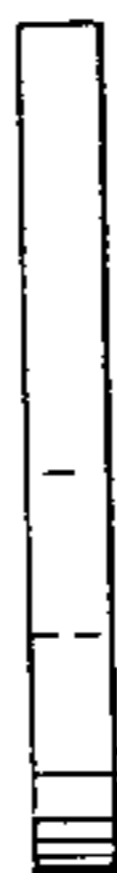
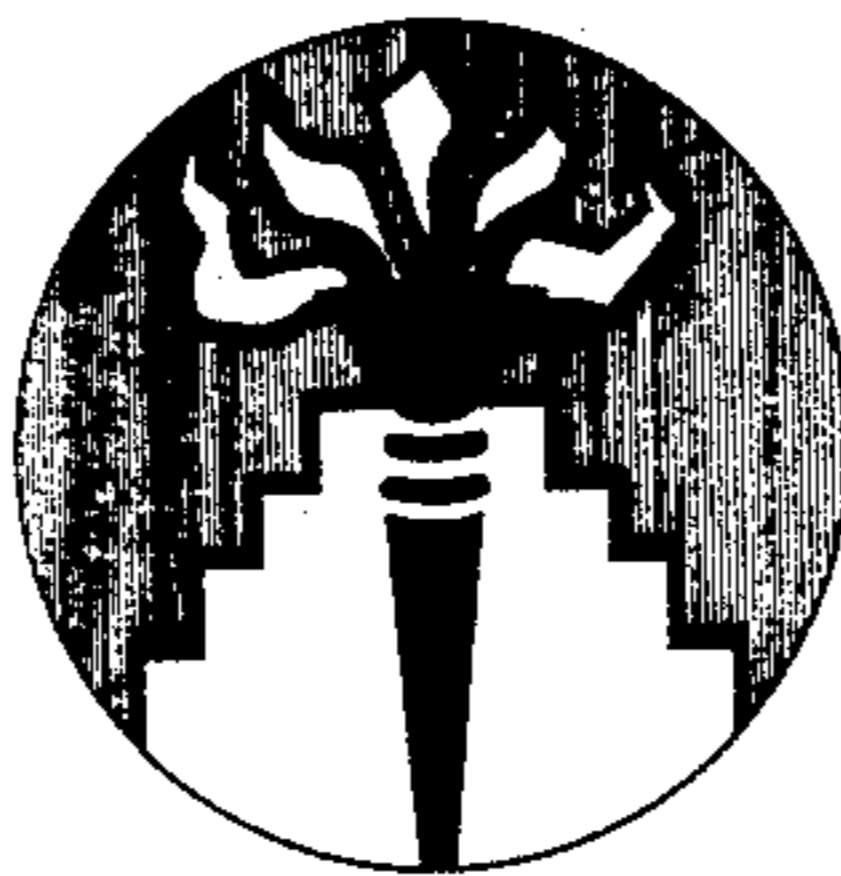
The ornamental design for a medallion, as shown and described.

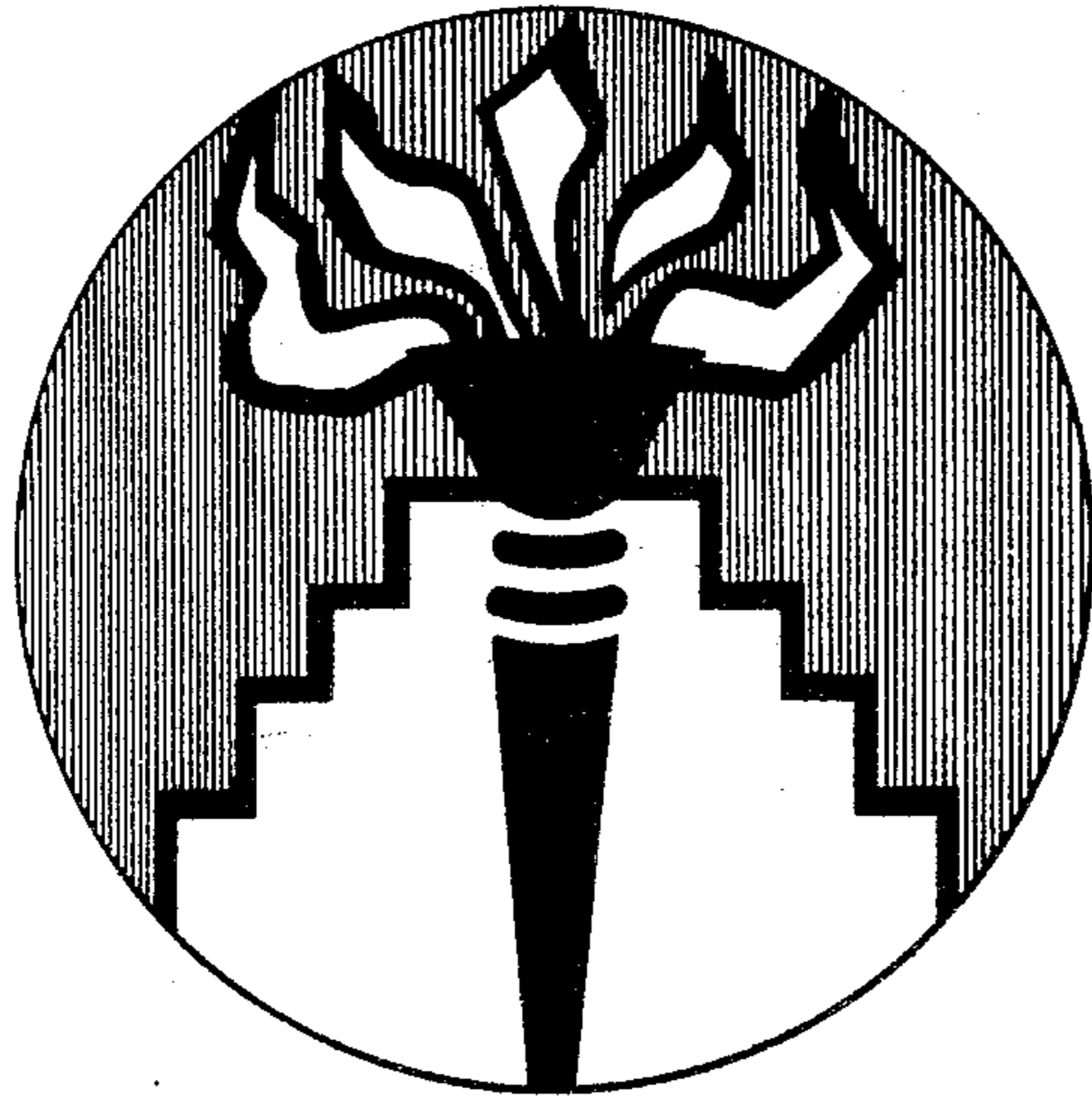
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a medallion showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the medallion of FIG. 1.
