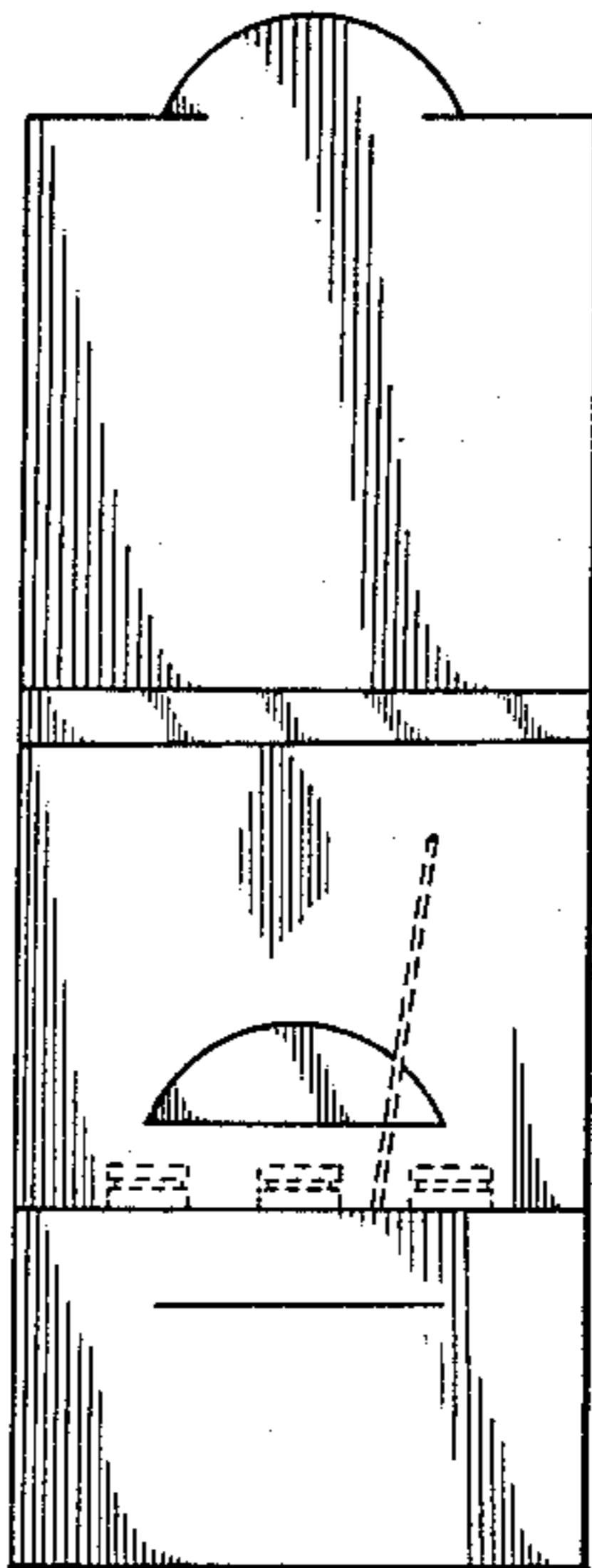

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a packaging container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view in the closed position of a packaging container showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a side view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan thereof in the open position; and
 FIG. 7 is a front elevation thereof in the open position. The broken lines in FIGS. 5, 6 and 7 showing vials and a rod are for the purpose of illustrating environmental use only.



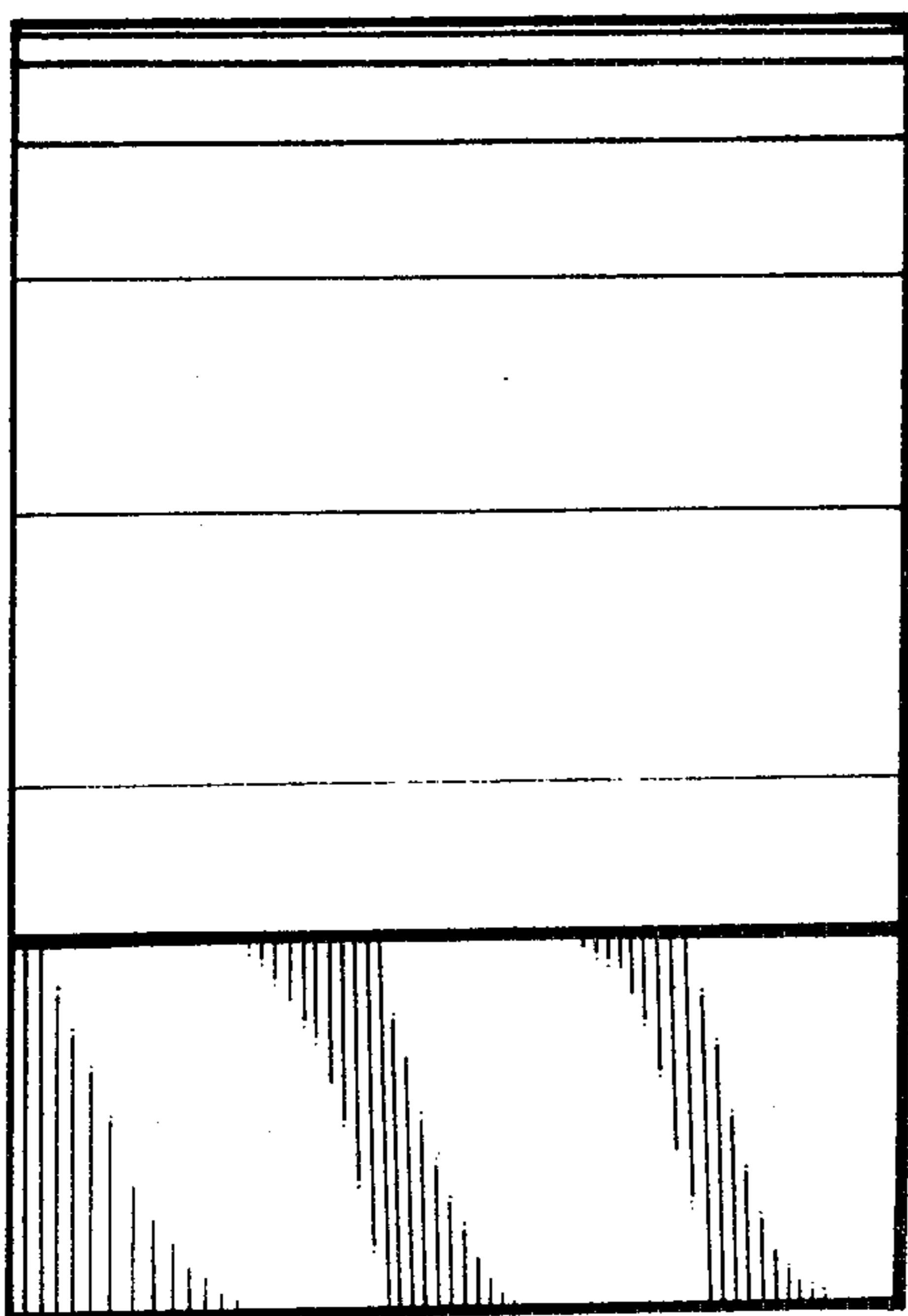

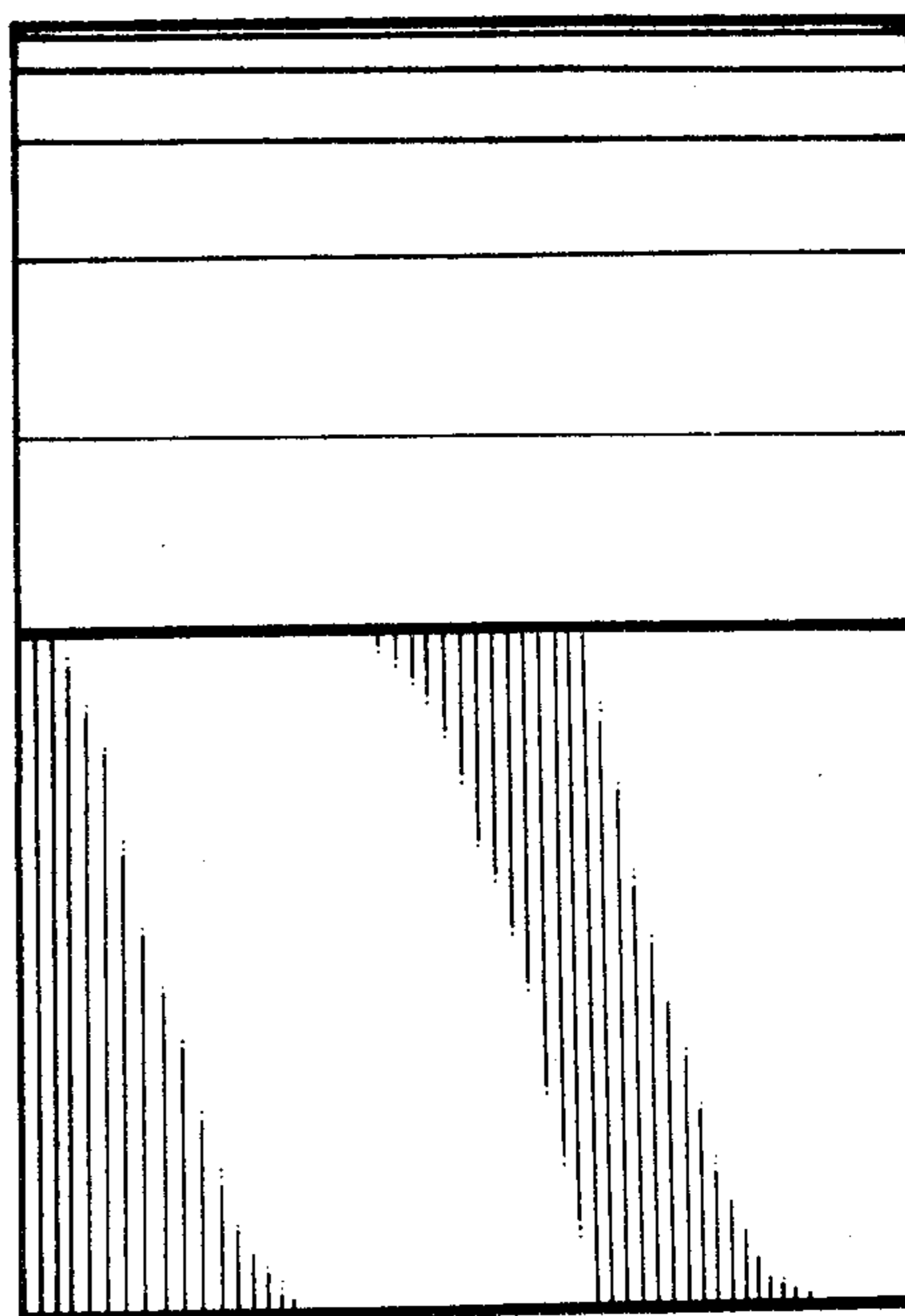

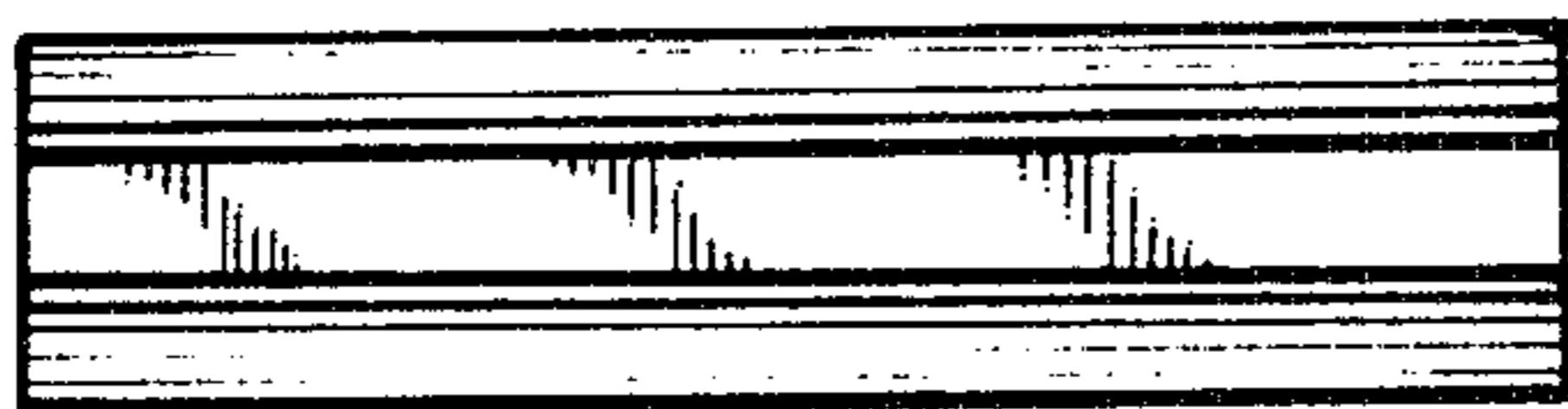

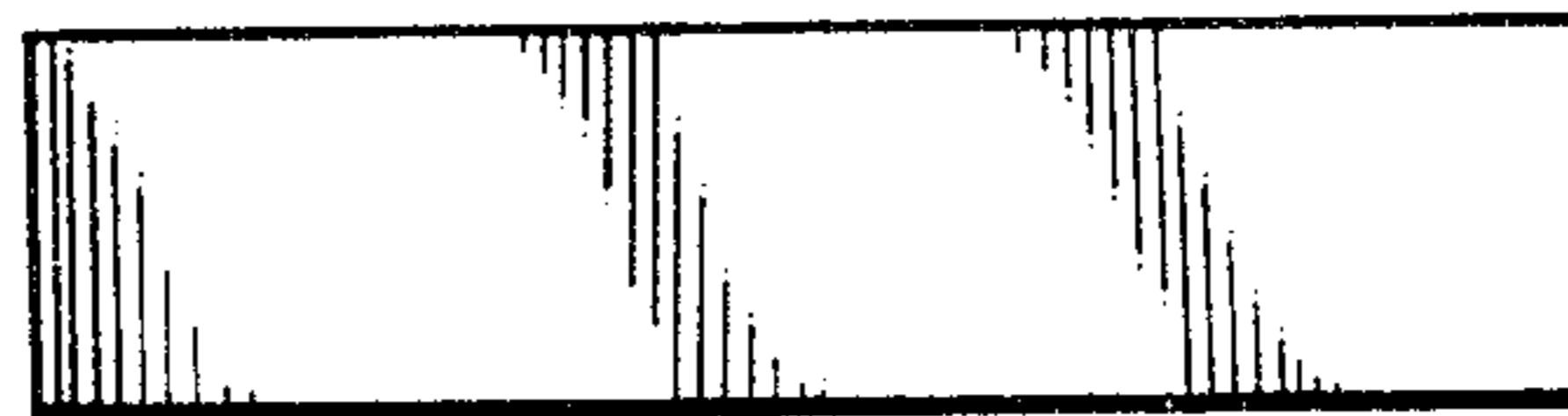

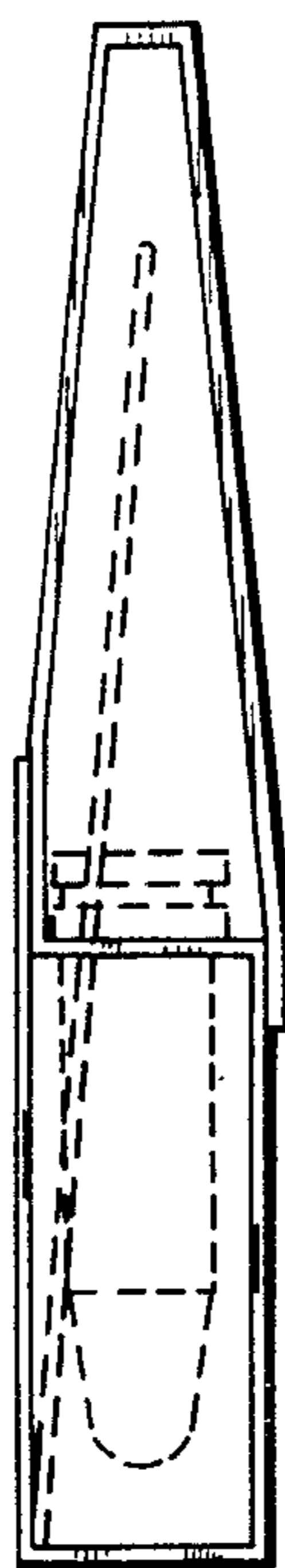

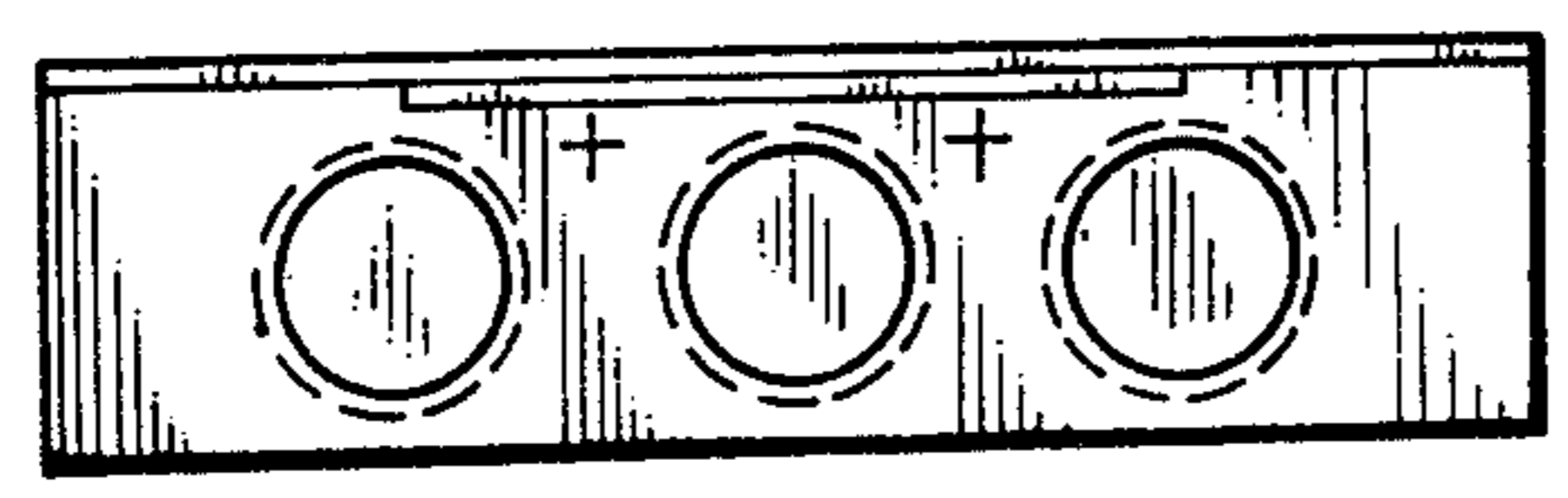

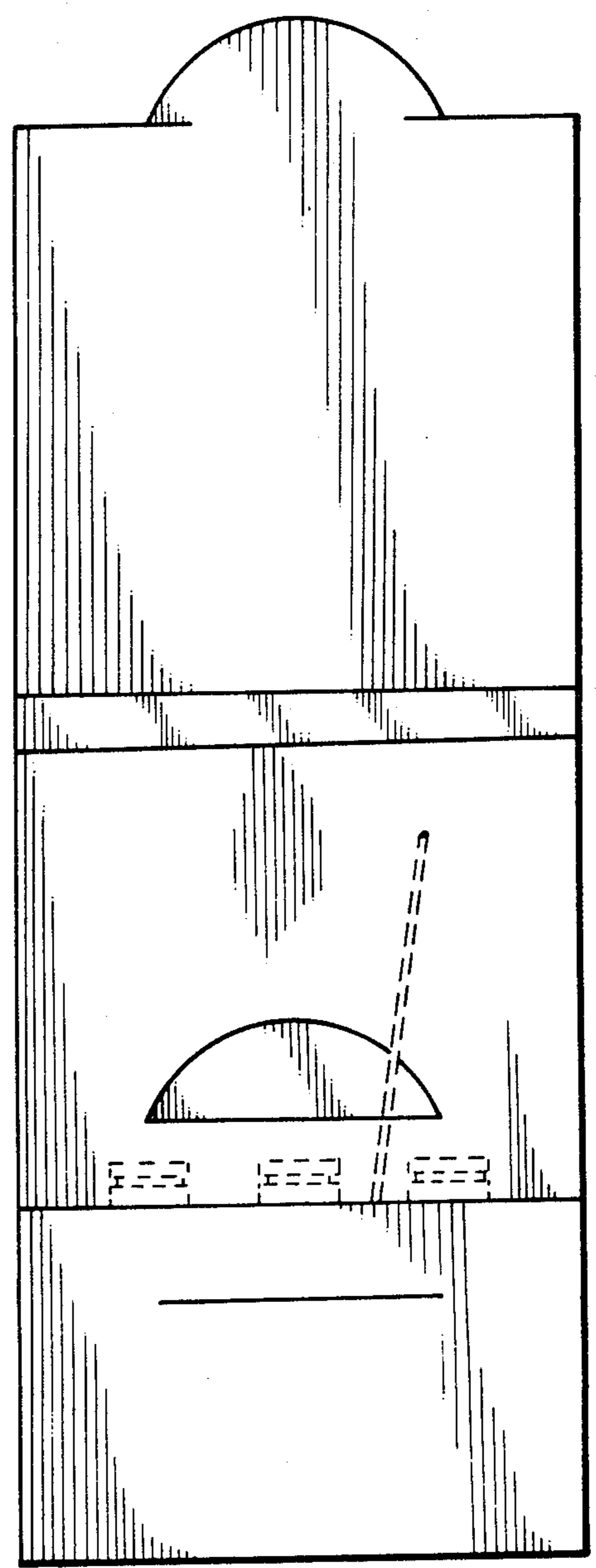
