[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a long stem valentine card, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a front elevational view of a long stem Valentine card; the undisclosed rear side is a mirror image of the side shown.

The broken lines representing the frill portion are shown for illustrative purposes only, and form no part of the claimed design.
