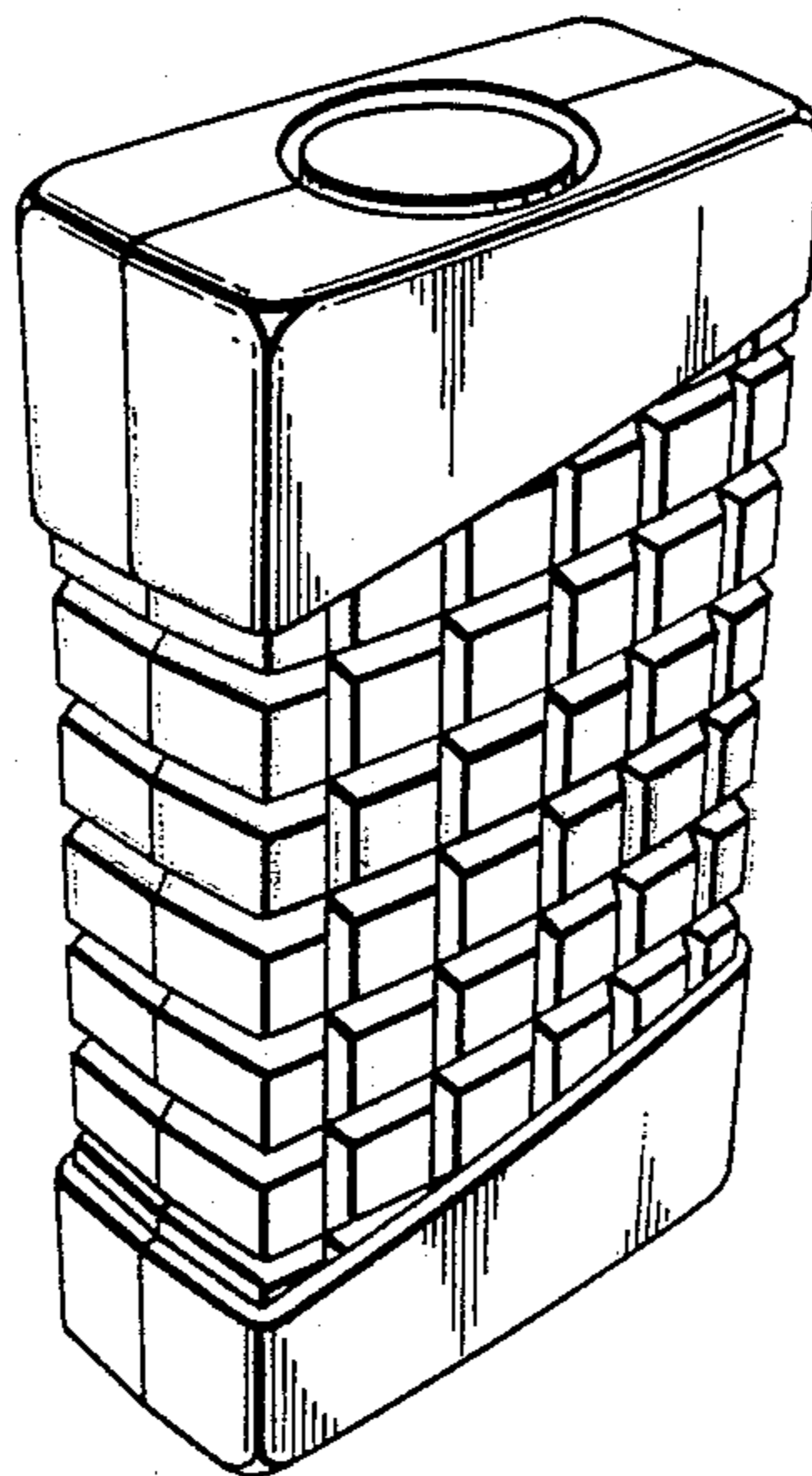
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a perspective view, showing the bottom, back and left side of the container of FIG. 1.



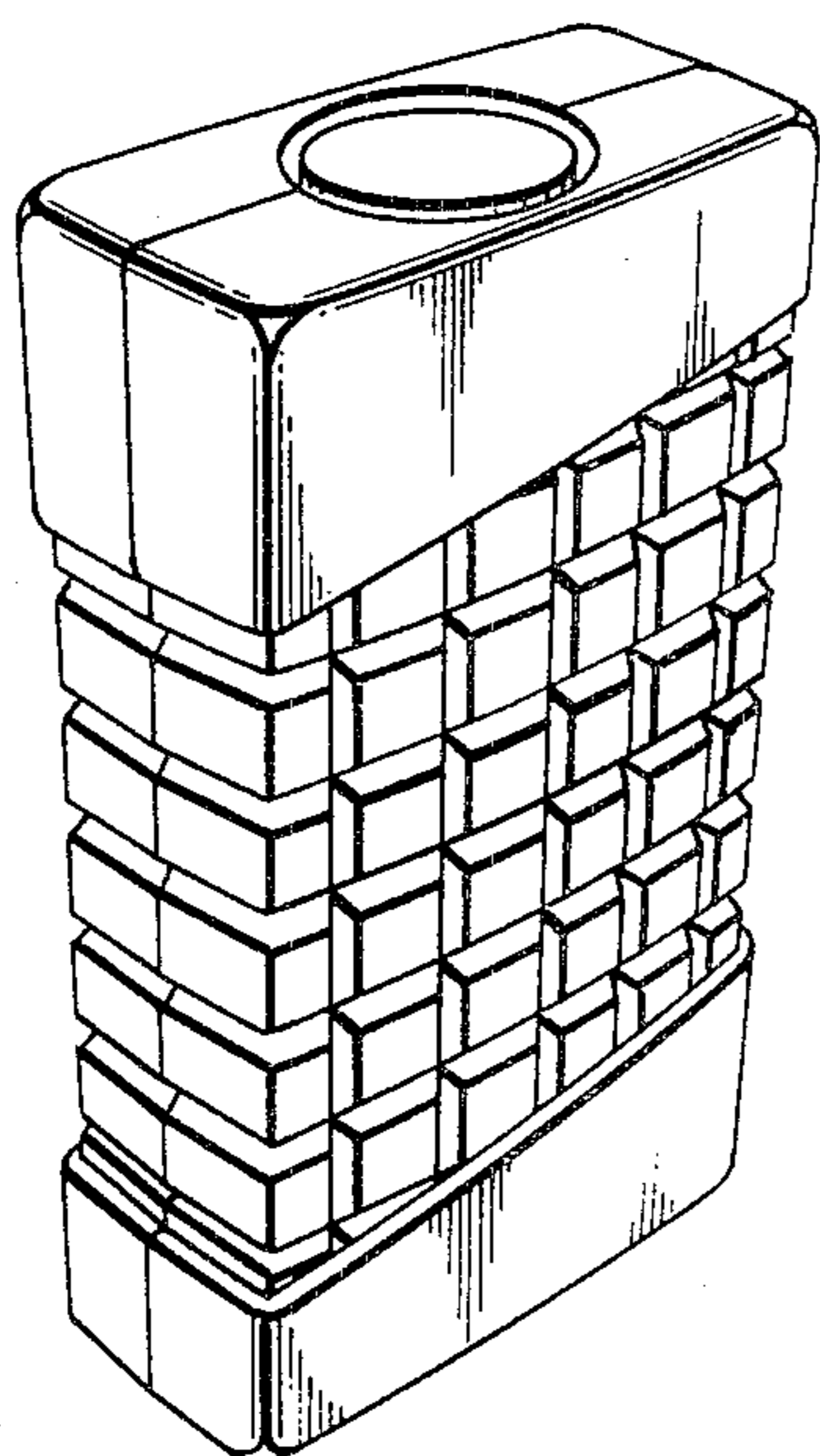

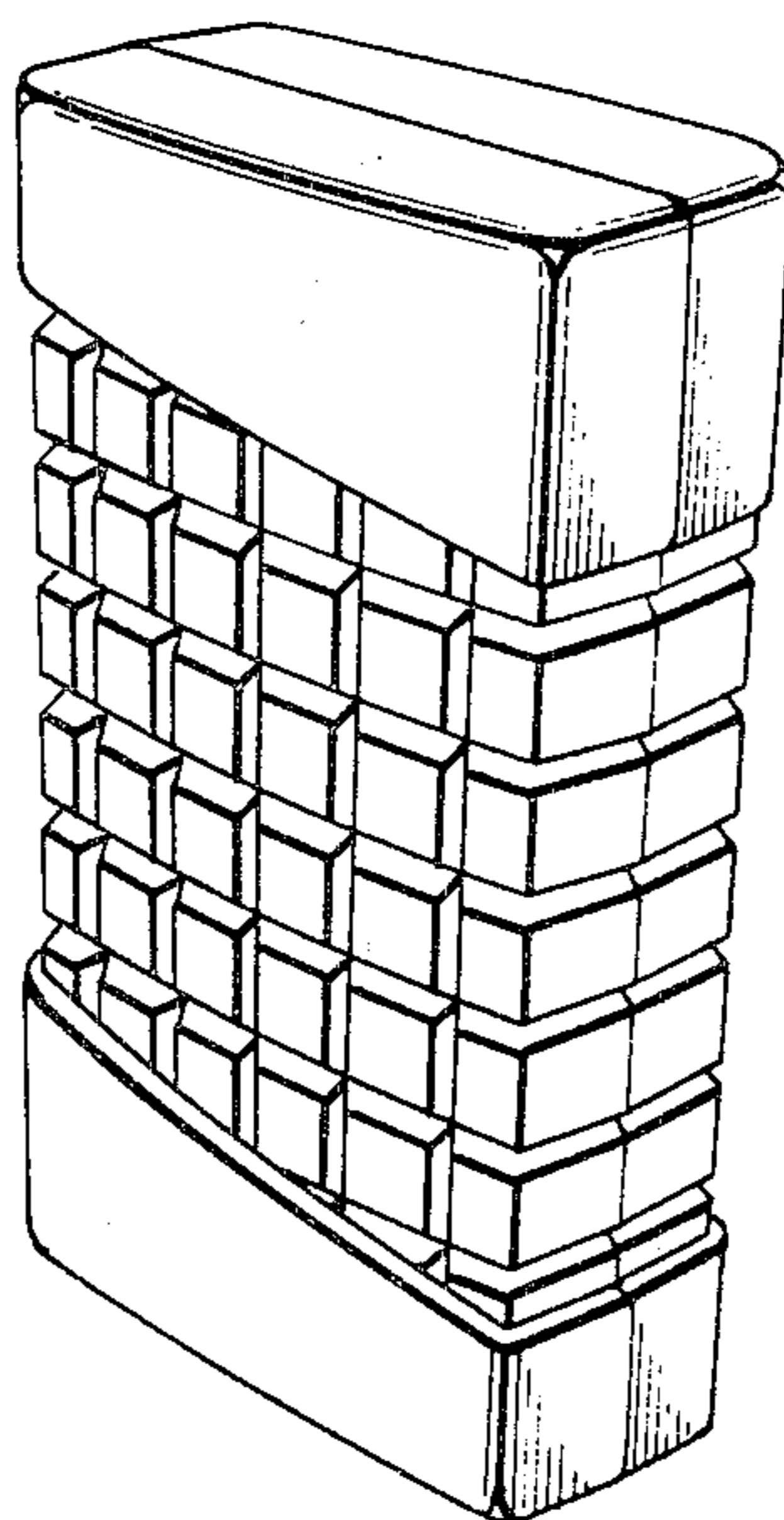
