FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

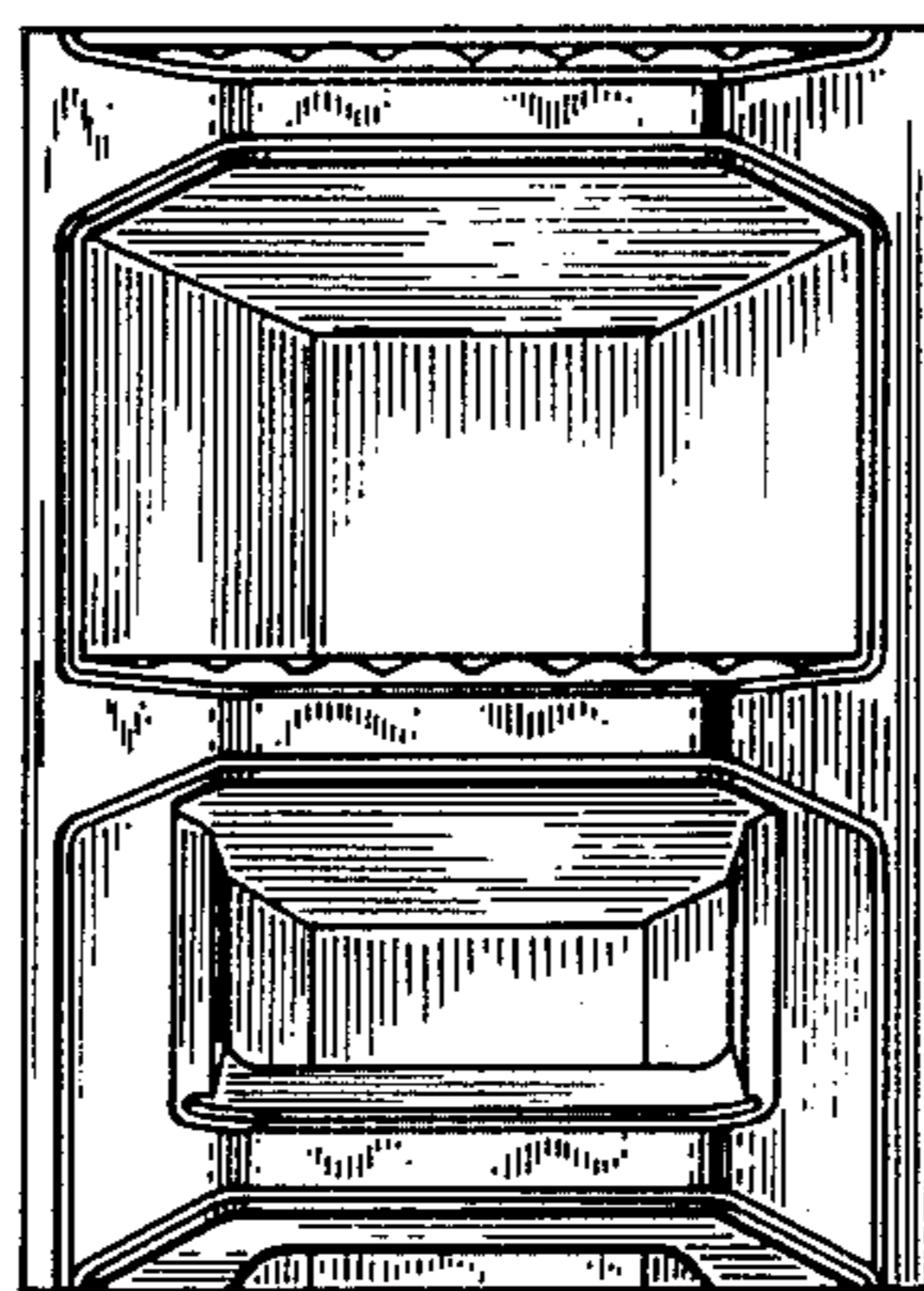
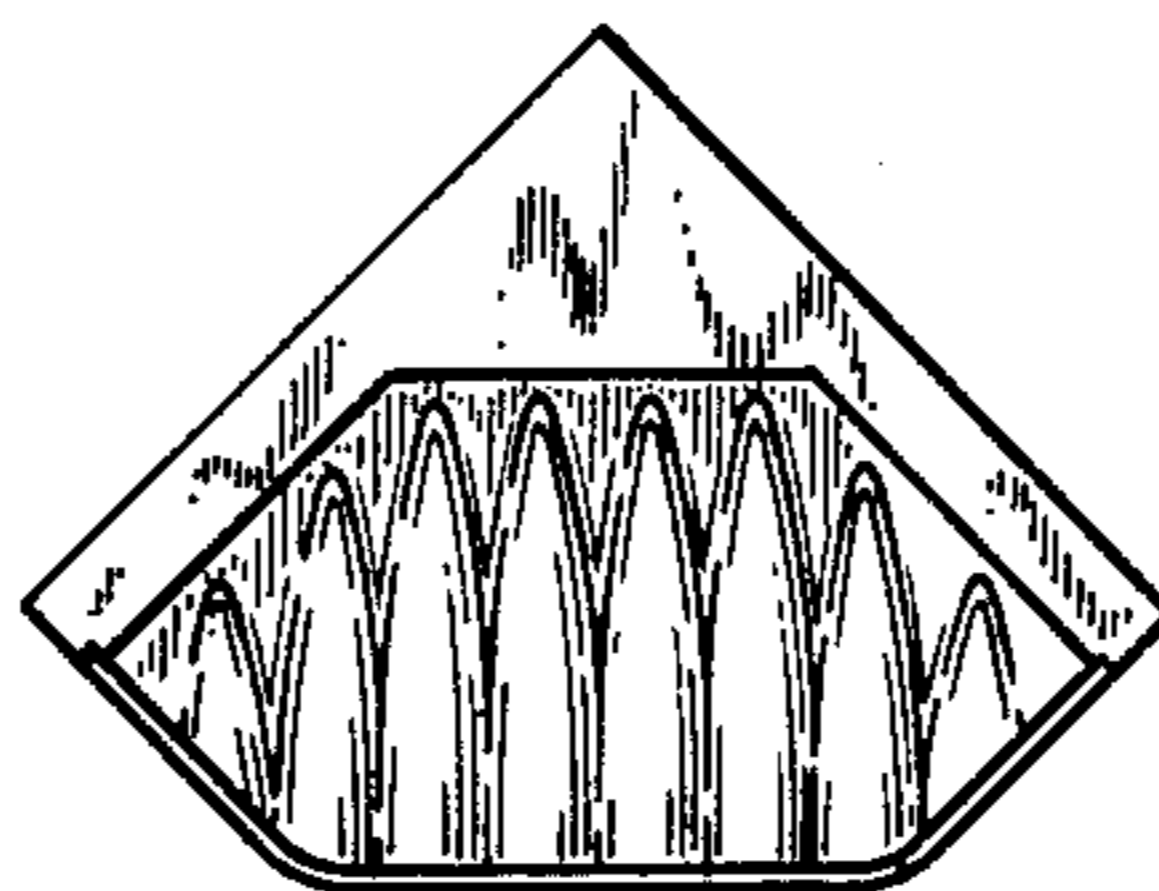
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 6.



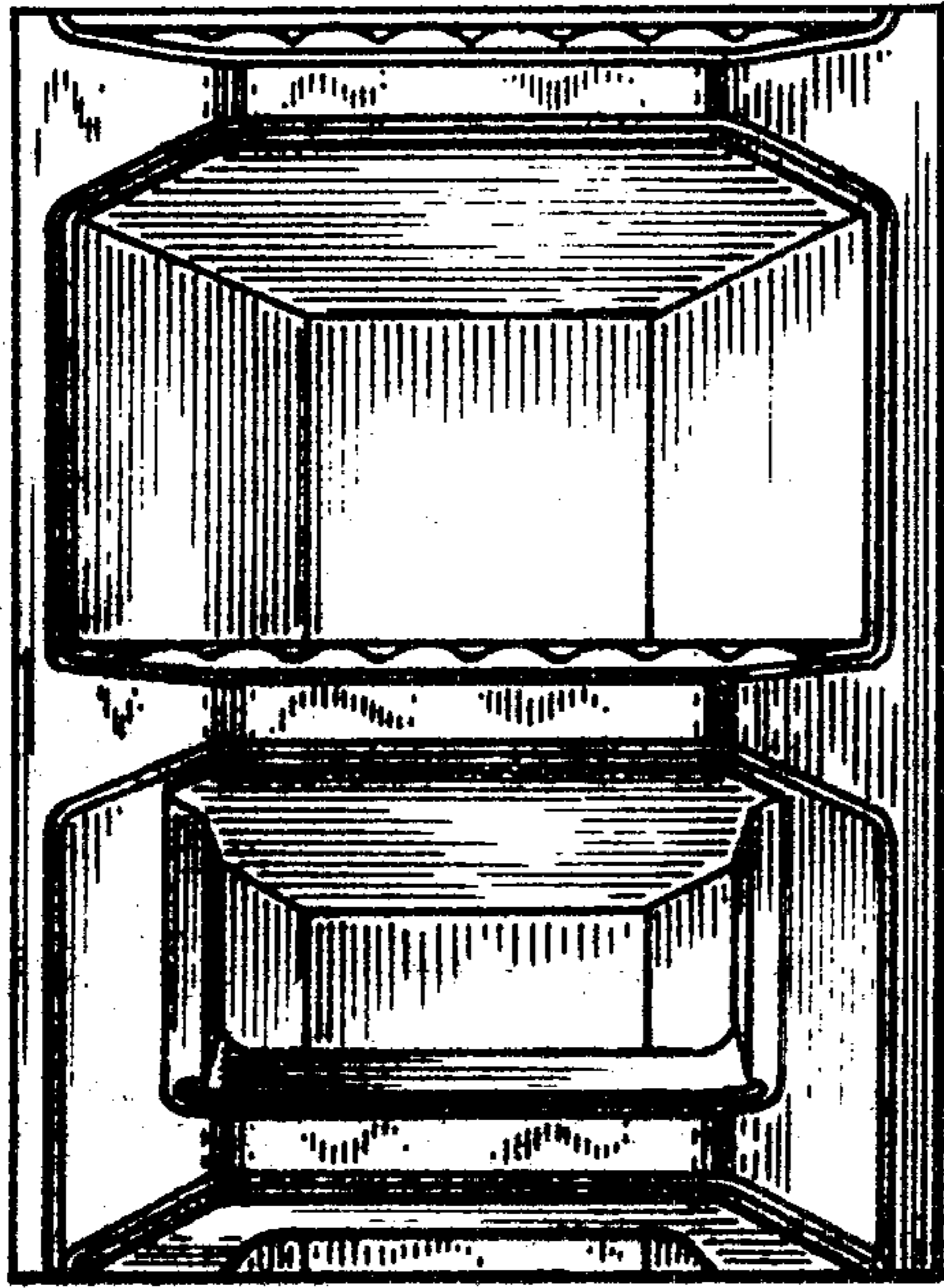
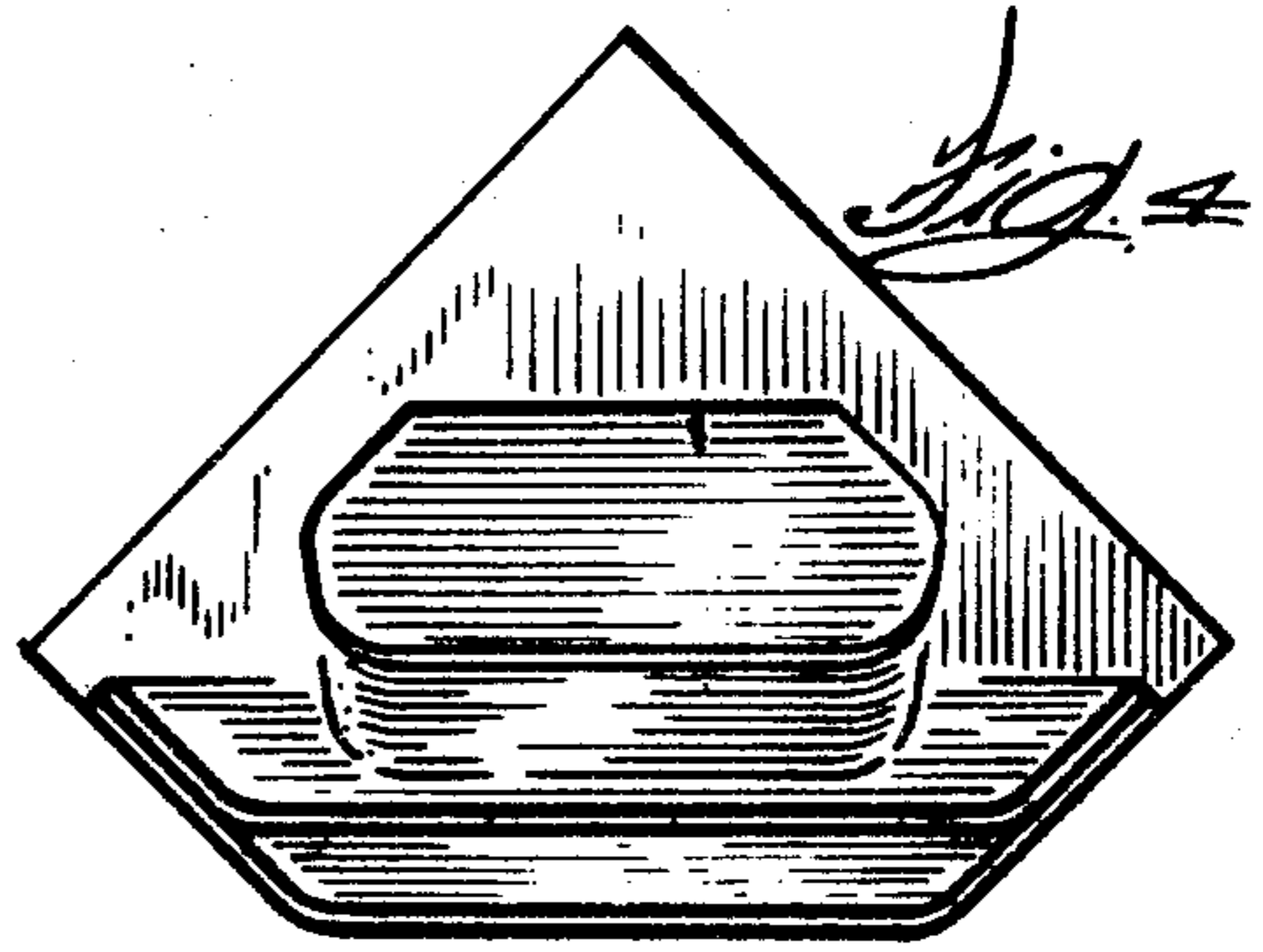
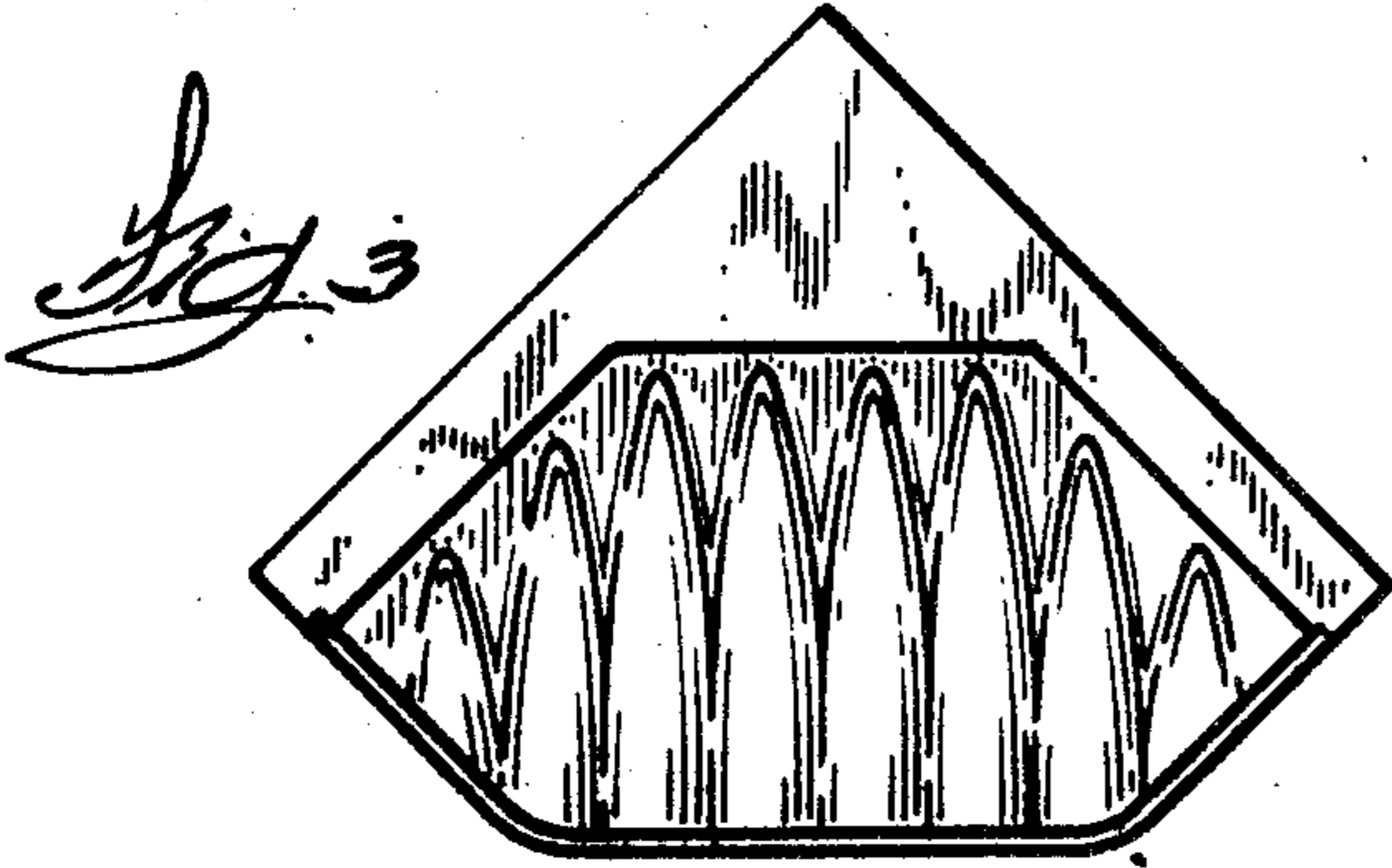

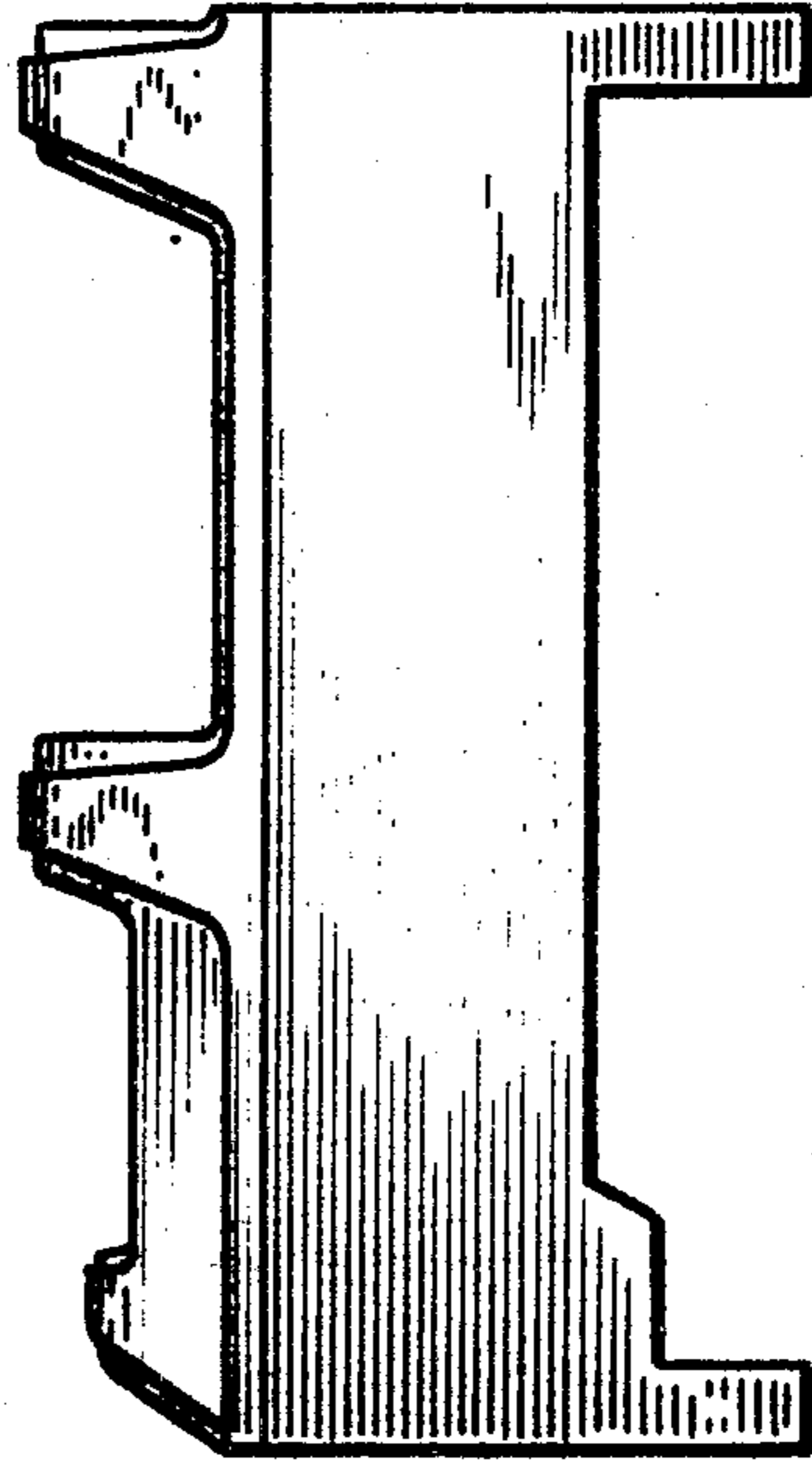

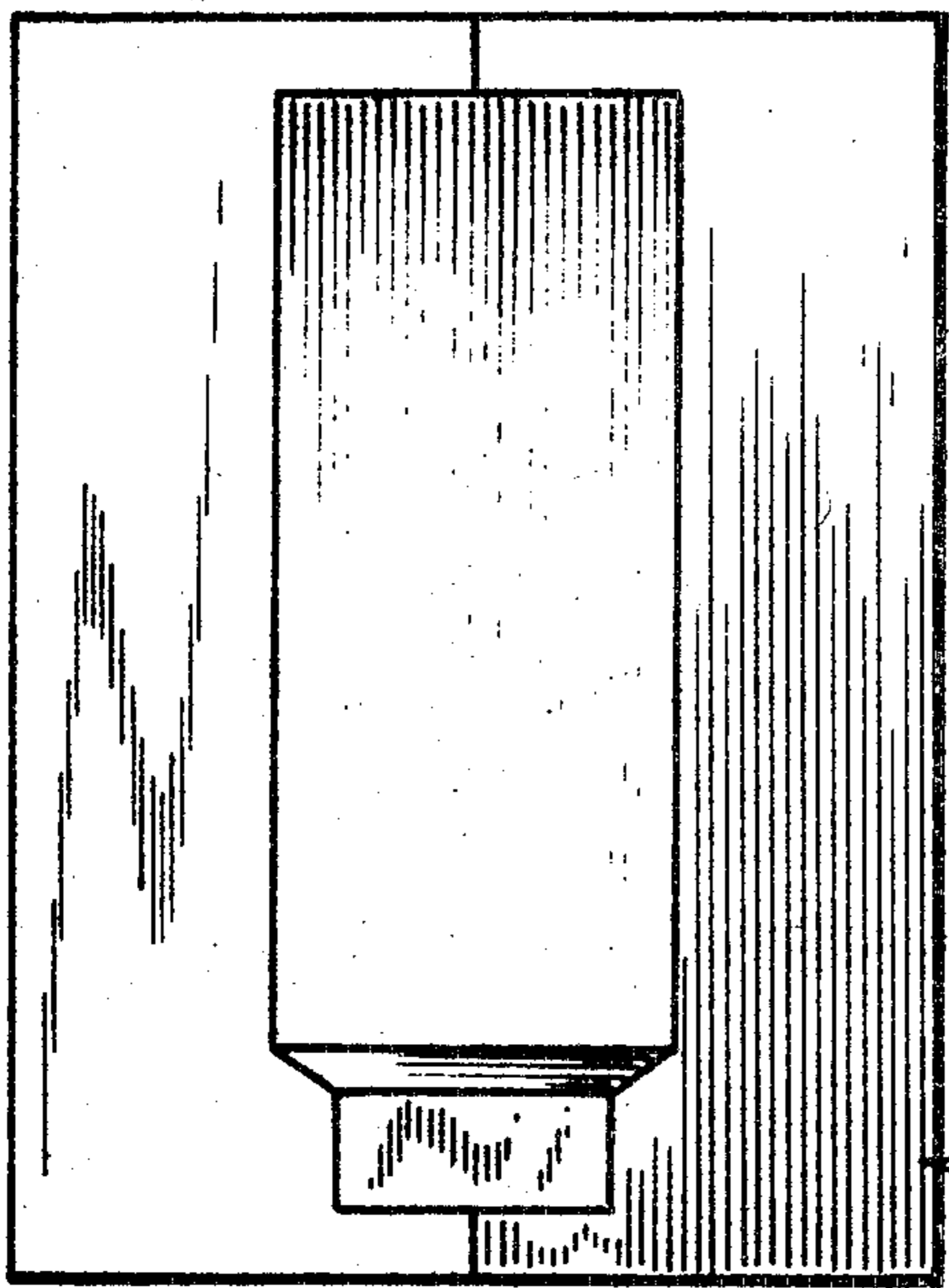

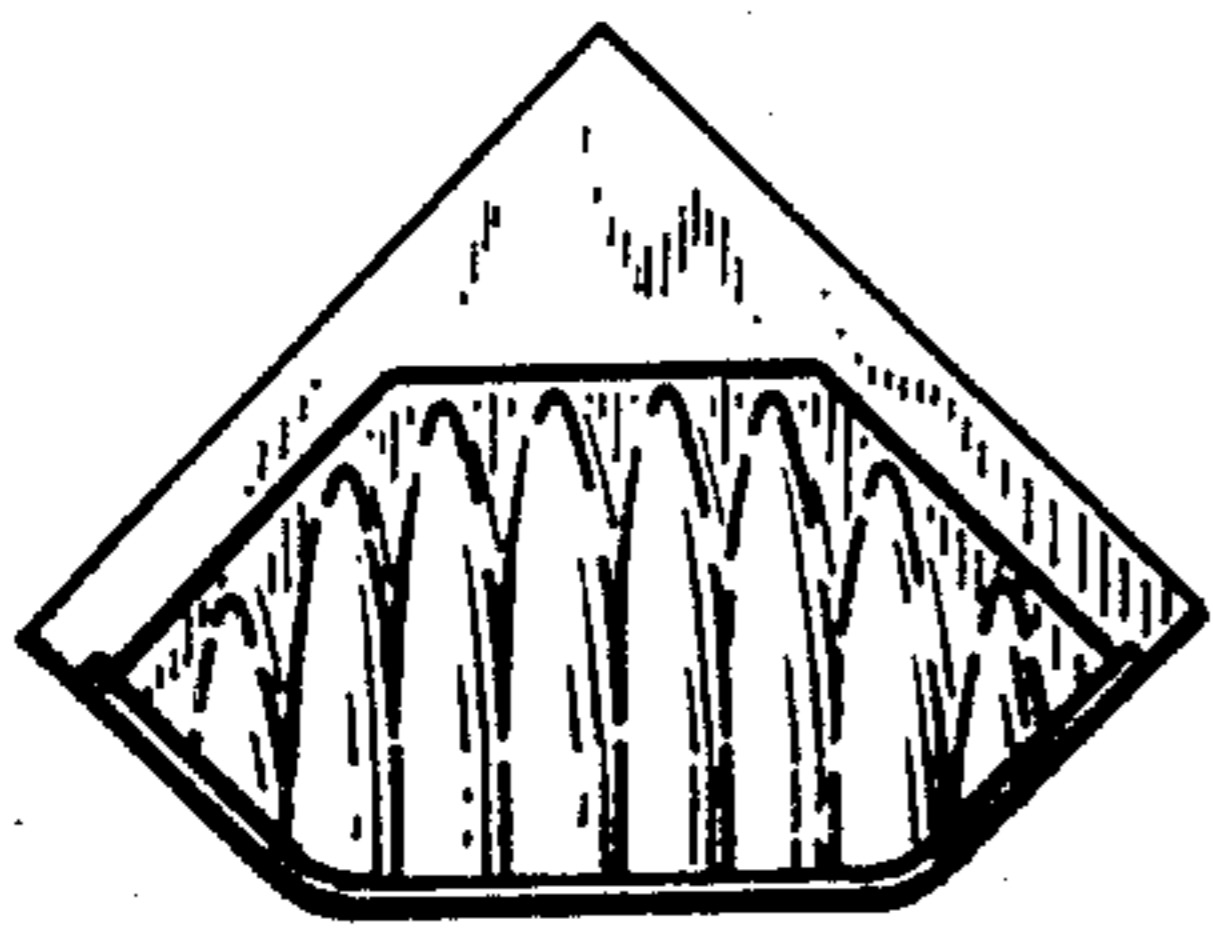

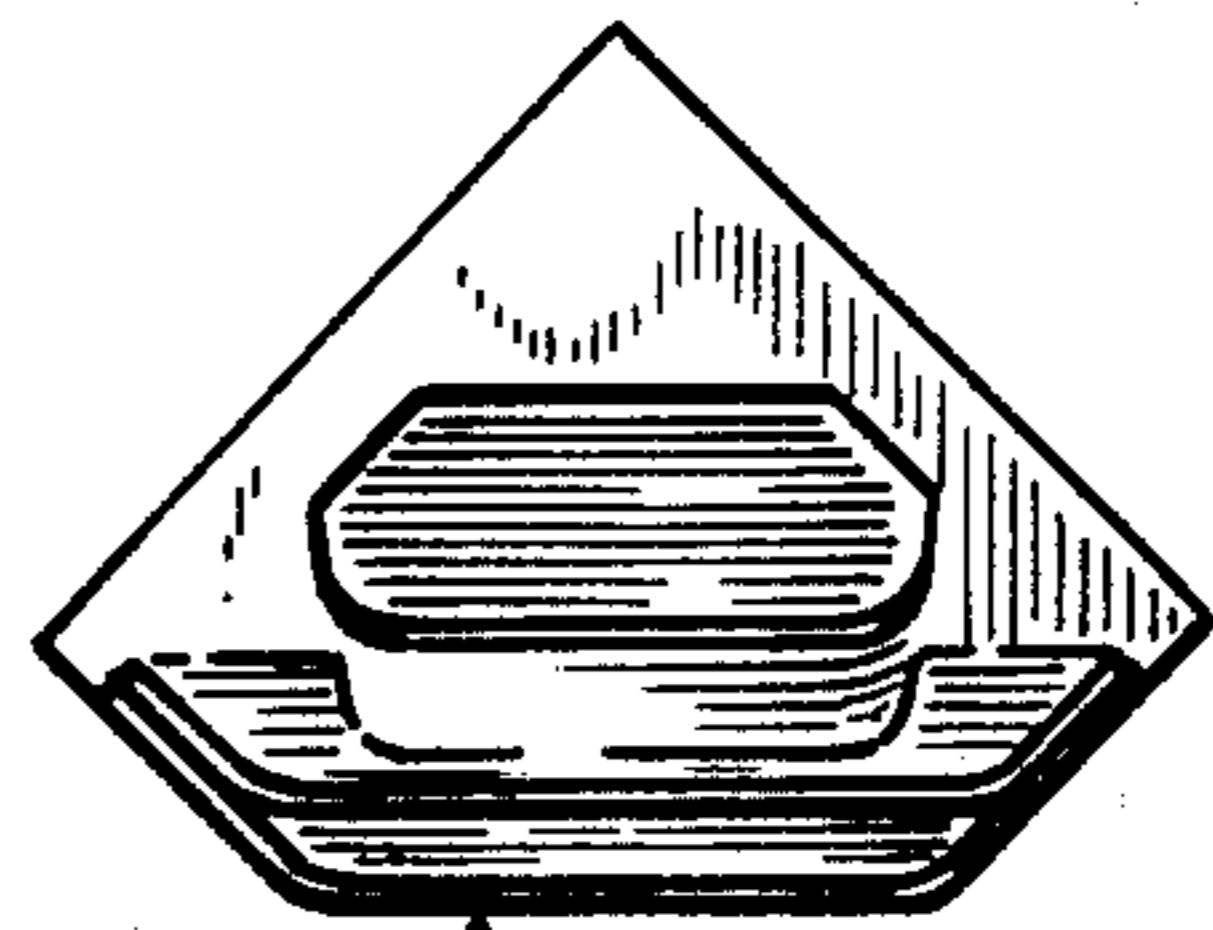

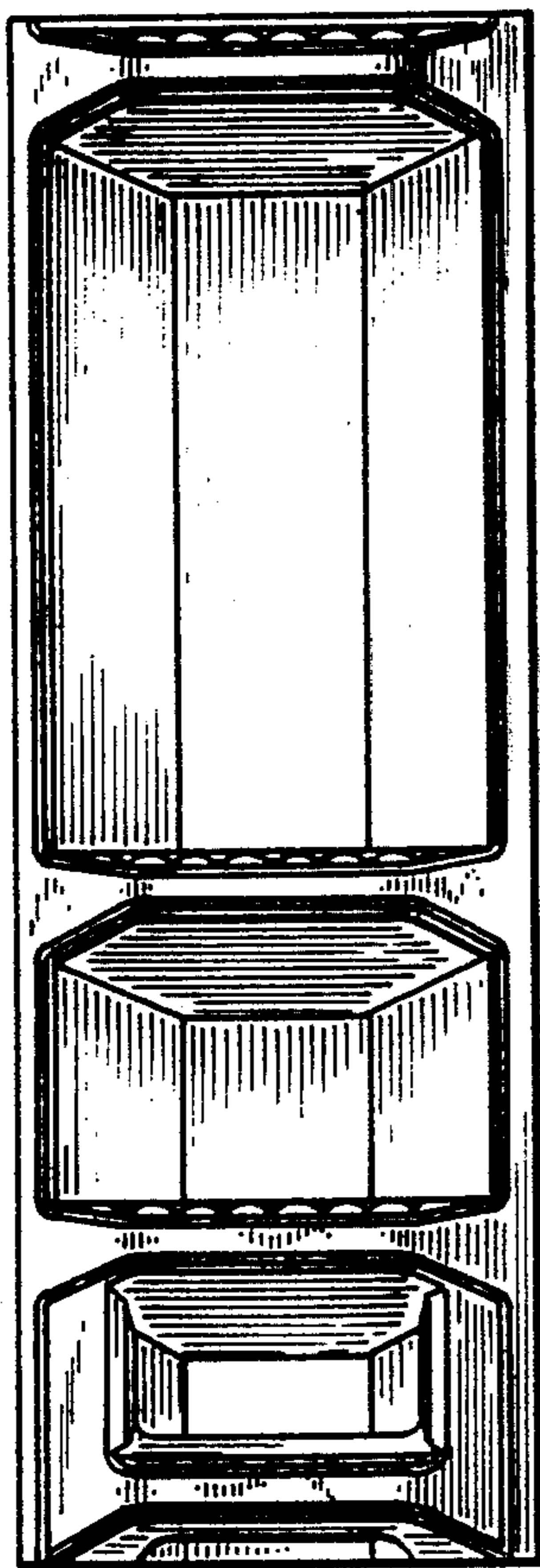

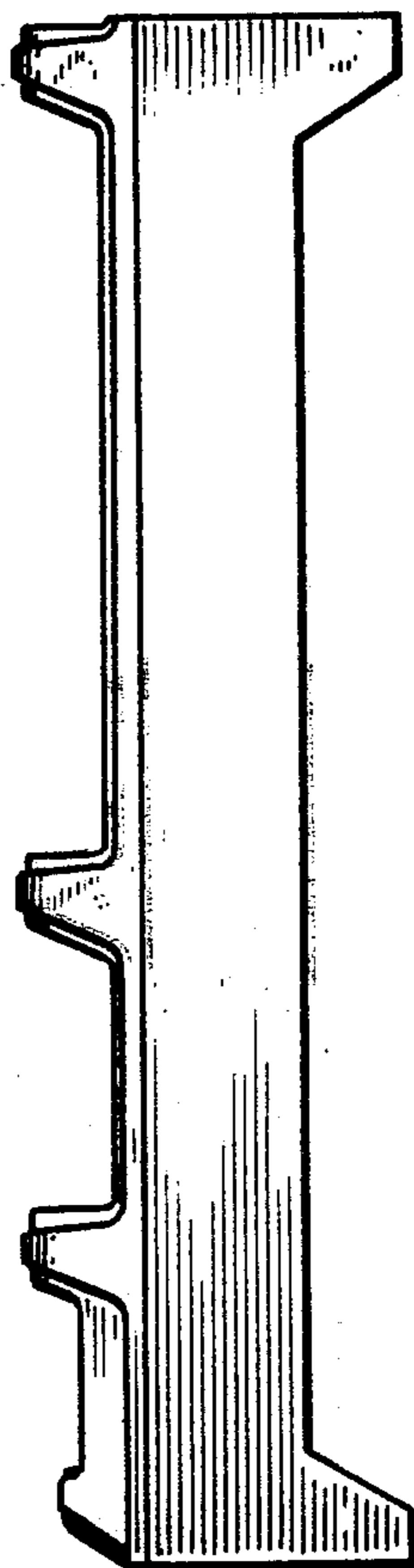

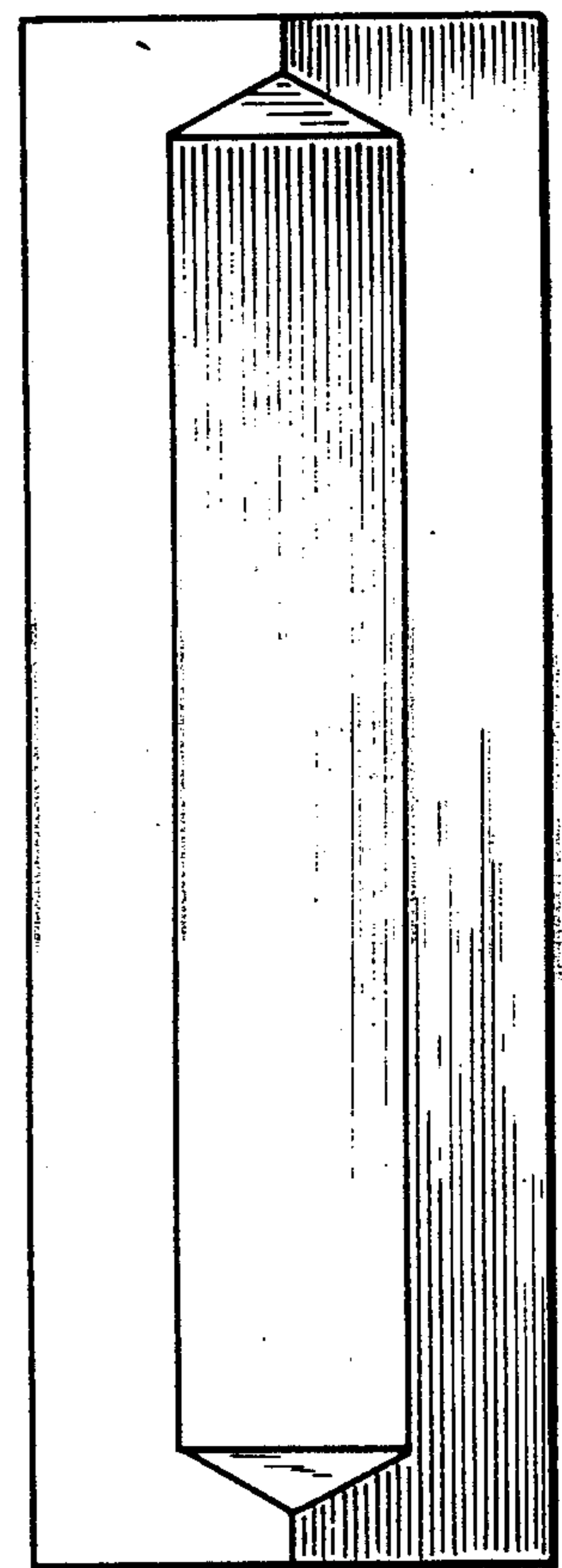
