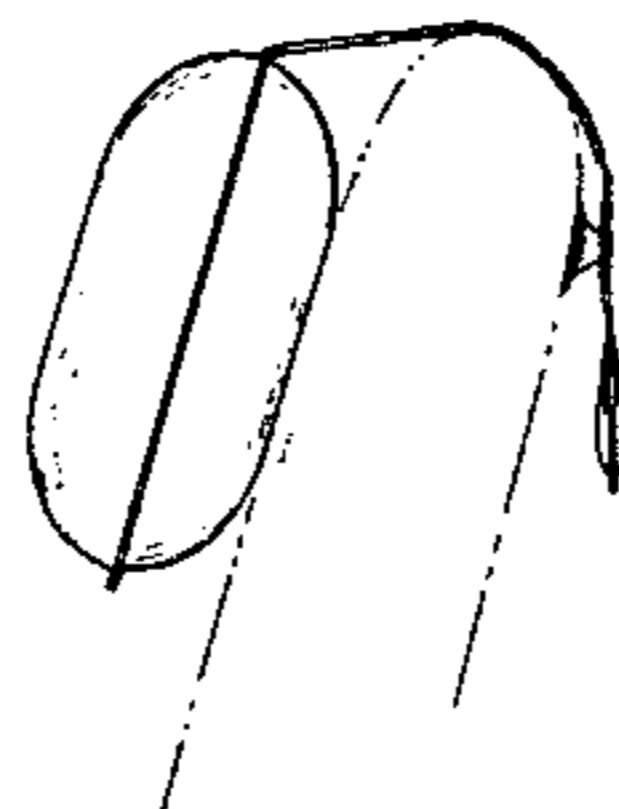
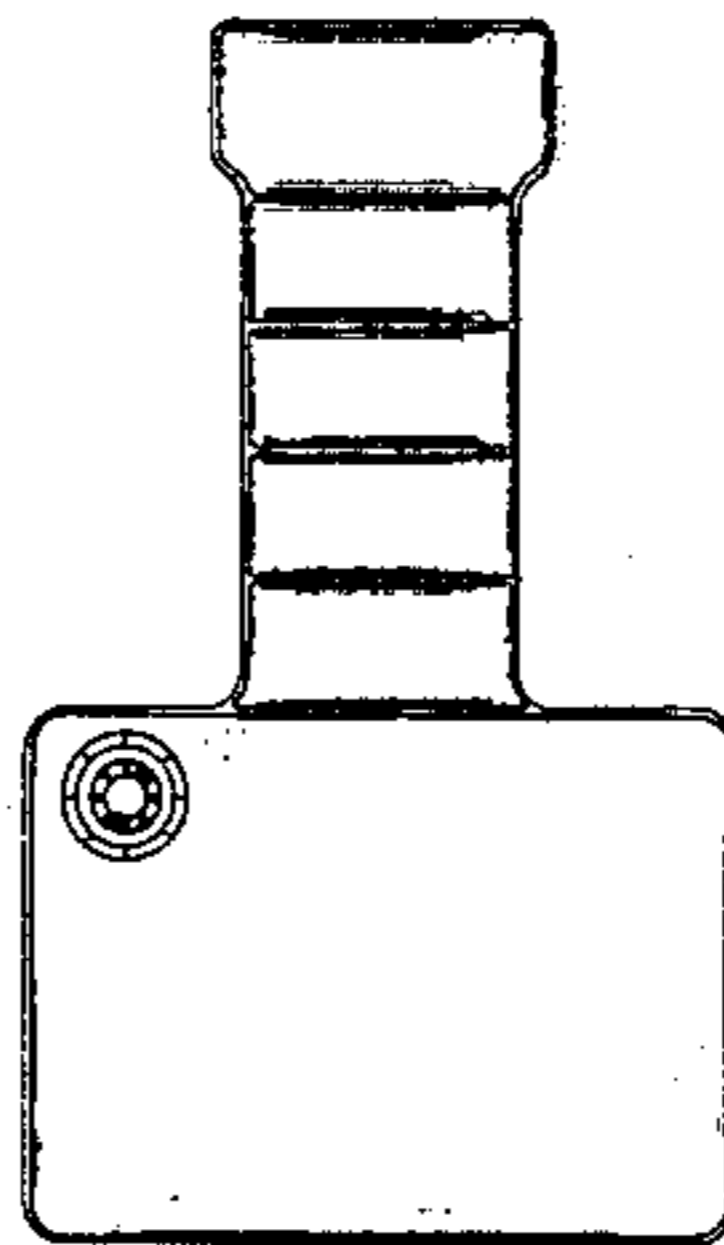

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a head cushion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a head cushion showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevation view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, shown in use;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of the head cushion of our new design.
The broken line showing of the seat back in FIG. 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



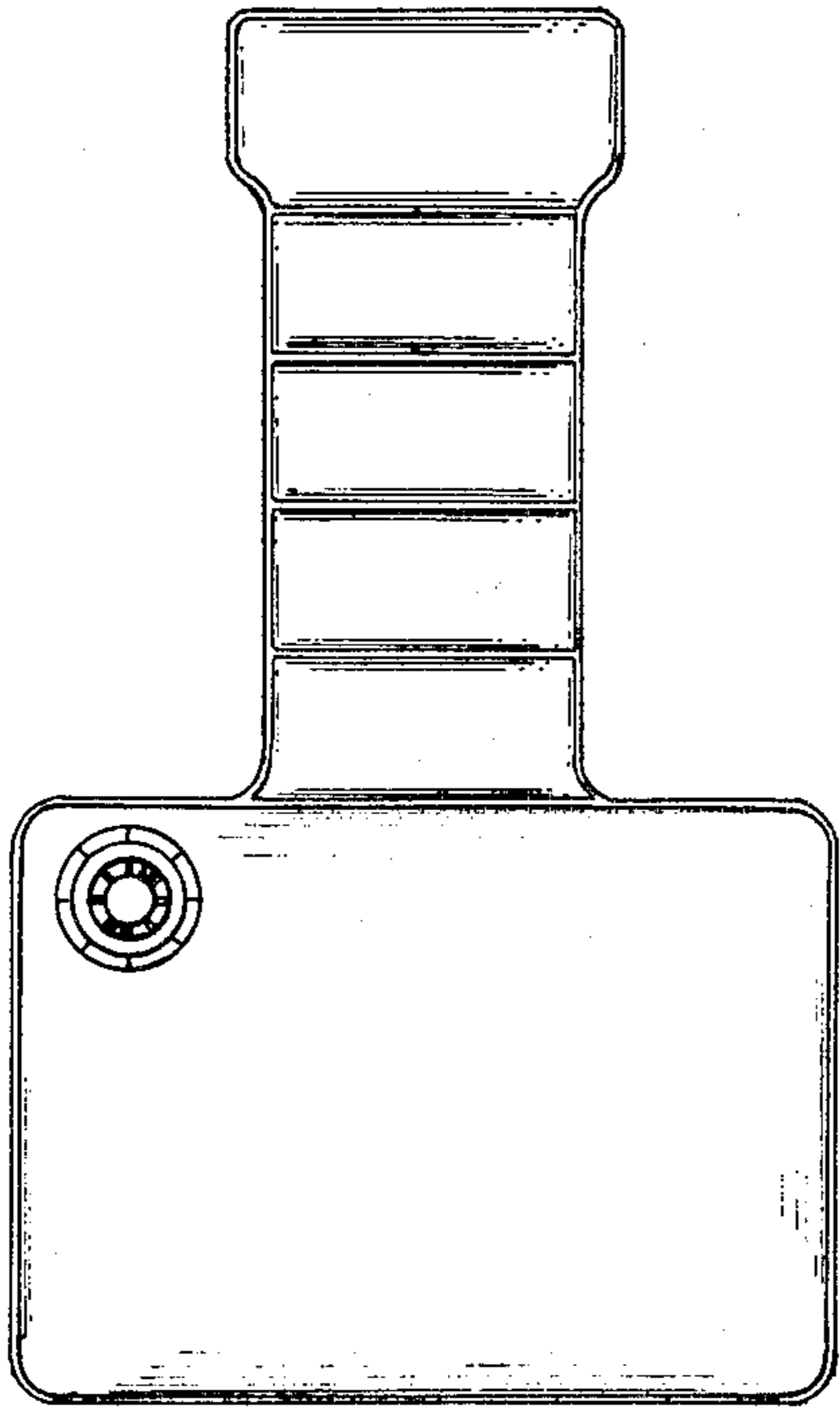

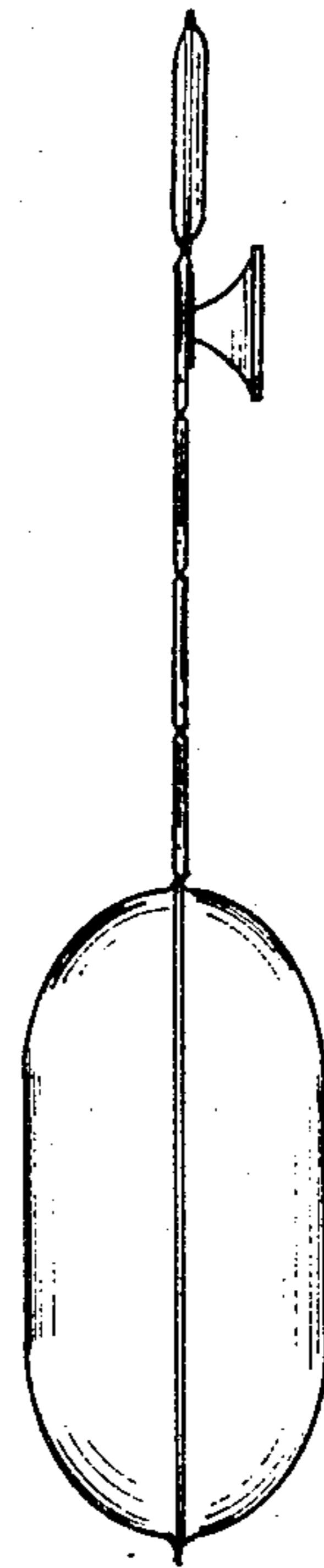

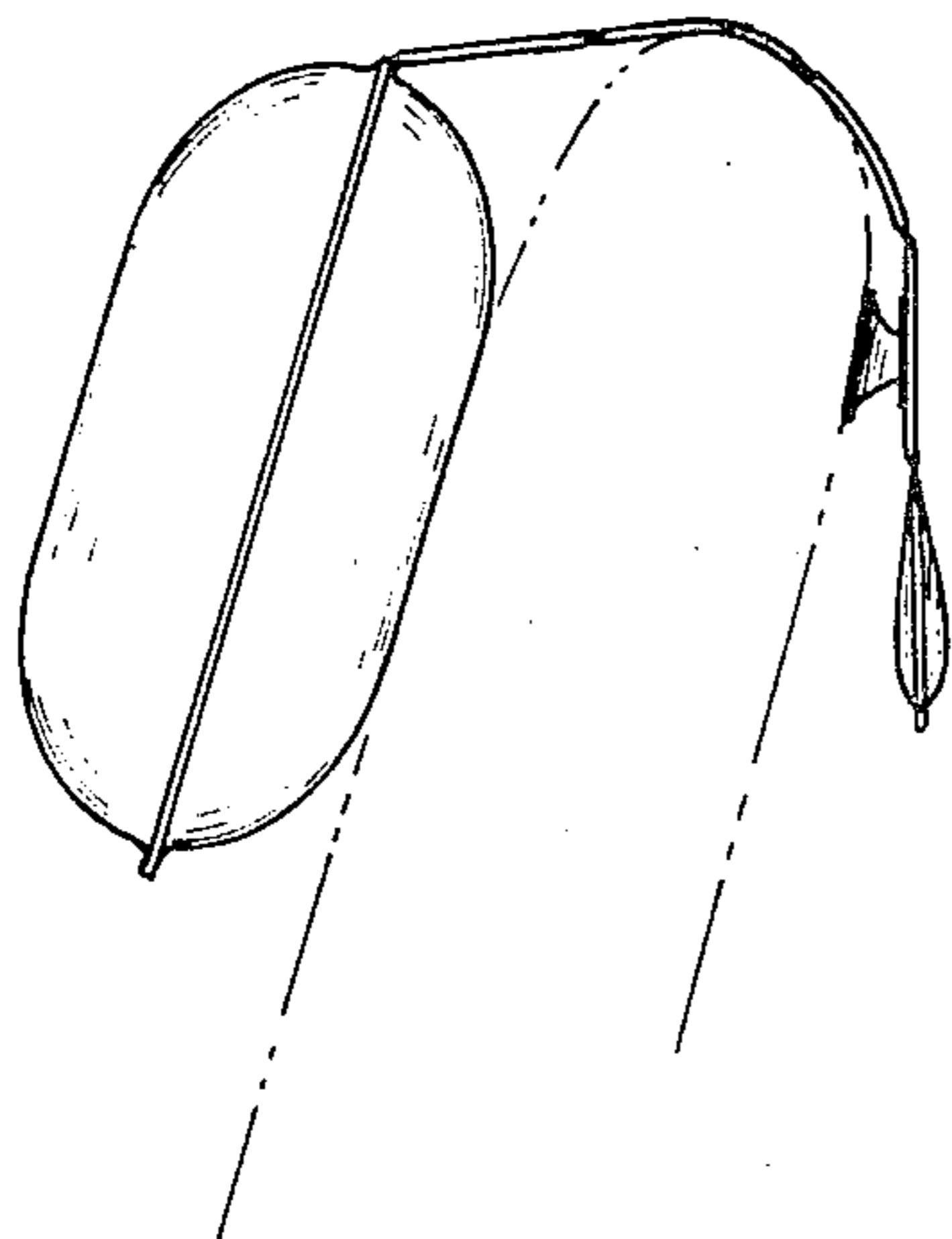

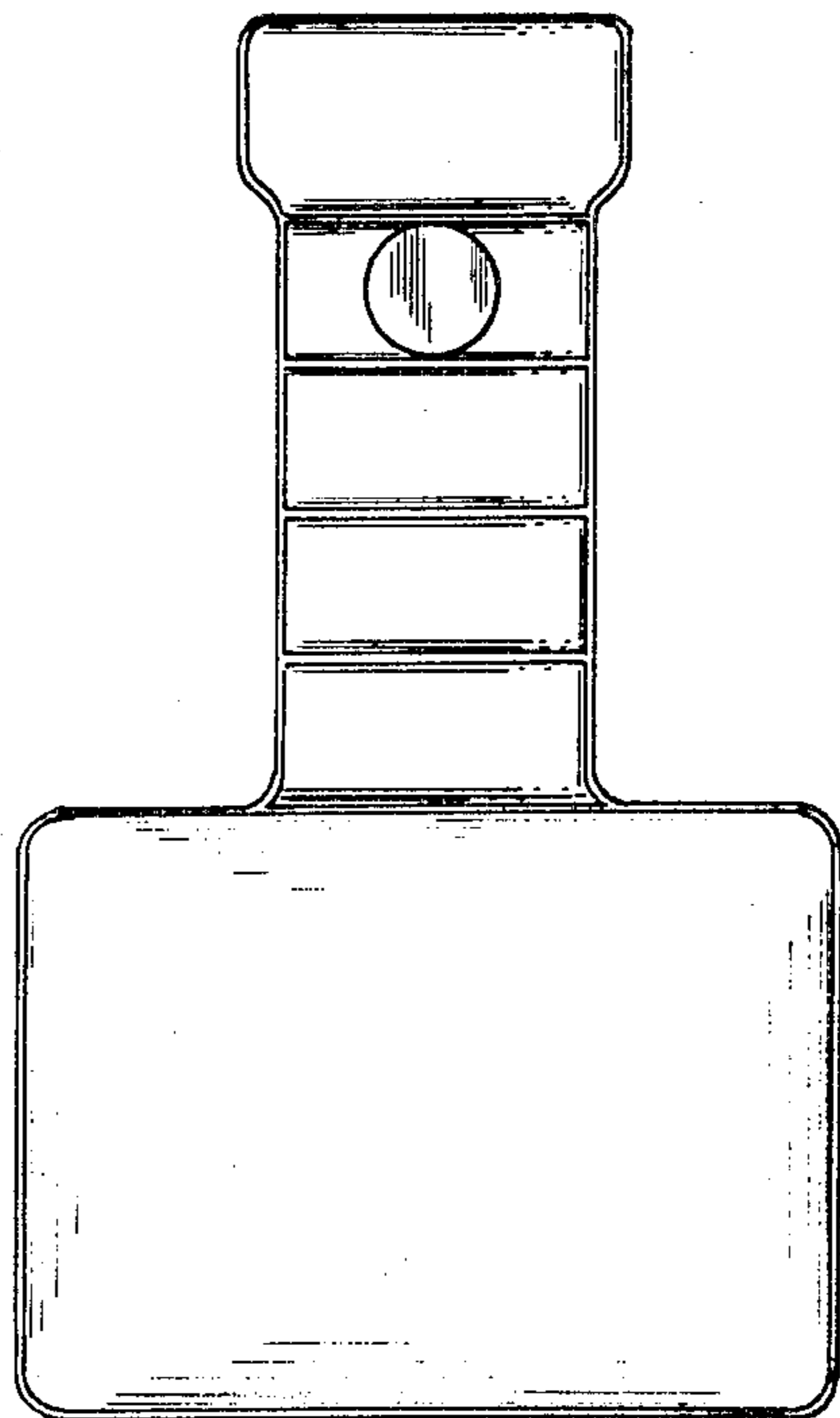

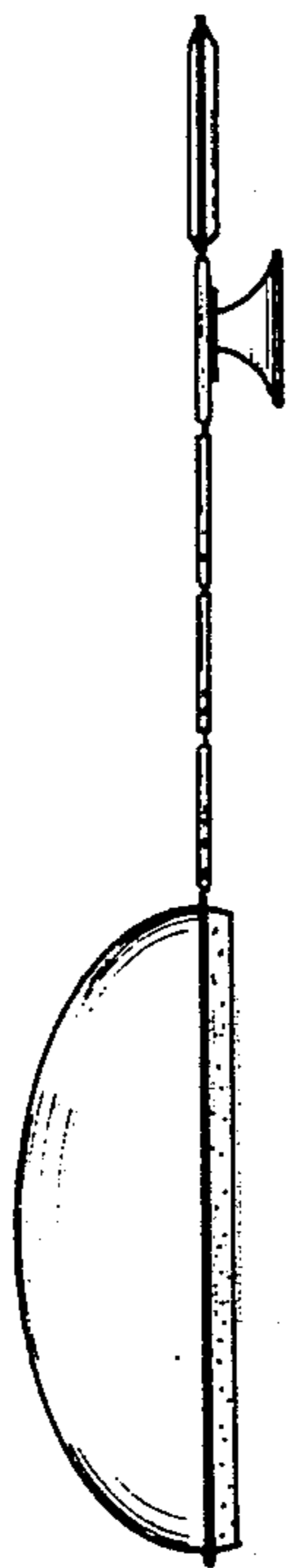
