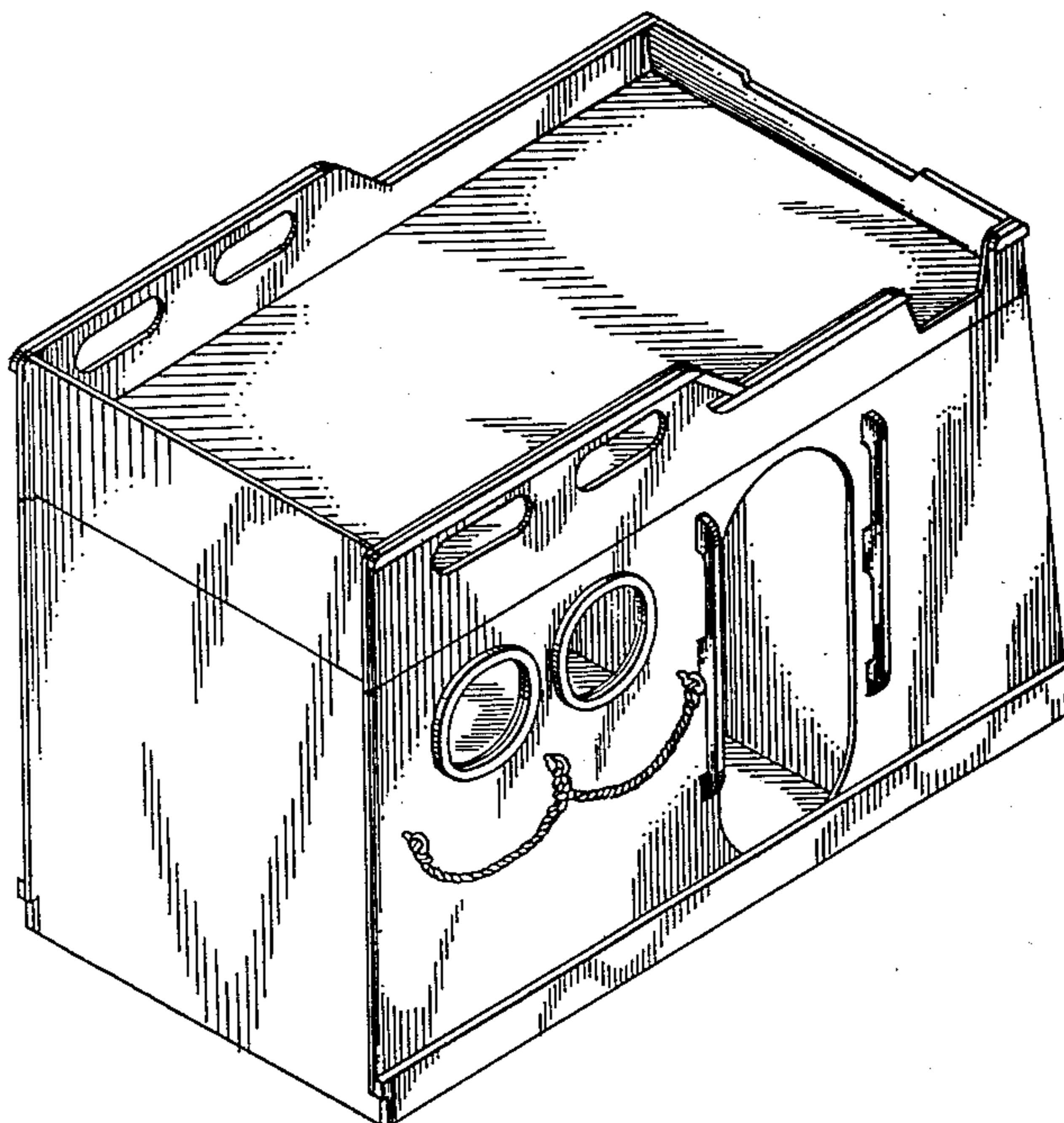
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a combined children's bed, storage unit and amusement center, showing my new design, there being seen through a doorway a full height and full width interior partition;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.



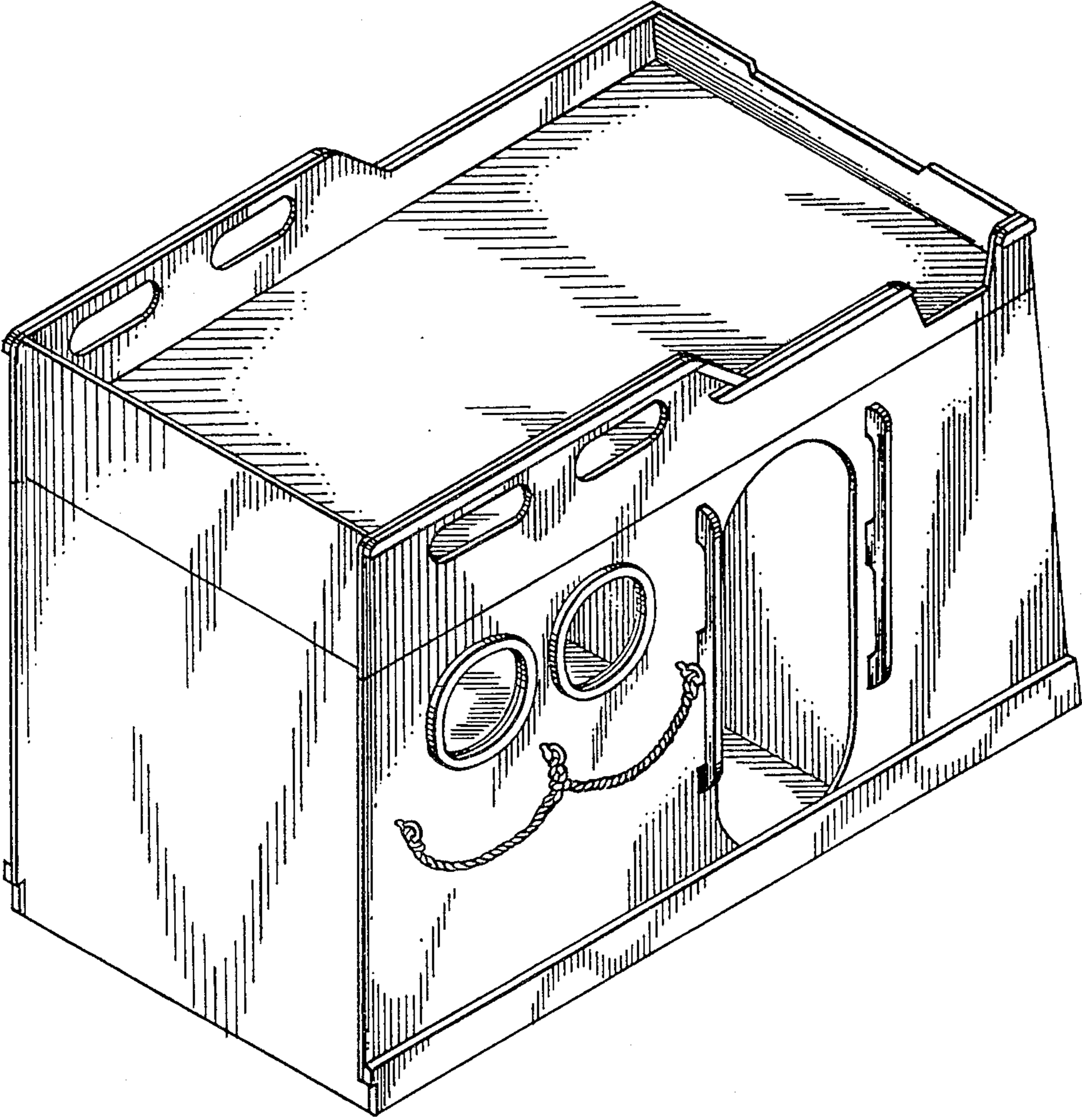

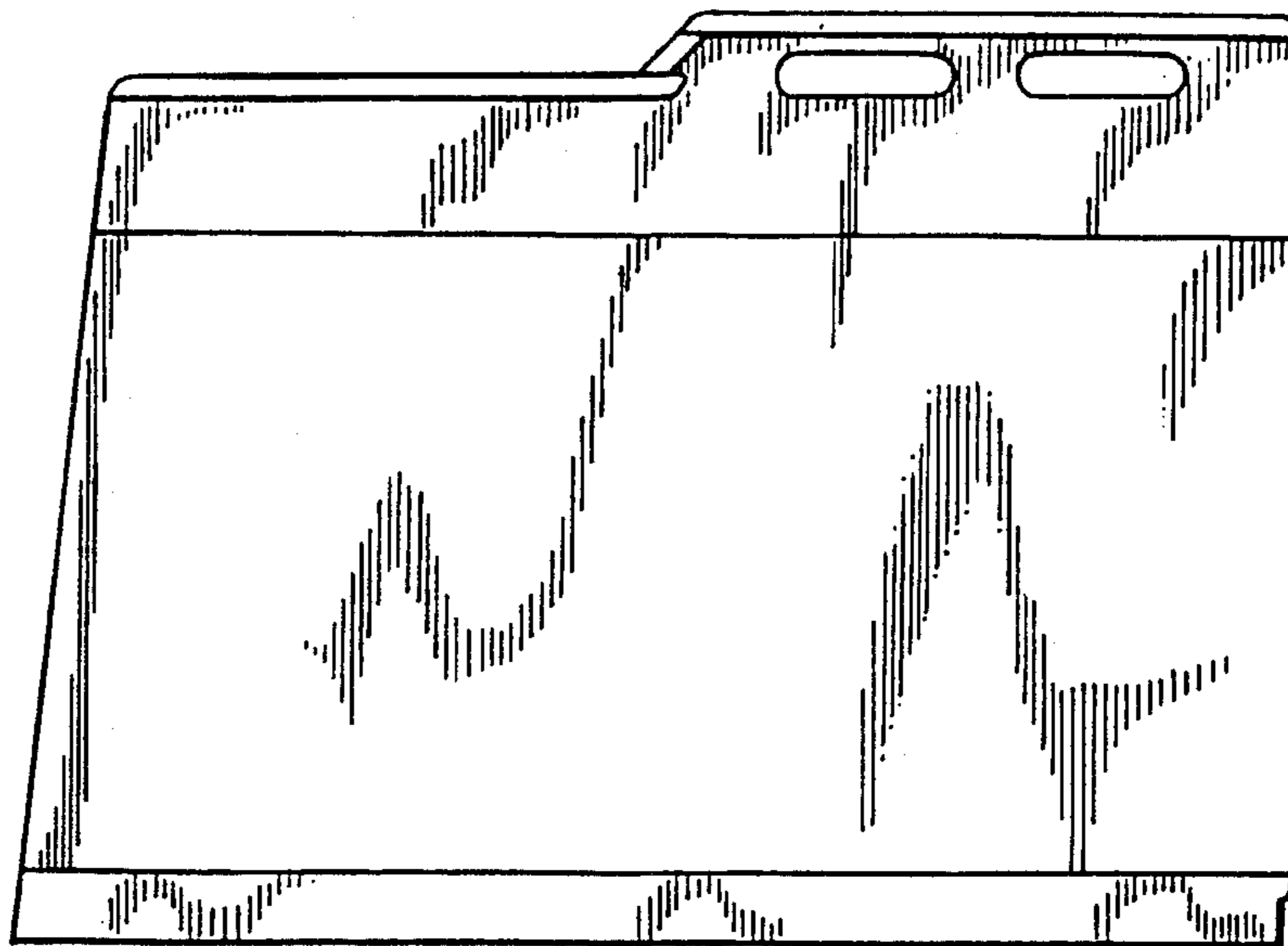

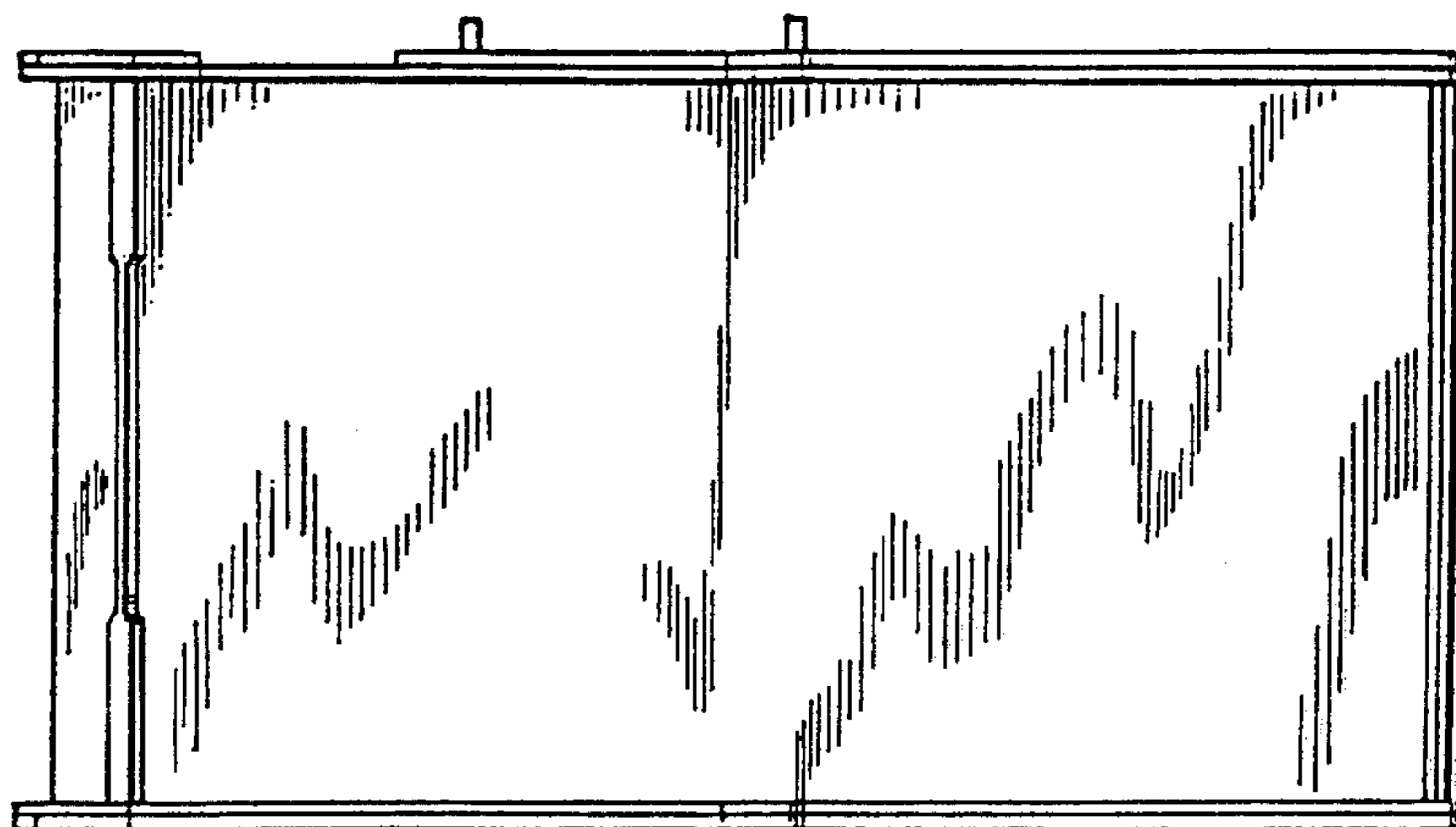
