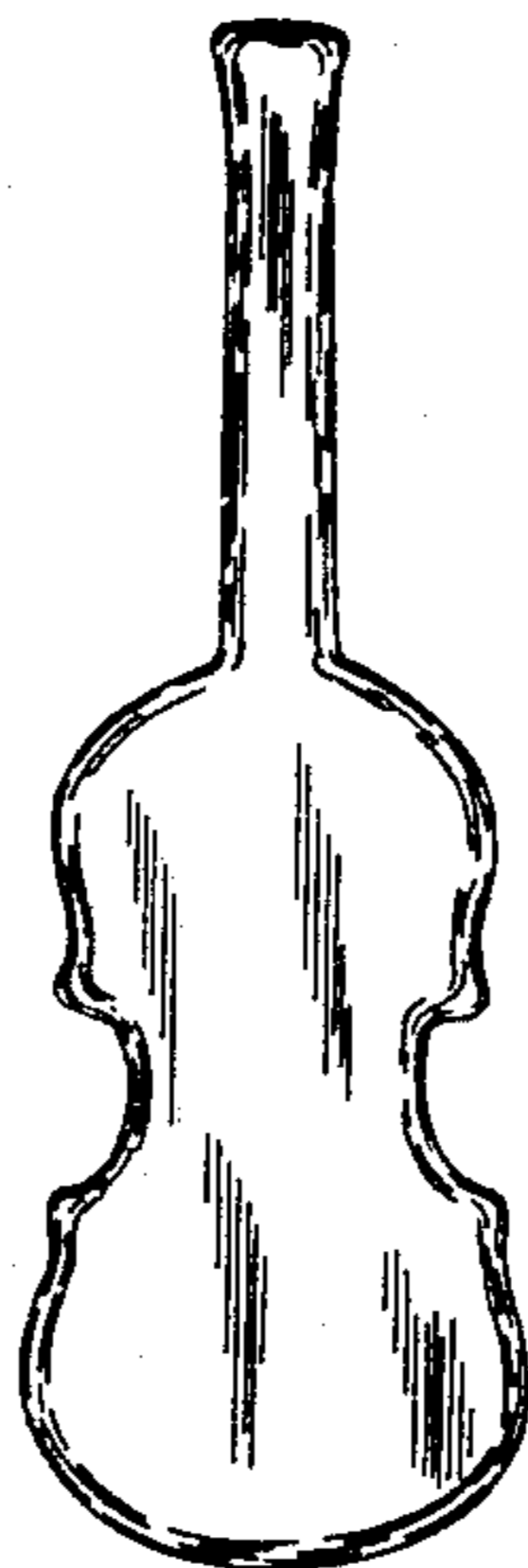

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a violin learning board, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a violin learning board showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, turned 90° from FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image; and
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.



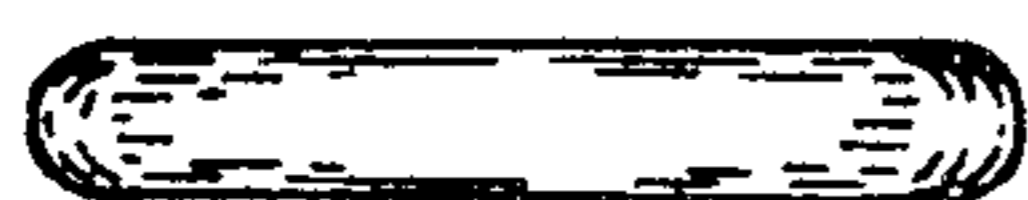

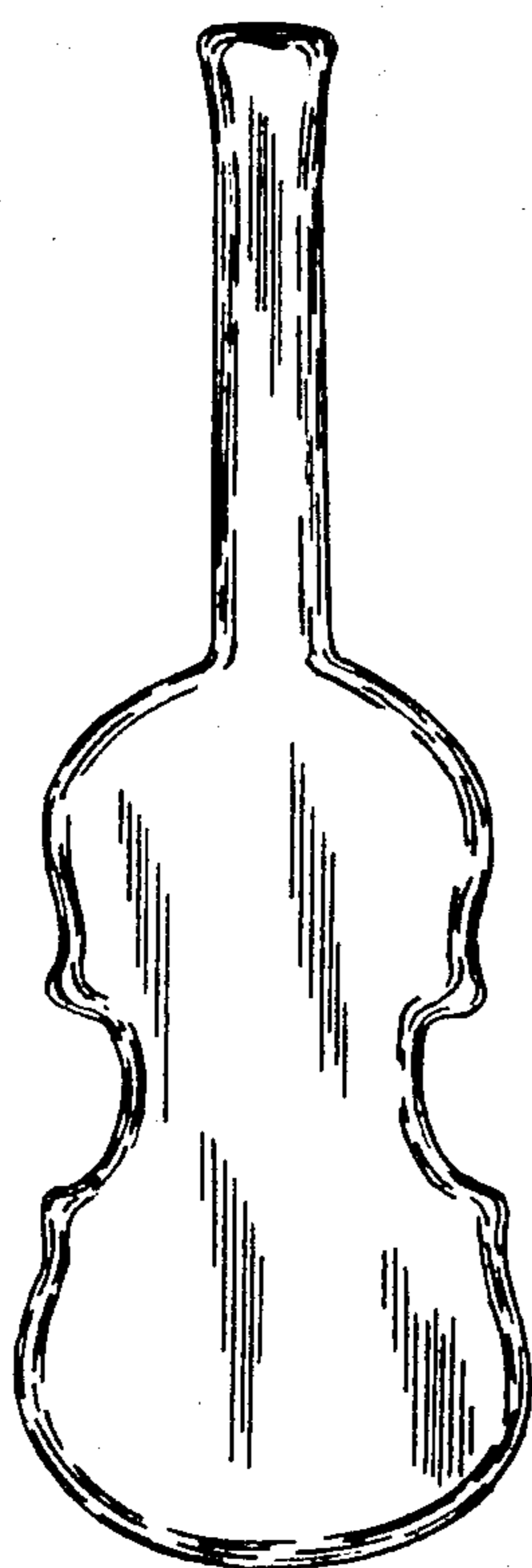
