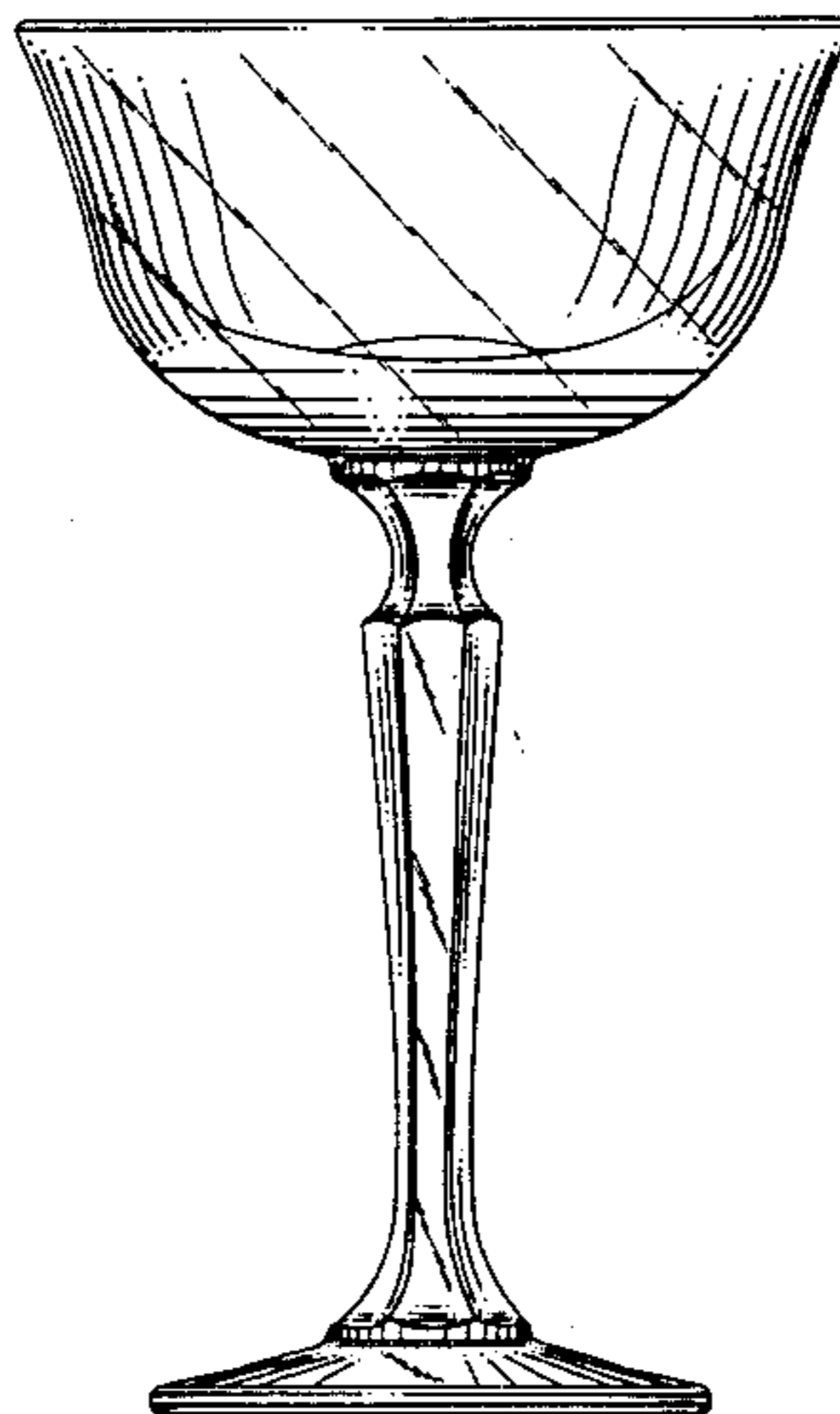

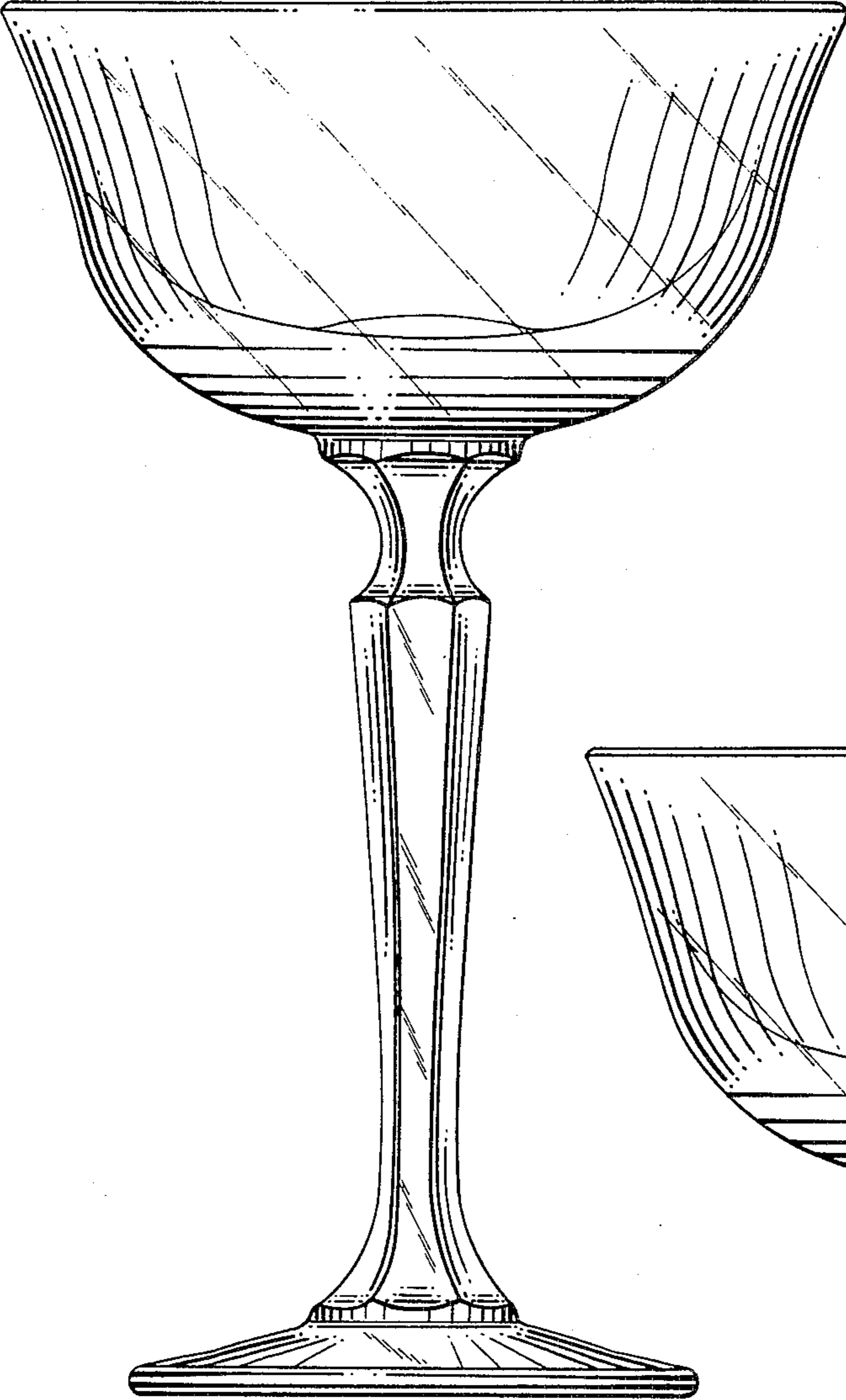
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a champagne glass, as shown and described.

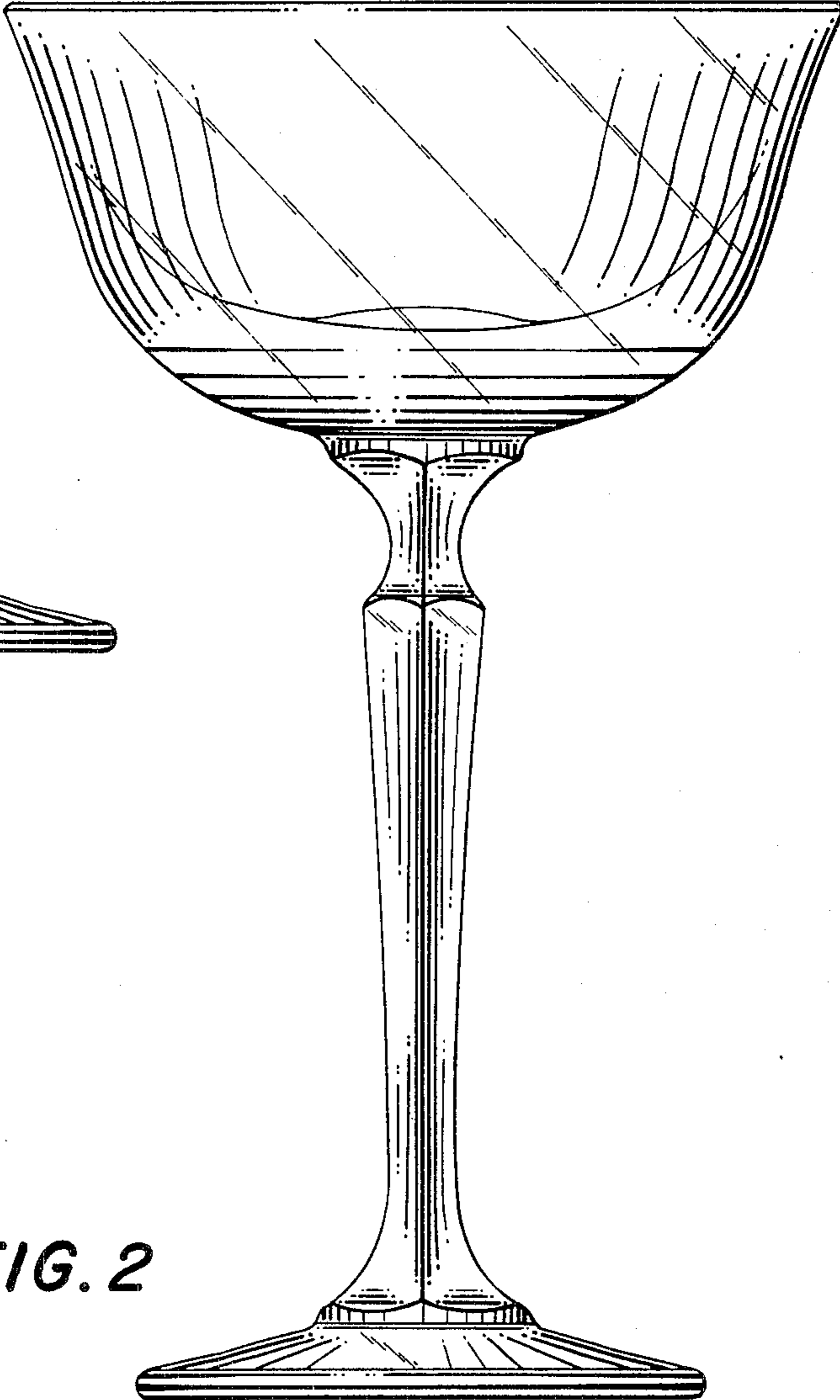
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side elevational view of a champagne glass showing my new design, the rear side view being substantially identical therewith;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

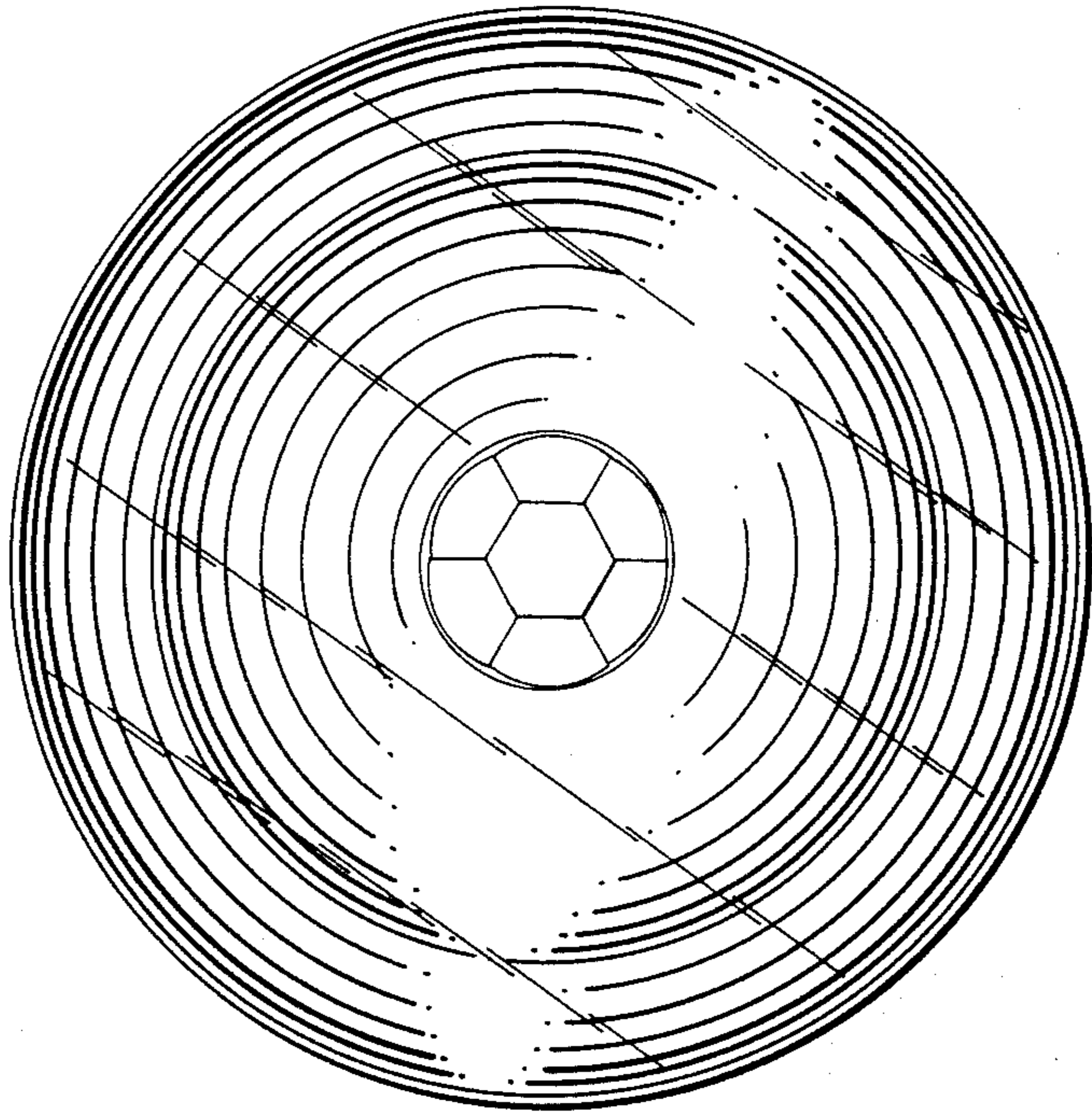




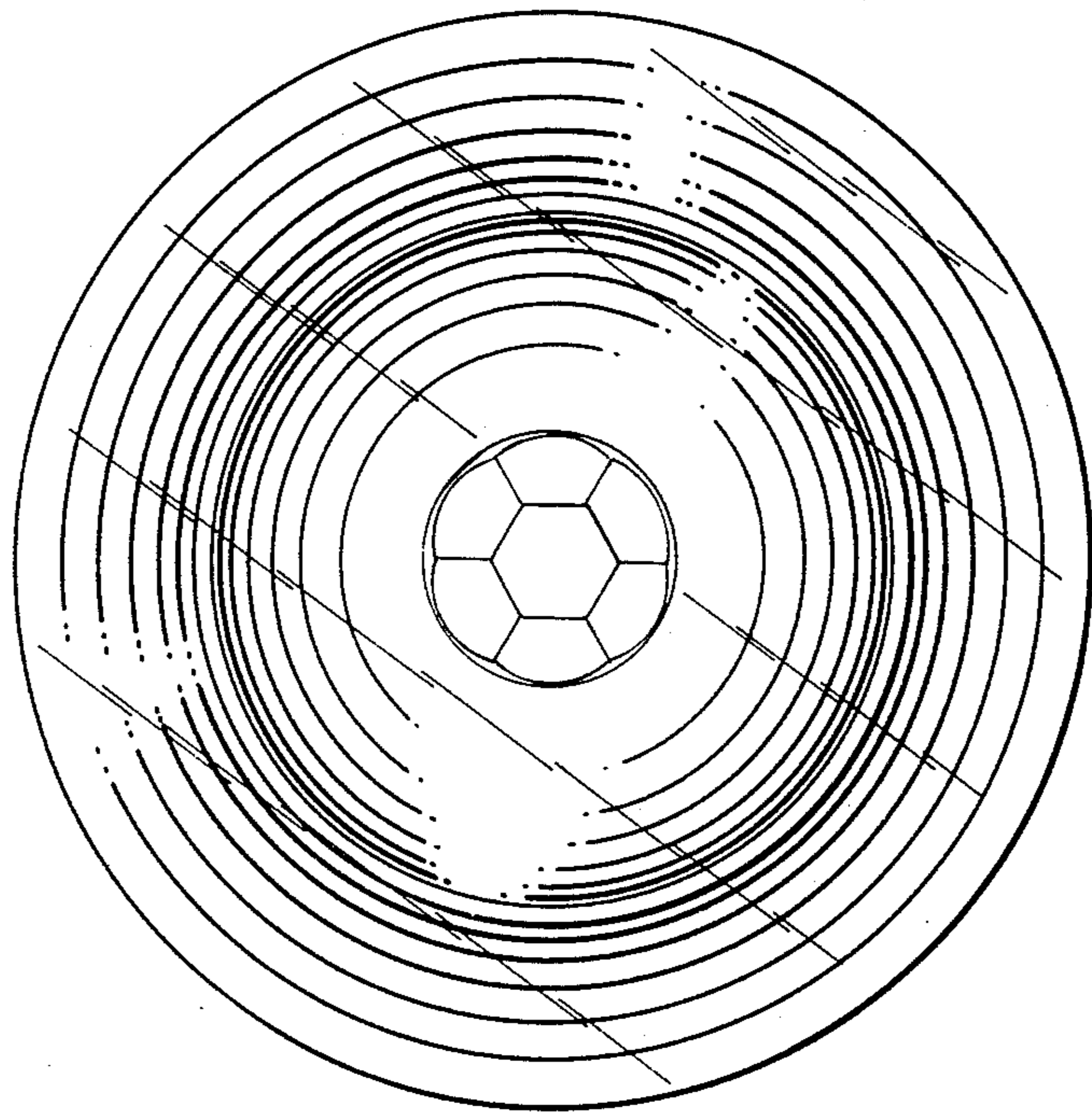
